**C3 - PRIX MAURICE ET HENRI DE LAGENESTE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF -
Condition - Flat - EUR € 11,000**

- 1. NO RISK ALLEN** - Nice 3rd on debut over 2500m at Argentan on March 6th in a conditions race. Open to plenty of progress and can be competitive
- 2. NE CRAINS RIEN** - Showed plenty of promise on debut when 3rd at this track over 2400m in a conditions race on March 7th. Should know more this time and warrants close attention
- 3. NAKAFLY D'ECHIGEY** - Finished 5th over 2400m at this track on her sole start in a conditions race on March 7th. Open to progress and will know more this time
- 4. NUTSHELL D'AIRY** - Fair effort to be 4th at this track over 2400m in a conditions race on March 7th. One to pay attention to and can step forward from her debut
- 5. NUMEROBIS** - Unraced gelding by Waldpark, the dam never ran. Some good aspects to his profile and from a respected trainer that will have this gelding well tuned
- 6. NORMAN PRINCE** - Gelding by Born To Sea, the dam won 3 races. Looks good on paper and is worth a market check for clues
- 7. NOSSLAND** - Gelding on debut by The Grey Gatsby, the dam was unraced. Likely to improve for this run unless the betting says otherwise
- 8. NEW WILL** - Gelding by Kapparde, the dam ran several times over hurdles without success. Stable runners tend to improve for a run or two and he is best watched for the time being
- 9. NIFTY DREAM** - Filly by Elarqam, the dam won 1 race over jumps. Can improve for this debut run and is best watched in the betting for clues
- 10. NAKINA** - Filly on debut by Ectot, the dam won 1 race and was placed in Group 3 AQ races. Nice profile and from a respected trainer that knows the time of day
- 11. NEIGE DES MERS** - Filly by Goliath Du Berlais, the dam won 3 races, 1 on the flat and 2 over jumps. Can be expected to improve for this debut and others make more appeal
- 12. NUANCE GABY** - Filly by Bande, the dam was placed on debut on the flat. One to watch in the betting exchanges for any market interest

Summary: NO RISK ALLEN (1) ran well to be third on debut at Argentan on March 6th and will be sharper for that outing. He is given the nod over NE CRAINS RIEN (2), who also showed plenty of promise when third over this track and trip in a conditions race early last month and can make things interesting. NUTSHELL D'AIRY (4) was back in fourth in the same race and can have a say in proceedings. NAKINA (10) completes the shortlist.

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C4 - PRIX DE SAINT-HILAIRE-EN-LIGNIERES - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Condition - Flat - EUR € 13,700

- 1. KAMIKAZE** - Ran well to be 2nd at Le Mans over 1950m in a claimer on March 20th last time out. Capable of a leading role
- 2. SULLY** - Two 4th place runs of late, the latter over 1800m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 3 race on March 21st. Can be effective on turf for only the second time
- 3. NEWLOVE DE BRABOIS** - Finished 3rd last time out over 2100m at Limoges in a maiden race on March 15th. Others rate higher
- 4. PRINCESS ALICE** - Two 5th placed runs of late, the latter over 2400m in a claimer on the PSF on March 21st. Among the leading each way chances
- 5. SARMYA** - Three unplaced efforts so far, 6th over 2400m at Lyon La Soie in a maiden race on March 2nd last time out. Looks vulnerable
- 6. SILVAROLE FAL** - Two unplaced efforts since a 3rd on debut over 1700m at Pornichet in a maiden race on February 5th. Unlikely to be a threat
- 7. AUSTRALIAN ROMANCE** - Four unplaced runs, 6th two runs back at Chantilly on the PSF in a maiden on February 5th over 1600m. Ought to be thereabouts
- 8. ACME** - Three tame efforts so far, well beaten over 1600m in a maiden race at Le Lion D'Angers on March 21st last time out. Pass over
- 9. GALA QUEEN** - Three unplaced runs, the latter over 2000m at Durtal on March 22nd in a maiden race. Looks of limited talent

Summary: SULLY (2) has been fourth on his last two starts on the PSF, the latter at Lyon La Soie in a Class 3 event on March 21st. He is given the vote in a race that will not take much winning. KAMIKAZE (1) ran well to be second at Le Mans in a claiming race last month and could be the main danger to the selection. AUSTRALIAN ROMANCE (7) has shown ability in her four starts and can make the top three. PRINCESS ALICE (4) has fared reasonably on her last two starts and looks best of the rest.

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C5 - PRIX DE L'AVENIR DE LIGNIERES - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 10,100

- 1. BUDOKAN** - Placed on all three runs, 4th on the latest over 1650m in a maiden race at Craon on September 6th. Can get off the mark and will be fit from a layoff
- 2. KING ARTHUR** - Finished 9th on his debut at Chantilly over 1600m on March 16th in a conditions race. He will strip fitter today and warrants respect
- 3. IRRESITIBLEMENT** - Showed promise when 7th on his sole start over 2000m at Saint-Cloud in a conditions race on March 19th. Capable of progress and can make the top three
- 4. STOP THE ROCK** - Finished 8th on the sole start over 1900m at Chantilly on March 26th in a maiden race. One to watch with the future in mind
- 5. BENVENUTI** - Two unplaced runs this year, the latter over 1500m at Marseille-Vivieux in a maiden race on March 9th. Makes limited appeal
- 6. DSCHINGIS AREON** - Unraced gelding by Dschingis Secret, the dam won 2 races and was Listed placed in Germany. One to monitor in the betting for any support
- 7. GEORGE IS FIRE** - Gelding on debut by George Vancouver, the dam won 5 races on the flat. From a stable not known for producing many first time out winners and he is best watched unless the betting vibes are lively
- 8. VIA AURELIA** - Filly by Victor Ludorum, the dam won 1 race on the flat. Likely to improve for this run and she is best monitored in the betting for any market moves
- 9. SEE YOU TREZY** - Filly by Dariyan, the dam won 1 race. Can be expected to improve for this debut run and is best watched with the future in mind
- 10. CHACONNE** - Filly by Sea The Stars, the dam won 2 races. From a leading stable that will have this newcomer well tuned. Bold show expected

Summary: BUDOKAN (1) ran well on all three starts last year and was a decent fourth at Craon on the latest in a maiden race over 1950m in early September. He can use his experience and get the verdict over the well bred newcomer CHACONNE (10), who can be expected to be well tuned for her racecourse debut and connections might have found an ideal race for her. IRRESITIBLEMENT (3) can step forward from his debut run when he showed signs of ability at Saint-Cloud. KING ARTHUR (2) heads the remainder.

C1 - PRIX DE L'OPERATION OVERLORD - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 50,900

1. DIVINE CHRISNAT - Three unplaced runs this year, the latter over 1600m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 2 handicap on March 24th. Look elsewhere

2. QUIET KING - Track and trip winner in November and he has performed well to be placed in strong handicap on both starts since then. The most recent over 1900m in a Class 2 at Chantilly on March 23rd. Sets the standard

3. CELESTIAL - Three good efforts of late, 3rd on the latter over 1900m in a Class 2 handicap at this track on January 23rd. Well drawn in stall 4 and can feature

4. STAR OF ARTABAN - He has won all three races this year, twice over track and trip in Class 3 handicaps in January and February and the latter over the same trip in a Class 3 handicap at Chantilly on March 8th. Improving and merits consideration

5. KAHUNA - Two unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2000m in a Listed race at La Teste on March 21st. Unlikely to be involved

6. WATCH HIM - Placed 2nd on the last start over 2000m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 2 handicap on February 18th. Might find a few of these too smart

7. STORMY DONALD - Unplaced last time, a win before that over this track and trip in a Class 3 race on February 6th. Merits consideration at this venue

8. ZELZARI - Four good runs this year, 4th on the most recent over 2400m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 2 handicap on March 15th. Can overcome a wide draw and be involved

9. FEVE - Finished 6th last time over 1900m in a Class 2 handicap on March 23rd at Chantilly. Won over track and trip in October last year in a claiming race. Outside place contender

10. RAKHIM - Unplaced last time, a win before that over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap at Pau on February 20th. Others seem better equipped

11. DARI RIVER - Three unplaced runs this year, 6th on the latter over 1500m at Chantilly in a Class 2 handicap on March 12th. Has eased in the handicap and can make the frame

12. CICCIO BOY - Won last time over 1700m in a Class 4 handicap at Pornichet on March 25th. Faces a stiff task from a wide draw

13. BAUHINIA RHAPSODY - Finished 5th over the track and trip last time in a Class 3 race on January 2nd. He has dropped in the handicap and has place claims

14. GOWAY - Two unplaced runs of late, a win before that over 1600m in a Class 4 claimer at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on January 20th. Can be opposed

15. DUBALAA - Three solid runs this year, 2nd on the most recent over 1600m at Chantilly in a Class 2 handicap on March 12th. One to pay close attention to



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16. STAR ROCK - Two unplaced runs since a 2nd over 1600m at Chantilly in a Class 2 handicap on November 18th. Well treated on his best form and warrants respect

Summary: QUIET KING (2) won over the track and trip in November and has shaped well in two good handicaps since then at Chantilly on the PSF. He is well drawn and can get the verdict over CELESTIAL (3), who has been in good form recently with three honest performances, the most recent over the track and trip in a Class 2 handicap when third in late January. DUBALAA (15) is another to pay attention to and can make the top four. DARI RIVER (11) has dropped in the handicap and can be competitive off her current handicap mark. ZELZARI (8) looks best of the remainder.

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C2 - PRIX DU PREMIER PAS - 1000m (a5f) - TURF - Newcomers - Flat - EUR € 45,700

- 1. SCAPIN** - Colt by Cotai Glory, the dam never ran. From a good stable that does well with newcomers. One to pay attention to if the betting vibes are positive
- 2. COCO BEACH** - Colt by Goken, the dam won 2 races over middle distances. Likely to improve for this run and could need further in time
- 3. DEFI** - Colt by Threat, the dam won 3 races over middle distances. One to watch with the future in mind on his racecourse debut
- 4. MEDRONHO** - Colt by Territories, the dam ran a few times. Does not appeal as a likely first time out winner and is one to watch on his racecourse bow
- 5. MR PYRRHUS** - Colt by Starspangledbanner, the dam won 1 race. Nice pedigree and from a leading trainer who has his horses in top-form at the moment. Live contender
- 6. LA BARAKA** - Filly by Goken, the dam ran twice. Speedy pedigree and she is one to watch in the betting market for any market moves
- 7. BELLE NOIRE** - Filly by Texas, the dam won 1 race. Stable runners tend to improve for a run or two and she is best watched on her debut
- 8. DESEO** - Filly by Starspangledbanner, the dam was unraced. Should improve for this outing and is best watched for the time being unless the betting market speaks volumes
- 9. MAIAKOVSKA** - Filly by Goken, the dam won 1 race over 1100m and was placed several times. Speedy pedigree and her trainer can ready a juvenile to strike on debut. Watch the betting patterns closely
- 10. SAY MY NAME** - Filly by Blackbeard, the dam ran a few times. First crop of a speedy Sire who should produce plenty of two-year old winners. Monitor the betting for any support
- 11. KATA TJUTA** - Filly by Dark Angel, the dam was unraced. Her trainer has two in the race and she will be well tuned for this debut run. Watch the betting market for any support
- 12. VENETIAN TEMPLE** - Filly by St Mark's Basilica, the dam won 1 race over 1400m and was Listed placed. Nice pedigree and should know what is required on her first day at school

Summary: This could go to the Francis-Henri Graffard colt MR PYRRHUS (5), who has a nice pedigree and could be the more forward of the trainers two in the race. MAIAKOVSKA (9) comes from a trainer that can produce a juvenile to score on debut and her dam was a speedy performer. She is one to keep onside. SAY MY NAME (10) looks good on paper and is another to consider if the betting market is positive. VENETIAN TEMPLE (12) has some good aspects to her profile and is also worth considering.

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C3 - PRIX DE L'OPERATION BOSTON - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,300

1. **J'AURAIS DU** - Two unplaced runs since a win on the PSF at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 4 handicap on February 22nd. Capable of being on the premises
2. **LUCERO** - Several unplaced runs of late, the most recent over 2400m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 4 handicap on March 21st. Has dropped in the weights and warrants respect
3. **ESKANDANI** - Unplaced last time in late March, a win previously over 2150m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 4 handicap on February 24th. Handles this surface well and can be involved
4. **TRIPTAJIKA** - Two unplaced runs on turf recently, 2nd before that behind J'AURAIS DU (1) on the PSF at Cagnes-Sur-Mer when beaten narrowly in a Class 4 handicap on February 22nd. Well drawn in stall 6 and can feature
5. **NEROKAS** - Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 2000m at Pau in a Class 4 handicap on February 23rd. Outside place contender
6. **FLOWERY COAST** - Three unplaced runs this year, the most recent over 2600m at Morlaix on March 29th in a Class 4 race. Hard to recommend
7. **DIWAN SENORA** - Three unplaced runs since a 4th over 1600m at Chantilly in a Class 4 handicap on November 18th. He needs to bounce back to his best form
8. **ANONYME** - Four unplaced runs this year, the latter over 2000m at Compiègne on March 27th in a Class 4 handicap. Can make the frame
9. **JOUKOVKA** - Three tame efforts of late this year, the most recent over 1500m in a Class 3 handicap at Saint-Cloud on March 19th. One to steer clear of
10. **NOT SO SILLY** - Two unplaced runs this year, 8th at Chantilly in a Class 3 handicap on March 23rd on the last run. Decent course form before and can not be ignored each-way
11. **DETESNOUVELLES** - Two unplaced runs late last year, the latter over 2700m at Chantilly in a Class 4 handicap on December 6th. Has work to do to get back on track
12. **ENORA SENORA** - Recent 4th over 2000m at Compiègne in a Class 4 handicap on March 27th. Capable of getting her first success
13. **MAESTRO CHOP** - Four unplaced runs of late, the latter when 6th at Chantilly over 1900m in a Class 4 handicap on March 30th. Not the most consistent
14. **ALPENGEIST** - Out of form with numerous unplaced efforts, the latter when well beaten in a Class 3 handicap at Chantilly on March 23rd. Opposable

Summary: ENORA SENORA (12) has some decent placed form and was a good fourth at Compiègne on March 27th in a Class 4 handicap when last seen. She has the best draw and is racing off a good handicap mark. She can get deserved success at the expense of TRIPTAJIKA (4), who arrives after a couple of unplaced runs on the turf. She was beaten narrowly into second on the PSF in late February and can reverse placings with J'AURAIS DU (1), who won that day. ESKANDANI (3) makes up the shortlist.

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C4 - PRIX DJEBEL - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Gr3 - Flat - EUR € 73,200

- 1. DOSTOIEVSKY** - Two wins of late, the latter over 1400m at Chantilly in a Listed race on October 11th. Good juvenile who can do well this year
- 2. SAMANGAN** - He won his last three runs last year after a 4th on debut. His latest success was over 1200m at Chantilly in the Criterium De Maisons-Lafitte (Gr.2) on October 11th. Strong claims up in trip
- 3. AFANDY** - Solid effort to be 2nd over 1500m in a Listed race on February 22nd at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on turf when narrowly beaten. Outside place contender
- 4. CROWN RELIC** - Unbeaten in two starts, the latest success over 1450m at Wolverhampton (UK) on the artificial surface on March 9th. Strong traveler who can feature on turf debut
- 5. BOURGOIN** - Unplaced on his one run this year in March over 1300m in a Listed race, he won over 1300m at this racecourse before that on the PSF on December 18th. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- 6. FIREFALL** - Score on debut over 1900m at Chantilly on November 10th by 4.5 lengths on the PSF. The race has produced several winners and he looks like a smart prospect
- 7. CIELO DI ROMA** - Placed 3rd last time over 1600m in a Listed race at Saint-Cloud on March 15th. Listed winner over 1400m last November at this track. In the mix
- 8. ROMANTICON** - Two wins in Spain last year, and a 2nd on the most recent at Madrid over 1600m in a conditions race on October 26th. Faces a stiff task on French debut
- 9. TAKE ME ON** - Won on his sole start over 1600m at this track on October 22nd in a newcomers race by an easy 5 lengths. The second won recently and this colt looks smart
- 10. MICHAEL THE GREAT** - Unplaced last time on March 16th in a Listed race, a win before that over 1300m at this track on November 28th in a Class 2 race. Others rate higher

Summary: SAMANGAN (2) improved with each start last year and won well on his last outing in the Criterium De Maisons-Lafitte (Gr.2) on October 11th over 1200m at Chantilly. He can edge this on his second attempt over this trip. DOSTOIEVSKY (1) is another that improved with experience last year and can make the likely favourite work for success. CROWN RELIC (4) has won twice on the artificial surface at Wolverhampton and is an interesting challenger from the UK. FIREFALL (6) won easily on debut and is another to consider.

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C5 - PRIX DE L'OPERATION ALBANY - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- 1. NOOTKA BAY** - Off form and was 12th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. On a long losing streak and needs to improve to score
- 2. HARRISON POINT** - Victorious in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Carries a penalty but could make the frame
- 3. CORONADO** - Disappointing form of late and was 11th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 29 March. Victorious back in February on the PSF and could be a threat back on this surface
- 4. MELANIES JOY** - In good shape and finished 4th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Has claims in an open looking race
- 5. SILVER TOWER** - Finished 3rd in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Has shown improvement and is a course and distance winner. Must be respected
- 6. GRAND ANGEL** - Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in a Conditions race at Compiègne over 2400m on 27 March. Might play a minor role
- 7. RIO GRANDE** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2400m on 21 March. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 8. COMTE NOIR** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. In decent form and is not out of it
- 9. LA BONITA** - Unreliable and was 5th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 30 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 10. CHUBASCO** - Unreliable and was 14th in a handicap at Senonnes-Pouance over 2300m on 13 March. Has won over this track and trip and is capable of an upset
- 11. KIM KARALA** - Did not show her best when 7th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 12 March. Likes this course and distance and should be competitive once again
- 12. INMATE** - Finished 9th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 8 March. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 13. ANGLESEA** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2600m on 13 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 14. HAUTE GAMME** - Very consistent and was 3rd in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Should fight out the finish once again

Summary: A reliable performer at this level, MELANIES JOY (4) makes plenty of appeal as a solid starting point for punters. That said, his margin for error isn't huge, and he'll need to keep a close eye on the strong-finishing HAUTE GAMME (14), who continues to hold his form well. KIM KARALA (11) has been slightly below her best over a mile of late, but she's worth another chance back over a trip that suits her better. SILVER TOWER (5) arrives in improved form and could have a say, although she'll need to overcome a wide draw in the stalls.

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C6 - PRIX IMPRUDENCE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Gr3 - Flat - EUR € 73,200

- 1. VALASARA** - Unbeaten in two starts last year, the latest in a Listed race at this course over 1000m on 9 August. Returns from a break but can be competitive
- 2. HALF SOVEREIGN** - Successful in a Group 3 at Chantilly over 1400m on 27 October. Returns from a break but is talented and quite capable of scoring
- 3. ISLE OF FERNANDEZ** - Finished 4th in a Listed race at Redar over 1200m on 4 October. Returns from a break but could play a minor role if fit enough
- 4. INJU** - Finished 5th in a Listed race at Chantilly over 1100m on 16 March. Victorious back in January but others are preferred
- 5. ZALINA** - Finished 10th in a Listed race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 15 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. MY HIGHNESS** - Victorious in a Group 2 at over this course and distance on 24 August. Class filly and could win again if fit from a break
- 7. BAKLAWA** - Consistent and was victorious in a Listed race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1500m on 22 February. Has shown improvement and can earn some money
- 8. SHOWNA** - Did not show her best when 8th in a Listed race at Chantilly over 1300m on 8 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. KOZLOVSKHA** - Consistent so far and was runner-up in a Listed race over this track and trip on 2 November. Can earn some more money if fit enough
- 10. REPEL** - Victorious in a Conditions race at this course over 1100m on 5 August. Steps up in distance but has scope for improvement and could make the frame
- 11. PIANA** - Successful in a Listed race at Meydon over 1600m on 28 February. Fit and could get into the mix of things
- 12. QUIESCENT** - Has won her last four starts, the latest in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 9 November. Tougher task this time returning from a break

Summary: A highly regarded filly, MY HIGHNESS (6) makes a much-anticipated return to the track and is set to face a proper test on her comeback. Chief among her rivals is HALF SOVEREIGN (2), a proven performer who landed the Prix Miesque late last year and brings valuable experience to the table. Unbeaten in two starts at Deauville, VALASARA (1) reappears here, though she tackles a significantly longer trip this time. She renews rivalry with her stablemate REPEL (10), whom she had the measure of when they made their debuts together.

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C7 - PRIX DE L'OPERATION FORTITUDE - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 21,100

- 1. HUMAN EVOLUTION** - Victorious in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Carries a penalty for that success but can double up
- 2. EFFIRA** - Victorious in her last two starts, the latest in a handicap over this track and trip on 23 January. Can complete a hat-trick
- 3. HAVANA SIX** - Did not show her best when 12th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Capable of doing better and should be competitive in this line-up
- 4. VENTS CONTRAIRES** - Usually competitive and was 3rd in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 12 March. Capable of making the frame
- 5. KEANU** - Not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Should be in the mix of things once again
- 6. GOLDENSIM** - Not reliable an finished 9th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Victorious back in February but needs to improve to score
- 7. RUE DE L'ODEON** - Has struggled of late and finished 15th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 19 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. PRINCE OF CLOUDS** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Has won over this track and trip and is capable of an upset
- 9. DENIA** - In good shape and was runner-up in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 18 March. Could play a minor role at very best
- 10. BLUFF** - Finished 9th in a claimer at Chantilly over 1600m on 23 March. Needs to do a lot more than that to beat these rivals
- 11. TIC TAC** - Off form and was 12th in a handicap at this track over 2500m on 6 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 12. HER CHRISTOPHER** - Returned from a break and was runner-up in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. In decent form and can go one place better
- 13. FAMOSO** - Consistent of late and was runner-up in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 1800m on 21 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 14. SEE THE LIGHT** - Unreliable but was successful in a handicap over this course and distance on 6 November. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: Fresh from getting off the mark in handicap company, HUMAN EVOLUTION (1) may well have turned a corner and could be ready to follow up. HAVANA SIX (3) faced a stiff task in a Quinté+ at Chantilly last time, and this looks a more manageable assignment. Back to something like his best, VENTS CONTRAIRES (4) has been knocking on the door and deserves to get his head in front again. HER CHRISTOPHER (12) shaped with plenty of promise on his return and could take some pegging back if allowed an easy lead.

Front-runner PONNTOS (1) is sure to blaze a trail and will have his chances. The eye-catching STOLEN KISS (2) has plenty of natural pace and could prove a revelation in division.

3. RAQEEBB - Did not show his best when 12th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 3 March. Did better at this track before that and can bounce back to score

4. ALLURRE - Has struggled of late and was 9th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Capable of doing better but others are preferred

5. STANGHELI - Not reliable and was 15th in a handicap over this track and trip on 2 December. Can be a threat to these rivals

6. VOLCANO - Did not show his best when 15th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 3 March. Had some nice wins before that and could earn some money

7. LAVENDIN - Did not show his best when 5th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 23 March. Likes this course and distance and has claims

8. AQUILA VOLANTE - In good shape and was 3rd in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 10 March. Can get into the mix of things again

9. TIGER ROCK - Off form and was 9th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 3 March. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal

10. ROCKY RUN - Not reliable but was 3rd in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 8 March. Has won over this track and trip and is not out of it
