

**RACE 1 11:02 AM | NZD25,000 | HAWERA | 1600m**

4	<b>THE BLACK PRINCE</b>	Last start finished 6th over 1300m at New Plymouth. Take beating.
15	<b>KINGSBROOK DIVA</b>	Battling last start when finishing 7th from 9 runners, beaten 4.90 lengths over 1600m. Needs to improve.
9	<b>SUPER ECLIPSE</b>	Midfield runs of late have not been without some merit.
3	<b>DERRYMAN</b>	Resuming from a break and fitness is a query. May need the run.

**RACE 2 11:20 AM | AUD100,000 | RANDWICK-KENSINGTON | 1300m**

6	<b>METALLIC CAT</b>	Excellent debut performance when just nabbed at Warwick Farm at \$3.40. Looking for this trip now. Breaks from a low barrier. This looks very winnable.
7	<b>ALADDIN'S GIRL</b>	Set for second campaign. Will have furnished and strengthened over the spell (23-weeks). Shown promise in limited runs. Readied with two soft trials. Made the frame every run in her first preparation and looks to have more upside to come.
2	<b>LONTRICE</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (18-weeks). Signalled some ability on debut at Canterbury 14 Nov. Trial suggests he is ready to build on early promise. Makes strong appeal fresh in this affair.
9	<b>MUMBAI MAHARANI</b>	In very good hands however safely contained at Warwick Farm on debut 11 Mar. Could give some cheek at odds.

**RACE 3 11:40 AM | NZD25,000 | HAWERA | 2100m**

1	<b>LEGEND OF KINGS</b>	Going well at the moment, most recently finishing third over 2200m at Sunshine Coast. Deserves a win and gets the chance here.
3	<b>STARPELLO</b>	Last start winner who retains form, will be handy here.
4	<b>THE TRENDSETTER</b>	Recorded the fastest time over this distance. Has claims.
10	<b>QUILL</b>	Was underwhelming last start when finishing 9th at Hawera over 1400m. Betting market the best guide.

**RACE 4 11:55 AM | AUD60,000 | RANDWICK-KENSINGTON | 1100m**

2	<b>UNDER FOCUS</b>	Promising debut performance at Warwick Farm 11 Mar. This looks very winnable.
10	<b>STEEL WILL</b>	Wasn't all that far from the action on debut at Warwick Farm 11 Mar. Makes strong appeal.
13	<b>BAYLIE'S FOLLY</b>	Not too far off them at Warwick Farm on debut 11 Mar. Drawn to receive every chance. Can make his presence felt.
3	<b>DRUMFIRE</b>	Excellent debut victory at Muswellbrook 8 Mar. Drawn more favourably. Right in the mix.

8	<b>RICHEMONT</b>	Well prepared for debut run and won impressively by 5.80 lengths. Improving type who will do well here.
7	<b>FAWZOR</b>	Ran home in fourth position at Hawera last start over 1200m. Should be handy here.

**RACE 6 12:30 PM | AUD60,000 | RANDWICK-KENSINGTON | 1150m**

9	<b>HAY STREET</b>	4 weeks since last run. Dominated the race at Rosehill at second run back. Has a light weight. Breaks from a low barrier and a nice weight drop.
4	<b>HEZDARNHOTTOO</b>	Ranged up but punctured late at Flemington second-up. Barrier a blow but possesses early toe. Key player.
2	<b>FINE VINTAGE</b>	Fresh. Won a 1100m Benchmark 72 at Canterbury two back. Led, gave away final stages at Canterbury. Has early speed.
6	<b>MAFIA</b>	Resuming (13-weeks). Tried up super at Kembla Grange 5 Mar and proven first-up. Leader. Each way prospect fresh in this line-up.

**RACE 7 12:50 PM | NZD25,000 | HAWERA | 1600m**

6	<b>FOSSE</b>	Didn't finish far off last start when 2.90 lengths from the winner at Ellerslie over 1400m. Capable type.
11	<b>STIPULATOR</b>	Raced midfield last run and should do better with a return to Hawera. Good record over this track.
7	<b>SPERLARI</b>	Out of the money last start, finishing 4th position beaten 2.10 lengths. Capable of sharp improvement.
2	<b>DESERT MYSTIC</b>	Has been racing in the money recently placing third over 1600m last start. Will feature here.

**RACE 8 1:05 PM | AUD60,000 | RANDWICK-KENSINGTON | 1400m**

1	<b>AZARAX</b>	Ex John O'Shea & Tom Charlton in NSW. Has stakes form. Solid 60.5kg winner at Hawkesbury 19 Feb. Sent forward, outgunned late but kept boxing on at Canberra in second run from spell.
6	<b>MONOPOLISTIC</b>	Let-up (68-days). Strong Benchmark 64 1550 win from midfield at Canterbury last outing. Since trialled at Rosehill 10 Mar. Wet form - soft (3:2-1-0); untested heavy.
7	<b>SATIRICALLY</b>	Fresh. Showcased his talent by running out an impressive 1.2 len debut winner at Warwick Farm, 18 Feb. Since trialled at Randwick 16 Mar. Makes a strong case in this company.
13	<b>ROYAL SILVER</b>	Prominent and responded strongly at Kembla Grange at first run for new trainer. Nicely weighted. Tommy Berry retains the ride. Can challenge.

**RACE 9 1:40 PM | AUD60,000 | RANDWICK-KENSINGTON | 1150m**

1	<b>RANTAN</b>	Fought on with some conviction for the minors at Warwick Farm at second run back. Wet form - soft (8:2-1-1); untested heavy. Key player.
3	<b>SOUTHERN HEIRESS</b>	On pace and surrendered in the field of 7 at Canterbury. Has form in wet. Possesses high speed. Makes strong appeal.
4	<b>HORSESHOE HILL</b>	Out of the money at Randwick when off an extended spell. Wet form - soft (2:1-1-0); untested heavy. Will be fitter second-up. Drawn well.
2	<b>SURF'S UP</b>	First-up (19-weeks). Broke her maiden at Warwick Farm last campaign. Just missed at Caulfield 11 Oct. Nearly won in Benchmark 64 company at Warwick Farm first-up last campaign while indicating was forward winning a Randwick trial.

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| <b>3</b> | <b>CAP SAINT MARTIN</b>  | Second run now in Australia. Got back, cut loose late to fill the minors at Warwick Farm at first run for new trainer. Will be fitter second-up. Highly rated in this line-up.              |
| <b>4</b> | <b>MAJORIAN</b>          | Settled back and didn't figure in choppy conditions first up in the 3yo+ (Bm78) at Warwick Farm. Fitter second-up. Can make his presence felt.  |
| <b>2</b> | <b>GLAD YOU THINK SO</b> | Settled back and passed a few late in the 3yo+ (Bm88) at Randwick second-up. Drops to shorter trip. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Handles wet ground.                   |
| <b>5</b> | <b>KENMARE BAY</b>       | Ex John O'Shea & Tom Charlton in NSW. In the thick of it at Canterbury two back 13 Feb. Couldn't get near winner but found enough for the minors at Canterbury. Stats are good this course. |

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| <b>7</b>  | <b>MONTE VEEBEE</b>      | Sent forward, outgunned late but kept boxing on at Warwick Farm. Wet form - soft (4:1-1-0); untested heavy. Drawn to get an economic trail. Form good enough for this.                |
| <b>5</b>  | <b>FIDDLERS GREEN</b>    | Handy and dug deep to bag a Benchmark 78 win at Warwick Farm. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Has form in wet. Can repeat dose.  |
| <b>9</b>  | <b>SPIRIT OF CAMELOT</b> | Third run now in new stable/region. Terrific effort when just shaded in rain affected going at Warwick Farm 4 Mar. Ready to peak third-up. Wet form - soft (4:2-2-0); untested heavy. |
