R1 - GOLD COAST | 13:02 | AUD \$35,000 | 2YO TAB CALCUTTA ON SALE MDN

2	CAMERLENGO	Promising colt with placings at both career runs to date. Last start was third over 1100m at Gosford. Close to a win and should prove hard to beat.
9	SAKURA STAR	Resumes today after showing some ability in her debut prep placing once. Rates highly today.
6	SACRED ZIM	3yo colt who is making his debut here. Had four trials leading in to this. Latest was a win at Gold Coast over 1000m. Chance for the minors.
5	I AM THIRTY	3yo gelding who is making his debut here. Had three trials leading in to this. Latest was a win at Gold Coast over 1000m. Chance for the minors.
14	COME IN SPINNER	Finished a close second at Ipswich over 1200m last start as favourite. Winning chance.

R2 - GOLD COAST | 13:37 | AUD \$35,000 | BOXING DAY RACEDAY HCP (C2)

2	EURO BELLE	Finished a close third at Eagle Farm over 1400m in most recent effort as favourite. Main contender.
4	KATERU	Resumes in this after five months off. Goes well fresh. Trialled leading up to this so fitness shouldn't be a query. Can take this.
5	HAIL MANHATTAN	Resumed over 1100m and missed the placings when a 4 length fourth at Ipswich. Fitter again and rates a strong winning chance to break through.
3	EMMA'S JET	Resumes here after a five months spell and a 900m Gold Coast barrier trial where he placed. Form last campaign was excellent and a forward showing is to be expected.
12	AVIEMORE	Resuming from a spell in this. Only career win came in metropolitan grade when winning as a two-year-old. She has ability and with the drop in grade features as a top chance.

R3 - GOLD COAST | 14:12 | AUD \$35,000 | AQUIS \$1.5M RACEDAY 9/1 (BM72)

6	DIVINE DIVA	Has been racing well in recent times including a win two starts back at Ipswich before running third at Ipswich last start. Going well at present and is not to be discounted.
10	WARP SPEED	Finished a close second at this track over 1800m as favourite last start. Will take catching.
4	NORTH AFRIKA	Won four times earlier on in his prep, most recently ran sixth by 4.5 lengths at Doomben over 1615m. Rates a strong chance.
2	BATTLE PLANE	Made all last start and came away with a win at Beaudesert over 1650m on November 19. Proven to be race fit now. Expect another forward showing today.
5	KIRIANA	Scored a metropolitan win at Doomben last time out, should have an easier time dropping back to a provincial track today. Looks a good race for her and should go close.

R4 - GOLD COAST | 14:50 | AUD \$35,000 | TAB HCP (C5)

5	PINNACLE STAR	Went down by a head to finish second at Doomben over 1200m in most recent effort as favourite. Well drawn. Improver. Top Hope.
3	SUPERBOWL SUNDAY	Five-year-old gelding who won last time at this distance, winning by a nose at Ipswich. Going well and on strong record at this distance looks hard to beat again.
7	PARKO	Back from a three months spell following 1.5 lengths fourth over 1200m at Doomben. Rates highly here and looks well placed here fresh.
8	BARODA	Was not beaten far when win two starts back before running a disappointing 12th last start at this track. Winner at this track and should get a good run from barrier 1. Looms as a threat.
6	EXACTAMENTE	Lead the whole way when win over 1100m last start. Can contest.

7	TEST OF WAR	Led all the way first up and came away with a win at this track over 1200m on November 14. Proven to be race fit now. Expect another forward showing today.
2	SIDEKISS	Four-year-old gelding who has a liking for this distance with multiple wins at this journey. Well suited here. Should prove hard to beat.
5	INDIAN DREAMER	Consistent galloper fitter for two runs from a spell, the latest when 2.5 lengths fifth over 1350m at Ipswich. Good record overall and rates highly in this.
6	THE HAND	Returned from a spell last start when runner up beaten a head at Ipswich on November 18 over 1350m. Rates as the one to beat.
12	ROYAL SHEEN	Drops in journey since latest outing at Ipswich when seventh, finishing 4.5 lengths off the winner. Appears to be a top chance.
