

**RACE 1** 10:40 AM | AUD30,000 | **ALBURY** | 1175m

2	<b>CORAYS ROAD</b>	Found the debut assignment beyond him this course after blowing in the market 16 Jun. Better for it. Has scope to improve and worth a look here.
6	<b>FOUR ESSES</b>	Settled back and didn't figure in sloppy conditions and distance in the Country Boosted Mdn this course. Can make her presence felt with even breaks.
5	<b>BRUTAL TO THE MAX</b>	Battled home in bottomless conditions at Wagga. Hard fit and not out of it.
1	<b>LORD OF VALOR</b>	Failed to flatter this venue at first run off a long break. Will be better for the outing. Hope for exotics only.

**RACE 2** 10:55 AM | AUD30,000 | **SCONE** | 1300m

6	<b>CAPE COD</b>	Arrowfield filly. Signalled some ability on debut at Newcastle 13 Jun. Better for it. Significantly up in distance but can go one better.
10	<b>FLAUNTER</b>	Left a decent impression on debut this track 9 Jun. Wiser for experience and extra ground may help. Strong chance.
3	<b>NULKABA STAR</b>	Finished it off well in the Super Mdn in testing conditions at Gosford. Overdue but hard fit and well placed.
7	<b>JOIKA</b>	Back for second campaign (28-weeks). Given time to mature. Brought on with two trial hitouts. Can challenge fresh in this line-up.

**RACE 3** 11:15 AM | AUD27,000 | **ALBURY** | 1000m

3	<b>POSTWAR</b>	On speed, outgunned late but had enough in the tank for second Mdn Plate this track at first run off a long break. Fitter second-up. Looks poised to shake his maiden.
8	<b>METRO GIRL</b>	Fresh. Modest stats but thereabouts at times. Battled home without looking a threat on a soft deck at Corowa at second run back. Maps to get a sweet run.
2	<b>INZAIN BABY</b>	Kicks off second campaign (14-weeks). Feasible to think he has more to offer this time in. Don't take lightly.
9	<b>SENSESATIONAL STAR</b>	First-up (12-weeks). Ex Nadine Cameron in NSW. Capable of making an impact fresh in this company.

**RACE 4** 11:35 AM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 900m

1	<b>LADY SEGOSHA</b>	Gave a sight on debut at Newcastle under betting interest 6 Jun. Experience a positive. Looks a serious player.
5	<b>CHARLIES</b>	Let-up (52-days). Ex B D Bellamy in NSW. Failed to run on in the small field at Coffs Harbour when second-up. Can show early speed.
9	<b>KASUMI</b>	Off pace, only battled home at Gosford. Tougher test from the draw. Coming back in distance. Can improve to feature.
2	<b>BLIGHTY BOY</b>	Trials (1:1-0-0). Announced readiness with a polished trial win. Sticky gate but can make an immediate impact.

**RACE 5** 11:50 AM | AUD27,000 | **ALBURY** | 1500m

10	<b>ROYAL OVERTURE</b>	Shown promise in limited runs. No threat to winner but ran on for the minors on a waterlogged track at Wagga at latest outing. Highly rated in this line-up.
5	<b>PRINCE OF SPIRIT</b>	Well held but far from disgraced on debut on a H10 at Wangaratta at cricket score odds 14 Jun. Wiser for experience. Added trip may suit. Key player.
1	<b>CHIEF OF WAR</b>	Promising Shamus Award 3-year-old. Ran on okay without troubling in quagmire conditions at Wagga. Placed two from two here. This looks a nice race for the gelding.
4	<b>ETCHED IN BLUE</b>	Trailed speed, kept coming but winner too strong at Ballarat Synthetic when second-up. Good gate. All the better and sound claims.

**RACE 6** 12:10 PM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 2200m

10	<b>JADE SUNSET</b>	Honest type and went close again last start. Prominent, showed plenty of ticker in choppy conditions to just go under at Newcastle. Drawn to get an economic trail. This looks within her reach.
12	<b>PHAROAH QUEEN</b>	Handy, knuckled down with purpose in rain affected going at Newcastle following market easing. Worth a look back in a country Class 1.
9	<b>G'DAY AUSBRED</b>	Unplaced but has run some cheeky races. Not disgraced in 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Newcastle at \$20. Can lead or take a sit. First real test of stamina here.
13	<b>ZORKO</b>	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced in choppy conditions at Newcastle. Stamina on trial here. Place preferred option.

**RACE 7** 12:25 PM | AUD27,000 | **ALBURY** | 1600m

6	<b>INFER</b>	Unhurried early before driving hard late to get the money at Swan Hill at first run for new trainer. First time around Albury. Strikes a harder race.
12	<b>STRATEGIC DEFENSE</b>	Really good run in sloppy conditions coming from the back in Country Boosted (Bm58) this track and distance. Well into preparation now and has some claims.
1	<b>FORTE CHEVAL</b>	Corowa winner two back. Did the donkey work then dropped anchor this track. Has early speed. First go 1600m.
13	<b>JUST LIKE LIAM</b>	\$7 chance, handy and put them to the sword in the Country Boosted (Bm58) this course and trip. Shown can handle the wet here. Up in weight for that win but doubt that will be enough to prevent another bold performance.

**RACE 8** 12:45 PM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 1700m

11	<b>MOANA GOLD</b>	Finally in the winner's circle at Port Macquarie. Strikes another winnable race.
2	<b>OCEAN TSUNAMI</b>	Solid performance in defeat in the (Bm58) this course and distance. Can make her presence felt if she gets the breaks.
9	<b>ZOUGO BOSS</b>	Placed Country Boosted (Bm66) at Moree 2 Jun. Beyond midfield, under pump turn and plugged home at Tamworth. Makes strong appeal.
3	<b>SWEET JUSTICE</b>	Led and asserted total authority winning the Plate (C1) in soft going this track. Handles soft; untested heavy. Worth a look.

**RACE 9** 1:05 PM | AUD27,000 | **ALBURY** | 1400m

8	<b>FUTURE FUND</b>	Finished too well winning (Bm82) at Wagga and distance. Good draw and this is well within his wheelhouse. Can repeat dose.
11	<b>TOO BIG</b>	Resuming (29-weeks). Form solid last time in. Handy fresh horse. Been thereabouts here.
7	<b>ACHESON</b>	Made late rally from the back at Moruya. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Proven in wet. At optimum distance.
1	<b>BLAZING SWORD</b>	Let-up (79-days). Sent out \$41 when unable to threaten in choppy conditions at Caulfield. Ticks the wet and track boxes. Among the dangers fresh in this affair.

**RACE 10** 1:20 PM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 1100m

9	<b>LADY OF THE CASTLE</b>	Kicks off second campaign (20-weeks). Ex John O'Shea & Tom Charlton in NSW. Placed at Gosford on debut last campaign whilst has looked forward enough in latest trials. Bears close watching at first country assignment.
8	<b>DON'T SAY DO</b>	Boxed on for a distant second in the small field at Bathurst at second run back. All the better and can make her presence felt.
11	<b>SABLE COAT</b>	Safely contained at Tamworth on debut 15 Jun. Better for it. Rise in distance should help. More a minor money chance here.
6	<b>CELESTIAL DEAL</b>	Trials (6:0-1-1). With powerful stable and has shown her fair share of talent at the trials. Should be highly competitive.

1	<b>BESSIE LA BELLE</b>	Prominent and fought off challengers in an exciting battle this course. Proven record wet/track. Down in class. Warrants attention.
4	<b>BRUTAL FORCE</b>	Shooting for hat-trick. Responded well from just off leaders to snare a final bound win at Wagga. Drawn well. Prefers some give in the track.
11	<b>IROQUAI</b>	Bided her time at the back and let down smartly this course and trip. Ticks the wet and track boxes. Hard fit and can show up again at fair odds.
10	<b>ANDRES GIRL</b>	Sat behind speed and was strongest late at Wagga in only her second race appearance. Right in the mix again.

5	<b>STARVERNA</b>	Out the back, closed with raking strides in the Country Boosted Hcp (C1) at Dubbo last start. Major player here.
1	<b>OAKFIELD MISSOURI</b>	The money was spot on when saluted this venue on debut. Handles soft; untested heavy. A Bullock retains the ride. Solid hope if butters up.
7	<b>EPHEMERAL</b>	Just got there in a gripping finish at at Tamworth when off an extended spell. Tougher grade but can measure up.
3	<b>SOULS COMPANION</b>	Ran home respectably into a non-threatening 4th at Dubbo when off an extended spell. Will be fitter second-up. Can make his presence felt.

6	<b>BRIAL ROSE</b>	Dictated terms in recording a gritty win in the (Bm58) this venue. Maps well. Previous winner in wet here. All the better and right in this.
1	<b>SHEILA</b>	Resuming (40-weeks). Commanding winner at at Wodonga when fresh last campaign. Proven record wet/track. One for multiples fresh in this affair.
8	<b>ABSTRUSE</b>	First-up (17-weeks). In the minors at Sapphire Coast first-up last campaign while prepared for return with a Moruya trial. One for exotics fresh in this company.
4	<b>TESORO MIO</b>	Did little in choppy conditions at Mornington. Look for an improved effort here.

**RACE 14** 2:35 PM | AUD27,000 | **SCONE** | 1000m

7	<b>SOBEK</b>	Unbeaten gelding facing acid test. Sent forward and found plenty in compact affair this track in only his second race appearance. Handles soft; untested heavy. One for multiples.
1	<b>CASHAWAY GOLD</b>	Last assignment this trip when reasonable effort without seriously threatening in rain affected ground at Taree. Fitter second-up. Looks a serious player.
4	<b>COPPERLINE</b>	Lining up for three wins on the trot. Gutsy on-pace performance taking out the Hcp (C1) this course when second-up. Has early speed. Drops back a notch in trip.
2	<b>GIDDY GIRL</b>	Shouldered 61kg to victory at Goulburn. In touch but couldn't find anything when pressured at Newcastle. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Right in the mix at country level.
