

**RACE 1** 10:10 AM | AUD30,000 | **SCONE** | 1000m

2	<b>OAKFIELD MISSOURI</b>	Trials (4:1-0-0). It's all systems go for this gelding after winning a 1000m trial at Tamworth. Locally trained. Well worth a look.
3	<b>SPELLECAST</b>	Never better than midfield in the 3yo+ Mdn at Newcastle first up. Placed in Maiden company at Gunnedah second-up last campaign. Can play a role.
7	<b>FLAUNTER</b>	Trials (2:0-0-1). Making debut after two lead-up trials. Might be one to watch at this stage.
6	<b>PARIAH CAREY</b>	Fresh. Last at turn, ran on late at Quirindi in only her second race appearance. Only for the minors here.

**RACE 2** 10:45 AM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 900m

3	<b>COPPERLINE</b>	Pushed forward and found enough to score as a \$7.50 chance this venue in only his second race appearance. Ms M Weir retains the ride. Switching to 900m. Tougher grade but can measure up.
2	<b>THIRD BASE</b>	Finished full of running and just shaded in sloppy conditions (Bm64) at Newcastle in second run from spell. Jumps from better barrier. Likes some give in the track. Sharper now and will take stopping in this company.
7	<b>FLYING MOLLY</b>	Freshened. Handy competitor. Finally in the winner's circle with a 0.6 len victory at Quirindi second-up. Draws to do no work.
6	<b>GO RUSSIAN</b>	Broke maiden at Quirindi 28 Apr. Left in winner's wake but trudged home for the minors at Newcastle at last start this journey. Among the dangers back at country level.

**RACE 3** 11:20 AM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 1600m

2	<b>FORTHEO</b>	Strong win from off the pace in the Super Mdn Plate at Gunnedah, Kody Nestor retains the ride. In the placings only prior run here. Has claims for a repeat.
1	<b>DUNSTALL THE GUN</b>	Ridden cold, responded well but left with too much to do in testing conditions this track. Only win to date was this distance. Well into preparation now and could give some cheek at odds.
5	<b>GRANDE DIABLO</b>	Cleared maiden ranks at Tamworth 24 Apr. Finished well down the track in Plate (C1) at Warren last outing. Can atone for latest performance.
6	<b>HEAPY'S LEGACY</b>	Let-up (45-days). Well back and never sighted at Bathurst when off an extended spell after easing in betting. Wet form - soft (2:1-0-0); untested heavy. Not out of this.

**RACE 4** 11:55 AM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 1300m

10	<b>SERIOUS JEWEL</b>	Debut effort fair in spread-out finish this venue at huge odds 15 May. Better for race exposure. Added trip may suit. Capable of making an impact.
1	<b>BLANKS</b>	Trials (2:0-0-0). Soft in trial work but might show more under race conditions. Nice gate for first outing. Odds may prove best guide here.
12	<b>IMMORTAL ROSE</b>	Resuming (27-weeks). Ex Daniel Bowman in SA. Nearly won in Maiden company at Warrnambool first-up last campaign. Big watch under new trainer off long lay-off.
5	<b>ASTOUND BEAUTY</b>	Let-up (79-days). Astern 3yo with share of potential. Couldn't match winner but held on for second in rain affected going at Goulburn at latest outing. Two tick over trials since.

**RACE 5** 12:35 PM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 1100m

4	<b>GREAT HEIGHTS</b>	Let-up (61-days). Ex C J Waller in NSW. Raced in back half and failed to issue a serious challenge at Gosford. Two tick over trials since.
6	<b>VERY SIRIUS</b>	Handily placed and gave her all at Canberra Acton when in the market. Only win to date was this distance. Commands attention here.
1	<b>IRON FURY</b>	Resuming (22-weeks). In the minors at Beaumont first-up last campaign but wasn't pushed out in latest trial. Untested in wet. Could give some cheek at odds fresh in this affair.
3	<b>SUKIDA</b>	Resuming after a (67-weeks) spell. Ex Richard & Will Freedman. Trained here now. Wet form - soft (2:1-0-0); untested heavy. Latest trial hitout good at Tamworth and keeping safe at first run for new stable off long lay-off.

**RACE 6** 1:10 PM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 1700m

8	<b>CROWN LEGEND</b>	Now 4 weeks between runs. Bathurst (Bm58) placegetter 25 Apr. Did little at Mudgee over a longer assignment when in the market. Back to a BM58.
6	<b>AUTUMN HEIR</b>	Beyond midfield, under pump turn and plugged home in the slosh at Newcastle. Right in this.
4	<b>OCEAN TSUNAMI</b>	Solid run (Bm64) at Newcastle 19 May. Settled back and didn't come on at Rosehill second-up. Ready to peak third-up. Won only other time at Scone.
5	<b>SAINTLY SANDS</b>	Produced a driving charge from the back at Warren. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Can challenge again.

**RACE 7** 1:45 PM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 1100m

2	<b>HELLCIBELL</b>	Raced on the pace and went down in a thrilling stoush this track. Leads, handy. Coming back in distance. Right in the mix again.
4	<b>ENTERPRISE LEGEND</b>	Couldn't quite peg back winner at Gunnedah at first run back. Handles the sting out of the ground. Fitter second-up and takes a 4kg claim. At optimum distance.
5	<b>TOUGH GUY</b>	Won Country Boosted (Bm66) Moree 17 Mar. Made late rally from the back at Gunnedah. Key contender with even breaks.
1	<b>WAVE BREAKER</b>	Now 5 weeks between runs. Wore them down late at Dubbo at second run back. Can challenge again.

**RACE 8** 2:25 PM | AUD30,000 | **SCONE** | 1300m

4	<b>JAGERSCHNITZEL</b>	Lobbed handy, boxed on behind runaway winner in the Country Boosted Hcp (C1) this venue when off an extended spell. Strips fitter second run back. Featured both times here. Warrants attention.
6	<b>MAGURTZ</b>	Pretty good effort in defeat at Gunnedah second-up. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Wet form - soft (3:1-1-0); untested heavy. Drops back a notch in trip.
3	<b>EXTREME MERGER</b>	Rode the speed and kept finding on a soft deck to salute at Parkes over this trip. Gets through rain affected ground. Commands attention here.
5	<b>ODE SO MUCH</b>	Lightly raced and showing genuine ability. Really good run in rain affected going coming from the back in Country Boosted (Bm58) at Warren second-up. Wet form - soft (3:1-1-1); untested heavy. Stripping fitter and can play a role.
