C1 - PRIX VENTRE SAINT-GRIS - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 27,400

- **1. YEP -** Finished second on debut over 1400m on this course in Maiden on 10 June. He would have gained from the experience and should be the one to beat
- **2. SUGAR DADDY -** Needed debut when seventh over 1200m on this course in Unraced Conditional on 19 May. There may be improvement to come
- **3. UN PTI TRUC ENPLUS -** Finished behind Sugar Daddy when ninth over 1200m on this course in Unraced Conditional on 19 May. Others have a stronger winning chance
- **4. PRINCESS ZALTANA -** Ran a fair race on debut when fifth over 1400m on this course in Maiden on 10 June. She should make the natural progression
- **5. PISTOIA -** First timer by Wootton Bassett out of Mezzo Mezzo with Theo Bachelot doing duty. Watch the betting market
- **6. AUTENTICA -** Well-bred daughter of New Bay out of Auriga making her debut with Maxime Guyon in the saddle. The betting market will be the best guide for clues
- **7. KENDELYA -** Unraced daughter of Victor Ludorum out of Aniysa and Stephane Pasquier rides. The betting market will need to be monitored

Summary: YEP (1) produced an eye-catching debut effort when second over this course and distance, on 10 June. He would have gained from the experience and with the natural improvement that is expected, he is the horse to beat. AUTENTICA (6) is an unraced daughter of New Bay with Maxime Guyon booked to ride. The betting market will be the best guide with regards to her and the other first timers. PISTOIA (5) is a daughter of Wootton Bassett having her first run with Theo Bachelot up. KENDELYA (7) was supplemented for this race and is a daughter of Victor Ludorum. Stephane Pasquier does duty.

- **2. CHEVALDOR -** Finished fourth in all three starts, the latest over 2400m at Compiegne in Class 3 Conditional on 30 May. He is one of the leading contenders
- **3. TENDER MOMENT -** Showed good improvement when third over 2300m at Dieppe in Maiden on 9 June. He may have more to come
- **4. SANO -** Moderate latest when seventh over 3000m at Dieppe in Maiden on 14 June. Others have a stronger chance
- **5. KETMIE QUEEN -** Fair latest when fourth over 2100m on this course in Class 3 Conditional on 10 June. Cristian Demuro keeps faith in the mount, and she can show

Summary: GOLDEN WEAVER (1) raced in the Group 3 Prix Du Lys Longines on 15 June. He takes a big drop in class and should take a power of beating. CHEVALDOR (2) has finished fourth in all three career outings. He is a horse with scope and is one of the leading contenders. KETMIE QUEEN (5) has fair recent form lines to her credit. Cristian Demuro retains the ride which is a big plus and she can show. TENDER MOMENT (3) showed good natural improvement when third over 2300m on 9 June. He is coming along the right way and has scope.

- **1. FIRSTMAN -** Won over 2500m on this course in Class 4 Handicap on 13 June. He meets a similar line-up and can follow up with another victory
- **2. PLAIN BEAU** Better than latest when seventh over 2000m at Parislongchamp in Class 4 Handicap on 12 June. Can feature on previous form
- **3. MON RICIN -** Finished fifth over 1900m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in Class 4 Handicap on 11 June. Maxime Guyon is booked to ride which is a big positive
- **4. ALCEDIMZOE** Unplaced over 2400m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in Class 3 Handicap on 11 June. Needs to find best form
- **5. HUTTON -** Finished behind Firstman when second over 2500m on this course in Class 4 Handicap on 13 June. Merits obvious consideration

MON RICIN (3) has some fair form lines to his name and with Maxime Guyon booked to ride, he cannot be ignored. HUTTON (5) comes into this contest in good form. He finished behind Firstman when second on 13 June. He merits healthy respect once again.

- **1. MARKER -** Returned to form when second over 2400m at Parislongchamp in Class 3 Handicap on 8 June. Mickael Barzalona sticks with the ride, and he can go one better
- **2. VIANETA -** Unplaced in first run this year over 2500m at Argentan in Class 4 Handicap on 26 June. May find this difficult
- **3. ZALETTO -** Ran a fair race when fifth over 3150m at Lyon Parilly in Class 3 Handicap on 14 June. With luck from his awkward draw, he would not be a shock winner
- **4. SUMMER WAY -** Finished fifth in both starts this year, the latest over 3000m at Parislongchamp in Class 3 Handicap on 5 June. She will strip much fitter and can show from a good draw
- **5. LOU MARINA -** Tad disappointing in latest when sixth over 2650m at Chateaubriant in Class 4 Handicap on 12 May. Needs luck from the barrier position
- **6. SHANGHAI SPIRIT -** Better than last two starts. Unplaced over 3000m at Parislongchamp in Class 3 Handicap on 5 June. Can feature on best form shown
- **7. MATGIWELL** Finished fourth over 2800m at Compiegne in Class 3 Handicap on 21 June. Big runner if finding form of penultimate effort
- **8. WATT OHM -** Unplaced in first run this year over 2400m on this course in Class 3 Handicap on 10 June. May be outgunned
- **9. GOLD PALACE -** Has inconsistent form lines. Finished fourth over 2400m on this course in Class 3 Handicap on 10 June. Chance if putting best foot forward
- **10. JOLIEPIERRE** Two moderate runs this year. Finished eighth over 2400m at Le Lion D'Angers in Class 4 Handicap on 8 June. Others have a stronger winning chance
- **11. GAVIAL -** Unplaced in last three starts, the latest over 3000m at Craon in Class 4 Handicap on 11 June. Needs to find best form
- **12. OPUS -** Having first outing this year. Finished fourth over 2700m at Orleans in Class 4 Conditional on 9 June 2024. May be in need of this effort
- **13. GOOD QUESTION -** Battling to find best form. Finished sixth over 2600m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux in Class 4 Handicap on 21 June. Look elsewhere

Summary: MARKER (1) showed good signs of a form return when second over 2400m on 8 June. Mickael Barzalona retains the ride which is a big plus. If confirming his recent improvement, he can go one better. SUMMER WAY (4) has finished fifth in both of her starts this year. She will strip a much fitter horse and is one of the leading contenders. MATGIWELL (7) followed up her penultimate victory at Parislongchamp with a decent fourth-place finish. She is in a good space and must be considered. ZALETTO (3) ran a fair race when fifth at Lyon Parilly on 14 June and would not be a shock winner.

- **1. CONCERTO -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 3000m on 5 June. Others make more of an appeal in this line-up
- **2. LITTLE HEART -** Finished 9th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 3000m on 5 June. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- **3. MONSIEUR GEORGE -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at Craon over 3000m on 11 June. Needs to find a few lengths to be competitive
- **4. MILORD DU LEMO -** Fifth in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 3000m on 5 June. Finished third in the only attempt on this track
- **5. DETESNOUVELLES -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Chantilly over 2100m on 15 June. Probably best watched until improvement is shown
- **6. SINGEL MALT -** Fifth in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 3000m on 5 June. Seldom far off them and has place prospects
- **7. ARMORIGENE** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Argentan over 2500m on 26 June. Others are much preferred in this line-up

Summary: PARFAITE MERILL (8) has been unreliable this year but hinted at a return to form last time out and could win a race at this low level. MAESTRO CHOP (11) won at Argentan but lost it in the stewards' room and can make amends if in the same mood. ECLAIR DE VATI (10) is on a long losing run but ran well at Argentan and is clearly not out of it. HARLEY DREAM (9) showed improvement at ParisLongchamp and is another to consider.

- **1. FECAMP -** Finished 7th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 12 June. Came from well back in the latest and is not out of it
- **2. HIGHFIELD HEIRESS -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 20 June. Unlikely to be involved in the finish and is best watched
- **3. SHAMASUN -** A winner in a Handicap at this track over 1200m on 13 June. Can defy the 3KG penalty and follow up
- **4. BLUE DREAM -** Fifth in a Handicap at this track over 1200m on 13 June. Improved efforts in the last two can be competitive again
- **5. ROYALTIES -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 20 June. Probably best watched until improvement is shown
- **6. FILLE DU ROI -** Fourth in a Handicap at Waregem over 1600m on 20 June. Seldom far off them in Belgium, and can be involved in the finish
- **7. GARDOL MOON -** Third in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 20 June. Made a decent return and warrants attention

GARDOL MOON (7) returned from a break in fine form and can be involved at the finish. FECAMP (1) is not the most reliable but has won over this distance and is capable of making the frame.

- **1. LUNALA -** Fifth in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 8 June. Finished off the race well and warrants attention
- **2. MA MOME -** Fourth in a Handicap at Compiegne over 1400m on 27 June. If in the mood, can be competitive in this field
- **3. ELUSIVE FOOT -** Finished 8th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 12 June. A winner three runs back and is not out of it
- **4. VEGA -** Finished 7th in a Condition race at Chantilly over 1400m on 20 June. Will need to improve to feature
- **5. MRS HOLIDAY -** Finished 6th in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 12 June. A penultimate start winner who has place prospects
- **6. MR GOODNIGHT -** Finished 7th in a Claimer at Pornichet-La Baule over 1700m on 28 January. Others make more of an appeal in this line-up

Summary: RIVAL ORDER (7) has shown much improved form of late and gets the vote to score in an open-looking handicap. LUNALA (1) was not disgraced at ParisLongchamp and can get involved in the finish over this shorter distance. BAILEYS ILLUSION (10) has not been at her best recently but is usually competitive and has a winning chance in this line-up. DORIANELLO (8) is best judged on last year's form and is also capable of winning.

- **1. RISING UP -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 14 June. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- **2. ITAEWON -** Unplaced in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1200m on 24 June. Unlikely to be involved in the finish again
- **3. ISEULT -** Finished 10th in a Handicap at Strasbourg over 1400m on 28 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win here
- **4. KENDAYA** Well beaten 9th in a Condition race at Argentan over 1300m on 26 August. Probably best watched for now
- **5. URI -** A runner-up in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 20 June. Finished off the latest well and can go one better

WEEKEND WARRIOR (12) remains in very good form and should be right there at the finish.

C1 - PRIX NISSAN A.G.S. - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. NEBUR -** Good 2nd over 1200m in a claimer on his last run on June 16th at this track. One to pay attention to
- **2. GENERAL CHOP -** 5th last time at this track in a maiden over 1200m on June 2nd, and 2nd before that at Saint-Cloud on May 13th. In the mix
- **3. CAPITOL HILL -** 9th on his last run over 1400m at La Teste on June 26th in a conditions race. Unlikely to feature
- **4. BARISTO** Two solid 2nd placed runs, the latter over 1200m at this track in a maiden on June 2nd. Live chance
- **5. DAMABIAH ANGEL -** 4th on her second start over 1400m at Toulouse on June 22nd in a maiden race. Might find a few of these better equipped
- **6. VOLKONSKHA** Two 2nd placed runs so far, the latter at this track over 1200m in a maiden on June 2nd. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **7. HEPBURN -** Placed 3rd on both starts, the latter over 1200m at this track on June 2nd. Can not be ruled out and is likely to like this extra distance
- **8. BANKHOVSKI -** Unraced colt by Zelzal, the dam never raced. He is a half-brother to a Grade 3 winner in the USA. Watch the betting patterns
- **9. MOUSTIQUE -** Colt on debut by Earnshaw, the dam won two races. Stable runners are nicely tuned on debut, and any market moves should be noted

- **12. OCEAN DROP** Unraced filly by Al Wukair, the dam won 4 races, including a Listed event. Nice pedigree and is one to keep onside
- **13. FIVESTARS -** Unraced filly by Toronado, the dam was unraced. Stable runners warrant respect and any market support should be informative

Summary: BARISTO (4) has been knocking at the door with two second-place runs so far, the latter at this track in a maiden on June 2nd. He can be too smart for the promising filly HEPBURN (7), who was third behind a facile winner on her latest outing at this track, and should enjoy the step up in trip. One place ahead in second in the same race was VOLKONSKHA (6), and she can again give a good account of herself. BANKHOVSKI (8) is also worth consideration.

- **1. HM CHAWLAH -** Placed 4th on her last two runs, the latter over 1900m at La Teste on June 2nd. Might find a few of these too smart
- **2. HM TASSABIH** Filly by Al Mouwaffak, the dam won 1 race. Likely to need this race for experience. Watch the betting for any support
- **3. MOMINA -** Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 2100m at Tarbes on May 12th in a conditions race. Place contender
- **4. ANOUSTE AL CASSAGNE -** Two unplaced runs so far, the latter over 2250m at Montauban on June 15th. Looks safely held
- **5. ALREEM -** 5th on the last run, 3rd before that at Dax on May 1st in a conditions race over 1400m. One to keep onside
- **6. BEHOOR AL SHAHANIA -** Ran well to be 2nd at Gabarret over 1800m in a conditions race on May 8th on her last run. Capable of having a say

Summary: In a contest that lacks depth, SIGNATURE AL MAURY (7) sets a fair standard based on her Mont-de-Marsan second two runs back, and looks capable of getting off the mark. ALREEM (5) should be a strong contender if she builds on her earlier Dax effort, while BEHOOR AL SHAHANIA (6) is an improving type with an each-way appeal after a solid runner-up finish at Gabarret in May. MOMINA (3) could sneak into the frame, though she may need further improvement.

- **1. ARLONG FAL -** Credible 4th at Marseille Borely on his last run on June 13th in a Class 2 race over 1200m. Ought to be thereabouts
- **2. PAS DANSANT -** He won on his only run at La Teste on June 2nd over 1200m in a maiden race. He can improve and is one to consider
- **3. GOLDEN BREEZE -** 4th on the latest start over 1100m at Tarbes on June 5th in a Class 2 race. Course winner over 1000m on debut in March. She might find a few too smart
- **4. CATH HOCHE -** Fair 3rd in a Class 3 race over 1000m on May 29th in a Class 3 race. She won over 1200m on debut on May 5th. Player
- **5. ROYAL BAY CEN -** Won her maiden at Craon on June 11th over 1300m on her third start. The slight drop back in trip should not hinder her chances

Summary: ROYAL BAY CEN (5) won well on her latest start at Craon over slightly further 23 days ago on her third run. - **2. MAHROUSE -** 7th last time, 2nd before that on debut at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on March 28th in a conditions race. Player
- **3. JAWHARA -** Two unplaced runs, the latter over 1800m at Langon- Libourne in a conditions race. Others more likely to score
- **4. LEMPIKA PY -** 8th on her sole run over 1800m in a conditions race at Langon-Libourne on June 23rd. Has to make vast progress to feature
- **5. MAJESTE DE BOZOULS -** Newcomer by Nieshan, the dam won 2 races on the flat. Likely to need this run for experience unless she is supported in the betting market
- **6. SHAMROUKH -** Colt by Ajs Thrb, the dam ran once. His trainer will have this colt well prepared and a bold run can be expected
- **7. CEZANNE DE GHAZAL -** Unraced by Madjani, the dam was placed on the flat. Stable runners warrant respect on their debut

Summary: CEZANNE DE GHAZAL (7) has a taking pedigree, and she will be well prepared by her shrewd handler. She can edge this over SHAMROUKH (6), who also looks the part on paper, and his trainer can ready a newcomer to strike on debut. MAHROUSE (2) was unplaced last time, but a nice effort when second on debut gives him hope. RICH N CLASSY (1) ran well when fifth on his latest start and is worth considering.
