

RACE 1 11:10 AM | \$22,000 | CANBERRA | 1000m

10	TRAPEAZY	Trials (2:0-0-0). Unplaced in trials but latest was okay on a soft 5. Markets may prove best pointer.
3	UNION	Trials (2:0-0-1). By super sire Snitzel and making his career debut after showing fair ability in latest Randwick trial. Good draw for career opener. Market may prove a more fruitful guide.
4	AGRARIAN GIRL	Trials (2:2-0-0). By Tassort and out of a Mulaazem mare. Showing promise with wins at all trials. Market may prove best guide to expectations.

9	GEOSTORM	Smart on his day. Pretty good effort in defeat at Parkes over this trip. Has form this track and distance. Makes a strong case in this company.
2	DOLCE DIOR	First-up (17-weeks). Nice gate. Rates highly fresh in this affair.
3	FLASHY ICON	Just missed at Canberra 28 Dec. Got back, ran on late with purpose to claim second at Albury over this trip. Right in the mix.
4	EVER WAS	Fresh. Honest battler. Came from well back to place in a 2100m Benchmark 58 at Orange over a longer assignment. Has claims.
5	SIR TUA	Void of early speed but he let down strongly into the placings in Class 1 company at Wyong. Can make his presence felt.

2	MASTER OF WAR	Patiently handled and battled to line 3.3 lengths 5th at Newcastle when seemingly unfancied on debut. Drawn favourably. Among the dangers.
8	LISTEN SWEETHEART	First-up (17-weeks). Brought on with two trial hitouts. Each-way.
1	FAIR MASTER	Stepping out for only the second time after battling home at Parkes when in the market 24 Jan. Could give some cheek at odds.

8	SUPER SIOUX	Let-up (53-days). Mare specialises under 6-furlongs. Courageous when defeated 1 length second (Bm74) at Kempsey over this distance. This looks very winnable.
3	GOLD LOVER	Let-up (51-days). Forwardly placed, continued to stick on for third 3yo+ (Bm72) at Warwick Farm over this trip. Since trialled at Armidale 18 Jan. Nice gate.
9	DUNE AND DUSTED	Prominent and stuck to his guns running third at Grafton. Good draw. Key player.
1	RIVKIN	Long time since last saluted. Trailed speed, kept coming but winner too strong at Muswellbrook at first run for new trainer. Fitter second-up. Sticky draw to negotiate.

RACE 5 1:20 PM | \$30,000 | WALCHA | 1700m

5	TOULON FACTOR	Experienced campaigner. Ran an honest race and not beaten far at Parkes. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Hard fit and worth a look.
6	ALASKA DREAM	Rounded them up smartly in the small field at Grafton last outing. Can challenge.
4	A TENT HUT	Real tradesman. Determined winner at Deepwater when in the market. Deep into his campaign and can have a say here.
2	AIRSWING	Went close at Glen Innes two back. Stationed handy, tried hard but winner was simply too good at Warwick. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Drawn to get an economic trail.
9	AKAUWHEO	Was a long way from the action in 2150m (Bm58) at Gunnedah. Coming back in distance. Rates a risky proposition.

1	VORACIOUS	Now 5 weeks between runs. Ex T G Payne in NSW. Rode the speed and kept finding to salute at Inverell at first run for new trainer. On pacer.
12	TO BE FRANK	Not disgraced in Country Boosted (Bm66) at Armidale at first run back at \$3.90. Fitter second-up. Rough place prospect.

1	DAD AND DAVE	Made short work of the small field in the Launceston Guineas at Launceston. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Form good enough for this.
7	HELIOSON	Never a threat after showing no early speed from the barriers at Flemington. Only for wider exotics.
4	ADMIRE FLUKE	Went close at Wodonga two back. Finished too well winning 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Wangaratta last outing. Can play a role.

9	THANKGODITSFRIDAY	Reserved at back and gave late chase into third at Launceston. Drawn well. Only for wider exotics.
3	VERHOEVEN	Broke his maiden at start number 11 at Hobart. Place.

1	WHIPPIN PICCADILLY	Restrained, powered home to get up in final bounds at Launceston. Drops to shorter trip. Super fit from racing and right in the mix.
3	EASTCOAST MISS	Honest performance without menacing winner in the small field this venue. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Decent alley.
6	CAPITAL CHEVAL	Resuming (24-weeks). Seen in 3 trials since he last faced the starter. Ticks the track and distance win box and under less weight. Good draw and under less weight.
