**C1 - PRIX HUNYADE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Newcomers - Flat - EUR €
27,400**

1. TRIUMPH RETURN - Colt by Donjuan Triumphant, the dam never ran. Speedy pedigree and he is one to watch in the betting for clues

2. VIGNELLI - Colt by Siyouni, the dam ran once. From a top trainer who has his horses in rude health. Expected to be well prepared and any market support could be informative

3. SOULAGE - Colt by Dark Angel, the dam never ran. Half-brother to Kiss Melody, (Gr.3 placed and won on debut) From the Fabre yard that can have this colt well tuned.

4. THE HIGHLIGHT - Colt by Dark Angel, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed in the UAE and a Group 3 in France. Nice profile and is one to watch for any market moves

5. PIPPEN - Colt by Sealaway, the dam won 2 races. One to pay attention to in the betting market for any market moves

6. JAMINUS - Colt by Australia, the dam never ran. Likely to improve for this run and is best watched for the time being

7. ROSZAL - Colt by Zelzal, the dam won 2 races over middle distances. Likely to improve for this run and need a stiffer test of stamina. Look elsewhere

8. SAID EL FNA - Gelding by Liberato, the dam was placed a few times. From a respected trainer that knows the time of day. Monitor the betting exchanges

9. WOODOO CHILD - Colt by City Light, the dam was unraced. Stable runners are not renowned for scoring on debut and he is best watched in the betting for clues

10. KASSAB - Colt by Muhaarar, the dam won 1 race over 1200m. Speedy pedigree and should be nicely tuned. Ought to be in the shake-up

Summary: VIGNELLI (2) is from the Francis-Henri Graffard powerhouse and this son of Siyouni will be expected to get off the mark on debut. His main threat could be SOULAGE (3), who is a half-brother to Kiss Melody, who won on debut and was placed in a Group 3 race last year. PIPPEN (5) is also one to take seriously and can make his presence felt. THE HIGHLIGHT (4) is out of a smart mare that won 3 races and was placed in Pattern races. He is worth a market check.

1. LIBERTY LOU - Filly by Oscar Performance, the dam won 2 races and was Listed placed. Looks good on paper and she is worth a market check

2. EN CHANTANT - Filly by Marianafoot, the dam won 5 races, including a Listed race over 1400m. Her dam was a classy operator and she is one to keep onside on debut

3. WHY NOT - Filly by Space Blues, the dam won 1 race. Some good aspects to her profile and she is worth a betting market inspection

4. FLYING SPUR - Filly by Calyx, the dam won 1 race. Can be expected to improve for this run and is best watched for the time being

5. IMMATIN STORM - Filly by Blackbeard, the dam won 2 races. Speedy sire who was a Top-Class two-year old. The betting can be the best guide

6. LA BELLE ISOLA - Filly by Texas, the dam was placed a few times. From a good trainer that can ready a newcomer to strike on debut

7. MICHELADA - Filly by Havana Grey, the dam never ran. Can improve from this debut run and she is one to watch with the future in mind

8. ON THE ROAD AGAIN - Filly by Goken, the dam won 3 races. Stable runners warrants respect. One to monitor in the betting for any market support

9. CHECKERED FLAG - Filly by Starspangledbanner, the dam was unraced. Nice pedigree and she will be well prepared by shrewd connections. Player

10. KOSUMA - Filly by Night Of Thunder, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed event over 2400m. From a top trainer in Andre Fabre who excels with newcomers. Key chance

Summary: KOSUMA (10) is from the master trainer Andre Fabre stable, who excels with fillies. He will have this well-bred newcomer well tuned and she can score on her debut from CHECKERED FLAG (9), who has a taking profile and is from the Graffard stable that knows the time of day. She can feature, as can WHY NOT (3), who is from a good training operation and can have a say in proceedings. LA BELLE ISOLA (6) has Cristian Demuro booked to ride and can give a good account on her first day at school.

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C3 - PRIX FOURIRE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Newcomers - Flat - EUR € 24,700

1. TRESOR MAGNIFIQUE - Gelding by Romanised, the dam ran a few times. Likely to step forward from this run unless the betting market is saying otherwise

2. ZARIBIYAN - Colt by Megdalia D'Oro, the dam won 2 races, including a Group 3 and was placed in a Listed and Group 2 race. From a top trainer that has his horses in fine health. Bold show can be expected

3. WAYKIKI - Gelding by The Grey Gatsby, the dam won 5 races, including a Listed over 1900m. Stable runner tend to need a run or two and he is best watched for now

4. COSTA NAVARINO - Colt by Kingman, the dam was unraced. Looks good on paper and any market support could be a good indication to expected performance

5. NICOMEDE - Gelding by Ectot, the dam won 1 race. One to watch on his debut and likely to need a stiffer test of stamina in time

6. AWICK - Colt by Dubawi, the dam won 2 races, including a Group 3 and was placed in Listed, Group 2 and a Group 1 race. From the Fabre powerhouse. Taking profile and a good performance can be anticipated

7. MAZZALA - Gelding by Frankel, the dam was placed twice. Likely to know what is required on his first day at school. Watch the betting for clues

8. LOUIZA - Filly by Mehmas, the dam won 1 race. Stable runners warrant a close inspection on debut. The betting market can be informative

9. NOTRE ANGLAISE - Filly by Oasis Dream, the dam was unraced. Looks good on paper and she is best monitored in the betting for clues

10. HO HOLY MOLY - Filly by Holy Roman Emperor, the dam was unraced. Does not appeal as a likely first time out winner and is best watched on her racecourse debut

11. ESTIMA - Filly by St Mark's Basilica, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed race. Some good aspects to her profile and she is one to pay attention to if the betting vibes are lively

Summary: ZARIBIYAN (2) has a choice pedigree. His dam was a classy filly who won a Group 3 and was placed in a Group 2 and Listed event. He will be well tuned by his astute trainer and is preferred ahead of AWICK (6), who is also well bred, out of a Group 3 winner, who was also placed in a Group 1 race. He can play a lead role, as can ESTIMA (11), who is taking on the boys and is out of a mare that won a Listed race. COSTA NAVARINO (4) looks good on paper and is worth a market check.

- 1. LIBECCIO WIND** - Three placed efforts, 3rd on the latter over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a maiden race on April 3rd. Handicap debut and can be competitive
- 2. LOHENGREEN** - Three solid efforts this year, 2nd on the last two, the most recent over 2000m at Marseille Borely in a Class 1 race on April 10th. In the mix
- 3. TABEO** - Four placed runs, 3rd on the most recent over 1800m at Le Croise-Laroche in a Class 3 race on April 4th. Place contender
- 4. MUST BAY** - Placed 3rd on his last two starts, the latter over 1800m at Fontainebleau on April 11th in a maiden race. Handicap debut and warrants a close inspection
- 5. PERSIAN GRACE** - Finished 5th last time out over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a maiden race on April 3rd. Tries a handicap and looks well treated
- 6. MON PAULIN** - Placed 4th on his last start over 1900m at Chantilly in a handicap on March 30th. Might find a few of these too smart
- 7. BOX OFFICER** - Won easily over 2500m at Argentan on April 9th in a modest maiden last time and will be full of confidence after that success
- 8. ZELZARA** - Placed 2nd on her last run over 2000m at Deauville in a handicap on April 8th. One to pay attention to
- 9. TI AMO BELLO** - Unplaced last time, a win before that over 2150m in a maiden race at Lyon La Soie on February 24th. Outside place contender at nice odds
- 10. MARIA APOLLONIA** - Finished 5th last time over 2000m at Deauville in a handicap on April 8th. Seems better suited to the all weather surfaces
- 11. EXTRAVAGANTE** - Unplaced last time when 6th over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a maiden race on April 3rd. Handicap debut and others preferred
- 12. WITTELSBACH** - Placed 4th last time in a handicap at Toulouse over 1600m on March 18th. He is worth considering stepping up in distance
- 13. BLACKCLOVER** - Unplaced last time, 4th before that at Le Mans in a maiden race on March 4th. Handicap debut and has work to do
- 14. TOO DARN QUICK** - Two unplaced runs this year, 6th in a handicap at Deauville over 2100m on April 8th last time out. Has shown ability and was 3rd on his second start last year. Player
- 15. YZYA** - Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1600m at Saint-Cloud in a handicap on March 5th. One to consider each-way
- 16. POET'S LYRICS** - Two unplaced runs of late, 2nd before that over 1650m at Craon in a maiden race on September 6th. One to be avoided



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Summary: PERSIAN GRACE (5) has shown a good deal of promise in her three starts, with two second place runs and a fifth on her most recent in a maiden at Saint-Cloud early last month. She can edge this over TOO DARN QUICK (14), who has a light racing weight and was a decent third on his second start as a juvenile last year. He will be sharper after two recent starts. LIBECCIO WIND (1) heads the weights but has shown a good amount of talent in his three starts. He has a good deal more to come. YZYA (15) has been placed several times and looks solid each-way. MUST BAY (4) is another to keep onside on his handicap debut.

- 1. SAIDI EL FAL** - Finished 8th in a Group III over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 26th of October 2025. May just need the comeback run
- 2. TRUST ON** - Decent effort into 4th in a Group III over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 29th of March 2026. One for the backend of quartets
- 3. NEXT MINE** - Pleasant 3rd in a Group III over 1600m at Dusseldorf on the 12th of April 2026. Bold chance to feature well
- 4. TUMBLER** - Hearty 8th in a Group I over 1800m at Meydan on the 28th of March 2026. Can disrupt the top 4 play
- 5. SEAGULLS ELEVEN** - Forgivable 13th in the Golden Eagle back in Randwick over 1500m on the 1st of November 2025. Returns after a rest but can run well fresh
- 6. NO LUNCH** - Gallant winner in a Class 1 Condition over 1600m at Chantilly on the 8th of March 2026. Strong winning chance

Summary: NO LUNCH (6) is absolutely cherishing life having won his last five starts and he looks the right candidate that will take a power of beating in this Group II contest. SILIUS (7) is another that is in fine fettle and is in a threatening position to strike. He deserves serious consideration. SEAGULLS ELEVEN (5) delivered a considerable performance in the Golden Eagle back in Randwick and although returning after five months, he can run well fresh. NEXT MINE (3) completes the quartet mix and is not without a chance.

- 3. LIGHT THE GHOST** - A winner in a Group III over 21000m at Saint-Cloud on the 26th of October 2025. Lurker chance for the backend of quartets

Summary: CANKOURA (1) was encouraging when running her heart out in a Group I and Mickael Barzalona pilots her which he knows what it takes to win. She has the form to add this Group III to her winning tally. SUNLY (6) is a filly that is lightly raced and has bagged a Group III in her penultimate start. She has the ability to make a bold statement. TAJLINA (4) is another that has the right accolades in place and it would be no surprise if she came out victorious. INDALIMOS (2) holds a place chance.

1. HAPPY HUNTER - A winner in a Class 4 Handicap over 1900m at Argentan on the 9th of April 2026. Erratic but capable

2. DEVIL IN THE SKY - Finished 4th in a Class 4 Condition over 2500m at Langon-Libourne on the 6th of April 2026. Include in the backend of quartets

3. EUGENE SMITH - decent 3rd in a Class 3 Condition over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on the 10th of April 2026. Minor each way chance on form

4. TRABUCO - Trying 8th in a Class 1 Condition over 1900m at Deauville on the 12th of December 2025. Can disrupt the top 4 play

- 1. MOUSTIQUE** - Finished 5th in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 2000m on 27 November. Unreliable and could need this run returning from a break
- 2. SILVERO** - Finished 7th on debut in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 2000m on 6 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 3. AGNUS DEI** - Did not show much when 9th on debut in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 2100m on 5 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. SAND SWEEPER** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a Conditions race at Pau over 2000m on 18 January. Could prefer the PSF but cannot be ruled out from scoring
- 5. KING WOOD** - Only modest of debut when 6th in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 2100m on 5 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
