2	CELLPHONE	In the market all runs. Led from pillar to near the post in the 3yo Mdn this track. Drawn well. Switching to 1400m.
10	PEACE BIRD	Promising Hellbent 3-year-old. Prominent and showed plenty of ticker to just go under in thrilling finish in the 3yo Mdn Plate at Gosford second-up. Fitter, has scope to progress. Drawn more favourably.
9	ARTGIRL	Left in winner's wake but trudged home for the minors this venue at resumption. Will be fitter second-up. Rates highly in this affair.

4	THE BIG BLUE	Cleared maiden ranks at Hawkesbury 26 Mar. Started \$7 when battled home in Benchmark 72 company this venue. Not out of this.

8	MRS MAREE	Broke maiden at Wyong 16 Apr. Strode forward off wide gate, fought on bravely to just miss at Kembla Grange. Jump-and-run mare. Rates highly.
1	SUPER NUI	Resuming (18-weeks). Brought on with two trial hitouts and has placed first-up. Among the dangers fresh in this affair.

9	FIRST MISSION	Now 4 weeks between runs. Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Doomben. Warrants attention.

12	PARTY SPIRIT	Not disgraced in F&M (Bm78) at Eagle Farm at \$9.50. Ticks the wet and track boxes. Has form this track and distance. Can make her presence felt.

8	CROSSBOW	Midfield, picked up solidly at Randwick. Drops to shorter trip.
7	THEBLADE	Just wacked away without threatening over 1400m 3yo+ (Bm78) at Flemington at second run back. On pacer.
1	CELLARMASTER	Let-up (60-days). Ex John O'Shea & Tom Charlton in NSW. Took out the 3yo+ (Bm72) at Canterbury 27 Feb. Stationed around midfield, positive response gaining late ground at Rosehill.

9	MANUKAU	Went close at Warwick Farm two back 4 Mar. Gave a good sight making the frame at Eagle Farm when in the market. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Profiles well.
2	ALPHA BRAVO	Let-up (56-days). Took the 3,4yo (Bm70) from the front at Doomben 18 Mar. Since trialed at Beaudesert 8 May. Has early speed.
