

R1 DEAUVILLE [R-H]

C1 - THE AGA KHAN STUDS PRIX LADY O'REILLY (PRIX MINERVE) - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Gr3 Race - Flat - EUR € 73,200

- **1. ZIA AGNESE -** Comes off a good third-place finish over 2000m on this course in a Group 3 on 3 August. Christophe Soumillon retains the ride which is a big plus
- **2. CASPI STAR** Disappointing last two starts. Finished eighth over 2400m at Newmarket in a Listed race on 19 July. More needed to win this
- **3. GINALYAH** Finished behind Indalimos when fourth in a Group 3 over 2400m at Chantilly on 1 June. She may battle to turn the form around
- **4. RABBIT'S FOOT -** Finished third in the Group 3 Cygames Prix De Malleret over 2400m at Parislongchamp on 13 July. She is a filly with class and can go close
- **5. INDALIMOS -** Finished second in a Group 3 over 2400m at Chantilly on 1 June. Merits healthy respect
- **6. CONSENT -** Won over 2000m at Newbury on 19 July. That was her first outing this year and she looks to be loaded with ability
- **7. PINATIQUE -** Finished sixth over 2000m at Vichy in a Conditional Listed on 17 July. She may be outgunned in this line-up
- **8. KIAMBA** Won over 2400m at Parislongchamp in a Conditional Listed on 19 June. She is in a good space and should run an honest race
- **9. GALENE -** Lightly raced with good form. Finished second over 2100m at Chantilly in Class 2 Conditional on 16 May. She takes a big step up in class
- **10. UNDERSTUDY -** Finished fifth over 2400m at Newmarket in a Listed race on 19 July. She finished second in a Group 2 at Ascot in her penultimate run and can feature if finding the form of that run

Summary: RABBIT'S FOOT (4) was not disgraced when third in the Group 3 Cygames Prix De Malleret on 13 July. She has class about her and has a winning chance. CONSENT (6) won a good race in her first outing this year over 2000m at Newbury on 19 July. Luke Morris makes the trip to ride, and she is one of the leading contenders. UNDERSTUDY (10) was a tad disappointing in a Listed race last time after finishing second in a Group 2. Oisin Murphy retains the ride and if putting her best foot forward, she should be competitive. INDALIMOS (5) has produced two good runs since winning on debut and merits healthy respect.

C2 - THE AGA KHAN STUDS PRIX NUREYEV - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Listed Race - Flat - EUR € 50,300

- **1. SEA SCOUT -** Has lost best form. Finished sixth over 2000m at Royal Ascot in a Group 3 on 19 June. William Buick is booked to ride but others look stronger
- **2. INSTANT FRAGILE -** Won over 1600m at Toulouse in a Conditional Listed on 20 April. He faces his toughest test to date
- **3. NITOI -** Was disappointing in the Group 1 Qatar Prix Du Jockey Club over 2100m at Chantilly on 1 June. Chance if finding form of penultimate run
- **4. PURVIEW -** Finished second in both outings this year, the latest of which was over 1800m at Leopardstown in a Group 3 on 17 July. He is one of the leading contenders
- **5. JACKKNIFE -** Finished third in a Listed race over 1600m at Sandown on 29 May. He is a horse with scope and should be right there
- 6. MISTER RIZZ Finished unplaced over 2050m at York in a Group 2 on 15 May. Look elsewhere
- **7. DAMYSUS -** Is much better than his last start in the Group 1 Betfred Derby over 2400m at Epsom on 7 June. John and Thady Gosden won this race last year with Ombudsman
- **8. THORDIS** Finished second over 2000m at Vichy in Conditional Listed on 17 July. May find it difficult to win a race of this nature

Summary: DAMYSUS (7) is much better than his last start in the Group 1 Betfred Derby. His form prior to that outing was good. John and Thady Gosden won this race last year and will be looking to retain their title. PURVIEW (4) is another talented visitor who has finished second in his last two outings at Leopardstown, and he should be involved at the finish. JACKKNIFE (5) comes off a good third-place finish in a Listed race at Sandown. Oisin Murphy rides and he is an interesting runner. NITOI (3) is the best French runner in this contest. He is much better than his last outing in the Group 1 Qatar Prix Du Jockey Club.

C3 - THE AGA KHAN STUDS PRIX DES GRENIERS A SEL - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 50,900

- **1. PRINCE DES VILLES -** In good form this year. Finished second over 2300m at Senonnes in Class 3 Conditional on 9 July. Theo Bachelot rides and he should have a say
- **2. ETATIQUE** Finished behind Thunderspeed when ninth over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon in Class 2 Handicap on 27 July. Can upset on best form shown
- **3. SEREMINI -** Finished second over 1900m at Cholet in Class 3 Conditional on 2 June. Place chance at best in this line-up
- **4. DOLLAR INDEX -** Unplaced over 1800m at Clairefontaine in Class 2 Handicap on 2 August. Needs to find best form
- **5. LOU MAN** Finished fifth over 2800m at Vichy in Class 2 Handicap on 17 July. More is needed to win this contest
- **6. O'WOOD -** Finished behind King Trezy when sixth over 2400m at Saint-Cloud in Class 2 Handicap on 29 June. He may have to settle for the same result
- **7. VILLA DES ARTS -** Battling to find best form. Finished unplaced over 2000m at Lyon Parilly in Class 2 Handicap on 23 June. Look elsewhere
- **8. WILD HORSES -** Finished seventh in first run this year over 2400m at Chantilly in Class 3 Conditional on 20 July. Should strip a much fitter horse and can improve
- **9. KING TREZY -** Has good form this year. Finished second over 2400m at Saint-Cloud in Class 2 Handicap on 29 June. He was supplemented for this race and should be involved
- **10. RECONSTRUCTED** Won over 1400m at Vichy in Class 4 Claimer on 18 July. Takes a big step up in class and may be outgunned
- **11. VERITABLE -** Finished behind Thunderspeed when fourth over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon in Class 2 Handicap on 27 July. Don't ignore with Mickael Barzalona booked to ride
- **12. SIYOUKING -** Is better than latest when unplaced over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon in Class 2 Handicap on 27 July. Chance if finding form of penultimate run
- **13. OLYMPIC GOAL -** Is coming along the right way this year. Finished second over 2000m at Parislongchamp in Class 2 Handicap on 13 July. This is his peak run, and he can go one better
- **14. MELBORA -** Won over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon in Class 3 Handicap on 27 July. Steps up to Class 2 and may find this difficult
- **15. THUNDERSPEED -** Is an honest type who finished third over 2000m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon in Class 2 Handicap on 27 July. Merits healthy respect
- **16. RAQEEBB** Finished behind Olympic Goal when third over 2000m at Parislongchamp in Class 2 Handicap on 13 July. There should not be much separating the pair at the finish



Summary: OLYMPIC GOAL (13) is the mount of in-form Jockey Clement Lecoeuvre. The son of Olympic Glory ran a good race when second on 13 July. With luck in running, he can go one better. KING TREZY (9) has been supplemented for this race. He has produced good form this year and merits healthy respect. RAQEEBB (16) finished behind Olympic Goal when third on 13 July. There should not be much separating the pair at the finish. THUNDERSPEED (15) has good consistent form lines to his credit. Maxime Guyon steps back into the saddle and he should run another honest race.

C4 - THE AGA KHAN STUDS PRIX JACQUES LE MAROIS - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Gr1 Race - Flat - EUR € 1,000,000

- **1. ZABIARI** Unbeaten from three starts this year. He won a Group 3 over 1600m at Chantilly on 15 June. This is his toughest test to date, but he should give a good account of himself
- **2. ROSALLION** Finished strongly when second in the Group 1 Visit Qatar Sussex Stakes over 1600m on 30 July. He is a quality miler and should be the horse to beat
- **3. DANCING GEMINI -** Disappointing latest when eighth in a Group 1 over 1600m at Royal Ascot on 17 June. Chance on previous form
- **4. NOTABLE SPEECH -** Finished fifth over 1200m at Newmarket in a Group 1 on 12 July. He has won a Group 1 over this distance and merits consideration
- **5. GO TO FIRST -** Two poor outings this year. Finished eighth over 1600m in Japan in a Group 3 on 5 April. Look elsewhere
- **6. KING GOLD -** Won over 1400m at Parislongchamp in a Group 3 on 19 June. He may find it difficult to win this race
- **7. DOCKLANDS -** Finished behind Rosallion when fifth in the Group 1 Visit Qatar Sussex Stakes over 1600m at Goodwood on 30 July. He may have to settle for the same result
- **8. DIEGO VELAZQUEZ -** Won over 1400m at the Curragh in a Group 2 on 20 July. Needs to confirm that effort to be competitive here
- **9. ASCOLI PICENO -** Is a visitor from Japan. Won both starts this year, the latest of which was in a Group 1 over 1600m at Tokyo on 18 May. She is an interesting runner
- **10. RIDARI -** Finished third in a Group 3 over 1600m at Chantilly on 20 July. Cristian Demuro rides and he can finish in the placings
- **11. THE LION IN WINTER -** Finished third in the Group 1 Prix Jean Prat over 1400m on this course on 6 July. He should be ideally suited to this distance and merits healthy respect

Summary: ROSALLION (2) was doing his best work late when second in the Group 1 Visit Qatar Sussex Stakes at Goodwood. The son of Blue Point can prove that he is Europe's best miler by winning this race. THE LION IN WINTER (11) finished third in the Group 1 Prix Jean Prat. He should be ideally suited to this distance and is a big threat. ASCOLI PICENO (9) is a visitor from Japan. She has won both her outings this year, the latest of which was a Group 1 in her homeland. She is an interesting runner. ZABIARI (1) is unbeaten from three starts this year. This is his toughest test to date and from pole position, should give a good account of himself.

C5 - THE AGA KHAN STUDS PRIX FRANCOIS BOUTIN - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Gr3 Race - Flat - EUR € 73,200

- **1. RAYIF -** Won a good race on debut over 1200m on this course in Unraced Conditional on 5 July. He could be anything
- **2. ANDAB -** Was a tad disappointing when sixth over 1400m at Goodwood in a Group 2 on 29 July. Christophe Soumillon picks up the ride and he cannot be discounted
- **3. EVANESCO -** Made the natural improvement when second over 1400m at Goodwood on 2 August. He is a progressive type but may find this to be a difficult task
- **4. LAUREATE CROWN -** Finished behind Andab when eighth over 1400m at Goodwood in a Group 2 on 29 July. He may have to settle for the same result
- **5. BOURBON BLUES -** Finished sixth over 1400m at Newmarket in a Group 2 on 12 July. Others have a stronger winning chance
- **6. DAYTONA -** Is unbeaten from two starts, the latest of which was in a Listed race over 1600m at Naas on 5 July. He looks to have class and can keep his unbeaten record intact
- **7. KENZEL -** Is unbeaten from two starts, the latest of which was over 1400m at Dieppe in Class 2 Conditional on 22 July. He takes on much stronger but looks to have ability

Summary: DAYTONA (6) is unbeaten from two starts, the latest of which was in a Listed race at Naas. He makes the trip to France and clearly has class about him. The son of Wootton Bassett can remain unbeaten. RAYIF (1) won a good race on debut over 1200m on this course. He could be anything and should be competitive. KENZEL (7) is unbeaten from two starts, the latest of which was over this distance at Dieppe. He takes on stronger but looks to have loads of ability. ANDAB (2) is better than his last start in a Group 2 at Goodwood. Christophe Soumillon does duty and he would not be a shock winner.

- **1. AZOTE -** Finished sixth over 1600m at Vichy in Handicap on 18 July. Needs to find form of penultimate run to have a say
- **2. MIA JULIA -** Won over 2000m at Parislongchamp in Claimer on 3 July. She is in a good space and merits healthy respect
- **3. ANOTHER COUNTRY -** She has finished second in her last three starts, the latest of which was over 2400m at Vichy in Handicap on 30 July. She may be rewarded for consistency
- **4. GOT FLOWER -** Finished behind Another Country when seventh over 2400m at Vichy in Handicap on 30 July. She may battle to turn the form around but can place
- **5. BONJOUR MON AMOUR -** Improved to win over 2500m at Saint-Malo in Handicap on 24 July. Needs to repeat that outing to have a say here
- **6. MOKKA LATTE -** Finished third over 2000m at Vichy in Claimer on 25 July. Is looking for first career victory
- **7. DIVINISKA** Finished third over 2000m at Vichy in Maiden on 16 July. She has plenty of scope and would not be a shock winner
- **8. MEYUDINE'K -** Won over 2400m at Vichy in Claimer on 25 July. Others have a stronger winning chance
- **9. BETISE -** Finished behind Another Country when fourth over 2400m at Vichy in Handicap on 30 July. She may have to settle for the same result
- **10. FILE INDIENNE -** Finished fourth in last two starts, the latest of which was over 1600m at Saint-Cloud in a Claimer on 9 July. She jumps from a good draw of four and cannot be discounted
- **11. HAPPY LADY -** Has run three fair races to date. Finished fourth over 2100m at Senonnes in Maiden on 2 August. She should perform well in handicaps
- **12. ANDANOTHERGLORY -** Showed some signs of a form return when fourth over 2000m at Compiegne in Handicap on 24 July. Needs to confirm that effort
- **13. EASY STAR -** Finished fifth over 2400m at Vittel in Class 3 Conditional on 20 July. Will need luck in running from the wide draw
- **14. HOLLY GOODHEAD -** Finished ninth over 2000m at Compiegne in Handicap on 24 July. Others have a stronger winning chance
- **15. FELICIA STORM -** Finished third over 2200m at Clairefontaine in Handicap on 6 August. Antoine Hamelin retains the ride which is a big plus

Summary: ANOTHER COUNTRY (3) has finished second in her last three starts. Tony Piccone rides and she may be rewarded for consistency. HAPPY LADY (11) has produced three fair runs to date and should perform well in handicaps. She jumps from pole position which is a big plus. MIA JULIA (2) comes off a victory at Parislongchamp. Maxime Guyon retains the ride, she is in a good space and merits healthy respect. BETISE (9) finished behind Another Country when fourth on 10 July and she may have to settle for the same result.

C1 - PRIX ALGY'BAR (PRIX LA BATE) - 2100m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 11,500

- **1. LOVE THE STARS -** Fair effort to be 2nd at Compiegne over 2000m behind REACHING THE MOON (2) in a Class 3 handicap on July 29th. One to keep onside
- **2. REACHING THE MOON -** Got off the mark over 2000m at Compiegne on July 29th in a Class 3 handicap on her last run. Capable of making her presence felt
- **3. BAKHCHISARAY -** Several unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2000m at Compiegne on July 29th in a Class 3 handicap. Needs more to be involved
- **4. JANISA BERE -** Two decent wins in May and June, the latter over 2400m in a Class 4 race. She has been placed on her two runs since her wins and can once again be in the mix
- **5. TRIPTAJIKA -** Nice effort to be 2nd at Deauville over 1900m on August 5th in a Class 3 handicap. Capable of a leading role
- **6. KALAHARI KING** Five unplaced efforts this year, the latter over 1600m at Vittel on July 20th in a Class 4 handicap. Opposable
- **7. COMTESSE VERA -** 5th on her latest start over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers in a Class 4 handicap on July 18th. Others seem better equipped
- **8. AKAGERA -** Better run at Vichy 8 days ago in a Class 4 race over 2000m when she was 3rd after a couple of less favoured efforts. Player
- **9. JAAMIR -** 6th on his last run over 1600m at Ostende (BEL) in a conditions race on July 28th. Hardly inspiring form
- **10. DETESNOUVELLES** 5th on her most recent run over 1800m at Duindigt (NLD) on August 3rd in a conditions race. Look for an alternative
- **11. LANDARYNA -** Placed on her last two runs, 3rd on the most recent over 2100m at Vittel in a Class 4 handicap on July 25th.
- **12. LORD SPIRIT -** Four unplaced runs, 7th over 2400m at Vittel on July 20th in a Class 4 handicap when last seen. Hard to recommend

Summary: TRIPTAJIKA (5) ran a solid race on the PSF at Deauville 12 days ago when beaten in a close finish into second. She acts well on turf and is preferred ahead of AKAGERA (8), who shaped encouragingly when she was third at Vichy 8 days ago over 2000m in a Class 4 race. JANISA BERE (4) is a consistent performer and can not be ruled out of the top three. REACHING THE MOON (2) lost her maiden tag when scoring 19 days ago at Compiegne and is worth considering.

C2 - PRIX RESTAURANT "L'ENDURO PLAGE" (PRIX GUYOT-LALIGANT) - 2100m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 9,600

- **1. DIPLOMATE -** Two tame efforts since a 2nd over 2500m in a maiden race on April 20th at Nort-Sur-Erdre. Others look more likely to score
- **2. LORD SHAMROCK -** Showed promise when 6th over 1800m at Dieppe on July 7th on his debut. Should improve and warrants respect
- **3. PADDOCKWOOD -** 5th over 2200m at Gramat on August 3rd in a maiden race last time out, 2nd in a handicap at Compiegne before that in late July over 2000m. Capable of making the frame
- **4. BUFFALO WOMAN -** Placed on her last four runs, 3rd at Vichy over 1850m in a claiming event 10 days ago. Live chance of winning again
- **5. ROSALITA -** Got off the mark over 2100m at this track in a claiming race on July 27th in a close finish. One to pay attention to
- **6. PIECE MAITRESSE -** 7th on her last run, 3rd before that over 1800m in a claiming event at Saint-Malo on August 1st. She needs a few to falter
- **7. TURTLE BAY -** Three runs so far, showed very little at Parislongchamp on his last run over 2000m in a claiming event on July 3rd. Hardly inspiring credentials
- **8. LIGHT FACTOR -** Fair 6th in a claiming race at Deauville over 1900m in a claiming race on August 7th. He is capable of being on the premises
- **9. MIAIMAOU** 8th on her last outing, 4th previously over 2100m at this track in a claiming race on July 27th. Ought to be thereabouts
- **10. BELLY DANCER** She has been unplaced on all three runs, well beaten over 2400m in a maiden at Compiegne on May 10th last time out. Look for an alternative
- **11. SAN FANTASMA -** 7th last time out, 3rd previously over 2200m at Hamburg-Horn (DEU) in a conditions race on June 29th. In the mix

Summary: BUFFALO WOMAN (4) has been consistent recently with four placed efforts. Her third at Vichy 10 days ago was a credible performance, and a third behind ROSALITA (5) in late July over this course and distance on her penultimate start was a solid run. On more favoured weight terms, she can beat her old rival. LIGHT FACTOR (8) has shown promise in four runs and can make the top three. SAN FANTASMA (11) is also worth considering.
