5	TIS NO MAN	Trailed pace and kicked strongly in the slosh at Gundagai second-up. Suited by the longer assignment now and can play a role if things pan out.
7	RUSSIAN GANGSTER	Straight into the black book after a terrific DH debut win in the soft at Narrandera. Hard to knock winning form.
