

RACE 1 11:25 AM | \$60,000 | GOSFORD | 1100m

4	WAVERLEY ROAD	Resuming (59-weeks). Patiently handled and safely contained at Randwick on debut 21 Dec 2024. Drawn to receive every chance. Rates highly fresh in this company.
3	RHETORIC	Supported in early runs. Got a stitch late after leading in the small field at Canterbury at his second race start. Highly rated in this line-up.
6	SPHERE	Got back, closed the race off solidly into second at Warwick Farm. Scope for improvement. Breaks from a low barrier. Worth a look.
2	GRAVEL ROAD	Trials (2:2-0-0). By Capitalist and out of a High Chaparral mare. Showing promise with wins at all trials. Benefit of decent alley. Follow any betting leads.
7	NAFANUA	Resuming (23-weeks). Will have matured since her initial campaign. Given two trials and has placed first-up. Signalled some ability on debut when a hot fav. and sure to be improved by the experience. Only for wider exotics fresh in this line-up.

RACE 2 12:00 PM | \$45,000 | GOSFORD | 1100m

8	THE NETBALL QUEEN	Now 4 weeks between runs. Led, gave away late finishing 2.6 lengths astern of winner this track. Strikes a race she can win.
6	KAVAL	First-up (13-weeks). Usually gets back. Among the dangers fresh in this line-up.
4	NESS	Trials (4:0-1-1). Good pass mark in earlier trial. Dylan Gibbons on from trials. Well worth a look.
2	SOHO	Resuming (86-weeks). Can challenge fresh in this line-up.
3	CIRCUS GIRL	Trials (3:0-0-1). Market may prove best guide to expectations.

RACE 3 12:35 PM | \$42,000 | GOSFORD | 1200m

5	MAIDOFF	Early form encouraging. Showed plenty of fight on the pace at Warwick Farm at first run back. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Placed in Maiden company at Canterbury second-up last campaign.
3	EYNESBURY	Was super closing at Canterbury in only his second race appearance. Warrants attention.
6	RHETORIC	Been supported at each run. Set tempo and surrendered late at Canterbury at his second race start. Key player.

1	CASTAGNOLA	Determined winner in choppy conditions at Randwick-Kensington at his second race start when in the market. Fancy the extra trip will suit. J Parr retains the ride. Key player.
5	VALIANT BOMB	Battled home in rain affected going at Kembla Grange. Tactical speed, inside draw. Warrants attention.
4	I AM WILD	4 weeks since last run. Ran on soundly into third in the small field this venue second-up. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Makes a strong case in this company.
2	AUSSIE NATION	Resuming after a (88-weeks) spell. First run this region for new stable. Consistent first-up form while fitted with 2 Scone trials. Can atone for latest performance.
3	HUSH HUSH	Came from back half to post a commanding 2.5 lengths Maiden win at Kembla Grange at \$3. Among the dangers.

RACE 5 1:28 PM | \$38,000 | DOOMBEN | 1600m

9	ARATIRI	Went close at Ipswich two back. Showed all her fighting qualities as she shook off rivals attentions to win the (Bm65) at Ipswich. Has a light weight. Drawn more favourably.
3	RUINS OF ROME	Solid 61kg winner at Sunshine Coast 9 Jan. Not disgraced at Sunshine Coast. Looking for this trip now. Shown can handle the wet here.
8	TRAPEDO	Went close at Sunshine Coast two back. Showed a fine turn of foot from the back to snare third place this track. Nicely weighted. Drawn to receive every chance and under less weight.
7	FAIRWAY CHOICE	Snagged back to the tail, gave late chase into third at Gold Coast. Usually gets back. Can make her presence felt.
4	KADALL	Last win was 20 Jan 2024. Started \$4 when safely held in Benchmark 70 company at Gold Coast. One for multiples.

RACE 6 2:03 PM | \$38,000 | DOOMBEN | 1350m

4	HEAVENLY IMPACT	Well back and made minor headway when 4th at Gold Coast. Breaks from a low barrier. Makes a strong case in this company.
10	DATA SCRAMBLE	Just missed at Sunshine Coast 20 Dec. Not disgraced in F&M (Bm68) this track at \$15. Drawn favourably. Makes strong appeal.
3	FIREFORCE	Ran a cracking race when just edged out at Gold Coast 23 Jan. Nice gate. Right in the mix.
6	CASTELLO GRANDE	Back to the track for second campaign (16-weeks). Broke maiden at Sunshine Coast in his first preparation. Worth a look fresh in this line-up.
7	BELLS OF STEEL	Kicks off second campaign (33-weeks). First run this region for new stable. Winner at Kilmore in her first prep. Brought on with two trial hitouts.

9	DEMARCAY	On pace, not beaten far at Ipswich. Any give helps. Goes forward and takes a large claim. Can challenge.
5	BAVARIAN LADY	No answer when first two cleared out but ran on bravely for third in the (Bm70) at Sunshine Coast. Minor money hope at best.

1	THE CATCH	Experienced campaigner. Off pace but only battled home to cross the line 6.9 lengths 4th at Ipswich. Among the dangers.
6	TRAPEDO	Went close at Sunshine Coast two back. Showed a fine turn of foot from the back to snare third place here. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Drawn well.
3	ZOU BIG BOY	On pace, not beaten far at Ipswich. Looks a first four candidate.
2	CHANGE THE DATE	Sent forward, outgunned late but kept on for second (Bm74) at Grafton. Can lead or take a sit. Can make his presence felt.

RACE 9 3:50 PM | \$38,000 | DOOMBEN | 1350m

4	TRIBECA STAR	Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Ballina. Switching to 1350m. Breaks from a low barrier. Sound claims.
7	MEAN APPROACH	Midfield and worked home solidly at Gold Coast. Can make his presence felt.
3	SER JOH	Mid-division, well held by winner but ran on for second at Eagle Farm at \$4. Good gate and races well at home. Highly rated in this line-up.
2	MISTER BIANCO	Brave effort in busy finish at Sunshine Coast. Form sound this track and distance and a proven weight carrier. Key player.
6	GORBACHEV	4 weeks since last run. Did little 8 lengths 13th at Gold Coast. Rough place prospect.
