

RACE 1 10:25 AM | \$120,000 | ROSEHILL | 1500m

4	TOMMY FLYER	Shouldered 61.5kg to victory at Sapphire Coast. Set tempo and surrendered late but had enough in the tank for second in the 3yo+ Highway Hcp (C3) at Kembla Grange. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Leader.
3	SANTATIME	Knuckled down strongly from back half to salute in the 3yo+ Plate (C1) Class 1 1600m at Gosford. More suitable draw and under less weight. This looks very winnable.
1	TIETAR	Chasing hat-trick. Solid 61.5kg winner at Grafton 5 Nov. Pressed pace in choppy conditions put paid to them in a matter of strides when in the market. On pacer.
2	ZUCCHERO	Just got the nod in at Scone at first run off a long break. Drops in weight for this. Will be fitter second-up. Good gate and a nice weight drop.
7	STORMBRINGER	In touch and fought on dauntlessly for a 0.3 length win at Canberra. Maps wells. Has claims.

RACE 2 11:00 AM | \$160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1500m

5	SWIFT LEGEND	Knuckled down well from midfield to salute at Canterbury. Has a tricky draw to contend with this time. Could give some cheek at odds.
1	EDITING	Has decent Stakes form. Ran on soundly into second in the small field at Kembla Grange. Makes a strong case in this company.
2	DARK SIMBA	Last at turn, ran on late at Caulfield at resumption. Will be fitter second-up. Drawn more favourably. Warrants attention.
4	VIKTOR	Just got the nod in at Newcastle second-up. Well placed for repeat.
9	MORTAL HALO	Cleared maiden ranks at Scone 24 Oct. Close-up and gave his all to just here second-up. Nicely weighted. Can play a role.

RACE 3 11:35 AM | \$160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1200m

9	PLAINTIFF	Made immediate impact on the track with a convincing win this venue 12 Nov. Has a touch of quality and deserves a shot in metro company.
7	SUPERMASSIVE	Just missed at Kembla Grange 4 Nov. Rode the speed and kept finding to salute at Canterbury at his second race start. Tim Clark retains the ride. Breaks from a low barrier.
1	DAMIEN	Freshened after resuming from a break. Reserved midfield and picked up intently for a 1 length third this track. Since trialled at Gosford 25 Nov. Others with more appeal.
3	LOVING	Back to the track for second campaign (23-weeks). Ex James Cummings in NSW. Brought on with two trial hitouts. Happy to watch.
4	NITRO	Ran on okay into the placings this venue at his second race start. Good draw and under less weight. Sound claims.

RACE 4 12:10 PM | \$160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1100m

2	CARBONADOS	Freshened after resuming from a break. Made short work of the small field in the 5yo+ (Bm84) at Randwick at first run back. Rates highly.
6	HAWKER HALL	Going well lately. Prominent and went down fighting in soft going in the Benchmark 78 company at Kembla Grange at first run back. Fitter second-up. Has early speed.
7	CREPE MYRTLE	Striving for hat-trick. Finished too well to claim victory at Canterbury at this distance, when in the market. Drops in weight for this. Among the dangers.
5	HANAU	Resuming (18-weeks). Tends to race well first-up without winning while fitted with 2 Gosford trials. Awkwardly drawn. Rough place prospect fresh in this line-up.
4	DOLLAR MAGIC	Let-up (78-days). Led, gave away late finishing 2.5 lengths astern of winner at Randwick. Since trialled at Scone 19 Nov. Looks a first four candidate.

3	FLYING THINKER	Sent out \$16 when unable to threaten on a soft deck at Kembla Grange when off an extended spell. Winner at only other start at Rosehill. Fitter second-up. Worth a look.
7	WINGS OF DESIRE	Game win from just off the pace at Caulfield Heath at first run for new trainer. Will be fitter second-up. Form good enough for this.
5	DAME COMMANDER	Resuming (25-weeks). Fresh form solid without winning while fitted with 2 Hawkesbury trials. On pacer, perfect gate. Key player fresh in this line-up.
4	SUPER NUI	Started \$13 when handily placed and showed fine turn of foot to register a 1 length win at Kembla Grange. Each-way.
2	CHANGING COLOURS	First-up (19-weeks). Proven fresh and looks fit for return to racing. Won only other time at Rosehill. Sound claims.

RACE 6 1:30 PM | \$28,000 | **SUNSHINE COAST** | 1600m

12	BATTLESPACE	Not disgraced at Ipswich. On pacer. Warrants attention.
14	SAVVY BEE	On a quick back-up. Hasn't been all that far away. Kept coming and just fell short at Ipswich. Deep into her campaign and among the dangers.
13	DEEP DAWN	Off pace and comfortably beaten at Ipswich. Each-way.
11	ACE'S IN BLOOM	Prominent and went down fighting in the Benchmark 60 company at Beaudesert. Rise to 1600m a new challenge. Has early speed. Can be thereabouts.
6	HAMILTON BROWN	Long time since last saluted. Raced in back half and failed to issue a serious challenge at Doomben second-up. Has a tricky draw to contend with this time. Can run a drum.

2	DUST ASIDE	Set for second campaign. Will have furnished and strengthened over the spell (27-weeks). Given two trials. Battled home on a soft deck at Pinjarra Scarp side on debut. Worth a look fresh in this affair.
9	MODERN GIRL	In the money at her only start at Narrogin 20 Nov. Better for race experience. More suitable draw. Wiser for the run and should have more to offer.
7	TENNESSEE SPIRIT	Freshened. Capitalist filly who has displayed some early ability and heavily supported at each occasion. Couldn't go with first two but ran home for third at Northam. Improver, fitter third-up.

3	AMBASSADORS	Given an armchair ride and slipped clear to a 2.2 lengths verdict at Ipswich 20 Nov. Can lead or take a sit.
4	DOWNEY	Settled at rear, produced a grinding charge into the placings at Toowoomba.
11	SIRKEL	Out of the money in soft going at Doomben at second run back.
15	RINGER'S REWARD	Last win was 8 Apr 2023. Picked up intently to just miss in the 3yo+ Plate (C2) at Ipswich. Drops to shorter trip.
2	DRIALLE	Turned on the speed and fended off challengers to narrowly prevail at Beaudesert 23 Nov. Leads, handy.

11	LOVE OF FAR FA	Just missed at Bunbury 4 Nov. Put in some big strides late to place here when blew out in betting. Right in the mix.
7	AWESOME FORCE	Promising Admire Mars 3year-old. Showed a fine turn of foot from the back to snare second place at Belmont Park. Looking for this trip now. Form good enough for this.
5	IRAYCHOUX	Wasn't beaten far this track at resumption. Can play a role.
1	YALDA NIGHT	Did little 8 lengths 6th at Narrogin when in the market. Has claims.
12	SHE'S RESOLUTE	Well back and made minor headway when 5th at Narrogin. Switching to 1695m. Can run a drum.

8	FLY AWAY FLIRT	On speed, outgunned late but had enough in the tank for second 3yo+ Mdn at Narrogin over a longer test. Drops to shorter trip. On pacer. Worth a look.
10	BIT TIRED ACTUALLY	Went close at York two back. Brave in defeat 1.6 lengths third 3yo+ Mdn here at her second race start. Can play a role.
2	EXTREME RULER	Just wacked away without threatening over 1400m 3yo+ Mdn this track over this distance. Good draw. Warrants attention.
11	CHINO BAY	Trials (2:0-0-0). Market may prove a more fruitful guide.

RACE 11 3:45 PM | \$25,000 | **BUNBURY** | 1200m

2	BULLETIN BEAU	Resuming (19-weeks). Signalled potential in his in first campaign. Highly fancied for a winning return.
9	OFFSHORE	Resuming (24-weeks). Form reasonable. Went close at Northam two back. Tried up super at Belmont Park 24 Nov.
3	HOPE TO ADMIRE	Off the speed, picked up soundly and wasn't beaten far at Belmont Park when off an extended spell. Strips fitter second run back. Breaks from a low barrier. Makes strong appeal.
6	GINGER TED	Not disgraced in 3yo+ Mdn at Belmont Park at first run back at \$81. Will be fitter second-up. Has claims.
5	LAST SHOUT	Kicks off second campaign (26-weeks). Ex B P Fitzgerald in WA. Indicated some potential placing at both his starts in first campaign. Market watch advised in first run for new stable.

RACE 12 4:20 PM | \$30,000 | **BUNBURY** | 1000m

6	TROPICAL SUN	Just missed at York 9 Nov. Under early hold and got home late for third at \$3.40 at Narrogin. Good gate and under less weight. Can play a role.
3	BLUE CAN TALK	Set tempo, offered little resistance when challenged 4.5 lengths 7th here. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Barrier a blow but possesses early toe. Highly rated in this line-up.
1	MANTUA	Sound form. Had the last crack at them and just missed 3yo+ Hcp (C3) this venue. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Makes strong appeal.
4	FANZ	Well back and never a factor this track second-up. Can be thereabouts.
2	PRIVATE SAPLING	First-up (15-weeks). Tends to race well first-up without winning. Awkwardly drawn. Minor money hope at best fresh in this line-up.

RACE 13 4:55 PM | \$30,000 | BUNBURY | 1400m

2	JAZALOT	Last, unleashed driving charge late to fill the minors this venue when off an extended spell. Strips fitter second run back. Drawn to effect. Right in the mix.
6	RIVER ANGEL	Midfield, lacked needed kick when 4.2 lengths 4th this track. Should relish the rise in distance. Rates highly.
7	GOD'S GRIN	Racing with conviction. Just got the nod in at Geraldton. Highly rated in this line-up.
8	KIDDING ME	Lightly raced and still learning the caper. Comes here after a determined 0.1 length 3yo+ Mdn win at Geraldton second-up. Rise to 1400m a new challenge. Good draw.
1	SPACE ACE	Raced in back half and never likely when 10.4 lengths 8th at Albany. Will be fitter second-up and takes a 3kg claim. Awkwardly drawn this time. One for exotics.

RACE 14 5:30 PM | \$30,000 | BUNBURY | 1200m

4	THREE GRAND	Let-up (69-days). Smart sprinter who likes to dominate up on the speed. Went close at Bunbury two back. Crossed to race forward, gave solid kick and fought on bravely for 0.1 length victory this venue 29 Sep.
6	UNIVERSAL HOTNESS	Wasn't beaten far here at first run off a long break. Fitter second-up. Highly rated in this line-up.
3	HIT THE JACKPOT	Short course specialist. Midfield, unable to muster a threatening rally when 3.6 lengths 9th this track. Since trialled at Lark Hill 1 Dec. More suitable draw and 3kg helps the cause.
14	STORM LORD	Aiming for hat-trick. Impressive coming from back half to score at Narrogin. One for multiples.
5	RUN PATTIE RUN	Trimmed margin late at Albany first up. Has a tricky draw. Place.
