C1 - PRIX DU Puits D'ANTIN - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Newcomers - Flat - EUR € 24,700

- 1. THE WHEEL OF TIME** - Gelding by Lawman, the dam won 7 races. His dam knew how to win and he is worth watching in the betting for any market moves
- 2. NOW FOR GLORY** - Colt by Almanzor, the dam was unraced. Nice pedigree and from a respected outfit that will have this colt well prepared. The betting can guide
- 3. CONTADOR** - Colt by Kingman, the dam won 1 race. Nice pedigree and he should know what is required on his first day at school. Can be on the premises
- 4. TAYLOR** - Gelding by Romanised, the dam ran twice. Likely to improve for this run and he is best watched for any market support
- 5. SCHWYZER** - Gelding by Savoir Vivre, the dam won 1 race. One that will step forward from his debut and is best watched with the future in mind
- 6. GAREYA** - Filly by Bated Breath, the dam won 1 race from two starts. Should play a leading role from a leading trainer that can produce first time out winners
- 7. PALMYRA** - Filly by Justify, the dam never raced. Expensive at 320,000 Euro purchase and from a respected trainer that knows the time of day. In the mix
- 8. VALDERRAMA** - Filly by Recoletos, the dam never ran. Can be expected to improve for this debut run unless the betting says otherwise
- 9. ELLE ECLIPSE** - Filly by Too Darn Hot, the dam won 1 race. Could be the second string of the Fabre pair as she has an apprentice booked to ride. Monitor the betting patterns
- 10. FINLANDAISE** - Filly by Lope De Vega, the dam won 1 race. Some good aspects to her profile and is from a top trainer that excels with newcomers. Player

Summary: GAREYA (6) is from a respected trainer that can get one ready to strike on debut. Her dam won one race from only two starts and she is given the nod over FINLANDAISE (10), who has some good aspects to her profile and is from the Fabre powerhouse. She can make things interesting. CONTADOR (3) is from a top stable that is firing on all cylinders at the moment and is worth a market check. PALMYRA (7), was a 320,000 euros purchase and is another worth considering.

- 1. THE MAGPIE** - Placed on the last four runs, a win on the most recent over 2600m at Marseille Borely in a maiden race on April 27th. Leading chance of scoring
- 2. MERVEILLE** - Two recent wins, the latter over 2500m at Evreux in a claiming race on April 15th. Knows how to win and can be involved up in class
- 3. ARIOSTO** - Unplaced last time, 2nd previously over 2500m at Argentan in a maiden race on April 9th. One to pay attention to each-way
- 4. ZITTO** - Two unplaced runs of late, the latter at this track in a maiden race on March 27th over 1600m. Has to do a lot more to make the frame
- 5. RUSAIR FAL** - Placed 4th on the latest start over 2000m in a claiming race at Parislongchamp on May 7th. Outside place contender
- 6. NATORSPEED ESSEF** - Two 3rd placed runs of late from only three runs, the latter over 2400m in a maiden race at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on April 27th. Can be on the premises
- 7. YUNA** - Below par last time over this track and trip in a maiden race on May 9th. Cristain Demuro booked to ride looks like the the only positive
- 8. ZARABABY** - She has been unplaced on all three runs, 5th at this track and trip in a maiden race when last seen on May 9th. Pass over
- 9. SYLVEROY** - She has three runs so far and has not troubled the judge, 5th on the most recent over 2400m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in a maiden on April 27th. Seems of limited talent

Summary: THE MAGPIE (1) has plenty of stamina having scored over slightly further at Marseille Borely in a maiden race late in April. She is preferred over NATORSPEED ESSEF (6), who has been third on his latest two outings. He can make life difficult for the selection. ARIOSTO (3), has leading claims each-way, he has been second in two of his four starts. MERVEILLE (2) is full of confidence after two recent wins in lower class events and heads the remainder.

- 1. RIASSOU** - Ran well to be 2nd last time over 1600m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 2 handicap on May 8th. Live chance each way
- 2. HALF HALF** - Recent win over 1400m at Parislongchamp in a Class 2 handicap on April 30th. One to pay attention to and can be on the premises
- 3. PUMALIN PARK** - Tad below par last time behind HALF HALF (2) in a Class 2 handicap on April 30th at Parislongchamp over 1400m. Remains capable of being involved
- 4. CALAS** - Back in the winner enclosure at Parislongchamp on April 16th when last seen in a Class 3 handicap. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 5. COMME QUOI** - Two 2nd placed runs of late, the latter over 1800m at this track in a Class 3 race on April 27th. Key player
- 6. SERINES** - Out of form of late, 10th at Parislongchamp on April 16th when last seen in a Class 2 handicap over 1600m. Among the leading chances
- 7. TRUE TEDESCO** - Below par runs on each of his three runs this year, 10th at Chantilly in a Class 2 handicap on April 27th over 1900m on the latter. Back on turf but has something to prove
- 8. ZIGGY STAR** - Ran a creditable race to be 5th at Lyon Parilly in a Class 2 handicap on May 8th over 1600m when last seen. Might need a few to falter
- 9. DUBALAA** - Tad low key last time on April 7th at Deauville, 2nd before that in a Class 2 handicap at Chantilly on March 12th over 1600m on the PSF. Has the ability to make an impact
- 10. JOH SPIRIT** - Placed 3rd last time over 1600m in a Class 2 handicap at Lyon Parilly on May 8th. Has work ahead to make the frame
- 11. PRINCE AUBOIS** - Two tame efforts of late, the latter when well beaten over 1400m at Parislongchamp on April 30th in a Class 2 handicap. Look elsewhere
- 12. BAUHINIA RHAPSODY** - Seems out of sorts with four unplaced runs this year, the latter over 1900m at Chantilly in a Class 2 handicap on April 27th. Hardly inspiring
- 13. CASARES** - Lukewarm on all three runs this year, the latter when well beaten at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 2 handicap over 2000m on February 18th. Pass over
- 14. BABY HARTWOOD** - Two 5th place runs recently, the latter over 2000m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 2 handicap on March 10th. Might find this challenging
- 15. THE SNARK** - Got another win over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on April 27th. Can not be ruled out of the top-four
- 16. LISIPPO** - Two recent placed runs, 3rd on the most recent over 1600m at Fontainebleau in a Class 3 handicap on April 11th. Can make the frame

Summary: COMME QUOI (5) has been threatening to score after back-to-back runner-up finishes, most recently in a Class 3 contest over 1800m at this venue in late April. With a leading jockey booked, he looks capable of going one better. DUBALAA (9) rates the main danger and can be forgiven a below-par latest effort, especially given his versatility across different surfaces. CALAS (4) arrives on the back of a win at ParisLongchamp in mid-April and should remain competitive, while HALF HALF (2), another last-time-out winner, deserves each-way consideration. PUMALIN PARK (3) also warrants a mention.

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C4 - PRIX DES FRONDAISONS - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 3 - Flat - EUR € 18,300

- 1. LOVATREE PARIS** - Won on the latest start over 2100m at Dax in a maiden race on May 1st. Honest performer who can give another good account of herself
- 2. MAJOIE** - Got off the mark at Le Lion D'Angers on May 7th in a maiden race over 2000m when last appearing . Enters calculations
- 3. PIYANGO** - Placed on the last two runs, 2nd on the latter over 1600m at Saint-Cloud in a handicap on May 5th. Lightly raced and looks ready to score
- 4. LA MARITZA** - Finished 5th last time over 1600m in a handicap at Fontainebleau on April 20th. Others seem better equipped
- 5. BEAU ROMAN** - Still a maiden after five runs, 7th on the latter over 1600m in a handicap at Nantes on May 11th and 3rd before that in a maiden in April. Can make the frame
- 6. SYDNEY SUNSET** - Three unplaced runs since a 4th over 1600m at Chantilly on February 29th in a maiden race. Not the most reliable and can be overlooked
- 7. PARVAGE** - Creditable 6th last time in a handicap at Nantes over 1600m on May 11th. Placed in two handicap's before the last run and is capable of making his presence felt
- 8. KAPKAN** - Two unplaced efforts this year, the most recent over 1600m in a handicap at Saint-Cloud on May 5th. Hard to recommend
- 9. AL PASO** - He has been unplaced on all four runs, 6th at Fontainebleau in a handicap last time over 1600m on April 20th. Looks vulnerable
- 10. GANODIN** - Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 2000m at Strasbourg in a maiden race on March 3rd. One to pay attention to each-way
- 11. HEUREUSE** - Placed on all four runs, 2nd on the latter over 1800m in a maiden race at Langon – Libourne on May 1st. Outside place chance

Summary: PARVAGE (7) was a creditable sixth in a competitive race last time, and with two solid placed runs before that in decent handicap events, he is given the verdict over the lightly raced PIYANGO (3), who arrives after two good placed runs and can be a threat to his rivals. BEAU ROMAN (5) is also worth considering and can have a say in the business end. LOVATREE PARIS (1) is consistent and can not be ruled out of the shake-up.

- 1. RUBENESQUE** - Two 5th place runs of late, the latter over 1500m in a maiden race at Tarbes on May 11th. Looks vulnerable off top weight
- 2. GLOW UP** - 7th on the last two runs, a win before that on debut at Toulouse in a conditions race over 1600m on March 1st. Has to bounce back to form
- 3. ORINOCO** - Got off the mark on her third start over 1500m at Vannes in a claiming race on May 8th. Up in class and others rate higher
- 4. DEUX DE COUPE** - Four unplaced runs recently, the latter over 1600m in a handicap on April 29th at Lyon Parilly. Needs to show more to have a say
- 5. TCHIKITA** - Placed 4th on her last run over 1800m in a claimer at Le Croise-Laroche on May 17th. Can make the top four
- 6. FILIGRANE** - Placed 4th last time in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1600m in a handicap on May 5th, a win over 1400m at Parislongchamp on April 26th. Merits close attention
- 7. MISTY CITY** - Unplaced last time over 1400m at Parislongchamp in a handicap on May 10th. Has to show more consistency
- 8. MAURICIA** - She has been unplaced on all three runs, the latter over 1400m in a maiden race at this track on April 25th. Pass over
- 9. ASTREA** - Ran well to be 4th at Marseille Borely in a handicap on May 6th over 1200m when last seen. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 10. LADY SOFIA** - Placed 2nd on her last three runs, the latter over 1400m at Parislongchamp on April 26th behind FILIGRANE(6). Can play a leading role
- 11. ARKEN** - Placed 4th last time over 1600m at Fontainebleau on April 20th in a handicap. Can be involved at the finish and be a threat
- 12. EVEROSE** - Three solid runs of late, 3rd on the latter at Strasbourg in a handicap on May 8th over 1550m. One to keep onside

Summary: LADY SOFIA (10) was a decent second at Parislongchamp in late April on her most recent start behind FILIGRANE (6). On better weight terms she can reverse placings. Her main threat could be ARKEN (11), who was a decent fourth at Fontainebleau in a handicap on April 20th when last seen. FILIGRANE (6) has acquitted herself well with a win two runs back and a recent fourth at Saint-Cloud 20 days ago on her latest start. She can be on the premises, as can ASTREA (9), who heads the rest.

- 1. CROWDFUNDING** - Placed 4th on the latest two runs, the most recent over 1600m at this track in a Class 3 handicap on May 20th. Enters calculations
- 2. DORIANELLO** - Honest performer, two wins this year and three 3rd placed runs, the most recent at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 handicap on May 8th over 1600m. Player
- 3. LETTY'S MARVEL** - Four unplaced efforts this year, the latter when well beaten at Parislongchamp over 2000m in a Class 2 handicap on May 10th. Avoidable
- 4. SAXON VILLAGE** - Three unplaced efforts since a 3rd over 1600m in a Class 2 handicap at Chantilly on March 12th. Needs to get back on track
- 5. MODERN SPIRIT** - 8th last time on May 14th, a win before that over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap at Chantilly on March 16th on the PSF. Place contender

- 2. LUNALA** - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 1400m at Parislongchamp on May 3rd in a Class 3 handicap. Capable of being competitive
- 3. GOLDEN VALE** - Two tame runs this year, well back over 2000m at Chantilly in a Class 3 handicap on May 12th last time. Look elsewhere
- 4. PERGOLOR** - Numerous unplaced runs, in the rear at Parislongchamp over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap on May 14th. Seems out of sorts and best to avoid
- 5. INKIOSTRO** - Won on her sole run this year over 2000m at this track in a Class 3 handicap on March 27th. Top-three contender

- 2. KATANA DES ROCS** - Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 1600m at Loudeac in a Class 4 race on April 6th. Others make more appeal
- 3. MEARAS STYLE** - Below par recently, 7th at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 handicap on May 15th over 2000m when last seen. She has eased in the weights and warrants respect
- 4. EARLY LIGHT** - Below par runs of late, well back on the latest start in a Class 3 handicap at Saint-Cloud on May 15th over 2000m. Look elsewhere

- 1. INSTRUIT** - Finished 8th in a Handicap over 1200m at Mont-De-Marsan on 23 March. Not beaten that far and could place on a good day
- 2. DADAS BOY** - A 0.25-length 2nd in a Handicap over 1200m at Agen on 26 April. In good form, likes this trip and should fight out the finish
- 3. HAARICIA** - A moderate 8th in a Handicap over 1200m at Marseille Borely on 27 April. Well held by others on that last run
- 4. BOSQUET** - A 3-length 2nd in a Handicap over 1200m at Marseille Borely on 27 April. Won his penultimate with Coralie Pacaut and they team up again. The runner to beat
- 5. THE DIG** - A promising 5th in a Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on 14 April. Has some decent runs of late and could place
- 6. GO JOHNNY GO GO GO** - Finished 6th in a Conditions over 1600m at Cavaillon on 10 May. Drops in both distance and class and could be competitive

Summary: BOSQUET (4) comes into this race with the best form and could prove hard to beat, especially with Coralie Pacaut in the irons as they have winning form together. DADAS BOY (2) stands out as the main threat as he too comes into the race in good form and jumps from No 1 draw. GO JOHNNY GO GO GO (6) comes in with a light weight but is drawn wide. He has the speed to overcome that obstacle. THE DIG (5) is another in good form.

- 1. GLAVIA** - Finished 12th in a Handicap over 1700m at Marseille Borely on 3 April. Her form is moderate but her rating is dropping so that could bring her into contention
- 2. PLATA D OCTOBRE** - Not beaten far when 3rd in a Handicap over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 29 April. She is consistent and should again fight out the finish
- 3. MAYISKI** - Finished last of the 6 runners in a race over 2200m at San Sebastian in Spain on 22 April. Will have to up his game to feature
- 4. INDIAN PACIFIC** - Beaten 8 lengths when 3rd in a Conditions race over 2200m at Cavillon on 29 March. Has been running consistently well of late and jumps from a decent draw
- 5. ARCUBIATU** - A close up 6th in a Handicap over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 29 April. He tends to come from behind so the race will need to pan out to suit him
- 6. DENGIE** - A tailed off 15th in a Handicap over 1600m at Vichy on 13 May. Recent form is poor and will need to find more
- 7. PEARL SPIRIT** - A close up 5th in a Handicap over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 29 April. Has placed in both of her starts at this course and looks the runner to beat
- 8. YAKAMOUN** - Not beaten too far when 8th in a Handicap over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on 15 May. Will need to show more to be competitive
- 9. POLYSPEED** - A 1.25-length winner of a Handicap over 2000m at Toulouse on 19 April. Penalised 3kg for that win but this gelding should still remain competitive
- 10. SHANCEL** - Never in the race when 15th in a Handicap over 2400m at Cagnes on 24 February. Little to recommend him on recent form
- 11. CANDY CHERIE** - Ran 3rd in a Conditions race over 2200m at Cavillon on 10 May. Has a lot more to do at this level and is unlikely to feature

Summary: PEARL SPIRIT (7) has been running consistently well in her last few starts and deserves to be rewarded with a victory. PLATA D'OCTOBRE (2) finished narrowly ahead of the selection in that race, but the selection is better drawn this time and should reverse the placings. Supplemented into this race after a solid victory last time, POLYSPEED (9) could overcome the 3kg penalty and could double up. ARCUBIATU (5) will need a strong early pace to run them down at the end.

- 2. NEW CHAPTER** - A well-beaten 5th in a Maiden over 2000m at Marseille Vivaux on 8 October. Coming back from 7-month layoff and will need to have improved to feature
- 3. KILLWINING** - Finished at the back of an 8-horse field in a Maiden over 2400m at Lyon Parilly on 8 May. Might prefer the drop on trip but will need to up his game
- 4. CELAGO** - A decent 4th in a Maiden over 2000m at Marseille Borely on 6 May. He finish behind BRUNETTE COLEMAN (5) but it was his debut run and he should progress
- 5. BRUNETTE COLEMAN** - A 4-length 2nd in a Maiden over 2000m at Marseille Borely on 6 May. That was an improved performance and she should run well again
- 6. TREIZE ACTIVE** - A moderate 7th in a Conditions race over 1600m at Cavaillon on 10 May. Has had many opportunities and looks unlikely to trouble the stronger candidates
- 7. NATURALISTE** - A promising 5th in a Conditions race over 2100m at ParisLongchamp. That was a decent debut effort and the form has been franked
- 8. BANSKY** - Unraced 3yo gelding by Galiway out of Dansili mare Balinaise trained by Patrick Monfort. He is related to Gr1 winner Indonesienne.

Summary: STUDY OF CASE (1) has been ultra-consistent in his four races so far and looks ready to notch up his first victory, especially fitted with blinkers this time. BRUNETTE COLEMAN (5) surprised when finishing ahead of the selection in that race and will try to confirm the form. NATURALISTE (7) made her debut in the important Prix de Chaillot and the winner has gone on to capture a Listed race, so the form is strong. CELAGO (4) looks held by the top two selections.

3. ROCQUEMONT - A decent 4th in a Handicap over 2000m at Marseille Borely on 18 May. Has a good record at this course and cannot be ignored

4. BON DERNIER - A moderate 12th over 1400m at Compiegne on 25 April. Will prefer this trip and his last win was at this course

5. GREY TORNADO - Not beaten far when 3rd in a race over 1800m at Madrid in Spain on 17 May. He has had a good start to his career for his new connections and is capable of winning a race of this nature

Summary: A small field but a competitive race. SOUS INFLUENCE (2) won a good race last time and had GRECIAN BONANZA (1) more than four lengths behind him on the sand. The weight difference is only 0.5kg so it favours the former once again ,but they race on turf this time. GREY TORNADO (5) showed up well in Spain last time and has been supplemented into this so deserves respect. ROCQUEMONT (3) has notched up two wins at this course and cannot be ignored.

- 2. UNFURLED** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 2600m on 6 March. Did better over this course and distance before that and can bounce back to score
- 3. CAVANI KAIZEN** - Successful in a handicap at Pau over 2400m on 20 February. Very unreliable but could earn some minor money
- 4. BERLINETTA** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2500m on 30 April. Capable of scoring at best
- 5. BEN DE DIANE** - Has only been modest of late and was 7th in a handicap over this course and distance on 16 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
