

**RACE 1 11:05 AM | \$65,000 | WARWICK FARM | 1100m**

10	<b>SPHERE</b>	Enough in the tank to place at Canterbury at first run for new trainer. Drawn to effect and under less weight. Form good enough for this.
2	<b>FARFETCHED</b>	In the money at her only start at Randwick-Kensington 14 Jan. Better for race experience. Respect in this company.
1	<b>FAIRWAY TO HEAVEN</b>	Set for second campaign. Will have furnished and strengthened over the spell (27-weeks). Given two trials and has placed first-up. Will have gained valuable experience by debut placing at Randwick-Kensington on a soft deck when in the market. Decent alley.
8	<b>OZ PRINCESS</b>	Trials (2:0-0-0). Market may prove a more fruitful guide.
3	<b>FIREPOP</b>	Not disgraced in 3yo F Mdn at Canterbury second-up at \$11. Has an adverse draw. Only for wider exotics.

**RACE 2 11:40 AM | \$100,000 | WARWICK FARM | 1400m**

7	<b>LET'S GO BARBIE</b>	Making good progress. Terrific effort when just shaded at Randwick-Kensington 14 Jan. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Improver, fitter third-up.
5	<b>FEAZABEEL</b>	Resuming (24-weeks). Will have matured since his initial campaign. Displayed early promise. Given two trials. Bold first-up showing anticipated.
1	<b>INDIGO STAR</b>	Went close at Beaumont two back. Last at turn, ran on late at Randwick-Kensington second-up. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Ready to peak third-up.
6	<b>BAJA BABY</b>	Bold debut effort when just shaded by winner at Kembla Grange 3 Jan at \$9. Will be improved. Worth a look.
4	<b>DELICIOUS DEREK</b>	Ran home into the minors 2&3yo C&G Mdn at Canterbury when off an extended spell. Looks a first four candidate.

**RACE 3 12:15 PM | \$65,000 | WARWICK FARM | 1600m**

4	<b>LANCELOT DU LAC</b>	5 weeks since last run. Not disgraced at Randwick in only his second race appearance. Since trialled at Warwick Farm 9 Jan. Drawn well.
2	<b>CLIMB THE LADDER</b>	Mid-division, well held by winner but ran on for second at Randwick-Kensington at \$2.90. Switching to 1600m. Drawn to effect. Fit from racing and right in the mix.
3	<b>FIFTYFIVECHEVY</b>	Went home tamely at Randwick-Kensington at \$12. Coming back in distance. Best results on firm going. Barrier a blow but possesses early toe.
7	<b>ROTHO BRO</b>	Let down with a fine turn of speed from the back half to win. Sound claims.
6	<b>TASSRON</b>	Ran on late from the back at Canterbury second-up. Could get into the placings.

**RACE 4 12:50 PM | \$65,000 | WARWICK FARM | 1400m**

2	<b>MAMUSHKA</b>	Randwick winner two back. Run down in the shadows after giving a kick from on pace at Gold Coast when in the market. Can show early speed. Hard to toss.
5	<b>SHANONI</b>	Left in winner's wake but trudged home for the minors at Randwick-Kensington in second run from spell. Ready to peak third-up. Has claims.
3	<b>CINSAULT</b>	Canterbury winner two back. Last start this trip handy and boxed on solidly finishing only 1.4 lengths behind winner at Randwick. Can play a role.
1	<b>TEQUILA BABY</b>	Won a 1200m Benchmark 72 at Warwick Farm two back. Failed to make an impression in the 3yo+ Midway (Bm72) in testing conditions at Rosehill. Has her first look at 1400m here. Drawn to get a conservative run.
8	<b>OUI FLOURISH</b>	Kicked off career with a narrow victory at Kembla Grange when in the market. Punching high. This looks stronger.

**RACE 5** 1:30 PM | \$200,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 2400m

1	<b>FUTURE HISTORY</b>	In stellar form. Dug in deep to score after leading at Rosehill. Handles the sting out of the ground. On pacer.
2	<b>SAINT GEORGE</b>	Lining up for three wins on the trot. Game win from just off the pace at Flemington. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Take beating again.
5	<b>ELLIPTICAL</b>	Produced a searching finish into the minors at Wyong. Should appreciate stepping up in distance and under less weight. Handles wet ground. Senior rider takes over.
3	<b>UNSPOKEN</b>	4 weeks since last run. Got back, cut loose late to fill the minors at Randwick. Has his first look at 2400m here. Seems to prefer it dry.
4	<b>NEWFOUNDLAND</b>	Freshened after resuming from a break. Well back and made some minor headway but passing mainly tired rivals to finish 4 lengths 5th at Randwick. Winner at only other start at Warwick Farm. Since trialed at Warwick Farm 9 Jan.

**RACE 6** 2:10 PM | \$65,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1400m

1	<b>SAINT EMILION</b>	First-up (38-weeks). Fresh form solid without winning while given some soft trial work in readiness for return. Makes strong appeal fresh in this affair.
4	<b>ANTHRACITE</b>	Returns for second campaign (19-weeks). First run this region for new stable. On a winning streak. Tuned up with a couple of trials and has placed first-up.
7	<b>DEPUTIZE</b>	Drifted back, cut loose late for a 1.3 lengths third at Gosford. First try at 1400m. Second-up record isn't flash. Freshen up and can go close.
9	<b>IL PASSERO</b>	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced this venue. Has claims.
11	<b>KEN'KER</b>	Up on the speed but outgunned late in rain affected ground at Tuncurry at first run for new trainer. First time around Warwick Farm. Sterner task awaits.

**RACE 7** 2:50 PM | \$65,000 | **WARWICK FARM** | 1000m

2	<b>SHALAA GOLD</b>	First-up (18-weeks). There or thereabouts in last campaign. Placed 100% first-up and proven here while he didn't do much in latest trial. Good draw.
11	<b>NAZWAH</b>	Resuming (26-weeks). Will have matured since her initial campaign. Broke maiden at Gosford in her first preparation. Winner fresh and 2 trials will have her ready for this. Gets in light.
3	<b>GENEROUS HARRY</b>	On target for hat-trick. On pace and stuck on grittily for narrow Midway (Bm64) win at Gosford. On pacer. Rates highly.
4	<b>STRAAND BEAUTY</b>	Prominent and showed plenty of ticker to just go under in thrilling finish in the 3yo+ (Bm72) this track in second run from spell. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Handles the sting out of the ground. Has early speed.
13	<b>THE MAIN EVENT</b>	First-up (18-weeks). Has performed well previously first-up without winning. First time around Warwick Farm. Steep class rise.
