

## R1 DEAUVILLE [R-H]

## C1 - PRIX DE GRANVILLE - 1100m (a5f1/2) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 27,400

- **1. HORNIG** Two unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1100m at Dieppe on July 22nd in a maiden race. Has not progressed from a promising debut
- **2. APOCOLYPTO -** Two unplaced runs so far, the latter over 1400m at Compiegne on July 21st. Hard to recommend
- **3. VIZIOSA -** Improved effort to be 2nd on her last run at Chantilly over 1200m on July 8th after a nice debut 3rd in June. One to keep onside
- **4. REPEL -** Good 2nd on debut at Deauville over 1200m on July 5th. She will improve for that run and should be suited by the drop in trip
- **5. BURGUESINHA -** Pleasing debut 2nd at Chantilly over 1100m on June 15th. Progress expected and she can play a lead role
- **6. SATOSHI -** Two unplaced runs, well beaten at Vittel over 1600m in a maiden on July 20th. Makes no appeal
- **7. GILDOR -** Unraced colt by Siyouni, the dam won 1 race over 1400m and was Listed and Group 3 placed. Nice profile and should know what is required on his debut

**Summary:** REPEL (4) showed plenty of promise when second at this track over slightly further on her debut last month. Interestingly, she drops back in distance, and she can get the better of BURGUESINHA (5), who ran with credit on her sole start when second at Chantilly in June. She will know more this time. VIZIOSA (3) is also worth considering after a solid second at Chantilly in July on her second start after a pleasing debut run. GILDOR (7) looks good on paper and could be smart.

## C2 - AL RAYYAN CUP (PRIX KESBEROY) - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 50,000

- **1. LAFFAN -** Two from two, the latest win over 1600m in a Group 2 PA on June 16th at La Teste. Looks smart and can play a lead role
- **2. FAHD AL CHAM -** Unraced colt by Mister Ginoux, the dam was placed twice. The trainer is respected, and this colt should be well-prepared for this opening run. Any market support could be informative
- **3. ROMEO AT -** Won impressively on his one start over 2000m at Toulouse on May 28th in a conditions race. Improvement is expected, and he can follow up
- **4. AMJAAD -** Placed twice since winning on debut over 1400m in March. His 3rd at La Teste on July 12th was a credible effort. Consider
- **5. SUBAHIYAH -** Won on debut by 2L over 1500m in a conditions race at Tarbes on April 19th. Ought to be thereabouts with progress anticipated

**Summary:** ROMEO AT (3) was an impressive debut winner at Toulouse in late May, scoring by over six lengths. With natural improvement, he looks poised to follow up. LAFFAN (1), unbeaten in two starts, is the likely danger after narrowly winning a Group 2 PA over 1600m at La Teste on June 16th in a tight finish. SUBAHIYAH (5) made a successful debut at Tarbes in mid-April and appears the pick of the rest.

## C3 - DOHA CUP (PRIX MANGANATE) - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 50,000

- 1. MOSHRIF Fair 2nd last time out over 2100m in a Group 1 PA race at Al Uqda (QAT) on April 10th. In the mix
- 2. AL ZWAIR 5th on his last run over 1600m in a Group 2 PA at Hamburg-Horn (DEU) on July 6th. Has work to do
- **3. LUWSAIL -** Two wins of late, the latter over 2000m at Parislongchamp on May 11th in a Group 1 PA race, he won a Group 1 PA race in Qatar before that on April 10th. Sets the standard
- **4. JOE STAR -** Fair 4th at La Teste over 1900m in a Group 3 PA race on July 12th on his last start behind RB KINGMAKER (5). Place contender
- **5. RB KINGMAKER -** Nice win over 1900m in a Group 3 PA at La Teste on July 12th by 2L over 1900m. Player

**Summary:** LUWSAIL (3) has the best form on offer. He has won his last two races, the latest at Parislongchamp in a Group 1 PA race, and he obliged in a same class race in Qatar in April. He can be too smart for his rivals. RB KINGMAKER (5), was third in the Group 1 PA at Parislongchamp and looks like the main threat. He has just over a length to find, as they meet on the same terms. MOSHRIF (1) looks best of the others.

# C4 - PRIX D'ETREHAM - FONDS EUROPEEN DE L'ELEVAGE - 1500m (a7f1/2) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 31,100

- **1. CANALEJAS -** Ran well to be 3rd in a Listed race over 1400m at Vichy on July 16th after a win at Toulouse in June. One to look at each way
- **2. KOMOREBI -** Nice win on his second start at Clairefontaine on July 11th over 1600m. Looks like a useful prospect
- **3. OTHON -** Nice win on his only start over 1400m at La Teste on June 26th in a conditions race . Hard to overlook with improvement likely
- **4. GOOD BYE MANU -** Won on his second start over 1350m at Cholet on June 30th in a maiden race. This is more challenging
- **5. MODELE ABSOLU -** 5th on the latest start over 1600m at Vichy on July 25th over 1600m in a maiden. Unlikely to threaten the principles
- **6. FEELINGS -** Ran well to finish 2nd on debut, when running green at Chantilly over 1400m on July 20th. He will have learned from that run and can feature
- **7. MAXIMILIEN -** Unplaced in a maiden over 1400m at Compiegne on his last run on July 21st, placed before that on both runs. Might find a few of these too smart
- **8. WARHOLM -** Unraced gelding by Time Test, the dam won 2 races, including a Listed race—nice pedigree and from a respected trainer. Can improve for this debut and is one to watch

**Summary:** KOMOREBI (2) improved from his pleasing second on debut to win cosily on his latest start at Clairefontaine over 1600m in a maiden on July 11th. He is preferred over FEELINGS (6), who showed plenty of promise when second at Chantilly late last month, despite showing inexperience. He can improve a good deal from that outing. OTHON (3) won nicely on his debut at La Teste and has to be considered, as does CANALEJAS (1), who was a decent third in a Listed race at Vichy in July.

### C5 - PRIX DE SURVILLE - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 21,100

- **1. BIRIATOU -** Unplaced last time, a win before that over 1600m in a Class 4 race at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on January 30th. Returns from a layoff and others make more appeal
- **2. KEY TO SUCCESS -** Three unplaced runs this year, the latter over 3200m in a Class 3 handicap at Cages-Sur-Mer on February 19th. Unlikely to be involved
- **3. PURPLE MOOD -** Previous course and distance winner in 2023, nice 5th at Parislongchamp on July 10th in a Class 3 handicap on the last run. Has a wide draw but can be competitive
- **4. LETTYT FIGHT -** Two good runs of late, 2nd on the latter over track and trip in a Class 3 handicap on July 5th. Previous course winner who can win again
- **5. ALCATOSER -** 7th last time over 2100m at Vittel in a Class 4 handicap on July 7th. He likes the PSF and can make the frame at big odds
- **6. TUPPES -** Several unplaced runs of late, 8th at Clairefontaine on July 26th in a Class 3 handicap last time out. He has dropped to a good rating and is one to consider
- **7. PIERRE LE GRAND -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 2000m at Marseille Borely on July 14th in a Class 4 handicap. Likes the PSF and can feature
- **8. BEST SHALAA -** Two credible 5th placed runs of late, the latter over 1600m at Vichy on July 17th in a Class 4 race. Each way angle
- **9. EFFIRA** Won on her last start over track and trip in a Class 3 handicap on July 5th. One to pay attention to
- **10. PERRINE -** Poor form of late, well beaten over 2000m at Compiegne on the last run on June 27th in a class 3 handicap. Pass over
- **11. LILY OFTHE KINGDON -** Several unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1800m in a Class 4 claimer at Parislongchamp on May 7th. Unlikely to feature
- **12. PRINCESSE BLONDE -** 6th last time over 1600m at Clairefontaine on July 26th in a Class 3 handicap. Won over track/trip in April. In the mix
- **13. TRIPTAJIKA -** 5th on her last start over 2100m at Vittel on July 25th in a Class 4 handicap. Among the leading each way chances
- **14. SAGUARO -** Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 1800m at Zweibrucken (DEU) on June 22nd. Hard to fancy
- **15. MAESTRO CHOP -** Two unplaced runs since a 2nd over 2500m at Argentan on June 26th in a Class 4 handicap. Opposable
- **16. COCO LIGHT -** Three unplaced runs of late, 6th at Chateaubriant over 1950m in a conditions race on July 23rd last time out. Hard to fancy



**Summary:** LETTYT FIGHT (4) has solid course form and arrives in good shape following two recent placings, including one over this trip in early July. He gets the nod. PURPLE MOOD (3) isn't ideally drawn in stall 13 but could pose a threat if ridden patiently. BEST SHALAA (8) returns to the PSF after some respectable turf efforts and should be suited. TUPPES (6) has dropped significantly in the weights and may prove dangerous.
