

RACE 1 11:00 AM | \$22,000 | CANBERRA | 1600m

4	FALCON LAIR	Cleared maiden ranks at Goulburn 7 Oct. Taken back from the alley, closed the race off powerfully here. Fitter second-up. Can challenge.
6	MISS STALWART	Ridden in back half, strong late to fill the minors on a soft deck Showcase (Bm58) at Sapphire Coast. Ready for the mile now and performs well at home. Ticks the wet and track boxes and performs well at home. Form good enough for this.
8	YES I WIN	Tame to line in small field at Newcastle at first run back. Can find a few lengths in this company second-up.
7	STAR BLING	Honest battler. Came from back half to post a commanding 2.1 lengths Class 2 win at Sapphire Coast at \$3.70. Can add to tally.
3	BRAZEN CRIME	Never a threat after showing no early speed from the barriers at Rosehill. Has claims.

RACE 2 11:36 AM | \$22,000 | CANBERRA | 1600m

5	YES I WIN	Tame to line in small field at Newcastle at first run back. Below par first-up but expect a more competitive showing here.
1	ARTIE STEAMER	Went close at Newcastle two back. Made short work of the small field in the Mdn at Gosford over this distance. Drawn to effect. Can win again.
2	AUTUMN WINTER	Resuming after a (69-weeks) spell. Ex A O'Brien in Europe. Broke his maiden at Ire - Thurles last campaign.
6	VELIA	Gave good account when 1.1 lengths 4th at Goulburn over this distance when in the market. Fit from racing and one for multiples.
3	ARISTOCRAT	Up on the speed but outgunned late in the slop at Nowra at last start this journey. Good draw. Each-way.

RACE 3 12:11 PM | \$40,000 | CANBERRA | 1400m

2	ZOUFIELD	Returns for second campaign (23-weeks). Will have matured over the break. Broke maiden at Newcastle in his first preparation. Winner fresh and 3 trials will have him ready for this. Expecting a prominent showing fresh in this line-up.
4	SILVALOA	Made late rally from the back at Wangaratta. Should relish the rise in distance. Warrants attention.
6	SPREAD THE LOVE	Resuming (23-weeks). Will have matured since his initial campaign. Broke maiden at Goulburn in his first preparation. Trialled well for return. Maps to get a sweet run.
3	TRIPTOLEMUS	Won (Bm58) Benchmark 58 Wagga 11 Jan. Tame to line in small field on a soft deck at Sapphire Coast in second run from spell. Among the dangers.
5	WOLF ISLAND	Ran home respectably into a non-threatening 5th here at second run back. Could give some cheek at odds.

RACE 4 12:46 PM | \$50,000 | CANBERRA | 1000m

6	FARCOLO	Kicks off second campaign (14-weeks). Given two trials. Held back to 400m and didn't show much fight at Rosehill on debut 8 Nov when blew like a gale in the betting. Better for the experience and has scope to improve here.
10	THE WIDLING	Heads into second campaign (19-weeks). Brought on with two trial hitouts. In close pursuit and put up a fair debut performance when 1.7 lengths 6th at Randwick at \$14. Has scope. First time back in a country Open.
1	BAR JESTER	Let-up (54-days). Showcased his talent by running out an impressive 1.6 lengths debut winner this venue on 28 Dec. Drawn to get a conservative run. Can be thereabouts.
2	FAWLTY AFFAIRS	Trials (2:0-1-0). Shown enough at the trials. Latest 0.1 lengths second Canterbury trial 899m 54.96, 6 Feb. Bears close watching.
3	MUSIC TIME	Comes into this off a dominant win in the 2yo Open Hcp here at \$5.50. Right in the mix.

RACE 5 1:00 PM | \$40,000 | QUIRINDI | 1100m

8	DUNE AND DUSTED	Just got there in a gripping finish at Walcha. Well placed for repeat.
10	INAZUMA BOY	Short course specialist. Responded well from just off leaders to snare a final bound win at Dubbo. Decent alley. Makes a strong case in this company.
3	CHANDON STAR	Freshened. In stellar form. Pushed forward and found enough to score as a \$5 chance. Leader.
4	RIVKIN	Steps out for third run new stable/region. Went close at Muswellbrook two back. Terrific effort when just shaded at Walcha 6 Feb. Ready to peak third-up.
7	CRESTA RUN	Sent forward, outgunned late but kept on for third Open Hcp at Walcha. On pacer. Has a few runs under her belt this campaign and one for multiples.

RACE 6 1:40 PM | \$50,000 | QUIRINDI | 1600m

6	FIORSUM FRED	On a quick back-up. Was a valiant but vanquished third in the (Bm74) at Tamworth. Ready to peak third-up. Right down in the weights.
7	HIBIKI HARMONY	Let-up (62-days). On pace and courageous in defeat finishing only 1 length behind winner at Randwick at this distance. Since trialled at Scone 30 Jan. Outer barrier but has good gate speed.
12	OTIUM	Puts in every start. Midfield, great effort running into second Open Hcp at Walcha in second run from spell. Experienced rider replaces apprentice. Can be thereabouts.
5	KNIFE'S EDGE	Freshened. No threat to winner but ran on for the minors at Tamworth at first run for new trainer when in the market. Has claims.
10	TAINUI	Never in the call at Gosford over a longer test. Drops to shorter trip. Fit from racing and could get into the placings.

RACE 7 2:20 PM | \$30,000 | QUIRINDI | 1450m

7	SILENT SERENADE	Led from pillar to post in the small field at Walcha. L P Rolls retains the ride. Form good enough for this.
14	VIA ROSE	Won F&M (Bm50) Benchmark 50 Quirindi 26 Dec. Punctured badly after leading in the 1600m (Bm50) at Tamworth. Ticks the track and distance win box. Drawn to get a conservative run.
2	FOUR DEGREES	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced at Walcha. Very fit and can fill the minors here.
19	LUCKY OZZIE	Puts in every start. Fought bravely to the wire 1 length third (Bm58) at Beaumont. Can have a say.
1	MELLENCAMP	On pace but folded up quickly at Newcastle. Minor money hope at best.

RACE 8 3:08 PM | \$25,000 | LAUNCESTON | 1100m

10	RUSHONOVA	Form reads well for this. Settled close, couldn't match winner but ran on for third this venue at her second race start. Improver, fitter third-up. Rates highly.
3	STRATO KEN	Ran a cracking race when just edged out at Hobart 8 Feb. Form good enough for this.
15	MISTER MANIHI	Now 4 weeks between runs. On pace but under siege late and weakened out of the fight over a longer test. Switching to 1100m. Can challenge.
7	AWESOME ORPHAN	Set for second campaign (23-weeks). Likely to have benefitted from the spell. Drawn well. Has claims.
6	TEAM HEIST	First-up (33-weeks). First run this region for new stable. Drawn to receive every chance. Betting watch advised at first run for new trainer.

RACE 9 3:38 PM | \$26,000 | LAUNCESTON | 1200m

2	ILOVETHISTOWN	Broke maiden at Launceston 14 Jan. On pace but under siege late and weakened out of the fight over this trip. Winner at track and distance. Draws to do no work.
3	ROUNDLE PARK	Mid-division, well held by winner but ran on for third at Hobart at \$8. More suitable draw. Worth a look.
13	VANITY STAR	4 weeks since last run. Ridden back and never a factor here. Switching to 1200m. Backmarker who needs everything to fall into place.
1	RAWABI	Freshened after resuming from a break. Handy but gave away tamely at Hobart at first run back. Since trialled at Longford 27 Jan. Maps well.
4	NOVALARGO	On pace but gave away tamely to finish well beaten 4.2 lengths at Hobart. Minor money hope at best.

RACE 10 4:08 PM | \$20,000 | LAUNCESTON | 1600m

10	RICH CLAN	Got the wobbles late after leading at Hobart over this trip. Has early speed. Can challenge.
7	ALPINE BLAST	Seasoned performer. Ran a cracking race when just edged out at Hobart 6 Feb. Effective this track and distance. Highly rated in this line-up.
4	MONTEZULU	Just got the nod in at Hobart at last start this journey. Can add to tally.
14	SKY EAGLE	Sound form. Lacked early speed and turn of foot at Hobart last outing. Stats are good this course. Can make her presence felt.
2	ALWAYS A WINNER	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Failed to threaten at Hobart when off an extended spell at blow-out odds. Since trialled at Devonport Synthetic 3 Feb. Place.

RACE 11 4:38 PM | \$26,000 | LAUNCESTON | 1400m

6	THEM'S THE BREAKS	Settled off pace, rallied well but couldn't match winner at Hobart. Key player.
9	THE PIRATE QUEEN	Gave good account when 1.2 lengths 4th at Hobart at this distance when a noted market drifter. Drawn more favourably. This looks very winnable.
11	GIE IT LALDY	Did little 8.3 lengths 13th at Hobart at a mammoth price. Form sound at this course and journey. Gets in light. Sound claims.
8	LAST TREMBLE	Issued decent challenge to claim second in the Plate (C1) this track. Switching to 1400m. One for exotics.
1	FRENCH SOUL	Was hopeless at Hobart last outing. Coming back in distance. Minor money hope at best.

RACE 12 5:08 PM | \$150,000 | LAUNCESTON | 1200m

1	ARISTOPOLOS	Waltzed in the Magic Millions 2YO Classic as the punters pick over this trip. Hard to beat.
8	WOOSH	Well bred filly out of the Group One winning mare Oohood. Impressive recent Caulfield jumpout winner. Big danger.
4	TAKE THE RISK	Trials (1:0-1-0). Only trial produced a narrow placing in good 4 conditions at Longford. Could run into the placings.
5	MOMENTSLIKETHESE	Reserved midfield and picked up intently for a second to key rival at Hobart last start. Been supported at each run and warrants attention.
3	RAMIRO	Stepping out for only the second time after battling home at Hobart when blew out in betting. Better for that but only for wider exotics.

RACE 13 5:38 PM | \$35,000 | LAUNCESTON | 1400m

4	WHIPPIN PICCADILLY	Now 4 weeks between runs. Shooting for hat-trick. Reeled them in late this venue. Has early speed.
1	MAGNAPRIME	Fresh. Lining up for three wins on the trot. Fine display of will and tenacity to win the (Bm76) here over this distance. On pacer.
5	CRIPPS	Lightly raced and showing promise. Pressed forward and kept on determinedly at Hobart when off an extended spell. Fitter second-up. Drawn more favourably and a nice weight drop.
7	THE TRINE	Making great progress. Produced a searching finish into the minors at Hobart. At optimum distance. Gets in light.
3	MS TASMANIA	Finished a well held 6th on a soft deck at Hobart. Has her first look at 1400m here. Minor money hope at best.
