

**RACE 1** 9:35 AM | AUD120,000 | **ROSEHILL** | 1500m

21	<b>OLINGTON LANE</b>	Early form good and a nice weight drop. Issued decent challenge Country Boosted (Bm58) at Moruya. Right in this.
6	<b>PORTOFINO</b>	Shouldered 61.5kg to victory at Gunnedah. Set tempo and surrendered late but had enough in the tank for third E&G (Bm64). On pacer. Has some claims.
11	<b>HOLY HELL</b>	Went home tamely this venue at \$18. Can improve to feature.
14	<b>SHEZAIN</b>	Off midfield when flew home to score at Nowra. Highly rated in this line-up.

**RACE 2** 9:50 AM | AUD150,000 | **CAULFIELD** | 1000m

7	<b>MIRADOR</b>	Heads into second campaign (21-weeks). In the minors this track on debut last campaign. Won a Flemington 800m jump-out 5/6. Should take plenty of beating fresh.
3	<b>ASTON</b>	Form to date sound and in the market at each run. Found enough to place in small field at Sandown-Hillside in only his second race appearance. Worth an each way play.
2	<b>PROFUMO</b>	Left a decent impression on debut at Flemington when in the market 6 Jun. Experience a positive. Back to shorter trip here. Can challenge again.
5	<b>STAKES</b>	A \$300K Magic Millions 2yo gelding by Capitalist and out of the Star Witness mare She's Glamourous. Was a solid winner of a Flemington jump-out 19/6. Look for any market confidence.

**RACE 3** 10:10 AM | AUD160,000 | **ROSEHILL** | 1100m

2	<b>ALBANY ROAD</b>	First-up (18-weeks). Two solid trials have brought him on nicely and is a first-up winner. Awkwardly drawn for return. Form solid this distance.
7	<b>JARRITO</b>	Just behind leading division and picked them up smartly at Randwick-Kensington, at \$3.70. Has claims for a repeat.
11	<b>LADY INVICTUS</b>	Pushed forward and found enough to score as a \$4.60 chance at Warwick Farm in only her second race appearance. Regan Bayliss retains the ride. Can make her presence felt again.
9	<b>GORGEOUS</b>	Solid run 3yo+ Midway (Bm72) at Rosehill 30 May. Went back, closed intently this venue at this trip. Profiles well.

**RACE 4** 10:25 AM | AUD130,000 | **CAULFIELD** | 1100m

5	<b>BIANCELLI</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Winner packed too many punches but she kept on bravely at Morphetville first up. Awkwardly drawn but has enough speed. Will be better for the outing.
8	<b>DELICATE LADY</b>	Knuckled down well from midfield to salute at Mornington. Strong wet stats. Worth a look.
4	<b>TAKEKO</b>	Resuming (46-weeks). Placed at Sandown-Hillside first-up last campaign. Right in the mix again fresh in this company.
12	<b>NEXT STEP IOWA</b>	Shooting for hat-trick. Bided her time at the back and let down smartly at Mornington at second run back. Excels on rain affected tracks. All the better and can again play a role.

**RACE 5** 10:45 AM | AUD160,000 | **ROSEHILL** | 1400m

6	<b>TARZING</b>	Drifted back, cut loose late this track at first run back. Can score here.
12	<b>VIRGIL'S GIFT</b>	Just beaten in the 3yo+ F&M (Bm72) at Randwick-Kensington when second-up. Ready to peak third-up. In the placings only prior run here. Capable of playing a key role in this.
4	<b>ROYAL FLARE</b>	Caulfield Heath winner two back. Handy and acquitted himself fairly well this venue. Stripping fitter and has some claims.
3	<b>CHERISH ME</b>	Responded well from back half to get the prize at Randwick-Kensington at this distance. Could add some value to exotics.

**RACE 6** 11:00 AM | AUD150,000 | CAULFIELD | 1200m

9	<b>MISS LOLA</b>	Sent forward from the wide gate and slipped clear in testing conditions to a decisive victory at Sandown-Lakeside when second-up. Has early speed. Nicely weighted. Right in the mix again.
5	<b>RACE FOR RULE</b>	Cleared maiden ranks at Pakenham 22 May. Worked on the speed and just missed in the 3yo F (Bm70) at Sandown-Hillside at this distance. Nice gate. Makes strong appeal.
7	<b>WRITTEN GLOW</b>	Sets out for second campaign (25-weeks). Maturity upside. First run across the ditch for new stable. Ex C W Cole in New Zealand. Hayes-trained and the money was spot on when saluted at Taupo on debut.
2	<b>AFTERBERNA</b>	Won from just off the pace-setters at Sandown-Hillside. Drawn favourably. Loves the wet. Worth a look.

**RACE 7** 11:20 AM | AUD160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1400m

15	<b>VIRGIL'S GIFT</b>	Refused to shirk task in 3yo+ F&M (Bm72) at Randwick-Kensington at second run back. Ready to peak third-up. Has a light weight. Placed only other time here.
6	<b>AYE AYE CAPTAIN</b>	Off midfield when flew home to score at Warwick Farm second-up. Can repeat dose.
1	<b>SURF'S UP</b>	Won in decisive fashion this venue at this distance. Well placed for repeat.
3	<b>MAKE IT SWEET</b>	Out the back, closed with raking strides in the (Bm78) at Swan Hill. New to Rosehill. Stiffer opposition here.

**RACE 8** 11:35 AM | AUD80,000 | CAULFIELD | 2000m

5	<b>SKIPPERS CANYON</b>	Great run at Caulfield 30 May. Finished well held in choppy conditions at Sandown-Hillside over a longer assignment. Placed only other time over this track and distance. Fit from racing and worth a look.
15	<b>FOIRE DE TRONE</b>	Driving finish from last to win the 3yo+ F&M (Bm70) at Sandown-Lakeside. Gets in light. Capable of figuring again.
9	<b>AMLETO</b>	Showed plenty of fight winning (Bm66) at Ballarat. Can go back to back.
12	<b>PROMISED LAND</b>	Outgunned but did enough for third at \$3 at Bendigo. Handles wet ground. A distance specialist. Not out of this.

**RACE 9** 11:55 AM | AUD160,000 | ROSEHILL | 2400m

10	<b>MASOUN</b>	Upped in distance when went home tamely here at \$101. Has to lift considerably.
9	<b>KING PEDRO</b>	Great run at Gosford 9 May. Super run coming from back half in Benchmark 78 company this venue at \$4.40. Both efforts here stack up. Makes strong appeal.
5	<b>SOUNDS UNUSUAL</b>	On a quick back-up. Started \$7 when battled home in Benchmark 88 company at Randwick. Proven record wet/track. First try at 2400m.
2	<b>BLACK RUN</b>	Jumped in distance when led from pillar to near the post in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup this venue. Goes forward and a proven weight carrier. Can challenge again.

**RACE 10** 12:15 PM | AUD150,000 | CAULFIELD | 2000m

4	<b>GILDED WATER</b>	Freshened after resuming from a break. Finished in another postcode in soft going at Sandown-Hillside at first run off a long break when in the market. Winner at track and distance. Highly rated in this line-up.
6	<b>NELLIE LEYLAX</b>	4 weeks since last run. Last start this trip handily placed but lacked the necessary pick-up and battled to line at Rosehill. Appreciates some cut in the track. Warrants attention.
1	<b>BANKERS CHOICE</b>	Gallant old stager. Turned on the speed and fended off challengers to narrowly prevail at Sandown-Hillside 13 Jun. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Handles the sting out of the ground.
2	<b>SMOKIN' ROMANS</b>	Experienced campaigner. Raced on the pace and went down in a thrilling stoush at Sandown-Hillside. Ready to peak third-up. Adept heavy/proven track.

**RACE 11 12:35 PM | AUD160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1800m**

9	<b>HOVLAND</b>	Wore them down late at Warwick Farm. Suited by the longer assignment now. Well placed for repeat.
15	<b>CONGRESSMAN</b>	Threw the anchor out late after leading at Eagle Farm. Has his first look at 1800m here. Can play a role.
10	<b>SACRIFY</b>	4 weeks since last run. Very tame performance in the slosh this venue at this distance. Right in the mix.
5	<b>GOLDEN CENTURY</b>	Got back and ran home steadily this venue. Place prospects.

**RACE 12 12:55 PM | AUD150,000 | CAULFIELD | 1000m**

5	<b>STREET ARTIST</b>	Let-up (56-days). Made late rally from the back at Bendigo when second-up. Each way claims.
11	<b>FLY BY LIGHT</b>	Kicks off second campaign (17-weeks). Impressive debut at Cranbourne 30 Jan. Won a Cranbourne jump-out 15/6. Maps to get a sweet run. Watch closely first-up.
4	<b>FARCITED</b>	Resuming (66-weeks). Ex G Waterhouse & A Bott in NSW. Handy jump-out win a Cranbourne 15/6. Look for a bold showing fresh.
13	<b>SET ME LOOSE</b>	Gave them a spanking at Seymour at first run off a long break. Can show early speed. Won second-up last campaign. Worth a look.

**RACE 13 1:15 PM | AUD200,000 | ROSEHILL | 2000m**

4	<b>GOD'S WINDOW</b>	Kept coming and just fell short at Randwick. Since trialled at Rosehill 19 Jun. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Can have a major say.
6	<b>ZAPHOD</b>	Fresh. (Open) winner Gold Coast 23 Jan. Game effort this venue in the slosh over this trip. Been thereabouts here.
1	<b>GOLDEN PATH</b>	Fresh. There to threaten just couldn't quite finish it off at Eagle Farm. Adept heavy/proven track. Could get into the placings.
3	<b>MAISON LOUIS</b>	Settled back and didn't figure over a longer assignment in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup this track. Coming back in distance. Could give some cheek at odds.

**RACE 14 1:30 PM | AUD130,000 | CAULFIELD | 1700m**

15	<b>MADIYYA</b>	Primed to strike. Ran a cracking race when just edged out in rain affected ground at Flemington 6 Jun. Highly rated in this line-up.
14	<b>MR BLUNT</b>	Let-up (42-days). Won a 1800m Benchmark 74 at Flemington two back. Made some headway without troubling at Flemington. Right in the mix.
3	<b>THINK GIANT</b>	First-up (38-weeks). European import now in the Price/Kent yard. Has won past couple of jump-outs nicely. Will likely take benefit from the outing but can certainly run a forward race.
7	<b>FIRST CHORUS</b>	On a quick back-up. Won F&M (Bm78) Caulfield 30 May. Not disgraced in choppy conditions at Flemington. Shown can handle the wet here.

**RACE 15 1:50 PM | AUD160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1200m**

16	<b>STAGNUM</b>	First-up (37-weeks). Opened last prep with a win at Randwick-Kensington while brought on by 2 trials. Usually gets back. Placed only other time over this track and distance.
11	<b>CANDLEWICK</b>	On pace, not beaten far this track after blowing in the market first up. Strips fitter second run back. Form solid this distance. Worth a look.
6	<b>STARDEEL</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Closed with conviction from back half to win this track at resumption. Awkwardly drawn and rising in weight. Stays in this company with more weight but can go back to back.
14	<b>SANCTIFIED</b>	In touch, no match but did enough for a minor prize this venue in Benchmark 78 company. Solid efforts here. Among the dangers again.

**RACE 16 2:05 PM | AUD150,000 | CAULFIELD | 1400m**

7	<b>BIG SWINGER</b>	5 weeks since last run. Got back, ran on late with purpose at Sandown-Hillside over this distance. Placed only other time over this track and distance. Major player here.
2	<b>COEUR VOLANTE</b>	Made short work of the small field in the Open Hcp at Sandown-Hillside at second run back. Effective wet. Unbeaten at track and distance. Stripping fitter and can make her presence felt again.
13	<b>ELOUYOU</b>	Prominent, showed plenty of ticker in testing conditions to just go under at Flemington over this trip. Has a light weight. Placed only other time over this track and distance. Can play a role if he gets the breaks.
16	<b>ROADCONE</b>	Rallied powerfully from midfield to salute at Flemington at this trip. Has claims for a repeat.

**RACE 17 2:30 PM | AUD160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1500m**

10	<b>MR CHAPLIN</b>	Steps out for second Aust start. Determined effort to secure victory at Randwick at first run for new trainer. Can again play a role.
11	<b>NO DRAMA</b>	Positive ride but emptied late at Flemington. On pacer. Worth a look.
17	<b>SEVEN'S</b>	Great run at Doomben 23 May. On speed, outgunned late but had enough in the tank for third 3yo+ (Bm78) this venue over this trip. Nicely weighted. Ticks the wet and track boxes.
9	<b>MAWJOOD</b>	Strode forward off wide gate, fought on bravely to just miss here over this trip. Awkwardly drawn but has enough speed. Adept heavy/proven track. Major player here.

**RACE 18 2:45 PM | AUD100,000 | BELMONT PARK | 1400m**

1	<b>MT SHIRATAKU</b>	Patently handled, set alight and went down narrowly in the (Rs0ly) this venue 13 Jun. Pike on, and 1400m should suit. Hard to beat.
6	<b>DIAMONDS'N'RUBIES</b>	Fresh. Two runs this campaign have been good. Loves the wet. Just needs to show she can run out the trip.
3	<b>SPEED BUBBLE</b>	Responded well from back half to get the prize here. At optimum distance. Gets a 1.5kg penalty though, and loses CJP.
10	<b>RIGHT TO SILENCE</b>	Patently handled, set alight and went down narrowly in the (Rs0ly) this track 13 Jun. Likes the wet, so include if conditions suit.

**RACE 19 3:15 PM | AUD60,000 | BELMONT PARK | 1200m**

6	<b>SPICY THANG</b>	On a quick back-up. Filly racing with great gusto. Wet is ok. Just getting up in the weights now, and has a fiddly gate. Pike back on.
2	<b>DELTASON</b>	Midfield, good effort running into 2nd (Rs0ly) this track when off a decent spell. Likes Belmont, and has some upside. Include.
3	<b>HEDAWOOD</b>	Backing up quickly. Back from wide alley, flew late to grab third (Bm66+) over this trip. Bad gate again, and loses CJP. Each-way.
8	<b>POBLANO</b>	Has a picket fence. Good win last start, and 2nd horse won next go. Pike has elected to ride #6, which is a key lead. Not seen a wet track.

**RACE 20 3:45 PM | AUD80,000 | BELMONT PARK | 2100m**

12	<b>SAVVY RULER</b>	Aiming for hat-trick. Came from the clouds to score with authority in Bm54+ company here. Promising and can make the class rise.
5	<b>ANTIQUE QUEEN</b>	Raced a bit flat last time, so no surprise to see her go up in distance. W Pike elects to ride, so expect a bold showing.
4	<b>STARTLING STAR</b>	Shooting for hat-trick this track. Won in decisive fashion this track. Has some staying upside, but Pike has picked #5. Include.
8	<b>DUCHEES DEMERIT</b>	Put in a long run from the back here at this trip. Likes Belmont and handles the soft. Shapes as a solid place prospect.
