

**RACE 1 11:10 AM | AUD42,000 | GOSFORD | 1200m**

2	<b>FAWLTY AFFAIRS</b>	Gave a sight on debut at Muswellbrook 8 Mar. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Form good enough for this.
5	<b>VATICAN</b>	Returning for second campaign (13-weeks). Given two trials. Put up a tidy debut performance at Randwick at \$9.50. Rates highly fresh in this company.
8	<b>YAMASHITA</b>	Returns for second campaign (17-weeks). A very soft debut performance at Newcastle 15 Nov. One for exotics fresh in this line-up.
4	<b>SATOSHI</b>	Trials (2:1-0-0). Signalled was ready to go now with latest 736m trial win at Randwick. Look to market for a further guide.

**RACE 2 11:45 AM | AUD60,000 | GOSFORD | 1200m**

5	<b>WISHFUL THINKER</b>	Form from three runs has been respectable. Boxed on for a distant third in the small field at Kembla Grange at first run off a long break. Placed in Maiden company at Bendigo second-up last campaign. Nice gate.
3	<b>RIGA</b>	On a quick back-up. Just missed at Newcastle 28 Feb. Last assignment this trip when lost rider in the 3yo+ Midway Mdn here when in the market. Decent alley.
4	<b>STABILITY</b>	Trials (3:0-1-1). Did enough to finish second in last trial. Mitchell Bell sticks from latest trial. Can make a winning debut.
8	<b>MISS PEONY</b>	Unplaced but has shown glimpses of ability. Ran on soundly from midfield at Newcastle at first run off a long break. Will be fitter second-up. Could get into the placings.

**RACE 3 12:20 PM | AUD45,000 | GOSFORD | 1600m**

6	<b>CHA CHA CHA</b>	Led, gave away final stages at Wyong when off an extended spell. Form sound this track and distance. Will be fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim. Can lead or take a sit.
7	<b>EMERALD HILLS</b>	Determined winner at Newcastle in only her second race appearance when in the market. C Reith retains the ride. Drawn favourably. Highly rated in this line-up.
3	<b>BARRENGARRY</b>	Let down with a fine turn of speed from the back half to win in second run from spell. Zac Lloyd retains the ride. Drawn to effect. Looks up to these.
4	<b>GALLAHOP</b>	Just wacked away without threatening over 1800m 3yo+ (Bm64) at Hawkesbury. Ticks the track and distance win box. Right in the mix.

**RACE 4 12:55 PM | AUD45,000 | GOSFORD | 1200m**

1	<b>LIGHTNING GLORY</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (17-weeks). Winner at Newcastle in his first prep. Easy winner at Newcastle first-up last prep while readied with 1 trial hit-outs, latest at Wyong. Tactical speed, inside draw.
3	<b>JUST RESPONSE</b>	First-up (16-weeks). In the minors at Scone first-up last campaign while indicating was forward winning a Wyong trial. Winner at track and distance. Maps wells.
10	<b>TRIPLE YES</b>	Showed plenty of fight on the pace at Kembla Grange. Can lead or take a sit. Can make her presence felt.
4	<b>HE'S COOL</b>	Prominent and responded strongly at Wyong second-up. William Stanley retains the ride and takes a 2kg claim. Drawn to receive every chance. Sound claims.

**RACE 5 1:30 PM | AUD42,000 | GOSFORD | 1100m**

3	<b>HONEY PERFUME</b>	Freshened after resuming from a break. Went close at Hawkesbury two back. Ran on soundly into second in the small field at Hawkesbury at first run off a long break. Fitter second-up.
8	<b>CONFIDENTIALITY</b>	Returns for second campaign (20-weeks). Broke maiden at Wyong in her first preparation. Only for wider exotics fresh in this line-up.
9	<b>PERLE DE CHOCOLAT</b>	Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Kembla Grange. Switching to 1100m. Breaks from a low barrier. Worth a look.
1	<b>FUADEE</b>	Let-up (78-days). Finished too well winning Super Mdn this venue 11 weeks back. Had two trials since. Deon Le Roux retains the ride and takes a 3kg claim.

**RACE 6 2:15 PM | AUD45,000 | PAKENHAM | 1100m**

13	<b>CHAPADOS</b>	Reasonable debut performance when battled to line at Flemington when drifting in the betting. First time back in a country Maiden. Rates highly.
1	<b>CYCLOTRON</b>	Gave a sight on debut at Morphettville Parks when in the market 28 Feb. Form good enough for this.
12	<b>WONDERFUL SKY</b>	Trials (1:0-0-1). Crossed the line third in Caulfield Heath trial on 20 Nov. Drawn well for first assignment. Can make a winning debut.
2	<b>LEVENS HALL</b>	Unraced 2yo by Too Dam Hot and out of the Reliable Man mare Leven Lass. Can make an immediate impact here.

**RACE 7 2:45 PM | AUD45,000 | PAKENHAM | 1100m**

9	<b>BEE ADMIRE</b>	Gave a sight on debut this track when in the market 26 Feb. Sound claims.
4	<b>RADICAL DUDE</b>	Faman gelding heading to the races without a public trial. Can make an immediate impact here.
10	<b>FARAKTA</b>	Trials (1:1-0-0). Indicated ability and readiness with an impressive trial win at Benalla. Big watch.
11	<b>SMOKE SCREEN</b>	Went down narrowly in the small field at Caulfield Heath in second run from spell. Looks progressive. Good draw. This looks a nice race for the filly.

**RACE 8 3:15 PM | AUD45,000 | PAKENHAM | 1000m**

10	<b>MISS DECEIVER</b>	Back to the track for second campaign (18-weeks). Just missed at Ballarat 24 Oct. Placed at Geelong first-up last campaign while she didn't do much in latest trial. Maps wells.
7	<b>INVINCIBLE LOVER</b>	Went down narrowly in the small field at Caulfield Heath over this trip. Can fill the minors here.
8	<b>KOKESHI</b>	Prominent and went down fighting in the Maiden company this venue at first run off a long break. Better for recent exposure this trip. Worth a look.
11	<b>NEWS SCOOP</b>	First starter by Churchill and out of the Zoustar mare Shoop. Not seen at barrier trials. Can make an immediate impact here.

**RACE 9 3:45 PM | AUD45,000 | PAKENHAM | 1600m**

7	<b>KINGS DOMAIN</b>	Shown early ability. Settled off pace, rallied well but couldn't match winner at Wangaratta at his second race start. Fitter, has scope to progress. This looks very winnable.
12	<b>CERTAINLY QUIET</b>	Beyond midfield, under pump turn and plugged home at Kilmore first up. Better for recent exposure this trip. Key player.
4	<b>ACCIDENTAL BID</b>	Set for second campaign (23-weeks). Likely to have benefitted from the spell. Ex A Nicholls in Europe. International import with new trainer. Nice gate.
3	<b>ZAMPARINI SPIRIT</b>	Trimmed margin late here. Awkwardly drawn this time. Sound claims.

**RACE 10 4:15 PM | AUD40,000 | PAKENHAM | 1400m**

1	<b>BLAKMAX</b>	On a quick back-up. Led and boxed on to place in the small field for 1.5 len third at Cranbourne. Switching to 1400m. Key player.
3	<b>TREASUREFLIGHT</b>	Failed to threaten at Ballarat when off an extended spell. Will be fitter second-up. This looks very winnable.
2	<b>JET JITSU</b>	Midfield and worked home solidly at Warrambool at second run back. Ready to peak third-up. Right in the mix.
6	<b>SHIDAN</b>	Trimmed margin late at Sale at second run back. Fitter now and ready to improve. Worth a look.

6	<b>CUSTOMER SERVICE</b>	Put in some big strides late at Cranbourne. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Highly rated in this line-up.
13	<b>TOPSPIN</b>	Capable stayer. Impressive coming from back half to score this track over this trip. Since trialed at Hamilton 11 Mar. Capable of playing a key role in this.
7	<b>HOLLANDIA</b>	Adept stayer. Landed handy, unable to go with winner in Benchmark 62 company over this trip. Has a few runs under his belt this campaign and warrants attention.
10	<b>SHREWSBURY ROAD</b>	Solid 70.5kg winner at Kilmore 13 Feb. Not disgraced in (Bm62) here at this distance at \$6.50. Can figure.

**RACE 12 5:15 PM | AUD40,000 | PAKENHAM | 1200m**

4	<b>YAMASHITA'S GOLD</b>	On a quick back-up. Picked up strongly from back half this track. Good gate. Can challenge.
1	<b>BATTLE OF THE ICE</b>	Resuming (19-weeks). Drawn favourably. Expecting a prominent showing fresh in this line-up.
2	<b>DELIBERATE PLOY</b>	Rearward and impressed in his first outing running on in good style to score. J Mott retains the ride. Drawn well. Among the dangers.
3	<b>SPARKLING LUCK</b>	Just missed at Pakenham 5 Feb. Raced off the speed and mustered well to get the money at Sandown-Hillside, when in the market. Damian Lane retains the ride. Can win again.

**RACE 13 5:45 PM | AUD40,000 | PAKENHAM | 1000m**

7	<b>MY ZEPHYR</b>	Sent out \$101 when never got into the race at Flemington at this trip. Highly rated in this line-up.
2	<b>YES WE ARE</b>	Let-up (50-days). Won a 1000m Benchmark 62 at Sale two back. No match when 2.1 len 5th in the small field at Sandown-Hillside at short odds second-up. Handles all conditions.
1	<b>MR MAGNUS</b>	4 weeks since last run. Got back and wasn't totally disgraced at Flemington. At optimum distance. Solid closer.
6	<b>BOLD SUITOR</b>	Prominent and fought on determinedly in the 3yo Mdn Plate this track at second run back. Winner at only other start at Pakenham. J Noonan retains the ride. Decent alley.
