

R1 COMPIEGNE [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE L'EMPEREUR NAPOLEON III - 2800m (a2m) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 28,000

- **1. AZOU -** 4th on his last run over 2350m at Strasbourg on May 28th in a Class 2 race. Has work ahead to beat some of his rivals
- **2. BENAMIRA -** Good 2nd in a Class 2 race at Angers on May 20th and 4th in a Group 3 race before that at Saint-Cloud in April. Key chance
- **3. RODOYA -** Won on her last run over 2400m at Compiegne on May 30th. Looks progressive and can not be discounted
- **4. STUDY THE LADY -** Got off the mark over 3000m at Dieppe in a maiden on May 24th. Ought to be thereabouts
- **5. THROUGH THE FLAMES -** Won on her last run over 2500m in a maiden race at Evreux on May 27th. Live contender

Summary: BENAMIRA (2) brings solid recent form to the table, including a runner-up finish in a Class 2 contest at Angers in late May, and she gets the nod here. THROUGH THE FLAMES (5) opened her account at the third attempt with a win at Evreux, but she'll need to find further improvement to challenge the selection in this stronger field. RODOYA (3), a course winner last month, is another to consider and commands respect.

C2 - PRIX SAUTERNES'S (PRIX KARAKONTIE) - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 30,000

- **1. MEHDALI -** Colt by Van Beethoven, the dam won 6 races. Likely to improve from this debut run. Monitor the betting for clues
- **2. RIMEL -** Colt by Twilight Son, the dam never ran. Stable runners are respected on debut. Any market support should be noted
- **3. KOMOREBI -** Colt by Pinatubo, the dam won 3 of her four runs, including a Group 2 and a Group 1 race. From the Fabre powerhouse. Bold show expected for this well-bred colt
- **4. ARTILLEUR -** Colt by Siyouni, the dam won two races, including a Listed race, and was placed in Group 2 and Group 3 races. Choice profile and is one to watch for any market support
- **5. SYDNEY SUNSET -** Colt by Persian King, the dam won 3 races, including 2 Listed races. Nice profile and one to keep safe on debut
- **6. SEPTIEME TERRE -** Gelding by Martinborough, the dam was placed a few times. Stable runners tend to need a run or two. Watch the betting for clues
- **7. KENZEL -** Colt by Zelzal, the dam was placed a few times. Looks good on paper and is from a respected trainer. Can have a say on debut

Summary: KOMOREBI (3), a Godolphin-owned debutant, makes plenty of appeal on pedigree, being out of the high-class mare Lyric Of Light, a Group 2 and Group 1 winner in the UK. He is expected to be well-prepared for a winning debut. KENZEL (7), trained by a savvy operator, should also be forward enough to make a strong impact. ARTILLEUR (4) is another newcomer to note; his dam was a Listed winner, and he comes from a respected yard. SYDNEY SUNSET (5) rounds out the shortlist with a nice pedigree.

C3 - PRIX ETOILE DE LA REINE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 1 Race - Flat - EUR € 35,000

- **1. DUNE -** Has performed well on all of her runs, 4th on the latest over 1600m in a Class 2 race at this track on May 21st. Merits consideration
- **2. VENETIAN BEAUTY -** Got a win on her second start over 1600m in a maiden race at Le Mans on May 3rd. Has work ahead in a better race
- **3. PAIX DES DAMES -** 6th last time, a win before that over 1800m in a Class 2 race at Parislongchamp on April 30th. Can not be overlooked
- **4. SHE'S A TEASE -** Two unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2000m in a Class 1 race at Le Lion D'Angers on May 29th. Opposable
- **5. DANCING FLAME -** Nice 2L success on her last run at this track over 1600m on June 6th. She looks progressive and looks hard to beat
- **6. BADIE -** Ran well to be 4th in a Listed race at Parislongchamp on June 8th over 2000m on her last start. Can play a lead role

Summary: DANCING FLAME (5) won nicely on her second start over 1600m at this track earlier this month by 2L. She was unlucky on her debut not to win after a slow start, and looks like a useful prospect. BADIE (6) ran well to be fourth in a Listed race last time and looks like the main danger to the selection. PAIX DES DAMES (3) was not up to Listed class last time, but these calmer waters are more appealing. DUNE (1) has consistent form and heads the rest.

- **1. GALEGO STAR -** Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 3100m at Parislongchamp on April 17th in a Class 2 race. Capable of making the top-three
- **2. ZULU WARRIOR** 6th last time over 2400m at Chantilly in a Class 1 handicap on June 1st. Others rate higher
- **3. ROCK JOYEUX -** Placed on all three runs this year, the latter over 3000m at Strasbourg on May 28th in a Class 2 handicap. Hard to rule out
- **4. PENTAOUR -** Fair 2nd last time over 2900m at Argentan on June 4th in a Class 3 race. One to keep onside
- **5. KAPANI -** Three unplaced efforts of late, the latter over 3000m at Strasbourg on May 28th in a Class 2 handicap. Others rate higher
- **6. TIC TAC -** Four unplaced efforts this year, the latter over 3000m at Strasbourg in a Class 2 handicap on May 28th. Has dropped in the weights and can be involved
- **7. SHEEMA'S ROSE** Five unplaced runs this year, the latter over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on June 7th in a Class 3 race. Has to bounce back to form
- **8. SILLABUB -** Two wins of late, the latter over 2900m at Argentan on June 4th in a Class 3 race. Up in class and has work to do
- **9. SUPER ALEX -** 5th on the last run, 3rd before that over 3000m at Fontainebleau on April 1st in a Class 2 handicap. Outside place contender
- **10. EARENDEL** 2nd on the last run over 2500m in a Class 3 race at Parislongchamp on April 24th. Needs to be more reliable
- **11. SAPRISTI -** Three decent runs of late, a win in a Class 2 handicap at Saint-Cloud on June 3rd on the latest over 2400m. Might be in the handicapper's grip
- **12. MYKISS -** Fair 3rd last time over 3000m in a Class 2 handicap at Strasbourg on May 28th. Among the leading each way options
- **13. ROUDOUDOU -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 3100m at Saint-Cloud on May 1st in a Class 2 handicap. Each way angle
- **14. HATIM -** Unplaced last time, a win before that over 2400m at Toulouse on April 20th in a Class 3 handicap. Player
- **15. MOZART DES BRIERES -** 5th last time, a win before that over 3100m at Saint-Cloud on May 1st in a Class 3 handicap. Opposable
- **16. MARTIN** 4th on his last run over 2000m at Compiegne on June 6th in a Class 3 handicap. Place contender



Summary: HATIM (14) carries a low racing weight and benefits further from his rider's claim, giving him a distinct edge. He gets the tentative nod ahead of ROCK JOYEUX (3), who has placed in all three starts this year and appears ready to break through. PENTAOUR (4), a solid runner-up at Argentan last time out, is another with claims. ROUDOUDOU (13) warrants attention and won't make things easy for his rivals, while top-weighted GALEGO STAR (1) remains a respected contender from the head of the handicap.

- **1. EKLLEEL -** Filly by Wootton Bassett, the dam won 1 race and was placed in a Group 2 race. Looks good on paper, and she will be well prepared by connections. Player
- **2. DANICA -** Filly by Goken, the dam won 1 race. Should know what is expected on her racecourse bow. The betting market can guide
- **3. ZERIBA** Newcomer by Zelzal, the dam won 4 races. Stable runners are nicely tuned for their debut, and she is best watched in the betting for clues
- **4. VILLA ADRIENNE** Filly by Mohaather, the dam won 1 race. Her trainer is a shrewd operator and she is one to keep an eye on in the betting exchanges
- **5. WITH LOVE GRACE -** Newcomer by Iffraaj, the dam ran once. Likely to need this run for experience. Watch the betting exchanges
- **6. LIKE LINDY -** Filly by Midshipman, the dam won 2 races and was Listed placed. Watch the betting patterns for clues
- **7. LUCK HILA -** Filly by Lucky Team, the dam won 3 races. Can be expected to improve after this run, and could need more of a test of stamina in the future
- **8. NEWS DES BRIERES -** Filly by Birchwood, the dam won 1 race. Her trainer is a good operator and any market support could be significant to her expected performance
- **9. DARINICE -** Filly by Toronado, the dam ran twice. Likely to improve for this debut run unless supported in the betting market
- **10. SATOSHI** Filly by Seahenge, the dam never ran. Should improve for this debut run and is best watched in the betting for any support
- **11. WARAMINI -** Unraced by Persian King, the dam won 1 race. Nice pedigree, and she will know what is required on her racecourse bow. Watch the betting patterns
- **12. DUCHESSE MANOIR -** Filly by Goken, the dam ran twice. Stable runners are respected on debut. Any market support could be informative
- **13. CERAMIC** Filly by Lope De Vega, the dam won 2 races, including the Prix de Diane (Gr.1). Nice profile and a bold show can be expected on her first day at school
- **14. GRAZIA -** Newcomer by Lawman, the dam won 2 races. Stable runners tend to need a run or two for experience, and she is best monitored in the betting for any market moves

Summary: CERAMIC (13) is a well-bred filly out of Terrakova, the Group 1 Prix de Diane winner, and looks primed to make a winning debut. She gets the vote ahead of EKLLEEL (1), who also boasts a strong pedigree and hails from a yard capable of readying one first time out. ZERIBA (3) has an appealing profile and is one to watch closely for any positive market signals. WARAMINI (11) is another debutante worth keeping an eye on in the betting ring.

- **1. DILAWAR -** Winner over 1900m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in a Listed race on the 24th of May 2025. Include in the play
- 2. WILKO Runner up over 2200m in Germany in a Group 2 on the 1st of June 2025. More needed to feature
- **3. BOLTHOLE -** Finished 3rd behind a reopposing sort over 1900m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in a Listed race on the 24th of May 2025. Place chance
- **4. RAIMONDIN -** Held in 5th over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in a Listed race on the 17th of May 2025. Would be a shock winner

Summary: HORIZON DORE (6) has been running is some strong Group 1's and has been far from disgraced. He drops significantly in class and should be too good for this lot. He looks a stand out on the card. DILAWAR (1) notched up another win at Listed level and appears to be the horse that could run second. BOLTHOLE (3) is 1.5kgs better off at the weights for a 1.5L beating and could close the deficit with Dilawar if not reverse the form. GAMESTARS (7) has been running well and brings useful form to the table but will need to up his game to win.

- **3. DYLAN'S SPIRIT -** No type of run in 13th over 3000m at Parislongchamp in a Class 3 divided limited handicap on the 5th of June 2025. Hard to fancy on current form

He will need some luck in running but should be a major threat. WAKANDA TANGO (6) has produced two cracking efforts recently and should have every chance of delivering the goods in a race of this nature. EASTERN STAR (7) continues to drop in the ratings and showed signs of life last time out which could see him earning. WUKHANN (2) was just behind the top choice last time out and should challenge.

- **2. ROMAZIA -** Runner up over 1800m at Dieppe in maiden on the 24th of May 2025. Should go very close
- **3. MANSONNIENNE -** No show in 11th over 1400m at Dieppe in a maiden on the 24th of May 2025. Would be a surprise winner
- **4. GUILLERETTE** Poor run in 7th over 1800m at Parislongchamp in a maiden on the 29th of May 2025. Would be a shock winner
- **5. POKER STAR** Fair 5th over 2000m at Compiegne in a maiden on the 21st of May 2025. Can outrun odds

Summary: ROMAZIA (2) ran with plenty of promise on debut and would have learnt a lot with that experience under her belt. She can go on better in this. She appears to be the first choice for leading connections. TIYANADA (1) was just touched off on debut and is another that would have tightened up with a run under her belt. She gets the services of the apprentice again and should be in the firing line. MOONLIGHT ROSE (13) and MOODY (12) both come from yards that can ready them up on debut and are fillies worth keeping an eye on. Both could be involved first up.

C1 - PRIX DE RHONE-ALPES - 2600m (a1m1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,000

- **1. KINGORI -** Victorious in a claimer over this track and trip on 23 May. In very good form and should make a bold bid at victory
- 2. MAGIC TUNIS Only modest of late and was 11th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 16 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. LADY MANA** Has lost the way this year and was 12th in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 9 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. AL HABISSET -** Unreliable but was third in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 9 June. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **5. POP LIFE** Disappointing form of late and was 12th in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 1700m on 26 May. Capable of earning some minor money
- **6. GAMECHANGER** Unreliable and was 6th in a conditions race at Biguglia over 2400m on 1 June. Victorious in March and is not out of it

RISUENA (7) is better on this surface, so her last run is safely ignored, and she could contest the finish. AL HABISSET (4) has not won for some time now but is consistent and can make the frame again. GAMECHANGER (6) has won at this track and is another to consider.

- **3. SELKET -** Unreliable and finished 10th in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 9 June. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- **4. QUEEN BAY -** Holding form and was fourth in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2400m on 31 May. Capable of making the frame
- **5. BREIZH WOOD -** Unreliable finished 10th in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 19 March. On a long losing streak but could pop up in a place

- **7. GOOD QUESTION -** Disappointing form of last and finished 9th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 10 June. Capable of better and can earn some money back on the PSF
- **8. MISS ROAZHON -** Only modest of latw abd was 5th in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 9 June. Needs to do more to win this race
- **9. DRAGON LOVE -** In good form and was runner-up in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2000m on 13 June. Should contest the finish once again
- **10. NEVER LEAVE -** Finished 7th in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 9 June. Has yet to win a race and others are preferred
- **11. LE RAVI -** 10th in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2000m on 15 March. Has yet to win and is best watched for now

Summary: A competitive-looking race. CAVANI KAIZEN (2) scored in all three of his starts in Portugal and can win again.
