

## **R1 COMPIEGNE [L-H]**

## C1 - PRIX DE SAINT JEAN AUX BOIS - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 27,000

- **1. WHEELER -** Colt by Spieghtstown, the dam won 3 races, including a Grade 3 in the USA. Nice pedigree and a leading role can be anticipated. In the mix
- **2. ESCALINA -** Filly by No Nay Never, the dam never ran. Likely to improve for this run and is best watched in the betting for clues
- **3. BEAUTY KING'S -** Filly by Bande, the dam was unraced. Stable runners warrant respect on debut. Monitor the betting for any market interest
- **4. DEODATA -** Filly by Churchill, the dam won 1 race and was Listed placed. Choice pedigree and a bold show can be expected. Live contender
- **5. PERSIA BELLA -** Filly by Le Havre, the dam won 1 race. 150,000 euros as a foal. Watch the betting patterns for any support
- **6. QUEEN'S TRIAL** Filly by Kingman, the dam won 1 race. Half-sister to a Listed race winner in Wishfully. From a good stable who will have her well prepared. Player
- **7. TTAINTED DREAMS** Filly by Toronado, the dam was placed on her only start. Best watched in the betting market for any support

**Summary:** DEODATA (4) is from a top stable that can ready a newcomer to strike on debut. Mickael Barzalona should get a nice tune out of this filly on her first day at school. She is preferred over QUEEN'S TRIAL (6), who is a half-sister to Wishfully, who won at Listed class. She can have a say in the business end. WHEELER (1) is the only colt in the line-up; his dam won a Grade 3 race in the USA, and market support should be noted. PERSIA BELLA (5) is also one to keep onside.

# C2 - PRIX DU POLYGONE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Class 3 Claiming - Flat - EUR € 19,000

- **1. TIMBER LIGHT -** 7th last time in a Class 3 handicap on May 20th at Angers over 1600m. Seems to have lost his form at the moment
- **2. CYNOSURE -** Three unplaced runs of late, 2nd before that over 1750m at Wolverhampton (UK) on January 4th. French debut and is best watched
- **3. BURGUNDY REGAL -** 7th last time, 2nd previously over 1400m at Pau in a Class 3 handicap on January 14th. Others make more appeal
- **4. ROUGEGARDE -** Won on his last start over 1700m at La Roche-Posay in a Class 4 race on May 18th. Capable of playing a leading role
- **5. DAPANGO -** 5th last time, 3rd before that over 1600m in a claimer at Fontainebleau on March 7th. Won 2 Class 3 races in October last year. Live contender
- **6. CREW DRAGON -** In top form of late, a win at Angers in a Class 4 claimer on May 20th on his latest run. Hard to ignore in this class of race
- **7. EL RUBIO -** 6th last time, 2nd before that over 1500m at Mulheim (DEU) in a Class 3 claimer on May 6th. Each way angle

**Summary:** DAPANGO (5) could be the answer to this claimer, he was a decent second two runs back in a Class 3 handicap. He won on the PSF in December in a claimer and is preferred over CREW DRAGON (6), who is useful in claiming class races and can give another good account of himself. ROUGEGARDE (4) looks like an option for the each-way backers to look at after a win on his latest start. EL RUBIO (7) makes up the shortlist.

### C3 - PRIX BENJAMIN BOUTIN - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 55,000

- **1. ZIGGY STAR -** Two good wins recently, the latter over 1600m in a handicap at Parislongchamp on May 4th. A hat trick of wins is not out of the question
- **2. VEGETALE -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1900m in a Class 1 race at Chantilly on March 24th on the PSF. Has to prove she handles the turf but is bred to
- **3. SAKHALINE -** 5th last time in a Class 3 race at Saint-Cloud on May 13th, a win before that over 2000m in a handicap on April 21st at Le Lion D'Angers. Place chance
- **4. MINO GALESTE -** Won nicely last time over 1600m at Parislongchamp on May 4th in a handicap. Live chance of scoring
- **5. CITY TOWN -** Three unplaced runs this year, 9th at Parislongchamp over 1400m in a handicap on May 15th. She won last year and can make the top three if back to form
- **6. ACTO -** Two unplaced runs of late, 3rd before that over 1600m at Saint-Cloud in a handicap on March 6th. Among the leading chances
- **7. EL PEQUENIO -** Ran well to be 2nd over 1600m in a handicap at Parislongchammp on May 4th last time when beaten a nose. Player
- **8. SEONA -** 6th last time, 4th before that over 2000m at Parislongchamp on April 30th in a handicap. In the mix
- **9. RUE ERNESTINE -** 5th last time, 2nd before over 1600m at Toulouse on March 19th in a handicap. Likely to find a few of these too smart
- **10. LUFFY -** Won on his last run over 1600m at Le Mans in a maiden on May 3rd. Has to improve again in a stronger race
- **11. ISPERIA -** Fair 3rd last time out over 2300m at Angers on May 20th in a Class 2 race. This will be more challenging
- **12. DSCHINGIS ZANDEE -** Two wins recently, the latest a handicap at Parislongchamp on April 30th in a handicap. Hard to rule out
- **13. SANGRE DE DRAGO -** 6th last time, 3rd before that over 1600m at Parislongchamp on April 30th in a claiming race. Opposable
- **14. KOHANA -** Placed on the last two runs, 3rd over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on May 17th in a handicap. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **15. RIDE ON -** Fair 3rd over 2000m at Nancy on his last run on May 20th in a handicap. Others make more appeal

**Summary:** EL PEQUENIO (7) was narrowly beaten at Parislongchamp in a handicap when last seen in May, and can go one place better this time. MINO GALESTE (4) won on his last outing in early May at Parislongchamp and can give a good account of himself. ACTO (6) was seventh on his last run behind a couple of today's rivals and looks like a sensible option each way. DSCHINGIS ZANDEE (12) is seeking a hat-trick and can not be overlooked. CITY TOWN (5) has been a bit low key this year but warrants respect and a better run can be expected.

# C4 - PRIX DE LA CLAIRIERE DE L'ARMISTICE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 27,000

- **1. PORTREATH -** Two unplaced runs since a win over 2100m at Mons-Ghlin (BEL) in a conditions race on February 20th. Look elsewhere
- **2. PRIDE OF AMERICA -** 8th last time, a win before that over 2000m at Fontainebleau on March 18th in a Class 3 race. Capable of making an impact
- **3. GUARDIAN -** Fair 5th on the one run this year over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 1 race on April 11th. He won his maiden last October and warrants respect
- **4. WILL SCARLET -** Good win last time over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on May 17th in a Class 3 race and placed in a Class 2 race on his two runs this year. Live contender
- **5. OLYMPIC GOAL -** 5th last time out in a Class 2 handicap over 2500m at Deauville on November 16th. First run of the year and will be sharper for this outing
- **6. LORD ACHILLES -** Two unplaced runs this year, 6th at Lyon Parilly on the most recent over 2400m in a Listed race on May 17th. Place chance
- **7. BALTIC EMPRESS -** Two unplaced runs of late, 6th at Saint-Cloud on the latest in a Class 3 race on May 1st. Listed placed last year and has the talent to be involved
- **8. QUISISANA -** She was useful last year, winning her last run of 2024 at Chantilly in a Listed race on June 16th. She has almost a years absence to overcome but can not be overlooked
- **9. LORIA -** 5th last time, she got off the mark previously in a maiden at Compiegne on April 25th over 1400m. Needs a few to misfire

**Summary:** Several in the line-up with some sort of chance, the Andre Fabre-trained WILL SCARLET (4) could be the most likely to prevail. He got a confidence-boosting win at Lyon Parilly in mid-May on his latest start, and he is preferred ahead of QUISISANA (8), who has solid form in 2024. She makes her return after almost a year away, with fitness a slight concern. PRIDE OF AMERICA (2) won on his penultimate start in March and can be involved. GUARDIAN (3) is also of interest.

- **1. ISLAND FANTASY -** Two placed efforts of late, 2nd on the latest over 1700m at Saint-Brieuc on May 29th in a conditions race. Others make more appeal
- **2. MANDRES -** Creditable 6th on her last run over 1900m at Chantilly on May 2nd in a Class 3 handicap. Capable of making the frame
- **3. JACK OF TRADES -** Two recent unplaced runs, the latter over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on May 9th in a Class 3 handicap. Look for an alternative
- **4. PRAIRIE GLORY -** Fair 6th over 1600m at Compiegne on May 30th in Class 3 handicap last time out when not beaten far. Each way angle
- **5. ICE CLIMBER -** Several unplaced runs of late, the latest over 1400m at Parislongchamp on May 22nd in a Class 3 handicap. Unlikely to threaten
- **6. TIGER KING -** 5th last time, 3rd before that over 1800m in a Class 4 race at Parislongchamp on May 7th. Can make the top four

- **3. SAXON'S PRIDE -** Promise when 5th at Compiegne in a maiden over 2000m on April 25th. Handicap debut and she is lightly raced and has more improvement
- **4. ZAUBA -** 5th on the last run over 1800m at Evreux on May 27th in a maiden race. Tries a handicap and makes limited appeal
- **5. MOMO NELSON -** 5th over 2000m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 4 handicap on May 29th on his last run. Capable of having a say
- **6. EMPRESS STAR -** Fair 5th last time, a win before that over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers on April 21st in a Class 4 race. One to keep onside
- **7. FOXEY LADY -** Three placed runs this year, 4th on the latest over 2000m at Parislongchamp on May 7th in a Class 4 race. Looks ready to win

- 2. TAIKINABOLT Five unplaced runs, well beat in a Class 3 handicap over 1600m at Compiegne on May 30th. Can be avoided
- **3. PALETUVIER -** Two unplaced runs since a win over 1900m at Chantilly on April 14th in a Class 4 handicap. Can make the top four
- **4. ALBERT BRIDGE -** Placed on the last two runs, 4th on the latest over 1800m at Compiegne on May 21st in a Class 3 handicap. Capable of being involved
- **5. PUERTA DEL SOL -** Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 2100m at Mons-Ghlin (BEL) in a conditions race on April 14th. Not the most consistent
- **6. LANDARYNA -** 8th on the last run over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on May 29th in a Class 4 handicap. Not the most reliable, but has an each way chance
- **7. MEARAS STYLE -** Ran a better race when 6th at Argentan on June 4th in a Class 4 handicap over 2100m. Out again quickly and can feature
- **8. MITARC -** Three unplaced runs this year, the latter over 2500m in a Class 4 handicap on May 18th. Has the ability to be involved with a return to form

She makes a quick return and is a tentative choice ahead of HOT SUMMER (10), who was a decent fourth at Compiegne late last month and can be competitive. ALBERT BRIDGE (4) has been placed on his last two starts and is an each-way candidate. LADYBUG (9) makes up the shortlist.

- **1. EMINENCE GRISE -** Unplaced last time, a win before that over 2000m at Chantilly on April 10th in a handicap. One to keep onside
- **2. KENOSTORM** Two unplaced efforts since a 4th over 1900m at Chantilly on February 7th in a maiden race. Place chance
- **3. ANDRE AS -** Fair 3rd last tie over 2000m on the PSF in a Class 3 race on May 23rd. Ought to be thereabouts
- **4. EVER FAST -** Improved run when 2nd at Parislongchamp on May 4th in a handicap over 1600m. Looks progressive and can feature
- **5. ZENBATI -** Three runs so far, well beaten over 2000m at Chantilly on April 28th in a maiden race. Tries a handicap and might need a few to misfire
- **6. LE SID -** Three unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1800m at Evreux on May 27th in a maiden race. Handicap debut and others preferred
- **7. BOTICELLI -** Ran well to be 3rd at Parislongchamp on May 9th in a handicap over 1700m. Live contender

AZOTE (9) could feature in the final stages and wasn't disgraced when finishing fifth at Lyon Parilly in mid-May. EMINENCE GRISE (1) won at Chantilly in April and heads the remainder.

- **1. RAW ENERGY -** Decent effort finishing 6th in a maiden over 2400m at Lyon Parilly on the 8th of May 2025. Place chance at best
- **2. LIBERTY WAY -** Supplemented Liberty Way produced a good 3rd in a maiden over 2000m at Marseille Borely on the 9th of May 2025. Good winning chance
- **3. NOUS Y SOMMES -** May have needed the debut finishing 10th in a maiden over 2000m at Marseille Borely on the 9th of May 2025. Scoping for an improving effort
- **4. AMERICADREAM -** Has had 14 racing experiences thus far and finished 8th in a Handicap over 1200m at Marseille Borely on the 9th of May 2025 in her last start. Top selectors won't be threatened much
- **5. WINDFLOWER -** Improving effort finishing 5th in a maiden over 2400m at Salon-De-Provence on the 15th of May 2025. Should go closer here
- **6. MILLE JOYCE -** Finished 10th in a maiden over 1600m at Vichy on the 14th of May 2025. One to respectfully pass by

**Summary:** Supplemented LIBERTY WAY (2) enters the race as the top selector and produced a good third last time out. He looks to have met the ideal field for him to claim victory. WINDFLOWER (5) showed improvement last time out when going the extra ground and although stepping back to the 2000m, she will be running strongly at the finishing line.
