**C5 - PRIX DU PARC AUX DAIMS - 2200m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Maiden - Flat -  
EUR € 11,900**

- 1. LAMIRAL DARHAAN** - Placed on the last two runs, 2nd on the most recent over 2800m at Vichy on May 24th in a conditions race. Look for an alternative
- 2. LAKES DANCER** - Two unplaced runs of late, well held over 2000m in a Class 3 race at Saint-Cloud on April 24th. Others rate higher
- 3. MESSENGER DE FAUST** - Unplaced last time at Compiègne over 1800m in a conditions race on May 9th. Placed 3rd on debut before that and can not be ignored
- 4. AZIMUTS** - Ran well to be 2nd over 2400m at Compiègne in a conditions race on April 25th. Among the leading contenders
- 5. ORAGEUX** - Nice debut to be 2nd at Fontainebleau in a conditions race on March 13th. Open to improvement and looks like the one to beat
- 6. VINO** - Three unplaced runs of late, 6th on the latter over 2600m in a Class 4 handicap on May 22nd on the PSF. Still a maiden after 45 starts
- 7. NOT TODAY** - Finished 5th last time over 2800m at Vichy in a conditions race on May 24th. Has to improve vastly to trouble the principles
- 8. SAPHO** - - Placed on both runs this year, 4th on the latter over 2000m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on May 14th. Respect each-way

**Summary:** ORAGEUX (5) caught the eye on debut at Fontainebleau in mid-March in a conditions race when a promising second. He will be sharper for that run and can get off the mark. His main danger could be AZIMUTS (4), who also finished second on debut when beaten less than a length at Compiègne in a maiden race in late April. He has a good deal more to come. MESSENGER DE FAUST (3) ran well on debut and can give a better account than his latest start when unplaced. SAPHO (8) looks best of the rest.

### C6 - PRIX DU CHATEAU D'EAU - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 - Flat - EUR € 14,600

- 1. ODEMAR** - Finished 6th last time on March 27th in a Class 3 claimer, a win before that over 2600m in a Class 3 claimer at Fontainebleau on February 28th. In the mix
- 2. WESTMINSTER PILOT** - Fair 3rd last time over 2500m in a Class 4 race at Le Croise-Laroche on May 17th. Others seem to be better equipped
- 3. WAITARA** - Recent win over 2400m at Vichy in a Class 4 handicap at Vichy on May 13th. More needed in what could be a stronger race
- 4. INCREMENTAL** - Placed 3rd last time over 2000m at Compiegne in a Class 3 race on May 20th. Capable of making an impact
- 5. EXCELSIOR** - Won on his latest start over 2900m at Cavaillon on May 10th in a Class 4 race. One to pay close attention to
- 6. CAMELOR** - Unplaced last time over 2000m at Strasbourg in a Class 3 handicap on May 8th. Capable of making the top-three
- 7. PAPILLE D'ARGENT** - Three below par runs recently, well beaten on the latest at Parislongchamp in a Class 3 handicap on May 21st. Hardly inspiring
- 8. RED NUREYEV** - Creditable 6th last time at Strasbourg over 2000m in a Class 3 handicap on May 8th. Has work ahead to make the frame

**Summary:** INCREMENTAL (4) produced a solid effort when finishing third in a Class 3 contest at Compiegne late in May and holds strong claims. EXCELSIOR (5) appears the main danger after his victory in a Class 4 event at Cavaillon in early May. A repeat of that performance would see him firmly in contention. ODEMAR (1) scored in a claimer at Fontainebleau two starts ago in February and has the ability to make his presence felt. CAMELOR (6) should strip fitter for his recent comeback run and is capable of playing a supporting role.

### C7 - PRIX DU PARC DE LA TETE D'OR - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 3 - Flat - EUR € 13,700

- 1. JOH SPIRIT** - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over this track and trip in a Class 2 handicap on May 8th. Others rate higher
- 2. LES PETITS PRINCES** - Two 6th placed runs of late, the latter over 2000m at Marseille Borely in a Class 2 race on April 10th, 2nd before that in January in a Class 1 race. Player
- 3. MAIGRET** - Won on his last run over this track and trip in a Class 4 claimer on April 29th. Can make the top three
- 4. HARPER** - Four tame efforts at the end of last year, the latest at Deauville in a Class 2 handicap over 1900m on December 2nd. Look elsewhere
- 5. LAITH** - Unplaced last time at Parislongchamp in a Class 1 handicap on April 5th over 1400m, 2nd before that over 1400m in March in a Class 3 at Saint-Cloud. Live chance
- 6. FRANKLIN AL GUNAY** - Two unplaced runs of late, 7th at Munich-Reim (DEU) over 1600m on the most recent on April 19th. Might find this challenging
- 7. PYRAMIDE** - Not seen since a 3rd at Chantilly in a handicap over 1900m on the PSF on October 31st. Should be ready from an absence and can be involved
- 8. CLEOPATRA AL GUNAY** - Well beaten on the latest start at Munich-Riem (DEU) over 1400m in a conditions race on April 19th. Hard to fancy
- 9. MQSE DES NYMPHES** - Did not feature on the latest start at Parislongchamp in a Listed race on April 5th over 2100m. One to consider each-way

**Summary:** LES PETITS PRINCES (2) has performed creditably on both starts since finishing second at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in January and is narrowly preferred. LAITH (5) rates the main danger after a strong runner-up effort two starts ago at Saint-Cloud and should be competitive once again. MQSE DES NYMPHES (9) found Listed company too demanding last time and is expected to be more at ease back in this grade. PYRAMIDE (7) returns from a break and has a fitness question to answer, but is worthy of consideration.

### C8 - PRIX THEODORE RAVIER - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- 1. GANODIN** - Got off the mark at Compiègne in a Class 3 race on May 24th on his last run.
- 2. SODA ZABEEL** - Recent 5th at Saint-Cloud in a maiden race on May 22nd over 2100m. Has work ahead to be on the premises
- 3. MAJOIE** - 5th last time at Compiègne, a win before that at Le Lion D'Angers over 2000m in a maiden race on May 7th. Merits consideration
- 4. RIGEL BLUE** - Placed on all three runs, 3rd on the most recent over 2000m at Lyon Parilly in a maiden race on April 13th. Can get off the mark
- 5. I AM MAELIA** - Two unplaced efforts of late, the most recent over 2000m at this track in a handicap on May 8th. Looks vulnerable
- 6. DERNI CHOP** - Placed on his last two runs, the latter when 2nd at Vichy in a handicap on May 13th. Enters calculations
- 7. COUNSELOR** - Below par with four unplaced runs, 6th on the most recent over 2600m in a handicap on May 2nd on the PSF. Needs to get back on track
- 8. MARIE LA CROIX** - Won on her last run at Marseille Vivaux in a Class 3 race over 2100m on May 2nd. Faces a stiffer task back on turf
- 9. MERCI CHERI** - Placed 2nd on her last run over 2000m at this track in a handicap on May 8th. Capable of having a say in the finish
- 10. JIVEDA** - Placed 4th on her most recent run over this track and trip in a handicap on May 8th. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 11. LINDEN BLOSSOM** - Tad below par last time on May 22nd at Cluny, 2nd previously over 2000m at Chatillon in a maiden race on April 27th. Others preferred
- 12. IZAWAY** - Three unplaced runs, 5th on the latter over 2000m at this track in a claiming race on May 23rd. Out of form and best avoided

**Summary:** RIGEL BLUE (4) has been admirably consistent this year, finishing in the placings on all three starts. After another solid effort in a maiden at this track in early April, she looks capable of getting off the mark. DERNI CHOP (6) rates the main danger, having filled a place on his last two outings, most recently in a handicap at Vichy in May. MERCI CHERI (9) has proven course form and arrives on the back of a runner-up finish in a handicap here in May. JIVEDA (10) also merits consideration.

- 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Newcomers - Flat - EUR € 24,700**

- 1. BUSY KITTEN'S JOY** - A three-year-old gelding by Kitten's Joy out of Endless Fancy who is making his debut. Dam never raced in France. Monitor the betting
- 2. SIR PATRICK** - A three-year-old gelding by City Light out of Cressida who is making his debut. His dam won twice in 28 starts. Might play a minor role
- 3. LEKER** - A three-year-old gelding by Golden Horde out of Ligera who is making his debut. His dam never won a race after three starts in the UK. Capable of making the frame
- 4. LIGHTNING SKY** - A three-year-old colt by City Light out of Romanne who is making his debut. His dam won once in 60 starts. Likely to need this experience
- 5. MAGUELONE** - A three-year-old gelding by Romanised out of Queendara who is making his debut. His dam won once in six starts. Might earn some money
- 6. SPIELER** - A three-year-old gelding by Saxon Warrior out of Isine who is making his debut. His dam was unplaced in her only start. Could not do this run
- 7. CHIRON** - A three-year-old colt by Balios out of Nemezis who is making his debut. His dam never raced in France. Others are preferred
- 8. MORNINGSIDE** - A three-year-old filly by Sea The Moon out of Meseika who is making her debut. Her dam was unraced in France. Others are preferred
- 9. SILVER DEW** - A three-year-old filly by Kendargent out of Angélogie who is making her debut. Her dam won five races from 42 starts. Could need this run
- 10. VALLEE DE MAI** - A three-year-old filly by Frankel out of Seychelloise who is making her debut. Her dam won twice in the UK. Not out of it
- 11. LIFE STUDY** - A three-year-old filly by Kingman out of Pocket Square who is making her debut. Her dam won a Group 3 in the UK. Can score
- 12. AMILA** - A three-year-old filly by Kendargent out of Angélogie who is making her debut. Her dam won five races from 42 starts. Could need this experience
- 13. GHAZALA** - A three-year-old filly by Camelot out of Agrotera who is making her debut. Her dam won three races, including a Listed race. Should be a threat
- 14. MARIA DEL FISH** - A three-year-old filly by Flintshire out of Si Maria who is making her debut. Her dam never won a race after five starts. Likely to need this experience
- 15. TRIVIAL** - A three-year-old filly by Siyouni out of Galima who is making her debut. Her dam won once in five starts. Can be competitive



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**Summary:** Daughter of the very smart Pocket Square, LIFE STUDY (11) is likely to attract plenty of support. Out of a Listed-winning mare in the United Kingdom, GHAZALA (13) is sure to be prominent from the outset, as is TRIVIAL (15), whose granddam Baahama was runner-up in the Group 3 Prix d'Aumale. Entrusted to Champion Jockey Cristian Demuro on debut, LEKER (3) also warrants a mention and could also be competitive.

**1. TRIPLE SEPT** - Showed some improvement second time out when runner-up in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 2400m on 8 May. Can go one place better

**2. HAYA GOLD** - Finished 8th on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 15 May. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

**3. SUMACO** - Improving and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Compiègne over 2400m on 20 May. Big chance in this line-up

**4. GLORIO** - showed some improvement when runner-up in a Conditions race at Moulins over 2800m on 9 May. More is needed to beat these rivals

**5. TALKA** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 16 May. Could earn some money

**6. MISS MONTMARTRE** - Finished 3rd in a Conditions race at Royan La Palmyre over 2900m on 14 May. Tougher task but might play a minor role

**7. STORY WAY** - A runner-up on debut in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 16 May. Can contest the finish

**8. LIKE A DOVE** - Finished 6th on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 15 May. Likely to improve and can be a threat this time

**9. SCHIZZO** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Conditions race at Montauban over 2200m on 24 May. May need to do a lot more to score

**10. SOCRATES** - A three-year-old gelding by Doctor Dino out of Sacarine who is making his debut. His mother won once in 7 starts. Could need this experience

**Summary:** A runner-up in a well-contested event at Compiègne on 20 May, SUMACO (3) looks capable of getting off the mark this time around. STORY WAY (7) made an encouraging debut at this venue and can be expected to build on that effort. Disappointing first time out on a demanding track, LIKE A DOVE (8) should show marked improvement. On the upgrade, TRIPLE SEPT (1) is likely to appreciate the step up in trip.

**1. BOKEI** - A three-year-old gelding by Wootton Bassett out of Bolshina who is making his debut. His dam won once in five starts. Might make the frame

**2. GAVILLO** - A three-year-old colt by Gallway out of Savina who is making his debut. His dam won once in six starts. Might need this experience

**3. SQUARE DESNOUETTES** - A three-year-old bay gelding by Threat out of Sleeping Storm who is making his debut. His dam never raced in France. Could need this experience

**4. COMMANDER TUNG** - A three-year-old gelding by Dubawi out of Mulan who is making his debut. His dam won once in three starts. Capable of scoring

**5. SET APART** - A three-year-old colt by Frankel out of Journey who is making his debut. His dam was a Group 1 winner. Should contest the finish

**6. GALASSI** - A three-year-old gelding by Siyouni out of Galibawa who is making his debut. His dam won once in eight starts. Can be competitive

**7. KATELL GOLETT** - A three-year-old filly by Ulysses out of Tweed who is making her debut. Her dam was unraced in France. Likely to need this run

**8. LAMELOISE** - A three-year-old filly by Almanzor out of Lapulced'acqua who is making her debut. Her dam never raced in France. Might play a minor role

**9. ROXY BREEZE** - A three-year-old filly by Wootton Bassett out of Alsace Lorraine who is making her debut. Her dam won a Listed race in the UK. Must be respected

**10. ARANYANI** - A three-year-old filly by Waldgeist out of Loredana who is making her debut. Her dam won once in four starts. Monitor the betting

**Summary:** Gelded in the spring after holding Classic entries, COMMANDER TUNG (4) is sure to attract plenty of attention. Out of the champion Journey, SET APART (5) will also be strongly fancied. A grandson of the champion Galikova (Prix Vermeille, Gr.1), GALASSI (6) is one to follow with confidence. The second runner from the Francis-Henri Graffard yard, ROXY BREEZE (9), out of a Listed-winning mare in the UK, could also get involv'd with the finish.

- 1. TIMUR** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Listed race at Vichy over 1000m on 13 May. Did score on debut and has claims
- 2. MR SAY** - Finished 7th in a claimer at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 22 May. Has a place chance on best form and must be respected
- 3. FERRA CHOPE** - Has not shown much yet and finished 8th in a Conditions race at Cholet over 1350m on 1 June. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 4. RENOUEAU** - Has run well in both starts, the latest when 3rd in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1000m on 4 May. Big chance in this line-up
- 5. LADY OSPREY** - Consistent and finished 3rd in a claimer at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 22 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 6. SUCRERIE** - Finished 4th in a claimer at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 5 May. Tougher task this time but could earn some money
- 7. SHE'S BOX OFFICE** - Finished 9th in a Listed race at Vichy over 1000m on 13 May. Can be a lively danger dropping to a claimer
- 8. FETE DE TROP** - A two-year-old filly by Thunder Moon out of Imotep who is making her debut. Her Dam won 3 of her 32 starts. Likely to need this experience
- 9. SPLENDIDA ONE** - A two-year-old filly by Victor Lodorum out of Al Rasmah who is making her debut. Her Dam never won a race after 6 starts. Could need this experience
- 10. ENFANT PARADIS** - Finished 8th in a claimer at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 22 May. Has not shown much so far and others are preferred
- 11. MA CHOPE** - Finished 9th on debut in a claimer at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 22 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. PARTIE ROCKET** - Finished 10th in a claimer at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 22 May. Needs to find a few lengths to trouble the judge
- 13. LADY BYRON** - Finished 7th on debut in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1100m on 11 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 14. FOOT TO THE FLOOR** - A two-year-old filly by Marianafoot out of Chalossa who is making her debut. Her Dam never won a race after 4 starts. Monitor the betting

**Summary:** Consistent in two runs in conditions races, RENOUEAU (4) drops into claiming company for the first time and does so with leading claims. Fifth in the Listed Prix des Rêves d'Or, TIMUR (1) takes a marked drop in class and should be a major player. Third at Saint-Cloud on 22 May, LADY OSPREY (5) commands respect, while SHE'S BOX OFFICE (7), who caught the eye two starts ago, is also worth noting at this level.

### C5 - PRIX ACTU (PRIX DE LA ROSE DE PORCELAINES) - 1100m (a5f1/2) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 24,000

- 1. THE BEST GLORY** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1200m on 23 May. Capable of an upset on best form
- 2. MISS CHIQUITA** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1300m on 3 March. Should be a threat to these rivals
- 3. VIZIOSA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1200m on 4 May. Capable of better and has a place chance on best form
- 4. DAISY DAISY** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1400m on 10 October. Returns from a break but could be a threat if fit enough
- 5. OSHIA** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a handicap at Chantilly over 1200m on 4 May. Can go one place better
- 6. FREE MOVEMENT** - Finished 6th in a handicap at Dax over 1400m on 18 May. Capable of a bit better and might play a minor role
- 7. CROOK** - Did not show his best when 12th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 21 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 8. ZERO STRESS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a claimer at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 20 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. AVEC DES SI** - Successful in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 22 May. Clearly unreliable but also cannot be ruled out
- 10. AMA DABLAM** - Finished 11th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 5 May. Capable of improvement trying a handicap but others make more appeal
- 11. SURFIN SAFARI** - Has not shown much and finished 10th in a handicap at Evreux over 1200m on 15 April. Others are much preferred
- 12. KENDARO** - Finished 12th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 10 May. Capable of being competitive over this shorter distance
- 13. CHARM PLATIN** - Has really struggled this year and finished 14th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 22 May. Needs major improvement to win

**Summary:** Narrowly beaten on her return to handicaps, OSHIA (5) could hav a winning turn. MISS CHIQUITA (2) has held her own in several well-contested conditions races and could have a say on her handicap debut. KENDARO (12) is not the easiest to handle but showed plenty of ability two starts ago and cannot be ruled out. CROOK (7) is better than his latest effort suggests and is worth another chance so must be respected.

- 1. QAMRAN** - Has only been modest so far and finished 6th in a Conditions race at Dieppe over 1100m on 16 May. Capable of earning some minor money
- 2. GOLDEN HIND** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 16 May. Should contest the finish
- 3. DAMN PRECIOUS** - Has only been modest this year and finished 10th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 21 May. Did better last year and is capable of an upset
- 4. WAYZATA MIST** - Consistent and finished 3rd in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 16 May. Can be competitive once more
- 5. FARAWAY TREE** - Has struggled this year and finished 9th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 10 May. Needs to do more to score
- 6. PHILLY BASSETT** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 16 May. Might play a minor role
- 7. SIGHISH** - A runner-up on debut in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1200m on 28 April. Can go one better this time
- 8. TCHIRIKHOVA** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 5 May. Should fight out the finish
- 9. ARAYA** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 16 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 10. DHIFFUSHI** - Finished 7th in a Conditions race at Compiègne over 1400m on 20 May. Has not shown much in two starts and others are preferred

**Summary:** An interesting race and a close finish is expected. TCHIRIKHOVA (8) travelled strongly and looked a likely winner for a long way on her return at Saint-Cloud. Top-rated in this field, she could well go one better. SIGHISH (7), a good runner-up on debut in a similar contest, must also be taken seriously. GOLDEN HIND (2) and WAYZATA MIST (4) finished in that order over this course last time and should be involved once again.

### C7 - PRIX DES NARCISSES - 1000m (a5f) - TURF - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 21,100

**1. MANA MAHA** - Has hit the crossbar twice in a row, the latest in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1200m on 23 May. Can be competitive yet again

**2. LEGAL EAGLE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a handicap at Evreux over 1200m on 26 May. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals

**3. YAKFEEK** - In good form and was runner-up in a handicap at Chantilly over 1200m on 12 May. Should fight out the finish

**4. SWEET AS** - Unreliable and finished 12th in a handicap at Le Croise-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**5. RED GUST** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a handicap at Chantilly over 1200m on 14 April. Likely to do even better this time
