

R1 SAINT-CLOUD [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DU CHATEAU DE SAINT-CLOUD - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 53,000

- **1. LORENZO DE MEDICI -** Ran well to be 2nd over 3100m in a Class 2 handicap on May 1st at this track on his last start. Down in trip, but should be competitive
- **2. WIT PERD -** Two unplaced runs of late, the most recent over 2400m at Parislongchamp on May 7th in a Class 3 handicap. Others preferred
- **3. LA TEMPLIERE -** Four unplaced runs of late, well beaten on the the most recent on May 1st at this track over 3100m in a Class 2 handicap. Look for an alternative
- **4. FREEZE -** Three unplaced runs recently, the latter over 2400m at Parislongchamp on May 7th in a Class 3 handicap. Capable but seems out of form
- **5. CIRCEO -** Two unplaced runs of late, 4th before that over 1900m in a Class 3 claimer on February 20th at Chantilly. Makes limited appeal
- **6. SAPRISTI -** Two 2nd placed runs this year, the latter over 3100m on May 13th in a Class 3 race at this track. Track and trip winner last May. Player
- **7. TREATWOOD -** 6th on the last run over 2000m at Parislongchamp on May 11th in a Class 2 handicap. Up in trip which looks a positive
- **8. ZELZARI -** He has been 2nd on the last three runs, the most recent at Nantes over 2400m on May 22nd. Can get off the mark
- **9. MISS WHITE SOCKS -** Two unplaced runs recently, 3rd before that over 2100m at this track on March 20th in a Class 2 handicap. Track winner over 2000m on March 6th in a Class 3 handicap. Can make the frame at nice odds
- **10. BEAUTIFUL MEMORY -** 2nd on the last run over 2500m at this track on May 19th in a Class 3 claimer. Needs to be more consistent
- **11. TURANIA -** Six unplaced runs of late, the latter over 3100m on May 13th in a Class 3 race at this track. He has dropped to a good handicap mark and Maxime Guyon booked to ride
- **12. ATHINEOS -** Ran a decent 2nd over 2500m on April 23rd at this track in a Class 3 handicap on the last run. Place contender
- **13. OLYMPIC FLAMBEE -** Placed on his last three runs, 4th over 2000m at this track on May 13th in a Class 3 handicap. Leading chance
- **14. ONE POINT -** 4th on her last two start, the latest over 3100m on May 13th in a Class 3 race at this track. She is versatile trip wise and should have a say
- **15. FIRSTMAN -** Three unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2500m at this track on May 19th in a Class 3 claimer. Needs to bounce back to form



Summary: ZELZARI (8) has been consistent with three second-place runs recently. He is reasonably well handicapped and can achieve deserved success. OLYMPIC FLAMBEE (13) has been in decent shape with three placed efforts, the latest over 2000m at this track in a Class 3 handicap in May. He can be a live threat. LORENZO DE MEDICI (1) heads the handicap and was second over 3100m last time out. He has solid form over this trip and is an each-way option. SAPRISTI (6) and ONE POINT (14) are both worth considering and are capable of being on the premises.

C2 - PRIX ALLEE D'AMOUR - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 30,000

- **1. NARISSA -** Unraced filly by Siyouni, the dam won one race. From a top stable that can ready a newcomer to strike on debut. Bold show expected
- **2. NEPETA -** Filly by Anodin, the dam won 3 races, 2 on the flat and one over hurdles. Can improve for this run, and others look more likely
- **3. SEESHAUPT -** Filly by City Light, the dam never ran. From a respected trainer. Any market moves should be noted
- **4. BALEINE -** Filly by Sea The Stars, the dam won 1 race. Nice profile, and she will be well prepared. Watch the betting for clues
- **5. VANINA RUNAWAY -** Filly by Zelzal, the dam was unraced. From a leading stable and the mount of Maxime Guyon. Expected to have a say in the finish
- **6. LAKE DREAM -** Filly by Dariyan, the dam was placed on the flat. Stable runners tend to need a run or two. Watch the betting patterns for any support
- **7. HATSLIANA -** Filly by Dabirisim, the dam was unraced. Stable runners are respected on debut and any market support should be noted

Summary: NARISSA (1) has a taking profile, and she will be well prepared by her astute trainer. She can score on her debut from VANINA RUNAWAY (5), who is from a leading stable and is the mount of leading jockey Maxime Guyon. BALEINE (4) is a daughter of Sea The Stars and can be involved on her first day at school. HATSLIANA (7) is from a respected trainer, and she is one to watch in the betting market for any support.

C3 - PRIX CHAPEAU ROUGE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 30,000

- **1. SYNARAN -** Colt by Mehmas, the dam won on her debut. Nice profile and a half-brother to Siyenica, who won a Listed race and was placed in Group races. Can be expected to play a lead role
- **2. MAC TYSON -** Colt by Golden Horde, the dam won 3 races, including a Class 1 race. One to watch in the betting for any market interest
- **3. LE DOC -** Colt by Fas, the dam never raced. Can be expected to improve for this run. Watch the betting patterns close to race time
- **4. SEGALL -** Colt by Sottsass, the dam won 3 races, including a Listed race and a Group 2. From the Andre Fabre powerhouse, and will be well tuned for this debut. Player
- **5. CHAWEL -** Colt by Ghaiyyath, the dam was unraced. Looks good on paper and he is one to look at in the betting market for clues
- **6. ZULU CHANT -** Gelding by Magna Grecia, the dam won 2 races. From the Fabre yard, which is doubly represented. Monitor the betting for clues
- **7. MAXIMILIEN -** Colt by Cotai Glory, the dam never ran. Likely to improve for this debut run. The betting can guide
- **8. VALPOVO -** Colt by Zarak, the dam never raced. His trainer will have this colt well tuned for this opening race. Any market support should be noted
- **9. STREET SHOW -** Colt by Showcasing, the dam was placed on the flat. Nice profile and he is one to watch in the betting for any support
- **10. GOOD BYE MANU -** Colt by Almanzor, the dam was placed on the flat. Stable runners are respected on debut. The betting market can guide

Summary: SYNARAN (1) has a nice profile and is a half-brother to Siyenica, who won a Listed race and was placed in Group races. He will be expected to make a winning debut under Mickael Barzalona. SEGALL (4) is one of two trained by Andre Fabre; his dam was a Pattern race winner, and he can play a lead role. His stablemate ZULU CHANT (6) is well bred and is one to watch in the betting market. VALPOVO (8) is another to keep onside.

C4 - PRIX DU VAL D'ENFER - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 27,000

- **1. MODERNISE -** 6th last time out, 3rd before that at Southwell (UK) when trained by Harry Charlton. Needs to show more than his run over 1600m at this track in Late April. Look elsewhere
- **2. SUMMER STORM -** Two unplaced runs, the latter when well beaten over 1800m at Fontainebleau on April 12th in a maiden race. Hard to recommend
- **3. ALLURE -** Placed on all three runs, the latest over 2100m at this track in a Class 3 race on May 9th. Hard to rule out
- **4. PANTA REI -** Nice run when 2nd on debut at Chantilly over 2000m on May 2nd in a conditions race. He can improve and is a player
- **5. MONARCH OF THE SEA -** 4th on his last start over 2100m at this track on April 18th in a maiden race. Might find a few too smart
- **6. TUSKER -** Two good 2nd placed runs, the most recent over 2000m at Chantilly on April 28th in a maiden race. Sets the standard
- **7. QUIRYN -** Gelding by Sottsass, the dam won 2 races and was Listed placed. One to watch in the betting for clues
- **8. ZAEL -** Unraced gelding by Zelzal, the dam won 1 race over hurdles. Can be expected to improve for this outing unless the betting says otherwise
- **9. ZORBA -** Filly by Le Havre on debut, the dam won 2 races. Looks good on paper and can have a say in proceedings. Wears a hood and tongue tie which is a slight worry

Summary: TUSKER (6) has finished second in both outings and, with his experience, has a strong chance to get off the mark. ALLURE (3) has shaped well in all three runs and looks like a future winner, ensuring tough competition for the selection. PANTA REI (4) should improve after his second-place finish at Chantilly last month and warrants respect. ZORBA (9) has a promising profile and could make an impact on debut, despite wearing a hood and tongue tie.

C5 - PRIX MARGOUILLAT - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 40,000

- **1. GRECIAN DESTINY -** Won at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a maiden race on February 22nd three runs back, placed twice since, the most recent over 1400m on May 4th in a Class 2 race at Parislongchamp. Live chance
- 2. TIEGO THE FIRST Ran well to be 4th on May 4th in a Class 2 race at Parislongchamp on the latest start. Can not be overlooked
- **3. COKTAIL -** 2nd on the last run over 1600m on May 17th at Lyon Parilly in a Class 1 race. More required in a stronger race
- **4. PYRAMIDE -** She won two runs back over 1600m at Chantilly in a maiden race in January and was 2nd on the latter over 1400m in a Class 2 race in March at the same track. Might find a few to smart
- **5. YAA WALE -** Placed on all three runs this year, 3rd on the last run over 1600m at this track in a handicap. Player
- **6. LE ROI LEON -** Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 1600m in a Class 2 race at Lyon Parilly on April 16th. Can be competitive
- **7. JOVIALITE -** Two placed runs this year, 2nd on the latest start over 1600m at this track on May 13th in a handicap. Merits consideration
- **8. MISTY QUALITY -** Five solid placed runs this year, 4th on the most recent over 1600m at Parislongchamp on May 15th in a Class 2 race. Can make the top three
- **9. TIGER -** Fair 4th last time out at Angers on April 26th in a Class 2 race over 2100m. Outside place chance
- **10. VICTORY FOLIE -** Four unplaced runs of late, 7th on the latest over 1600m on May 13th in a handicap at this track. Has work to do

Summary: GRECIAN DESTINY (1) won his maiden at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in February and has shaped well in his two runs since, finishing third in a Class 2 race at Parislongchamp in early May. He is given the vote ahead of TIEGO THE FIRST (2), who won a Listed race last year and was less than a length behind the selection in the Parislongchamp race. YAA WALE (5) has been placed in all three runs this year and looks like the each-way must. JOVIALITE (7) completes the shortlist.
