4	<b>STRATHTAY</b>	Gave solid chase in a good effort here when seemingly unfancied. Adept heavy/proven track. Hard fit and right in the mix.

9	<b>ASGARDA</b>	Won Open Hcp Mar 20. Wasn't beaten far at Wyong at first run for new trainer. At optimum distance. Will be fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim.
