C1 - QATAR PRIX MARCEL BOUSSAC - CRITERIUM DES POULICHES - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Gr1 - Flat - EUR € 400,000

- **1. NARISSA** Finished behind GREEN SPIRIT (8) when second over 1600m on this course in the Group 2 Prix D'Aumale on 11 September. She may have to settle for the same result
- **2. AYLIN** Won the Group 2 Betfred May Hill Stakes over 1600m at Doncaster in the Great Britain on 11 September. She clearly has class about her and cannot be discounted
- **3. CLEA CHOPE -** Finished behind GREAT SPIRIT (8) when third over 1600m on this course in the Group 2 Prix D'Aumale on 11 September. She may battle to turn the form around
- **4. BANDIAGARA** Comes off a third-place finish in a Conditional Listed over 1600m at Deauville on 23 August. She faces her toughest test to date and others are preferred
- **5. ESNA -** Made the natural improvement when winning over 1400m at Sandown in Great Britain on 17 September. She takes a massive rise in class and may be outgunned
- **6. VENOSA** Stable companion of DIAMOND NECKLACE (7) and Wayne Lordan will do duty. Finished fourth over 1400m at Leopardstown in Ireland in a Listed race on 13 September. Look elsewhere
- **7. DIAMOND NECKLACE** Unbeaten from two starts. She was victorious in a Listed race over 1400m at Leopardstown in Ireland on 13 September. Christophe Soumillon retains the ride, and she may be the one to side with
- **8. GREEN SPIRIT -** Unbeaten in four starts. Winner of the Group 2 Prix D'Aumale over 1600m on this course on 11 September. Merits healthy respect
- **9. OZONE -** Winner of both career efforts, the latest of which was in a Conditional Listed over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on 9 September. Maxime Guyon has decided to stick with GREEN SPIRIT (8)

Summary: DIAMOND NECKLACE (7) hails from the visiting Aidan O'Brien stable. She won a good race at Leopardstown last time and looks to have quality about her. Unbeaten in four starts, GREEN SPIRIT (8) looks to be the biggest challenger with Maxime Guyon opting to ride her. OZONE (9) is a winner of both her career efforts to date. The daughter of Lope De Vega looks to be a progressive type and cannot be ignored. AYLIN (2) comes off a victory in the Group 2 Betfred May Hill Stakes and should give a good account of herself.

C2 - QATAR PRIX JEAN-LUC LAGARDERE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Gr1 - Flat - EUR € 400,000

- **1. RAYIF -** Was an impressive winner in both his starts, the latest of which was in the Group 3 Prix Francois Boutin over 1400m at Deauville on 17 August. The son of Sea The Moon has class about him and can remain unbeaten
- 2. VARDIF Finished behind NIGHTTIME (8) when third in the Group 3 Prix la Rochette over 1400m on this course on 11 September. He may have to settle for the same result
- **3. CAMPACITE** Won a Listed race over 1600m at Deauville on 23 August. Faces his toughest test to date but is in search of the hat-trick
- **4. TIME TO TURN -** Won a Listed race over 1400m at Ascot in Great Britain on 25 July. The combination of Charlie Appleby and William Buick cannot be discounted
- **5. PUERTO RICO -** Comes off a victory in the Group 2 Betfred Champagne Stakes over 1400m at Doncaster in Great Britain on 13 September. He is one of the leading contenders
- **6. A BIT OF SPIRIT -** Comes off a Group 3 victory over 1400m at Sandown in Great Britain on 30 August. The son of Palace Pier can finish on the podium
- **7. CIELO DI ROMA -** Made the natural improvement when winning over 1400m at Deauville in Conditional Maiden on 9 September. Takes on much stronger here
- **8. NIGHTTIME -** Winner of his last three starts, the latest of which was in the Group 3 Prix la Rochette over 1400m on this course on 11 September. Merits healthy respect
- **9. IMPERIAL ME CEN -** Finished sixth in the Group 1 Sumbe Prix Morny over 1200m at Deauville on 24 August. Others have a stronger winning chance

Summary: RAYIF (1) is unbeaten from two starts and won a good race in the Group 3 Prix Francois Boutin last time. Mickael Barzalona retains the ride, and he may be the one to beat. PUERTO RICO (5) won the Group 2 Betfred Champagne Stakes easier than the official margin suggests. He should pose a massive threat. NIGHTTIME (8) is a winner of his last three starts, the latest of which was in the Group 3 Prix la Rochette on this course. He should be right there. TIME TO TURN (4) represents the Godolphin team and he can show.

C3 - PRIX DE L'ABBAYE DE LONGCHAMP LONGINES - 1000m (a5f) -TURF - Gr1 - Flat - EUR € 350,000

- **1. AGAINST THE WIND -** Finished third over 1000m at Southwell in Great Britain on 21 September. Look elsewhere
- **2. WASHINGTON HEIGHTS -** Finished unplaced in the Group 1 Nunthorpe Stakes over 1000m at York on 22 August. May be outgunned in this line-up
- **3. AIN'T NOBODY -** Unplaced in last two starts, the latest of which was over 1200m at Ayr in Great Britain on 20 September. Needs to find best form to have a say here
- **4. MEGARRY -** Finished third over 1200m at Deauville in the Group 3 Prix de Meautry on 30 August. Faces his toughest test to date and may find it difficult
- **5. JM JUNGLE -** Finished behind ASFOORA (17) when sixth in the Group 1 Nunthorpe Stakes at York in Great Britain on 22 August. Needs to find form of penultimate victory
- **6. PONNTOS** Finished behind MONTEILLE (13) when third over 1000m at Parislongchamp in the Group 3 Prix Du Petit Couvert on 14 September. He may have to settle for the same result
- **7. JAWWAL -** Won over 1100m at Chantilly in Class 1 Conditional on 15 September. Takes on much stronger and may find this difficult
- **8. RUMSTAR -** Finished sixth over 1050m at Newbury in Great Britain in a Group 3 on 20 September. Finished behind ASFOORA (17) in his penultimate outing at York
- **9. NIGHT RAIDER -** Finished fifth over 1000m at the Curragh in Ireland in the Bar One Racing Flying Five on 14 September. He is yet to win at Group 1 level but cannot be ignored
- **10. RAYEVKA -** Finished behind MONTEILLE (13) when second in the Group 3 Prix du Petit Couvert over 1000m on this course on 14 September. She cannot be discounted with Mickael Barzalona doing duty
- **11. FROST AT DAWN** Finished behind ASFOORA (17) when third over 1000m at York in Great Britain in the Group 1 Nunthorpe Stakes on 22 August. She is one of the leading contenders
- **12. SHE'S QUALITY** Finished fourth over 1000m at the Curragh in Ireland in the Bar One Racing Flying Five on 14 September. Is yet to shape at Group 1 level
- **13. MONTEILLE -** Winner of the Group 3 Prix du Petit Couvert over 1000m on this course on 14 September. Cristian Demuro rides from an inside draw and she should give a good account of herself
- **14. FIRST INSTINCT -** Won a Group 3 over 1050m at Newbury in Great Britain on 20 September. Is an honest individual but may be outgunned in this line-up
- **15. MGHEERA** Finished sixth over 1000m at the Curragh in Ireland in the Bar One Racing Flying Five on 14 September. Chance on best form shown
- **16. STAR OF LADY M -** Finished unplaced in a Listed race over 1100m at Ayr in Great Britain on 19 September. Others are preferred



- **17. ASFOORA** Is better than latest when seventh over 1000m at the Curragh in Ireland in the Bar One Racing Flying Five on 14 September. Oisin Murphy is back in the saddle, and she may the one to side with
- **18. SKY MAJESTY -** Disappointing latest when eighth over 1200m at Haydock in the Group 1 Betfair Sprint Cup Stakes on 6 September. Has work to do to win this contest
- **19. AFJAN -** Won the Group 3 Prix D'Arenberg over 1000m on this course on 31 August. The son of Mehmas takes on older rivals but he looks to have plenty of class about him and gets a good weight allowance

Summary: ASFOORA (17) is better than her last start in Ireland and she is a quality sprinter. Oisin Murphy steps back into the saddle and she should be the one to beat. FROST AT DAWN (11) finished behind ASFOORA (17) last time. William Buick will do duty, and she is one of the leading contenders. MONTEILLE (13) comes off a victory in the Group 3 Prix du Couvert on 14 September. She should be the first French based runner home. AFJAN (19) takes on older rivals but has plenty of class and carries a nice weight.

C4 - QATAR ARABIAN WORLD CUP - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 1,000,000

- **1. JOE STAR -** Finished behind AL ZEER (10) when second over 2170m in Belgium in a Group 3 on 2 September. Others have a stronger winning chance
- **2. MOSHRIF** Finished third over 2000m at Parislongchamp in a Group 1 on 7 September. May find it difficult to win this contest
- **3. AL GHADEER -** Has won six times from seven starts in France. Winner of a Group 1 over 1600m at Goodwood in Great Britain on 30 July. Won this race last year and can defend his title
- **4. AL ZWAIR -** Battling to find best form. Finished fifth over 2000m on this course in a Group 1 on 7 September. Others look stronger
- **5. LUWSAIL -** Finished behind HM ALCHAHINE (6) when second over 2000m on this course in a Group 1 on 7 September. He may have to settle for the same result
- **6. HM ALCHAHINE -** Winner of last four starts, the latest of which was over 2000m on this course in a Group 1 on 7 September. Merits healthy respect
- **7. RB KINGMAKER -** Was victorious in his last two starts, the latest of which was in a Group 1 over 2000m at Deauville on 5 August. He finished second in this race last year
- **8. CH'EZZA -** Finished behind AL GHADEER (3) when third in a Group 1 over 1600m at Goodwood in Great Britain on 30 July. With luck in running, he can finish on the podium
- **9. NABUCCO AL MAURY -** Finished behind AL ZEER (10) when third over 2170m in Belgium in a Group 2 on 2 September. Others look stronger
- **10. AL ZEER -** Won a Group 3 over 2170m in Belgium on 2 September. He may be outgunned in this line-up
- **11. MURAAD -** Finished second in a Group 3 over 1900m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on 12 July. Maxime Guyon knows him well and the combination cannot be ignored
- **12. RB MARY LYLAH -** Winner of last two starts, the latest of which was over 1600m in Turkey in a Group 3 on 7 September. James Doyle rides but more is needed

Summary: AL GHADEER (3) won this race last year and is in good form heading into this contest. Christophe Soumillon rides and he is the horse to beat. HM ALCHAHINE (6) is in top form and comes off a Group 1 victory over this course and distance. He should be involved at the finish. RB KINGMAKER (7) finished second behind AL GHADEER (3) in this race last year and should run another honest race. LUWSAIL (5) finished behind HM ALCHAHINE (6) last time and may have to settle for the same result.

C5 - QATAR PRIX DE L'ARC DE TRIOMPHE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Gr1 - Flat - EUR € 5,000,000

- **1. GIAVELLOTTO -** Won on his last run over 2400m in a Group 3 race at Kempton (UK) on September 6th. Group 1 success in the Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin (HKG) in December. Well drawn and can make the top four
- 2. WHITE BIRCH 5th on his last start over 2000m in the Irish Champion Stakes (Gr.1) on September 13th behind a few of today's rivals. Group 1 success in the Tattersalls Gold Cup in May
 2024.
 Hard to recommend
- **3. ARROW EAGLE** 6th on his last run over track and trip in the Prix Foy (Gr.2) behind BYZANTINE DREAM (6) on September 7th. Group 2 winner in June over 2400m at Chantilly of the Grand Prix De Chantilly. This will be more challenging
- **4. SOSIE** Fair effort to be 2nd in the Prix Foy (Gr.2) behind BYZANTINE DREAM (6) over track/trip on September 7th. Group 1 success over 1850m at this track on May 25th in the Prix D'Ispahan. Player from stall 3
- **5. LOS ANGELES -** Placed 4th on his last two runs, the latter over track and trip behind BYZANTINE DREAM (6) in the Prix Foy (Gr.2) on September 7th. Won the Tattersalls Gold Cup (Gr.1) at the Curragh in late May over 2000m. Stall 14 is a slight worry, but he can be involved
- **6. BYZANTINE DREAM -** Won over track and trip on September 7th in the Prix Foy (Gr.2) on his last start. Stall 15 is not ideal, and he has work to do
- **7. ESTRANGE** Fair 2nd on her last run over 2400m in the Group 1 Yorkshire Oaks behind MINNIE HAUK (17) on August 21st. She faces a tough challenge from stall 18
- **8. QUISISANA -** She has won all three starts this year, the latter over 2000m in the Prix Jean Romanet (Gr.1) at Deauville on August 24th. She is improving and is well drawn in stall 7. Consider each way
- **9. KALPANA -** Placed on all four runs this year, 2nd at Kempton (Gr.3) on the all-weather track in early September, and 2nd in the King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr.1) at Ascot (UK) on July 26th. Can play a lead role
- **10. AVENTURE -** Top class filly, who has solid credentials. 2nd in this race last year, in top form this year. She won the Prix Vermeille (Gr.1) over track and trip on September 7th by 1.5L. Leading contender
- **11. DARYZ -** Ran well to be 2nd in the Prix Du Prince D'Orange (Gr.3) over 2000m at this track on September 14th behind CROIX DU NORD (15). Tries this distance for the first time and has a favoured stall in 2
- **12. LEFFARD -** 6th on his last run in the Prix Niel (Gr.2) behind CUALIFICAR (13) on September 7th over 2400m at this track. He won the Grand Prix De Paris (Gr.1) in July over track and trip. He is well drawn and has place claims at big odds
- **13. CUALIFICAR -** Won well over track and trip in the Prix Niel (Gr.2) on September 7th and 2nd in the Prix Du Jockey Club (Gr.1) in June at Chantilly over 2100m. Improving colt and is well drawn in stall 8



- **14. HOTAZHELL -** Placed 4th on his last two runs, the latter over 2000m at Leopardstown (IRL) over 2000m on September 13th in the Irish Champion Stakes (Gr.1). Opposable
- **15. CROIX DU NORD -** Two good wins of late, in Tokyo (JPN) over 2400m in the Japanese Derby (Gr.1) in June on his penultimate and the latter over 2000m in the Prix Du Prince D'Orange (Gr.3) over 2000m at this track on September 14th. One to keep safe despite stall 17
- **16. ALOHI ALII -** Won on his sole run in France on August 16th in the Prix Guillaume D'Ornano (Gr.2) on August 16th over 2000m. A winner in Japan. Lightly raced and he might find a few of these too smart
- **17. MINNIE HAUK** Class filly who has won all four runs this year, three Group 1 races, including the Epsom Oaks in June, Irish Oaks in July and the Yorkshire Oaks on her last start on August 21st by 3.5L over 2400m. Well drawn and has a live chance
- **18. GEZORA -** Ran well to be 2nd behind AVENTURE (10) in the Prix Vermeille (Gr.1) over track and trip on September 7th last time. Prix De Diane (Gr.1) winner over 2100m in June. Can not be ruled out despite stall 13

Summary: This could go to last year's runner-up, AVENTURE (10), who has been in top form all year. She scored a convincing win in the Prix Vermeille (Gr.1) over this track and trip on September 7th, taking her Arc trial by 1.5 lengths. She clearly enjoys this course and could just edge out MINNIE HAUK (17), who has been targeted at this race all season. A triple Group 1 winner in the Oaks circuit—landing the Epsom Oaks, Irish Oaks, and the Yorkshire Oaks—she was last seen in late August, winning easily by 3.5 lengths. She is well drawn in stall 1 and has Christophe Soumillon booked to ride. GEZORA (18) was a solid second behind AVENTURE (10) in the Prix Vermeille and could be involved again. KALPANA (9) can rebound after her defeat on the artificial surface at Kempton in September and warrants respect. SOSIE (4) is well drawn and may also have a say in the closing stages.

C6 - PRIX DE L'OPERA LONGINES - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Gr1 - Flat -EUR € 500,000

- **1. ROYAL DRESS -** Placed 2nd on her last run over 1800m in a Group 3 race at Chantilly on September 20th. She might find this too much
- **2. GRAND STARS -** Placed on all five runs this year, 3rd on the most recent over 2000m in the Prix Jean Romanet (Gr.1) on August 24th at Deauville. Others rate higher
- **3. TAMFANA -** 7th last time out, 2nd previously over 1600m at Sandown (UK) in the Bet365 Mile (Gr.2) on April 25th. She has been given a break since May and has been trained for this race
- **4. START OF DAY -** 6th on her last run in late August, 3rd before that over 1600m in the Prix Rothschild (Gr.1) at Deauville on August 3rd. Capable of being involved
- **5. SEE THE FIRE -** Placed on her last three runs, 4th on the most recent over 2050m at York (UK) in the Juddmonte International (Gr.1) on August 20th. Hard to overlook
- **6. ONE LOOK -** Placed 2nd at the Curragh (IRL) over 2000m in the Moyglare Jewels Blandford (Gr.2) at the Curragh on September 14th behind BARNAVARA (7). Place chance
- **7. BARNAVARA -** Won on her last run over 2000m in the Moyglare Jewels Blandford (Gr.2) at the Curragh on September 14th by 3.5L. In the mix
- **8. WEMIGHTAKEDLONGWAY -** Good 2nd in the Irish Oaks (Gr.1) at the Curragh over 2400m on July 19th last time out. Capable of a bold show
- **9. JANUARY -** 7th last time out in September, 2nd before that over 1600m in the Prix Rothschild (Gr.1) at Deauville on August 3rd. Key chance
- **10. MERVEILLEUX LAPIN -** Fair 3rd last time out over 2100m in a Listed race at this track on September 4th. This looks like a step too far
- **11. QILIN QUEEN -** 4th last time out, a win before that over 2400m in the Prix De Malleret (Gr.2) at this track over 2400m on July 13th. The drop back in trip is not ideal
- **12. NICORENI -** Won on her last start over 2200m at Dusseldorf (DEU) in a Group 1 (German Oaks) on August 3rd. Can make the top three

Summary: WEMIGHTAKEDLONGWAY (8) is given the vote after an excellent run in the Irish Oaks (Gr.1) at the Curragh in July, when she was a good second behind Minnie Hauk. She is preferred ahead of SEE THE FIRE (5), who has performed well all year. Her fourth in the Juddmonte International (Gr.1) in late August was a creditable effort. JANUARY (9) warrants respect. If she emulates her second in the Prix Rothschild (Gr.1) at Deauville in August, she can not be excluded. TAMFANA (3) heads the rest.

C7 - QATAR PRIX DE LA FORET - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Gr1 - Flat - EUR € 350,000

- **1. ROSHVAR -** Two wins this year, the latter over 1400m in a Group 3 race at this track on September 14th. Up in class, but he should be suited by a strong pace
- **2. KING'S GAMBLE -** Ran well to be 2nd at Doncaster (UK) over 1400m in the Betfred Stakes (Gr.2) on September 13th last time out. Can make the top four at big odds
- **3. DEVIL'S POINT -** 6th on the last start over 1400m in the Betfred Stakes (Gr.2) at Doncaster (UK) on September 13th. Group 2 winner in Germany in 2024. Opposable
- **4. SAJIR -** Three wins from four runs this year, the latest success was over 1300m in the Prix Maurice De Gheest (Gr.1) on August 10th. Speedy and can be involved if able to see out this trip
- **5. ZOUM ZOUM -** Credible 4th on his last run over 1400m at Doncaster (UK) on September 13th. This is a stronger race, and it will not be easy for him
- **6. TOPGEAR -** 5th on his last run over 1300m at Deauville in the Prix Maurice De Gheest (Gr.1) on August 10th behind SAJIR (4) on August 10th. Place chance
- **7. WITNESS STAND -** Placed on the last three runs, 2nd on the latter over 1400m in a Group 2 race at Newbury (UK) on August 16th. Looks vulnerable
- **8. GEOGRAPHY -** Two wins of late, the latter over 1600m at Baden -Baden (DEU) on September 7th. Down in trip and he can make his presence felt
- **9. ZEROSTRESS -** Placed on his last five runs, a win two runs back over 1200m in a Listed race at Hoppergarten (DEU) on August 10th. This requires a lot more to make the top four
- **10. MORE THUNDER -** Two wins of late, the latter over 1400m at Newbury (UK) in the Hungerford Stakes (Gr.2) on August 16th. Hard to overlook
- **11. TEN BOB TONY -** Unplaced last time out, a win previously over 1450m in a Group 3 race at Haydock (UK) on May 31st. He has work ahead to be involved
- **12. MARANOA CHARLIE** Solid effort to be 3rd at York (UK) over 1400m in the City Of York Stakes (Gr.1) on August 23rd. Group 3 winner over track and trip on June 8th. Player
- **13. EXXTRA -** 4th on her last run over 1400m in a Group 3 race at this track on September 14th. She needs a personal best to score
- **14. ZARIGANA -** Top class operator, 2nd on her last run on June 20th in the Coronation Stakes (Gr.1) at Ascot (UK), and a win over 1600m in the Poule D'essai Des Pouliches (Gr.1) in May. Key chance
- **15. EXACTLY -** Ran well to be 2nd over 1600m at Leopardstown (IRL) on September 13th in the Matron Stakes (Gr.1). Ought to be thereabouts
- **16. GODSPEED -** Placed 4th on her last start over 1600m in the Prix Rothschild (Gr.1) on August 3rd at Deauville. Can place at attractive odds



Summary: Classy filly ZARIGANA (14) should have no trouble with the drop in trip today. She was awarded the Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (Gr.1) in May in the stewards' room and has shaped well in her runs since. MARANOA CHARLIE (12) is likely to set the pace and could establish a strong early tempo. His third-place finish at York in August was encouraging, and he's capable of giving another solid account. MORE THUNDER (10) landed the Hungerford Stakes (Gr.2) in mid-August and commands respect. SAJIR (4) has plenty of speed, and if he stays the trip, he could prove dangerous.

C8 - QATAR GRAND HANDICAP DES FLYERS PRESENTE PAR RMC - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 1 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 72,000

- **1. LANZELOT GOLD -** Two unplaced runs of late, 2nd previously over track and trip on May 7th in a Class 1 race. Class 1 handicap winner over track/trip in April. Can be involved if overcoming a wide starting position
- **2. REVERSO -** Credible 3rd last time out over 1400m at Prague (CZE) on September 20th in a conditions race. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- **3. MAJOR OAK -** Ran well to be 4th over 1200m at Chantilly in a Class 2 handicap on September 20th. His better form recently has been over 1200m
- **4. OMICRONE -** Unplaced last time in August over 1200m, a win previously over this track and trip on July 13th in a Class 2 race. Hard to rule out of the top three
- **5. HEYBETLI** Five unplaced runs of late, 6th on the latest over 1400m in a handicap at Saint-Cloud on September 19th. Capable of making the frame despite stall 16
- **6. SKYLIGHT BROCHARD -** Likes this track, 2nd on his last run over 1400m in a Class 2 handicap at this venue on September 7th. Good draw in 5 and can feature
- **7. LANAKEN -** Three good efforts of late, 2nd on the most recent over 1400m in a Class 2 handicap at Deauville on August 3rd. He can not be ruled out of the frame
- **8. LAITH -** Placed 2nd on the last run over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on September 21st in a Class 1 race. Outside place contender
- **9. RASTRELLARE** 5th on the last run over 1400m at Saint-Cloud on September 19th in a handicap. This might be difficult for him
- **10. EGIATEGIA -** Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1000m in a Listed race at Chantilly on June 24th. Makes limited appeal
- **11. BELLANO** Ran well to be 4th over 1400m at this track in a Class 2 handicap on September 7th. He is well drawn in stall 2 and can score
- **12. TORTISAMBERT -** Decent effort when 3rd over 1400m at this track on September 7th in a Class 2 handicap. Decent track form and he is well drawn. Player
- **13. FELIX AUX ORMES -** Three unplaced efforts of late, 7th over 1400m at Saint-Cloud on September 19th in a handicap last time. Has work to do to be involved
- **14. HEMEVEZ** Recent success over 1400m in a handicap at this track on September 4th. Capable of making the top four at attractive odds
- **15. LEOPARDUCCIO -** Two unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1400m at this track in a Class 2 handicap on September 7th. Look elsewhere
- **16. ROCK BOY -** Unplaced last time out over 1400m at Deauville on August 3rd in a Class 2 handicap. He might find a few of these too smart
- **17. AMEDRAS -** Five unplaced runs of late, the most recent over track and trip in a Class 2 handicap on September 7th. Pass over



18. PRINCE AUBOIS - 5th on his last start over track and trip in a handicap on September 4th. He is at the right end of the handicap and is well drawn in stall 3. Keep safe

Summary: BELLANO (11) ran well over track and trip in a Class 2 handicap when last seen in early September and has an ideal draw in stall 2. His main threat could be SKYLIGHT BROCHARD (6), who finished second in a similar type of race over track and trip in early September and has a liking for this track. TORTISAMBERT (12) was back in third that day, narrowly beaten. He can once again be involved at the business end. OMICRONE (4) enters calculations on his win over track/trip in July in a Class 2.

- **3. O'WOOD -** Ran well to win over 2000m at Deauville on August 17th in a Class 2 handicap on the turf. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **4. OLYMPIC GOAL -** Three decent efforts of late, a win on the latest over 1850m at this track on September 14th in a Class 1 handicap. Player
- **5. PRINCE DES VILLES -** Four decent runs this year, 4th on the latter over 2000m at Deauville on August 17th in a Class 2 handicap. Place contender
- **6. EVERILLO -** 5th on his last start over 1850m at this track in a Class 1 handicap on September 14th. One to pay attention to
- **7. PRINCE DE MONTFORT -** 8th last time out, a win previously over 1800m in a Class 3 race at Dieppe on July 31st. Others rate higher
- **8. EXCELSIOR -** Three unplaced runs this year, the latter over 2200m at Clairefontaine on August 8th in a Class 3 race. Looks vulnerable

- **12. JOHNNY HAMMER -** Placed on his last three runs, 3rd on the most recent over 1850m at this track on September 14th in a Class 1 handicap. Can make the top four
- **13. VERITABLE -** Ran well to be 2nd last time over 1900m at La Teste on September 25th in a Class 2 race. Hard to fancy from a wide stall
- **14. MELBORA -** Two unplaced runs of late, a win before that over 2000m at La Teste on July 27th in a Class 3 handicap. She might find a few of these too smart
- **15. BIG LOG -** Recent win over 1850m at this track in a Class 2 handicap on September 14th. Capable of being competitive
- **16. HAVIASSOR -** Three wins of late, the latter over 2200m at this track in a Class 3 handicap on September 14th. Might be in the handicapper's grip

Summary: COLGAN SENORA (2) has improved with racing and scored easily at Deauville on the PSF in late August when last seen. He is versatile and has won on turf twice before. He is a marginal choice ahead of OLYMPIC GOAL (4), who scored at this track over 1850m in a competitive Class 1 handicap in mid-September when last racing. O'WOOD (3) is also a last-time-out winner at Deauville on August 17th and has to be considered, as does EVERILLO (6), who makes up the shortlist.
