# C1 - PRIX JACQUES BOUTIER - 1100m (a5f1/2) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- **1. HORNIG -** Colt by Showcasing the dam never raced. From a top trainer who has his horses in good form. One to watch in the betting for clues
- 2. LIGHT L'AUDRIELLE Colt by Hunter's Light, the dam was placed. His trainer is not known for many first time out winners , and any market support
- **3. MEFIE TOI -** Colt by De Treville, the dam won 2 races. Might need this debut run for experience. The betting can be the best guide
- **4. MATAKI -** Colt by Goken, the dam ran a few times. From a leading stable who knows the time of day. Watch the betting for clues
- **5. NOBLE D'ARGENT -** Colt by Romanised, the dam won 3 races. Respected trainer who can get one to strike on debut. The betting can guide
- **6. AGIOTA -** Colt by Birchwood, the dam never ran. Might need this run for experience. Monitor the betting for clues
- **7. MAZELI -** Colt by Anodin, the dam won 4 races. Improvement is expected for this outing. One to watch in the betting for any support

- **3. CHOCOLATE CHEETAH -** Filly by Oasis Dream, the dam won 1 race and was placed in a Listed race. Top trainer and a nice profile. One who can have a say in the finish
- **4. MARIE ALICE -** Filly by Kendargent, the dam won 3 races and was Listed placed. From a leading trainer who can ready a newcomer. The betting can be the best guide
- **5. ONE REPUBLIK -** Filly by Muhaarar, the dam won 2 races, Nice profile and any market support should be noted
- **6. XINGA -** Filly by Gutaifan, the dam was placed on both starts. Watch the betting patterns for any support

- **1. LACHOP** Unplaced last time out, 2nd before that over 1200m at Agen in a maiden on March 31st. Looks vulnerable
- **2. MOSTRANDO -** Four unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2100m at Toulouse in a maiden on April 7th. He has shown ability and a better run can be expected
- **3. BARANTIN** Nice 3rd on the one start over 1600m at Toulouse on March 3rd. He can improve from that run and be involved in the finish
- **4. JARKI -** 5th over 1600m in a maiden at La Teste on March 22nd on the latest start. Can improve and has place claims

- **2. MARZOOG -** Nice 4th on the only start over 1400m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on March 28th. Improvement likely and he can have a say
- **3. MANSOOR DE FAUST -** Pleasing 3rd over 1400m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on debut on March 28th. Progress is expected and is in the mix
- **4. MAHROUSE -** Ran well to be 2nd over 1400m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on debut on March 28th. Can improve and has a leading chance
- **5. RICH N CLASSY -** Unraced colt by Big Easy, the dam never raced. From a good stable who can ready a newcomer. Watch the betting patterns

- **5. SEINE LADY -** Excellent last run when 2nd over 1400m at Le Mans on the 21st of March and should give plenty cheek all the way home. Strong each way claims
- **6. FANLINE -** Has scope to progress on debut run when finishing 6th over 1600m. Might need a run or two still for the win but can improve to place
- **7. ALREYYAH -** Caught the eye when finishing 4th on debut over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 29th of last month and with natural progression, could take a power of beating. Win

- **1. MONTERRICO -** Holding form, attractive effort last time when 2nd at Pornichet and must be taken very seriously. Big runner
- 2. LADY WANDA Was a winner at the last start which was over 1900m in March at Bordeaux Le Bouscat and should be a serious threat to the first choice
- **3. BIAK LESCRIBAA -** Running well, finished 2nd over 1900m in a Handicap on the 28th of March at Bordeaux Le Bouscat and is confidently selected to go one more
- **4. TEMIRI -** Placed 4th over 2400m on the 2nd of this month and has some scope to do better. Could be the value for the minor money positions

- **2. SIR SILJAN -** Below par on his seasonal return at Fontainebleau over 3000m in a Class 2 race on March 18th. Capable performer and more expected
- **3. HASTA LA VISTA -** Placed on both runs this year, the latter over 2600m at Marseille Borely in a Class 3 handicap on March 19th. Looks to have a stiff task ahead

- **2. BOOMERANG -** Three unplaced runs this year, the latter over 1500m on the PSF in a Class 4 handicap on April 4th. Seems out of form
- **3. OPERA -** Won on her last start over 1800m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 4 handicap on March 30th. In form and can feature
- **4. MAKENO -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 2000m at Marseille Borely on February 17th in a Class 4 race. One to consider
- **5. EKTORIA -** Two unplaced runs since a 4th over 1600m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 3 handicap on February 22nd. Hard to rule out of the top four
- **6. SINNDARILLO -** Several unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1600m at this track on March 16th in a Class 4 race. Opposable

- **2. ETERNEL** Recent win over 1400m at Compiegne on March 28th in a Class 3 handicap. One to keep safe
- **3. MADIGAN -** Two unplaced runs since a 2nd over 1600m at Lignieres in a Class 4 race on March 1st. Others preferred
- **4. NEW LIGHT -** Five unplaced runs last year, the latter over 1800m at Le Croise-Laroche on October 18th in a Class 4 handicap. Opposable
- **5. FERNANDO -** Three unplaced runs since a 4th over 1600m at Vichy in a Class 4 handicap on August 7th. Not seen since September 2024 and is best watched for now

- **1. BEECHCRAFT -** Finished 7th last time out in a Condition race at Deauville over 1300m on 29 November. Won in this division before that and can bounce back to score returning from a break
- **2. WETTERKOPF -** Well beaten in both starts, including last time out when 11th in a Conditions race at this course over 2000m on 22 March. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **3. LIKETHEWIND** Unreliable and was 8th last time out in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1300m on 12 February. Can contest the finish
- **4. SPECIALISSIMA -** Has some fair form and finished 5th last time out in a handicap at Argentan over 1300m on 9 April. Can contest the finish trying a claimer
- **5. HAZA -** Has yet to win a race and was 9th last time out in handicap at Senonnes-Pouancé over 1350m on 15 March. Has run well this course and distance and has a winning chance
- **6. MAYA CHOP -** Unrliable and was 5th last time out in a Conditions race at Nancy over 1400m on 5 April. Might play a minor role
- **7. BOCCA DI LUPO -** A three-year-old gelding by Hot Streak out of Billie Jo who is making his debut. Watch the betting

- **4. VAZIRPOUR -** Disappointing from this year and was 14th last time out in a handicap at Saint-Cloud iover 2000m on 29 March. Capable of a surprise on best form
- 5. AMI SOLEDAD Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 31 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **6. ROSETTA STONE -** Did not show his best when 7th in a handicap at Deauville over 3400m on 31 Janaury. Probably better on the PSF but might play a minor role
- **7. IT'S EAGLE -** Returned from a break to win a handicap over this course and distance on 22 March. Carries a 4kg penalty but is not out of it
- **8. COGOLIN -** Returned from a break and was 13th in a handicap at Nancy over 2000m on 5 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **9. DSCHINGIS HORUS -** Has struggled in both handicaps so far and was 15th last time out over this track and trip on 22 March. Needs major improvement to win

- **14. SAGUARO -** Needed his only run of the year when tenth in a Conditions race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1800m on 5 April. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **15. RED NUREYEV** Loves this track and was victorious last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 11 November. Returns from a break but is not out of it

**Summary:** POTE (3) clearly needed his only run of the year. He is sure to strip fitter this time and can bounce back to score. ZAMNESIA (13) chased home the solid winner IT'S EAGLE (7) over this track and trip last month. There is a big swing at the weights this time, and ZAMNESIA (13) can turn the tables on that rival. IT'S EAGLE (7) looked good that day and will not go down easily. JOLI COUP (11) is not reliable but can also get involved in the finish.

- **2. NANA GINA -** Returns from a lengthy break and was 15th last time out in a handicap at Compiegne over 2800m on 22 June. Likely to need this run
- **3. ELLE LA VITESSE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 22 March. Yet to win a race but might play a minor role
- **4. KATE DADDY -** Showed vast improvement when fourth in a handicap at Nancy over 3000m on 5 April. Can win off her current mark
- **5. LEXINGTON GOLD -** Needed his only run of this year when 16th in a handicap over this course and distance on 22 March. Better over further but is capable of winning
- **6. DALIAPUR -** Disappointing last run when 14th in a handicap at Compiegne over 2400m on 28 March. A winner of his penultimate start and is not out of it

- **4. ETOILE DE LENNY -** Finished 8th on debut in a Conditions race at Montluçon Néris-les-Bains over 2300m on 30 March. Improvement is needed
