

**RACE 1** 10:25 AM | AUD27,000 | **GRAFTON** | 1015m

1	<b>EVER SO READY</b>	Sent forward but flat-footed when things got serious at Doomben. Leads, handy. Looks the pick of these.
8	<b>WIN STAR</b>	On a quick back-up. Never a threat after showing no early speed from the barriers at Eagle Farm at her second race start.
2	<b>WITHOUT SURRENDER</b>	Promising debut performance this track 19 Apr as an odds drifter. Should come on. Among the dangers.
3	<b>ACRODANCE</b>	Kicks off second campaign (18-weeks). Broke maiden at Sunshine Coast in her first preparation. Goes into wider exotics fresh in this affair.

**RACE 2** 10:45 AM | AUD100,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1300m

1	<b>GRAFFITI TYCOON</b>	Looks a handy type judging by early form. Ran on soundly into second in the small field at Canterbury in only his second race appearance. Decent alley. Fitter, has scope to progress.
2	<b>CONDONE</b>	Returns for second campaign (31-weeks). Will have matured. Just missed on debut last prep and on song for return with 3 trials. Has plenty of scope to improve this time in. Can have a major say fresh in this line-up.
7	<b>ARTGIRL</b>	Couldn't get anywhere near winner but slogged away for a placing in the small field at Randwick-Kensington. Will be fitter second-up. Right in the mix.
5	<b>CLANWILLIAM</b>	Form to date sound. Ran a cracking race when just edged out at Newcastle 23 Apr. Will be fitter second-up. Comes back in trip a touch.

**RACE 3** 11:00 AM | AUD27,000 | **GRAFTON** | 1720m

3	<b>FOXY ARTIST</b>	Early form encouraging. Left in winner's wake but ran on soundly for 2.1 len third in the small field this track. Scope for improvement. Looking for this trip now.
4	<b>FRICTIONAL FORCE</b>	Freshened. Went home tamely this venue at \$8. Capable of making an impact.
1	<b>BURNING AMBITION</b>	Just missed at Grafton 30 Mar. Had all before him at turn and went home tamely at Wellington. In the placings only prior run here. Can put last run behind him.
7	<b>VIRGINIA BREEZES</b>	Sent back to the tail when 2.6 len 5th of 6 here. Not out of this.

**RACE 4** 11:20 AM | AUD60,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1000m

3	<b>CELTIC SPY</b>	Returns for second campaign (21-weeks). With elite stable but had a low-key debut at at Wyong 10 Dec. Had 2 trials since and has plenty of scope to improve. Good gate.
2	<b>ARTEMEX</b>	In the market all runs. Ran home into the minors Mdn at Newcastle in only his second race appearance. Commands serious attention.
9	<b>PORTICO</b>	Refused to shirk task in 2yo Mdn Plate at Hawkesbury in only his second race appearance. Nice gate. Can challenge.
7	<b>LORD HORATIO</b>	Trials (3:1-0-1). Showed good improvement to win his latest trial at Rosehill. Dylan Gibbons sticks from latest trial. Follow betting leads.

**RACE 5** 11:35 AM | AUD30,000 | **GRAFTON** | 1115m

9	<b>SWORD OF LEGACY</b>	Freshened after resuming from a break. Merit in Stakes form. Couldn't get near winner but found enough for the minors at Eagle Farm. Will be fitter second-up.
2	<b>IMMORTAL STORM</b>	Back for second campaign (24-weeks). Will have furnished. Displayed early promise. Nearly won in Maiden company at Grafton first-up last campaign. Posted some decent efforts in last campaign.
8	<b>COMMEDIA</b>	Rarely far away. Courageous in front and only denied in final bounds at Ballina. Capable of making an impact.
5	<b>SNEAKY BID</b>	4 weeks since last run. Stepping out for only the second time after battling home this track after easing in betting 7 Apr. Should improve off that. Could add some value to exotics.

**RACE 6** 11:55 AM | AUD60,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1000m

8	<b>TI AMO</b>	Excellent debut performance when just nabbed at Newcastle at \$5. Has scope. Can play a role.
12	<b>KRASINA</b>	Returning for second campaign (13-weeks). Wasn't all that far away in first campaign. Better for two runs and can build on that.
13	<b>PALMANOVA</b>	Returns for second campaign (22-weeks). In very good hands however returned a disappointing debut performance at at Rosehill 29 Nov. Had two subsequent trials, latest at Canterbury 10 Apr. Drawn to effect.
4	<b>LA BARRITA</b>	Trials (1:1-0-0). Cantered to an easy trial win at Caulfield Heath, 23 Apr. Jamie Melham stays on from trial. Well worth a look.

**RACE 7** 12:10 PM | AUD27,000 | **GRAFTON** | 1215m

4	<b>TOO HOT TO TORQUE</b>	Broke maiden at Lismore 26 Sep. Solid performance in defeat in the Country Boosted Hcp (C1) at Ballina at first run off a long break. Commands attention here.
8	<b>ON MY COMMAND</b>	Strode away from rivals to score an impressive debut win this track. Among the dangers.
1	<b>IN THE FINE PRINT</b>	Let-up (80-days). Went close at Murwillumbah two back 1 Feb. Reserved at rear, late into the frame at Coffs Harbour over a longer test. Down in class.
6	<b>RUPESTRIS</b>	Resuming (23-weeks). Will have matured further while indicating was forward winning a Ballina trial. Wet form - soft (3:1-0-0); untested heavy. Worth a look fresh in this line-up.

**RACE 8** 12:30 PM | AUD60,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1100m

6	<b>AGAINST THE LAW</b>	Ran on soundly from midfield at Canterbury over this distance. Form good enough for this.
1	<b>RIMBAUD</b>	On pace, not beaten far this track when off an extended spell. On pacer. Fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim. Not out of this.
4	<b>SUPER BRIGHT</b>	Let-up (68-days). Wasn't far away finishing 0.6 len 4th in a bunched finish at Canterbury. Since trialed at Gosford 13 Apr. Rates highly fresh in this company.
5	<b>ZALE</b>	Strode forward off wide gate, fought on bravely to just miss at Canterbury at last start this journey. Maps to get a sweet run. Makes strong appeal.

**RACE 9** 12:50 PM | AUD30,000 | **GRAFTON** | 1420m

1	<b>SINATRA</b>	Did little at Doomben first up following a market drift. Wet form - soft (1:1-0-0); untested heavy. Will be fitter second-up. Expect a much stronger performance here.
10	<b>OUR SPARKY</b>	Ran on soundly into third in the small field at Ballina when off an extended spell. Fitter second-up. One for exotics.
5	<b>HIGH VOLTAGE</b>	Back to the track for second campaign (18-weeks). Broke maiden at Kempsey in her first preparation. Can challenge fresh in this company.
2	<b>ARCHIE MAXIMUS</b>	Freshened. Prominent and scooted clear here 7 Apr. First try at 1420m. Among the dangers.

**RACE 10** 1:10 PM | AUD60,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1600m

13	<b>SUPERFABULISTIC</b>	Knocking on the door. Just missed at Hawkesbury 8 Apr. Trailed pace and ran on gamely at Canterbury. Good gate and a nice weight drop.
4	<b>IS IT SPECTACULAR</b>	5 weeks since last run. Gritty on pace victory Hcp (C1) at Newcastle. Since impressed with a Wyong trial win 24 Apr. Winner at only other start at Warwick Farm.
11	<b>ZOUFIELD</b>	Let-up (56-days). Won a 1400m Benchmark 65 at Canberra two back. Started \$3.50 when safely held in Benchmark 72 company in soft going this track at second run back. Drawn favourably.
9	<b>LONTRICE</b>	Fresh. Terrific winning the 3yo+ Mdn over 1600m at Hawkesbury at \$1.60. Drawn to receive every chance. Among the dangers.

**RACE 11** 1:25 PM | AUD27,000 | **GRAFTON** | 1015m

3	<b>DANCE GAVIN DANCE</b>	On target for hat-trick. Ran on well to bag a 1.5 len win in the Country Boosted Hcp (C1) at Ballina. On pacer. Right in the mix.
17	<b>LORD SEYMOUR</b>	Prominent and fought on determinedly in the Mdn Plate at Coffs Harbour at first run for new trainer. Leads, handy. Wet form - soft (2:1-0-0); untested heavy. Goes into wider exotics.
8	<b>DARN HOT LADY</b>	Resuming (17-weeks). Proven fresh and looks fit for return to racing. Jump-and-run filly. Highly fancied for a winning return.
11	<b>STEFFI ELECTRICA</b>	Let-up (67-days). Out of the money in testing conditions at Gold Coast at skinny odds. Since trialled at Beaudesert 9 Apr. Lone victory was over this trip.

**RACE 12** 1:50 PM | AUD60,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1300m

5	<b>SUPERMASSIVE</b>	Won two from four. Fought hard on the speed to bag the 3,4yo (Bm64) at Canterbury at first run back. Leader. Highly rated in this line-up.
1	<b>WHO EVER THOUGHT</b>	Resuming (24-weeks). Landed Coonabarabran Cup win Coonabarabran 26 Oct. Good recent trial. Decent alley and a proven weight carrier.
3	<b>ICEMAN</b>	Let-up (53-days). Had all before at turn and let down with a raking drive in Benchmark 78 company at Rosehill over a longer test. Since trialled at Warwick Farm 23 Apr. Adept heavy/proven track.
14	<b>JACOB'S LADDER</b>	Ran home into the minors Midway (Bm68) at Gosford when off an extended spell. Fitter second-up. Can play a role.

**RACE 13** 2:05 PM | AUD27,000 | **GRAFTON** | 1190m

1	<b>THE WOLF</b>	Set tempo and surrendered late but had enough in the tank for second (Bm82) in second run from spell. Leads, handy. Ticks the wet and track boxes. All the better and form good enough for this.
9	<b>COUNT NICHOLAS</b>	On a quick back-up. Genuine short-course sprinter. Knuckled down well winning the (Bm58) under a big impost at Gold Coast Poly. Placed two from two here.
2	<b>THE GAMBLING GREEK</b>	Forwardly placed, continued to stick on at Ipswich. Has early speed. Wet form - soft (4:1-0-0); untested heavy. Makes strong appeal.
8	<b>YENDY</b>	Ran on soundly into third in the small field at Gold Coast. Not out of this.

**RACE 14** 2:25 PM | AUD60,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1300m

2	<b>JUST GLAMOUROUS</b>	Scrubbed up from the wide gate and boxed on bravely for a 0.2 len win this venue. Better draw here and big weights don't seem to worry her. Ratings lift after that win but stays under strong notice at same level.
8	<b>ISHIKARI</b>	On target for hat-trick. Sent forward from the wide gate and slipped clear to a decisive victory at Randwick. More suitable draw. Has claims for a repeat.
10	<b>BLITZGAL</b>	Gave a decent kick but overhauled late at Canterbury. Can challenge with even luck.
13	<b>LOERA</b>	Prominent and dug in deep to score at Canterbury at her second race start. Tim Clark retains the ride. Stripping fitter and commands attention here.
