

**RACE 1** 9:40 AM | AUD30,000 | **PORT MACQUARIE** | 1206m

15	<b>NOT SO DUBIOUS</b>	Let-up (64-days). On pace but soon under pressure and he knocked up badly at Grafton. Drawn favourably and under less weight. Capable of making an impact fresh in this line-up.
5	<b>POETIC ANGEL</b>	Freshened after resuming from a break. Strong SP profile. Got back, ran on late with purpose at Grafton in only her second race appearance. Warrants attention.
1	<b>ADEQUATE EZE</b>	Set for second campaign (22-weeks). Strengthened up. Placed at Lismore first-up last campaign. Right in the mix fresh in this company.
7	<b>SUNSTAZ</b>	Last on turn, beat tired horses home at Taree. Drawn to effect. Makes a strong case in this company.

12	<b>TORPEDO TUBE</b>	Settled midfield, ran on fairly without threatening at Taree last start. Can fill the minors here.
10	<b>PRATIBHA</b>	Sent out \$4.40 when unable to threaten in choppy conditions here. More suitable draw. Capable of making an impact.
9	<b>BRITISH GEM</b>	Put in some big strides late at Wyong second-up when in the market. Sharper now and right in this.
7	<b>THUNDER LIGHTS</b>	Honest performer. Off pace, worked his way into the minors without threatening winner at Wyong 30 Apr. Drawn to get a conservative run. Among the dangers back at country level.

9	<b>DUBALENE</b>	Battled home in testing conditions at Coffs Harbour. Nice gate. Among the dangers.
2	<b>OAKFIELD NEPTUNE</b>	Back to the track for second campaign (38-weeks). Ex Ms K Buchanan in NSW. Broke maiden at Newcastle in her first preparation. Winner fresh and 2 trials will have her ready for this.
3	<b>TOO HOT TO TORQUE</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Cleared maiden ranks at Lismore 26 Sep. Brave in defeat Country Boosted Hcp (C1) at Ballina at first run off a long break. Looks a serious player.
4	<b>STORM MERCHANT</b>	Freshened after resuming from a break. Led and boxed on to place in the small field for 1.9 len third at Grafton. Natural leader, gun draw. Wet form - soft (1:1-0-0); untested heavy.

**RACE 5** 11:55 AM | AUD27,000 | **PORT MACQUARIE** | 1206m

2	<b>DIVA ROUGE</b>	On target for hat-trick. Led them a merry dance in sticky going to win the Hcp (C1) at Coffs Harbour. Leads, handy. Strikes another winnable race.
7	<b>RUPESTRIS</b>	First-up (25-weeks). Has done plenty right in short career. Given further time to mature while indicating was forward winning a Ballina trial. Drawn favourably.
5	<b>LOVECATS</b>	Started \$6 when toughed it out in Class 1 company at Sunshine Coast at first run off a long break. On pacer. Has form in wet. Warrants attention.
4	<b>NEWY</b>	In touch, winner cleared out but he kept fighting on at Coffs Harbour. Shown a liking for softer ground. Can play a role.

9	<b>BULLANT</b>	First-up (22-weeks). In the minors at Coonamble first-up last campaign while given some soft trial work for return. Wet form - soft (3:1-0-1); untested heavy. Merits obvious consideration.
12	<b>STIORRA</b>	Scrubbed up from the wide gate and boxed on bravely for a 0.8 len win at Tuncurry in second run from spell. Has early speed. Gets through rain affected ground. Worth a look.
10	<b>MAGNOLIA JEWEL</b>	On a quick back-up. Ranged up but punctured late at Quirindi. On pacer, perfect gate. Major player here.
2	<b>JEWELS STATEMENT</b>	Well back and never sighted at Taree as a market drifter. Wet form - soft (11:2-3-2); untested heavy. BM58 suits. Right in the mix.

**RACE 7** 1:10 PM | AUD27,000 | **PORT MACQUARIE** | 1106m

1	<b>GAYLORD</b>	Fresh. In the thick of it at Grafton two back 30 Mar. Ran on soundly into second in the small field at Grafton. Highly rated in this line-up.
11	<b>PERSONAL SPACE</b>	Set tempo and surrendered late but had enough in the tank for third (Bm58). Speedy and this is well within her wheelhouse. Thrives in wet. Worth a look.
9	<b>TOO DARN FINESSE</b>	Back to the track for second campaign (19-weeks). Winner at Scone in her first prep. Winner fresh and 2 trials will have her ready for this. Drawn to effect.
8	<b>FARNCIFUL</b>	Had all before her at turn and went home tamely at Gosford. Jumps from better barrier. Handles wet ground. Won only other time at Port Macquarie.

1	<b>DAMASCUS GATE</b>	Got the wobbles and faded out of the placings at Muswellbrook. Drawn for an easy lead and this is well within his wheelhouse. Handles the wet. Makes a strong case in this company.
2	<b>ARCHIE MAXIMUS</b>	Freshened. Showed fighting qualities to win the Country Boosted Mdn at Grafton. Should relish the rise in distance. Among the dangers.
4	<b>AUTUMN MISS</b>	Off pace, left in tearaway winner's wake but ran on doggedly for the runner up cheque at Beaudesert. Could add some value to exotics.
5	<b>KEN'KER</b>	Prominent to 400m but threw the towel in quickly at Taree. Drawn to receive every chance. Deep into his campaign and can fill the minors here.

1	<b>AGENT MAX</b>	Kicks off second campaign (17-weeks). Broke maiden at Taree in his first preparation. In the minors at Taree first-up last campaign. Good gate.
8	<b>HAYLEY'S ROCKET</b>	Ran on okay without troubling in rain affected ground at Coffs Harbour. Has wet form. Will be fitter second-up. Looks a serious player.
3	<b>YOUWROTEUPONIT</b>	Resuming (21-weeks). Ex G M Begg. Trained here. In the minors at Geelong first-up last campaign. Big show fresh in this line-up.
11	<b>I'M SUPER</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Gave solid kick from handy position to triumph at Tuncurry at resumption. Drawn favourably. Wet form - soft (3:1-0-0); untested heavy.
