RACE 1:EBF NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE)

Sed Maarib Dreadfort Alpine Lady

SED MAARIB improved from his debut when finishing second at Salisbury earlier this month, catching the eye with the way he closed out his race. With further improvement looking likely, the son of American Pharoah may be capable of breaking his maiden in this novice contest. Dreadfort offered promise despite showing inexperience on his first racecourse start at Ayr and may step up significantly this time, while Alpine Lady posted an encouraging debut performance from a wide draw at Carlisle and also looks worthy of consideration.

A chance is taken on the veteran MISTAMEL in this selling handicap, with the combination of a recent stable switch and the addition of cheekpieces expected to provide a major spark. Archive ran well when second over course and distance last time and is feared in first-time cheekpieces, while Flower Power enters the race in good form after a recent second at Catterick and should also get involved.

SHOWTIME MAHOMES showed a smart change of gear when breaking his maiden at Musselburgh on his penultimate start and, having not been disgraced in the Super Sprint at Newbury last time, looks capable of landing this novice contest under a 7lb penalty. Le Beau Garcon made a promising debut when second behind a useful prospect at Catterick earlier this month and should go well, while Ayling, who finished third in that same Catterick race, may also do better on just his second start.

The daughter of Acclamation is usually ridden under prominent tactics and has a good draw to capitalise from. However, there could be a strong pace on with Ava Go Joe, Impressor and Ventura Flame also liking to go forward. Therefore, SARAS HOPE might prove to be the answer after an encouraging return at Haydock earlier this month. The four-year-old gelding is normally held up and is likely to be doing his best work late on.
