

**RACE 1** 9:55 AM | AUD27,000 | GOULBURN | 2145m

2	<b>HOLD THE DOOR</b>	Broke maiden at Goulburn 27 Apr. No threat as a \$4.40 chance in 3yo+ (Bm64) at Randwick-Kensington. Winner at only other start at Goulburn. Below expectations last start but prior form keeps him in the hunt.
1	<b>MY GREEK GOD</b>	Very tame performance in rain affected going at Hawkesbury second-up after easing in betting. Sharper now and can make his presence felt.
3	<b>KNIGHT OF RHODES</b>	Backing up quickly. Sound two back in a Benchmark 60. Was a long way from the action in 2200m 3yo+ Plate (C1) at Newcastle. Can put last run behind him.
8	<b>TIME FOR SNOW</b>	On a short back-up. Continues to hold form with another solid finish last time. Ran home into the minors Plate (C1) at Canberra Acton. Placed only other run at Goulburn.

**RACE 2** 10:30 AM | AUD27,000 | GOULBURN | 1100m

6	<b>ARIZONA LONER</b>	Battled to line in the small field at Kembla Grange when drifting in the betting at first run off a long break. Key player.
2	<b>COLD GIN</b>	City grade filly. Failed to threaten at Kembla Grange. Can have a major say.
3	<b>KING FOR A DAY</b>	Trials (2:0-1-0). Making debut after two lead-up trials. Ashley Morgan stays on from trial. Can make an immediate impact.
4	<b>RUSSIAN REIGN</b>	Ran on soundly into third in the small field at Canberra in second run from spell. Untried in the wet. Could get into the placings.

**RACE 3** 11:05 AM | AUD30,000 | GOULBURN | 1200m

6	<b>FORTYTHREEBEANS</b>	Now 4 weeks between runs. Supported in early runs. Handy, knuckled down with purpose at Wagga when in the market. Reverting to shorter trip should help.
4	<b>TOUGH AS STONE</b>	Far from disgraced at Corowa on debut. Should come on. Worth a look.
2	<b>GLENN'S LEGACY</b>	Settled midfield, ran on fairly without threatening at Moruya at first run off a long break. Fitter second-up. Can make his presence felt.
7	<b>ROCKABYE ROXY</b>	Resuming (20-weeks). Ex G Portelli in NSW. Capable of figuring fresh while not asked to do much in lead-up trials. Can make a positive start for new trainer.

**RACE 4** 11:40 AM | AUD27,000 | GOULBURN | 1200m

3	<b>TOMMY FLYER</b>	First-up (23-weeks). Easy winner at Queanbeyan first-up last prep. Should be prominent. A distance specialist.
4	<b>BIG OPINION</b>	Freshened. Great run at Nowra 5 Apr. Midfield and worked home solidly at Randwick-Kensington in second run from spell. Makes strong appeal.
8	<b>THE EYES HAVE IT</b>	Resuming (20-weeks). Tends to race well first-up without winning. Won only other time at Goulburn. Has some claims fresh in this company.
6	<b>WANDAYE</b>	Let-up (45-days). Handy but gave away tamely at Hawkesbury. Since won a Rosehill trial 22 May. Wet form - soft (3:2-1-0); untested heavy.

**RACE 5** 12:15 PM | AUD27,000 | GOULBURN | 1100m

6	<b>OVERTOOK</b>	Started \$41 when safely held in Benchmark 64 company at Illawarra Grange in second run from spell. Untested in wet. Can fill the minors here.
4	<b>INDECISIVE</b>	Broke maiden at Hawkesbury 20 Feb 2025. Ridden cold, produced solid finish late at Kembla Grange when off an extended spell. Strips fitter second run back. Can challenge back in a country Class 3.
10	<b>CURLY BEND</b>	Solid performer. Settled midfield, let down really well at Moruya. Good draw and a nice weight drop. Makes a strong case in this company.
3	<b>DITTERICH</b>	Honest type. Just beaten in the Country Boosted Hcp (C3) at Mudgee over this trip. Rates highly.

**RACE 6** 12:55 PM | AUD27,000 | GOULBURN | 1500m

7	<b>I AM OVERS</b>	Brave effort in busy finish at Scone. Has her first look at 1500m here. Could get into the placings.
2	<b>LOOK HERE</b>	Ex Peter Snowden in NSW. Rarely far away. Kembla Grange F&M Mdn Plate placegetter 18 Apr. Run down late after showing pace in the small field at Newcastle.
5	<b>LET'S BE HONEST</b>	Goulburn Mdn placegetter 27 Apr. Not disgraced in Midway Mdn Plate at Kembla Grange at \$3.70. Capable of making an impact.
4	<b>ROY KELTON</b>	Made late rally from the back at Moruya at his second race start. Can challenge.

**RACE 7** 1:35 PM | AUD27,000 | GOULBURN | 1600m

14	<b>SHEZAIN</b>	Last at turn, ran on late this track. Wet form - soft (2:1-0-1); untested heavy. Added journey should assist. Profiles well.
6	<b>SWEET TREATS</b>	Midfield and worked home solidly at Queanbeyan over this distance. Wet form - soft (7:1-0-0); untested heavy. Should find this a bit easier. Makes strong appeal.
8	<b>MAMMA MIA</b>	Did little in rain affected ground at Warwick Farm at last start this journey. Has an adverse draw and up in weight. Looking elsewhere.
12	<b>TURN LEFT</b>	Went back, closed intently at Moruya. New to Goulburn. Shapes as a rough place prospect.

**RACE 8** 2:10 PM | AUD30,000 | GOULBURN | 1400m

15	<b>CAPITAL BABE</b>	Determined winner at Canberra when firmed from \$3.80 into \$2.90. Wet form - soft (7:1-2-0); untested heavy. Can show up again at fair odds.
5	<b>SHEZAIN</b>	Closed off late from the tail here. Wet form - soft (2:1-0-1); untested heavy. Worth a look.
2	<b>OLINGTON LANE</b>	Got up in final strides this venue at his second race start. Wet form - soft (1:1-0-0); untested heavy. Added journey should assist. Sharper now and highly rated in this line-up.
4	<b>SACRED INFERNO</b>	Went close at Albury 23 Apr. Finished well held this venue. Wet form - soft (5:1-1-1); untested heavy. Can make his presence felt.

**RACE 9** 2:25 PM | AUD28,000 | SUNSHINE COAST POLY | 1100m

4	<b>EVERYBODY RISE</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Won in decisive fashion here at first run for new trainer. Taylor Marshall retains the ride. Commands attention here.
6	<b>MARATHIA</b>	Winner too strong but ran on for the minors at Gold Coast Poly. A few runs under her belt this campaign and worth a look.
8	<b>FITZROY STREET</b>	Displayed a fine change of gears running home to just miss in the Hcp (58) this venue when off an extended spell. Strips fitter second run back. Not out of this.
3	<b>VACILLATION</b>	Let-up (78-days). Sent forward and boxed on bravely in the small field for 0.4 len second at Beaudesert. Can lead or take a sit. Can challenge again with even luck.

**RACE 10** 3:08 PM | AUD28,000 | SUNSHINE COAST POLY | 1400m

5	<b>INCA TRAIL</b>	Great run at Rockhampton 5 May. Sent forward, overhauled late but held on for third this venue. Barrier hurts but possesses early toe. Coming back in distance should suit.
8	<b>AIMA SUN</b>	Got the wobbles late after leading at Gold Coast Poly. Tactical speed, inside draw. Hard fit and right in the mix.
4	<b>ORIENTE</b>	Close-up at Doomben 22 Apr. On pace but conceded late at Sunshine Coast at second run back. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Breaks from a low barrier and big weights don't seem to worry him.
3	<b>NIGHTSTICK</b>	Fought bravely to the wire in the (Bm65) at Rockhampton at first run off a long break. Useful Synthetic form. Will be fitter second-up and takes a 3kg claim. Effective this track and distance and proven synthetic.

**RACE 11 3:50 PM | AUD28,000 | SUNSHINE COAST POLY | 1400m**

10	<b>PRIVALOVA</b>	Failed to run on in the small field here at first run for new trainer. Awkwardly drawn this time. Fitter second-up. Capable of making an impact if she gets the breaks.
8	<b>AIMA SUN</b>	Led, gave away final stages at Gold Coast Poly. Leads, handy. Right in this.
5	<b>VREDEFORT</b>	Showed plenty of fight on the pace this venue. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Switching to 1400m. Could add some value to exotics.
2	<b>ROYAL GLADIATOR</b>	Set tempo and surrendered late but had enough in the tank for third (Bm60) second-up. Has early speed. Claiming apprentice engaged again. First run synthetic.

**RACE 12 4:25 PM | AUD28,000 | SUNSHINE COAST POLY | 1600m**

2	<b>CHEERFUL CAT</b>	Ran a cracking race when just edged out at Gold Coast Poly 16 May. Deep into his campaign and can play a role if he gets the breaks.
7	<b>PROBLEMATICAL</b>	Let down strongly from midfield to score here at second run back. Added journey should assist. Sharper now and right in this.
4	<b>HE IS THE KISS</b>	Recorded a hard fought win at Gold Coast Poly when pushed out in the market. Placed only other run at Sunshine Coast Poly. Super fit from racing and can challenge again.
10	<b>KOJAK</b>	Not disgraced at Eagle Farm first up. First time synthetic. Strips fitter second run back and suited over the longer trip. Could give some cheek back in this company.
