

R1 Longchamp [R-H]

C4 - PRIX DE LA VILLE DE PARIS - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 55,000

- **1. ZAWAN** 6th in a Listed race last time, 3rd before that in a Class 2 race over 1500m on January 24th at Deauville. Live chance
- **2. MAHASEN -** Placed 4th on both starts this year, the latter over 1600m in a handicap at this track on April 13th. Might need to drop in the weights a few kilos
- **3. ALEKSINE** Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1400m at Chantilly in a handicap on February 21st. Capable if in the mood
- **4. ZOLIA -** Won on the last start over 1600m at Nantes in a handicap on April 9th. Might be in the handicapper's grip
- **5. ACTO** 9th last time out, 3rd before that over 1600m in a handicap at Saint-Cloud on March 6th. Place contender
- **6. EL PEQUENIO -** Three unplaced runs since a 4th in a Class 2 race on January 31st at Deauville over 1900m. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **7. RUE ERNESTINE** Ran well to be 2nd over 1600m in a handicap at Toulouse on March 19th on her latest start and won before that on the PSF in December, Consider
- **8. GREEN CAPE -** 6th on the one run this year over 1800m at Lyon La Soie in a maiden on March 30th. Has place claims
- 9. THE SNARK 2nd on the latest start over 1600m at Nantes on April 9th in a handicap. Might find a few of these too smart
- **10. ZIGGY STAR -** Won on his latest start over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on April 23rd in a handicap. More needed in a stronger handicap
- **11. SOMMERBLAU** 5th on her last start over 1600m at this track in a handicap on April 13th. Among the leading each way options
- **12. RIDE ON -** Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 1800m in a maiden race at Le Croise-Laroche on March 21st. Handicap debut and others seem more likely
- **13. TOOGOODTOBEROOD -** Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 1400m in a handicap on March 17th at Chantilly. One to pay attention to
- **14. GOLDEN ALQA -** Fair 5th over 2000m in a maiden at Le Lion D'Angers on April 6th on her third start. Handicap debut and warrants respect
- **15. BANMA -** Won on her third run over 1500m in a Class 3 race at Vannes on April 13th. Handicap debut and can not be ruled out



16. ORANGERIE - Tries a handicap after four runs in maiden races, she is better than her run at Compiegne over 1600m on March 28th, when she ran too freely. Off a low weight, she can play a lead role

Summary: ORANGERIE (16) gets in at the foot of the weights and has shown promise in maiden company. If settling better than she did last time, she can make a bold bid at nice odds. ZAWAN (1) brings solid form at a higher level, having tried Listed company last time and previously placed in a Class 2—she looks a major player. EL PEQUENIO (6) is better than recent efforts suggest and could represent each-way value. GOLDEN ALQA (14) also has claims among the remainder. SOMMERBLAU (11) was a good finisher in this division last time and has to be considered as well.

C5 - PRIX GOLD RIVER - 2800m (a2m) - TURF - Listed Race - Flat - EUR € 48,000

- **1. JANNAH PEARL** Ran well to be 4th in a Listed race at Saint-Cloud over 3000m on March 29th and won before that in a maiden last October over 2200m. Hard to overlook
- **2. KATHINA -** Fair 5th last time, a win before that in a Class 2 race at Fontainebleau on March 18th over 3000m. Strong stayer who is an honest performer
- **3. AGILE -** 3rd on the last start over 3000m in a Listed race at Fontainebleau on November 14th. Lightly raced last year and might improve for this after a layoff
- **4. MISS DYNAMITE -** Won twice last year in Poland, the last run was when 2nd over 2600m at Sluzewiec (POL) on October 6th. Fitness to prove and faces a stiff task
- **5. AQUA AUGUSTA -** Two unplaced runs this year, the latter over 2400m in a Class 2 handicap at this track on April 13th. Opposable
- **6. FULL OF HOPE -** Placed on both runs this year, 4th on the latest over 2400m in a Listed race on April 13th at this track. Might need a few to falter
- **7. BIBBIENA -** Won on her last start over 2400m at this track in a Class 2 handicap on April 13th. She should thrive over this extra trip
- **8. OLATZ DE VEGA -** Not seen since a win over 2500m in a Class 2 race at Deauville on November 9th. She should be fit and can not be ruled out

Summary: KATHINA (2) looks the one to beat in this Listed contest. She impressed with a strong win over 3000m in a Class 2 at Fontainebleau and ran with credit in a higher-grade race last time. JANNAH PEARL (1) rates the main danger after a solid fourth in Listed company at Saint-Cloud, backing up her maiden win last October. OLATZ DE VEGA (8) returns from a break but is interesting on form and could be a value each-way player. BIBBIENA (7) also warrants respect and can't be ruled out.

C6 - PRIX SAMOS - 1950m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 3 Race - Flat - EUR € 19,000

- **1. E VA BIN** Finished 5th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1800m at Fontainebleau on the 12th of April 2025. Holds unreliable form
- **2. ATANASIO -** A winner in a Class 3 Handicap over 1900m at Deauville on the 8th of April 2025. Huge runner, include in all bets
- **3. NARCOS -** Finished 10th in a Class 2 Handicap over 2000m at Parislongchamp on the 17th of April 2025. Has inconsistent form and will be hard to find trustworthy
- **4. VERNIX -** Finished 7th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1600m at Fontainebleau on the 21st of April 2025. Hard to recommend on overall form
- **5. THE FIRST DANCE -** Finished 16th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1600m at Chantilly on the 3rd of April 2025. Can put a line through her last two runs and holds strong a winning chance
- **6. MEAUTIS -** A winner in a Conditional over 1800m at Lyon La Soie on the 9th of January 2025. Winning claims
- **7. THARPE -** Finished 12th in a Class 3 Conditional over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 11th of April 2025. Others pose more interest
- **8. HIGHBARI -** Finished 3rd in a Class 3 Conditional over 1800m at Clairefontaine on the 24th of August 2024. Will need the comeback run
- **9. GRAN HABANO -** Finished 3rd in a Class 3 Handicap over 1600m at Nantes on the 9th of April 2025. Irregular form but can give a pleasing account of himself
- **10. LISEO -** Finished 14th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1900m at Deauville on the 8th of April 2025. Erratic but capable of a quartet chance
- **11. PALAZZO -** Finished 16th in a Class 2 Handicap over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on the 29th of March 2025. Others weigh more attraction
- **12. PREWITT -** Finished 8th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1800m at Lyon La Soie on the 23rd of March 2025. One to respectfully pass by
- **13. AL KHAMSIN** Finished 16th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1600m at Fontainebleau on the 21st of April 2025. Others preferred
- **14. TROPHANE -** Finished 5th in a Conditional over 1900m at Chantilly on the 31st of March 2025. Eachway claims
- **15. SALT FLAKE -** Decent 5th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Lion D'Angers on the 6th of April 2025. Include in exotic plays
- **16. CREEKATTEMPS -** Finished 2nd in a Class 3 Handicap over 2100m at Senonnes on the 12th of April 2025. Others have more appeal



Summary: THE FIRST DANCE (5) can be forgiven for her last two starts as she faced a much tougher opposition. The drop in class could see her bouncing back to produce a winning effort. MEAUTIS (6) was a courageous winner when breaking his maiden las time out and will be trying his best to make a big splash here too. TROPHANE (14) keeps knocking on the door and she can put her best foot forward here in breaking her maiden streak. ATANASIO (2) was a winner in his last start and has all the limelight upon him to produce a sneaky chance of snatching a victory again.
