

**RACE 1** 9:55 AM | AUD30,000 | **INVERELL** | 1200m

1	<b>SPARTAN STEEL</b>	Handily placed and worked home soundly at Taree. Coming back in distance. Sharper now and capable of making an impact.
6	<b>LA REGINA</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (15-weeks). Bold first-up showing anticipated.
5	<b>MOTION A NATION</b>	Back for second campaign (31-weeks). More developed now. Ex S B Lee in NSW. Placed at Casino on debut last campaign while prepared for return with a Deagon trial. Big watch under new trainer after long spell.

6	<b>ANTHRACIA</b>	Freshened after resuming from a break. Tame to line in small field at Queanbeyan at resumption. Leads, handy. Capable of making an impact.
4	<b>I SHOW SPEED</b>	In trailing position and kept on evenly at Albury at first run off a long break. Right in the mix.

7	<b>HIGHLAND HUSTLE</b>	Very tame performance in bottomless conditions at Coffs Harbour. Barrier hurts but possesses early toe. Proven in wet. Key contender with even breaks.
4	<b>SEETHING CHUCK</b>	Just missed at Tuncurry 9 May. Went down narrowly in the small field at Coffs Harbour second-up. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Down in class.

2	<b>DUNWITHYA</b>	Went back, closed intently at Kembla Grange when off an extended spell. Will benefit from that run. Among the dangers back at country level.
7	<b>BEAUER</b>	Freshened. Off the speed, picked up soundly and wasn't beaten far this venue in second run from spell. Meeting easier opposition here. Sharper now and highly rated in this line-up.
1	<b>BRANNUM</b>	On a short back-up. Flat-footed when the sprint went on at Nowra. Back to weaker company. Fit from racing and can fill the minors here.
