**C1 - PRIX DE VAUREAL - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR €
23,000**

- 1. MR SAY** - A promising 3rd in a Claimer over this course and distance on 5 May. Finished just 0.5 lengths behind TAXXI (8) so that must bring him into this race with a winning chance
- 2. MAITRE JIMMY** - A well-beaten 7th in a Conditions race over 1000m at Chantilly on 4 May. Unlikely to feature on exposed form
- 3. BODY PHYSICAL** - A 0.5-length 2nd in a Conditions race over 1200m at Marseille Borely on 6 May. She returns to the level at which she has won and has proven herself in wet conditions
- 4. LADY OSPREY** - Finished 4th in a Conditions race over 1100m at Nantes on 11 May. She has run 4th in both of her starts and should be competitive again
- 5. BELISA BAY** - A comfortable one-length winner of a Conditions race over 1200m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on 5 May. That was only her third run and there should be more progress to come
- 6. OFF SPRING** - A mediocre 9th in a Claimer over this course and distance on 5 May. Will struggle to turn the form around with a number of other runners
- 7. PARTIE ROCKET** - A moderate 8th in a Conditions race over 1000m at Chantilly on 4 May. Has only raced twice so there could be some improvement to come
- 8. TAXXI** - A 2.5-length 2nd in a Claimer over this course and distance on 5 May. That performance brings her into contention for her first win
- 9. HARMONY IN BLUE** - 2yo filly by Armour out of Due Diligence mare Linea Blue trained by Paul De Chevigny. Dam's first foal to race
- 10. ENFANT PARADIS** - A moderate 7th in a Claimer over this course and distance on 5 May. Another who is unlikely to threaten all the runners who finished ahead of him in that race.
- 11. NINAO** - Finished 5th in a Claimer over this track and trip on 5 May. Does look held by others on that run but could place
- 12. MA CHOPE** - 2yo filly by Captain Chop out of Vale Of York mare Mayana Hope trained by Miguel Blancpain. Related to a number of multiple winners so could make a strong start to her career

Summary: BODY PHYSICAL (3) ran an excellent second last time, and the form has worked out well because the winner went on to place in a Listed race. She has already won a Claimer and can easily repeat. BELISA BAY (5) has done nothing wrong in her three starts and won well last time extended to 1200m. She looks the main danger. TAXXI (8) continues to improve while LADY OSPREY (4) has run well in both starts and should be competitive.

C2 - PRIX DE CHILLY-MAZARIN - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 3 Claiming - Flat - EUR € 25,000

1. ARNAY LE DUC - A moderate 7th in a Conditions race over 2400m at Compiegne on 9 May. He is dropping in trip which should suit and runs well under Malone Favriaux

2. GALAGOS - A moderate 6th in a Condition race over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 29 April. Did win his penultimate over this course and distance so is not without some sort of chance

3. MONONOF - Not beaten far when 5th in a Conditions race over 1800m at Compiegne on 25 April. Runs on strongly, handles the soft and should be competitive again

4. CREW DRAGON - Never in when 12th in a Handicap over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on 8 May. Recent form is poor and he will be trying this distance for the first time

5. MIGHTY BOY - Won a Claimer over 1900m at Chantilly on 22 April. That was on the sand but he cannot be written off in this race

6. TOP TOWN TELL TALE - Finished 7th in a Conditions race over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 29 April. is having his first run at this level and will be fitted with Australian blinkers which might help him focus

7. MERKUR - Finished 7th in a race over 1600m at Hanover in Germany on 1 May. He drops in class and did run well enough in Condition races in France to have a winning chance in this

Summary: MERKUR (7) has been running well in Germany but did perform well in Conditions races in France last year and drops in class. MONONOF (3) has a good record in soft conditions and has been doing his best work at the finish, so he will be running at them. TOP TOWN TELL TALE (6) will be fitted in blinkers and will run in a Claimer for the first time. ARNAY LE DUC (1) has won his only race over this distance and should not be taken lightly.

24,700**

1. LIVORNO - A tailed-off 15th in a Maiden over 1600m at Le Mans on 21 April. That was a poor debut but might improve with the experience under his belt

2. PRINCE SAKURA - Finished 9th in a Maiden over 1900m at Deauville on 29 December. Finished well last time and now on turf in his return to the track, he could be one to watch

3. SORANO - A close-up 4th in a Maiden over 2000m at Fontainebleau on 20 April. A real fighter whose experience will work in his favour

4. TAJMAWAN - Never in it when 8th in a Maiden over 2400m at Compiegne on 9 May. Has to do more to be competitive in this race

5. NOBLE MEMORY - A well-beaten 7th in a Maiden over 2000m at ParisLongchamp on 30 April. Should show improvement in this race

6. OVERNIGHT - A narrowly beaten 2nd in a Conditions race over 2000m at this course on 19 March. He is a runner with high expectations and looks ready to open his account

7. VAN DER ROHE - Unraced 3yo gelding by Sea The Stars out of Redoute's Choice mare Vanzara trained by Christopher Head. He is a 3-part brother to Gr1 winner Vazira

Summary: OVERNIGHT (6) has a lot going for him after an excellent debut in which he was touched off by a decent rival. He looks the one to beat, although he could face a serious challenge from well bred first-timer VAN DER ROHE (7). He is well related to some Group race winners so could make a successful debut. SORANO (3) has experience on his side while PRINCE SAKURA (2) could make an impact in his comeback run from an almost 5-month break.

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**C4 - PRIX TIMANDRA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR €
24,700**

1. SODA ZABEEL - Not beaten all that far when 6th in a Maiden over 2000m at ParisLongchamp on 30 April. Does have some promising form and could place

2. LOUIZA - A close-up 3rd over 2000m at this course on 1 May. Ran on well and should be competitive again

3. LIGHTASS FAL - A disappointing 9th in a Maiden over 2400m at this course on 24 April. She is better than that run and the drop in trip could work in her favour

4. NORTHERN LINE - A well-beaten 9th in a Maiden over 1600m at Le Mans on 21 April. Will need to up her game to feature

5. IVANOVKA - A moderate 6th in a Conditions race over 1600m at Chantilly on 22 April. Will need to improve on her debut run if she is to have any chance

6. HAPP'INES - A poor 9th in a Maiden over 2400m at Compiègne on 9 May. Best overlooked based on her overall form

7. MERIDYS - A promising 4th in a Maiden over 2400m at this course on 24 April. Will benefit from the drop in trip and the wet track

8. THE LITTLE SWAN - A 3.5-length 2nd in a Maiden over 2500m at Argentan on 9 April. That was not a bad effort but drops in distance and takes on stronger

9. AMIE AMOUR - Looked decent when 5th in a Maiden over 1600m at this course on 17 April. Her penultimate 2nd was superb and if she stays the distance must be a big runner

10. LEFTEYE - A close 2nd in a Maiden over this course and distance on 30 April. That was a great comeback run after a 7-month absence and she has some lofty targets ahead

11. BROSNA - Unraced 3yo filly by Dubawi out of Frankel mare Fount trained by Andre Fabre. Dam won a Gr3 over 1600m at Deauville and is half-sister to Listed winner Apollo Fountain

Summary: LEFTEYE (10) produced an amazing comeback run after a seven-month break to go down narrowly over this track and trip. She was supplemented into the race and with Maxime Guyon up is the one to beat. The main threat could come from stablemate and well-bred BROSNA (11), whose dam won a Gr3, and is a half-sister to Listed winner Apollo Fountain. LOUIZA (2) ran a promising third last time while MERIDYS (7) should appreciate the drop in distance.

- 1. ANDOUINS** - Finished sixth over 3000m at Le Lion D'Angers in Class 3 Handicap on 7 May. Drawn nicely but more is needed to win this
- 2. BORN TO WIN** - Finished third over 3000m at Parislongchamp in Class 3 Handicap on 23 April. Has a wide draw to contend with and may find it difficult
- 3. HOT AND BEAUTY** - Won over 2500m at Parislongchamp in Class 3 Handicap on 30 April. Is in a good space but others are preferred
- 4. LILI STAR** - Victorious over 2500m on this course in Group 3 AQPS on 17 April. She is in a good space and merits healthy respect
- 5. TIMBALLINA** - Finished unplaced over 2400m at Vichy in Class 4 Handicap on 13 May. She can feature on her previous two efforts
- 6. LOFSONGUR ISLANDE** - Finished eighth over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in Class 4 Handicap on 29 April. Needs to produce previous form to have a say
- 7. SUMMER WAY** - Finished fifth over 3200m at Bordeaux le Bouscat in Class 4 Handicap on 5 May. She loves racing on soft ground and has a winning chance
- 8. KING MOTIF** - Won over 3400m at Orleans in Class 4 Conditional on 1 May. Axel Baron retains the ride, and he cannot be discounted
- 9. GLORI LEADER** - Finished fourth over 2400m at Chantilly in Class 4 Handicap on 12 May. He will enjoy the rise in distance and is a big threat
- 10. MARIOENTO** - Two poor efforts this year. Finished unplaced over 2400m at Chantilly in Class 4 Handicap on 12 May. Look elsewhere
- 11. AMIRAL D'AUMONT** - Finished eighth over 3200m at Bordeaux le Bouscat in Class 4 Handicap on 5 May. Will need luck from the widest draw
- 12. EASTERN STAR** - Two poor efforts this year. Finished unplaced over 2400m at Parislongchamp in Class 3 Handicap on 7 May. Overlook
- 13. YES ZARA** - Finished ninth over 3000m at Parislongchamp in Class 3 Handicap on 23 April. Marie Velon rides and the handy galloping weight will help

Summary: SUMMER WAY (7) ran a fair race over 3200m at Bordeaux le Bouscat on 5 May. She is ideally suited to soft ground and may be the one to beat. GLORI LEADER (9) produced a creditable effort when fourth at Chantilly recently. He will enjoy the rise in distance and is one of the leading contenders. - 1. ULYMINE** - Finished behind DANDY STYLE (4) when fifth over 1200m at Chantilly in Class 1 Conditional on 28 April. There should not be much separating the pair at the finish
- 2. HOMERE** - Finished fifth over 1400m at Bordeaux le Bouscat in Class 2 Conditional on 11 April. He has scope and should have a say
- 3. SEEWAY** - Finished unplaced over 1400m at Parislongchamp in Handicap on 26 April. Nicely drawn in Barrier Two but others are preferred
- 4. DANDY STYLE** - Finished fourth over 1200m at Chantilly in Class 1 Conditional on 28 April. He is in a good space and may be the one to beat
- 5. MATAKI** - Finished seventh over 1400m at Parislongchamp in Handicap on 26 April. Needs to produce best form to have a say
- 6. ACARY** - Finished unplaced over 1400m at Parislongchamp in Conditional Listed on 23 April. He has scope but needs improvement to feature here

Summary: DANDY STYLE (4) recently finished fourth on the Chantilly straight course. Augustin Madamet knows him well and the combination merit healthy respect. TARATEEL (7) was supplemented for this race. She has changed stables and if fit, she should be involved. ULYMINE (1) finished behind DANDY STYLE (4) when fifth at Chantilly recently. There should not be much separating the pair at the finish. HOMERE (2) followed up his debut victory with a creditable effort and has scope. He cannot be discounted.

- 2. MAXIMILIEN** - Victorious over 1700m at Marseille Borely in Class 2 Conditional on 27 April. He is in a good space but may be outgunned in this line-up
- 3. SORBETTO** - Finished fourth over 1600m at Toulouse in Conditional Listed on 19 April. Christophe Soumillon rides and he can show
- 4. AZURE DRAGON** - Finished behind SORBETTO (3) when fifth over 1600m at Toulouse in Conditional Listed on 19 April. There should not be much separating the pair at the finish

- 7. FRENCH COLORADO** - Finished behind MAXIMILIEN (2) when third over 1700m at Marseille Borely in Class 2 Conditional on 27 April. He may have to settle for the same result
- 8. ETCHEBASTER** - Finished fourth over 1600m at Chantilly in Class 2 Conditional on 2 April. He is having his peak run, but more is needed to win
- 9. KOMET CHOP** - Finished sixth over 1600m at Toulouse in Conditional Listed on 19 April. He is nicely weighted and can surprise

Summary: NEW CONNECTION (1) may not have seen out the 2150m at this stage of his career last time. He drops to 1600m and can win on his handicap debut. BOCCA AL LUPO (6) has some interesting form lines to his credit. He is a horse with scope and should pose a threat. KOMET CHOP (9) comes into this contest nicely weighted. Antoine Werle knows him well and the combination merit obvious consideration. SORBETTO (3) finished fourth in a Conditional Listed recently. With luck in running, he can feature.

- 1. SUGAR DADDY** - Finished fifth over 1200m at Chantilly in Handicap on 4 May. He remains competitive off this rating and can return to winning ways
- 2. PARISA** - Finished eighth over 1400m at Nancy in Conditional Maiden on 26 April. Was supplemented for this race and needs to improve
- 3. GUNS AND ROSES** - Finished third over 1600m at Nantes in Claimer on 3 July 2025. He is having his first outing this year and may need the run
- 4. HELLO VEGA** - Finished eighth over 1550m at Strasbourg in Handicap on 8 May. She is a filly with scope but may be outgunned in this line-up
- 5. WHY AM I BEAUTIFUL** - Finished third over 1400m at Parislongchamp in Handicap on 10 May. She has plenty of scope and should pose a threat
- 6. MISAN** - Finished sixth over 1200m at Fontainebleau in Claimer on 20 April. She has scope and is looking for first-career victory

C1 - PRIX DES FEUILLES MORTES - 2000m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- 1. OCRA** - Ran well to be 2nd last time over 1800m in a handicap on April 16th at Salon Provence. Won on the PSF last year. Leading player
- 2. MARIA APOLLONIA** - Below par last time on turf 21 days ago, 5th before that at Deauville on April 8th on turf in a handicap, course winner in December over this trip. Can make her presence felt
- 3. AL MA'IDA** - Two unplaced efforts since a 3rd at Marseille Borely in a maiden over 2000m on March 18th. Tries this surface for the first time and has work to do
- 4. SPACE GOOD** - Course winner two runs back over this trip in a maiden on March 4th, he can be forgiven for his 9th on turf last time in mid-April. In the mix
- 5. AUSTRALIPS** - She has been unplaced in all three runs, 9th at Marseille Borely on the most recent over 2000m in a maiden on May 6th. Handicap debut and could make the frame
- 6. PURPLE DAHLIA** - Failed to trouble the judge in three runs, 8th at Marseille Borely in a maiden on April 27th over 1700m last time. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- 7. MAGIC STORM** - Finished 6th on his third start over 2000m at Marseille Borely in a maiden on May 6th last time out. PSF bow and handicap debut and can be overlooked
- 8. NYMPHEAS** - She has been unplaced on all four runs, 6th in a claimer at this track/trip last time on May 7th. Look elsewhere

Summary: OCRA (1) was a decent second on the turf at Salon Provence in mid-April on the latest start and has strong claims for going one place better on her return to a surface she is effective on. MARIA APOLLONIA (2) could be the one that gives the selection the most to think about and is a previous course winner in December. SPACE GOOD (4) won over the track and trip in March and can have a say in proceedings. AUSTRALIPS (5) makes her handicap debut and is worth considering each-way.

- 1. BEWARE OF THE BEAR** - Recent success over this track and trip on May 2nd by 2 lengths. Likes this track and can not be ignored
- 2. LE DOC** - Three solid runs of late, 2nd on the most recent at Lyon Parilly in a claimer over 1600m on May 8th. Consistent in this class of race and can score
- 3. BALTA** - Two unplaced efforts since a win over this track and trip in a claimer on March 4th. Can get back on track and be a threat
- 4. OBLENSKHY** - He has failed to trouble the judge in three starts, 8th on the latest over 1300m at Chantilly in a maiden on April 14th. Drops in class but can be opposed
- 5. NOCTURNE BLOU** - Fair 5th last time over the track/trip on May 2nd, a win before that over the same on December 16th in a claiming race. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 6. PANTHERINA** - Better effort to be 4th at Nancy in a claiming race over 1400m on April 26th. Among the leading each-way chances
- 7. YODA** - Finished 6th last time in a Class 3 race on May 10th, 2nd previously in a claimer at Hyeres over 1850m on April 25th.
- 8. HORNIG** - Placed 3rd on his last start over this course and distance in a claimer on May 2nd. One to pay attention to
- 9. AGNESIT'A** - Not at her best with three unplaced runs of late, 9th at Cavaillon in a Class 3 race on May 10th at Cavaillon. Others rate higher
- 10. NEWS DES BRIERES** - She has been out of form with five unplaced runs, 5th over 1850m in a claimer on April 25th last time at Hyeres. Looks vulnerable
- 11. THE BLACK VELVET** - She has three unplaced runs recently, 8th over 1200m in a handicap at Marseille Borely on May 6th. Hardly inspiring

Summary: LE DOC (2) has been placed on the last three starts, a win on turf in early April at Lyon Parilly and two second placed efforts since that. His second at this track on his penultimate run was over this track and trip on May 2nd behind his chief threat BEWARE OF THE BEAR (1), who scored by two lengths. On 4 kilos better terms the placings can be reversed. HORNIG (8) looks like a sensible each way option and PANTHERINA (6) is also one to keep onside.

- 1. SASKATOON** - Ran well to be 4th over 1200m at Marseille Borely on April 3rd in a Class 3 handicap last time out. Outside place contender
- 2. THE DOCTOR** - Two 5th placed runs recently, the latter over 2000m in a Class 4 race over this track on May 2nd in a Class 4 race. Top-three chance down in distance
- 3. PASSINGSHOT** - Out of sorts with four tame efforts this year, well beaten over 1600m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 2 handicap on May 8th. Pass over
- 4. WAZIERS** - Two unplaced runs since a 2nd over 1500m at this track on March 22nd in a Class 3 handicap. Enters calculations
- 5. ISNEAUVILLE** - Did not feature last time in a Class 2 handicap 8 days ago at Parislongchamp, 3rd previously over 1350m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 race on April 13th. Live chance
- 6. CALA ROSSA** - Well beaten last time on April 11th in a Class 3 handicap, a win before that over 1600m at Cavaillon in a conditions race on March 29th. Needs to be more reliable
- 7. MERCI ELIE** - Three good runs of late, 2nd on the most recent over 2000m in a claimer on May 2nd at this track, and two wins before that on turf. Can make the frame

- 10. SMILE FOR ME** - Consistent performer with five placed runs, 3rd on the most recent over 1600m at Vichy on May 13th in a Class 4 handicap. Hard to ignore on a track she likes

Summary: ISNEAUVILLE (5) found Class 2 a bit too much on the turf at Parislongchamp 8 days ago, but should be more at home back on the this surface in a less competitive race. She is given the nod over SMILE FOR ME (10), who is a consistent performer who handles all types of surfaces and is a track and trip winner before. IRBIS (8) has solid form and is hard to rule out after two wins on turf in March. THE DOCTOR (2) is a course winner over further and merits consideration.
