

R2 ARGENTAN [R-H]

C1 - PRIX HUBERT BASSOT - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Condition Race - Flat - EUR € 17,500

- **1. MID STAR -** Fair 4th on his only run over 2300m at Durtal on June 9th in a conditions race. Among the leading chances
- **2. MALT -** Gelding by Prince Gibraltar, the dam never ran. Stable runners are well-prepared and are he is expected to play a prominent role. Watch the betting patterns
- **3. MERISIER ROUGE -** Gelding by Joshua Tree, the dam won 3 races. From a good stable that will have this horse nicely tuned. Bold show expected
- **4. MOMENT OPPORTUN -** Unraced gelding by Joshua Tree, the dam won 3 races over jumps. Likely to need this run for experience unless the betting market says otherwise
- **5. ME VOILA LA MOME -** Improved effort to be 2nd at Morlaix over 2600m in a conditions race on June 15th on her latest start. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **6. MERCI GABY** Filly by It's Gino, the dam was placed once in two starts. Should improve for this run and any market support should be informative

Summary: Trainer Daniela Mele saddles two well-bred geldings here, and based on jockey bookings, MERISIER ROUGE (3) looks to be the stable's first string. He's out of a mare who won three races and is likely to be well-prepared for his debut. MALT (2) appears to be the main danger, boasting an appealing profile—any market support would be significant. ME VOILA LA MOME (5) showed notable improvement when runner-up at Morlaix 11 days ago and heads the remainder on known form.

C2 - PRIX DE CHANTILLY - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming - Flat - EUR € 16,000

- **1. ALMACADO GREE -** Placed on all three runs this year, 3rd on the latest over 3200m at Lignieres on April 13th in a Class 4 handicap. Class 3 winner at Saint-Cloud in March. Player
- **2. BLACK HAWK -** Won on his last run over 2500m in a Class 3 claimer at Saint-Cloud on May 19th. One to pay close attention to
- **3. DSCHINGIS RANGER -** He has been 4th on his last two starts, the latter over 2200m at Dieppe in a Class 3 race on June 14th. One to keep onside
- **4. JARRY LORD -** Unplaced last time out over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 race on April 4th. He won two Class 4 races last year in the Autumn. In the mix
- **5. DSCHINGIS ARROW -** Three unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2400m at Nantes on May 22nd in a conditions race. Looks vulnerable
- **6. MOOR MALPIC -** Two unplaced runs this year, the latter in a Class 2 handicap at Angers on May 20th. Capable of a better run, dropping in class
- **7. SPEEDY ANGEL -** 6th on the one run this year over 2500m at Deauville on January 4th in a Class 4 race. Poor form last year, and seems to be out of sorts
- **8. WHISPERING OCEAN -** Out of form with two unplaced efforts this year, well beaten at Loudeac on April 27th in a Class 4 race over 2850m on the last run. Hardly inspiring
- **9. CRYSTAL WINE -** 5th last time, 3rd before that over 2000m in a claimer at Parislongchamp on April 24th in a Class 3 race. Can make the top-three
- **10. SAMBA** Two unplaced efforts since a win over 2400m at Limoges on May 4th in a Class 4 race. Has work to do

Summary: BLACK HAWK (2) arrives in winning form following success in a claimer at Saint-Cloud in May and is taken to follow up in this slightly stronger contest. ALMACADO GREE (1) has been consistent, placing in all three of his starts this year, and commands respect. DSCHINGIS RANGER (3) has shown enough in recent fourth-placed finishes to suggest he's a solid each-way contender. MOOR MALPIC (6), a Class 1 winner last year, takes a notable drop in grade and could be dangerous.

C3 - PRIX DE CRAON - 1900m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming Handicap - Flat - EUR € 12,000

- **1. CISKY -** Recent win at this track over 2100m in a Class 4 handicap on June 4th. Excels at this racecourse
- **2. HEY MAN -** Unplaced last time, 4th previously over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers on May 6th in a Class 4 handicap. Outside place chance
- **3. KALAHARI KING -** 5th on his last run over 1400m at Dieppe on June 14th in a conditions race. Needs to be more reliable
- **4. COLD PLAY -** Three unplaced runs of late, a win before that over 1800m at Evreux on April 15th in a Class 4 race. Can make the top-three
- **5. PIANTARELLA -** Fair effort to be 3rd over 2100m in a Class 4 handicap at this track on June 4th behind CISKY (1) on her latest run. On better terms and can be involved
- **6. RUE DES ORTEAUX -** Five unplaced runs since a win over 2700m at Chantilly in a Class 3 handicap on February 28th. Down in trip is a slight concern, but she has a place ambition
- **7. IT'S ALL A DREAM -** Unplaced last time out, placed on the previous six starts, the latter when 3rd over 2200m at Orleans on June 1st in a Class 4 race. Needs a few to misfire
- **8. CAROLINE BAY -** 5th on the last run at Rostrenen in a Class 4 race on June 7th. Yet to win in 14 attempts
- **9. KOULIKOFF** Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 1800m at Evreux on April 15th in a Class 4 race. Hardly inspiring

Summary: CISKY (1) thrives at this track and arrives in top form after winning a Class 4 handicap over a slightly longer trip earlier this month. She looks capable of following up. PIANTARELLA (5) finished third behind the selection on June 4th and, now meeting her on better terms, could close the gap. COLD PLAY (4) hasn't hit the same heights since scoring at Evreux in April, but is capable of bouncing back. RUE DES ORTEAUX (6) completes the shortlist and shouldn't be underestimated.

C4 - PRIX DE CAGNES-SUR-MER - 1300m (a6f1/2) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 12,000

- **1. TOOGOODTOBEROOD -** 5th on the last run over 1350m at Cholet in a handicap on June 2nd. Won a maiden on the PSF and has placed form in a handicap in March. Drop in class
- **2. GALLIUS -** Several unplaced runs recently, the latter over 1400m in a claimer at Compiegne on June 16th. Others preferred
- **3. MONARCH HUNZA -** Three unplaced runs since a 4th over 1300m at Deauville on January 3rd in a handicap. Can be competitive
- **4. STAY AROUND -** Fair 3rd on the last run over 1600m at Newcastle (UK) on March 20th in a Class 6 handicap. French bow and warrants respect
- **5. MABREGA -** 7th on her sole start over 1600m at Craon on June 11th in a maiden race. Looks vulnerable
- **6. SPICHOPE** Won over 1300m in a claimer at this track on June 4th. Can give a good account of herself
- **7. WESTMINSTER FOX -** Credible 4th in a claimer over track and trip on June 4th behind SPICHOPE (6) on her last run. Each way angle
- **8. AWAY WITH RUM -** Two unplaced runs so far, well beaten in a claimer at Dieppe on June 14th over 1800m on the latest. Pass over
- **9. BELVEDERE PALACE -** Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 1100m at Le Croise-Laroche on May 18th in a maiden race. Player
- **10. WIXON'S MEMORY -** Four unplaced runs this year, 7th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud on June 13th on her latest run. Look for an alternative
- **11. ESTAFETTE -** Three unplaced runs of late, 8th at Dax on June 9th in a claimer on her latest. Unlikely to threaten
- **12. MAMINOA -** Five unplaced runs this year, 5th over 1100m in a maiden at Dieppe on June 7th on the latest start. Hard to fancy
- **13. MAGIC IS MAGIC -** Two unplaced runs in October last year, 3rd before that in a maiden on September 15th at Le Lion D'Angers. Might need this run after an absence

Summary: TOOGOODTOBEROOD (1) takes a drop in grade following a respectable fifth in a Cholet handicap 24 days ago and should be competitive in this claimer. SPICHOPE (6) impressed when scoring over 1300m at this track in a similar contest and poses a definite threat. WESTMINSTER FOX (7) was fourth in that same event and holds each-way claims. BELVEDERE PALACE (9) ran a strong second in a maiden two starts ago and could sneak into the placings again.

C5 - PRIX DU MENIL-FROGER - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 11,500

- **1. SUNBEAM -** Placed on his last three starts, the latter over 3000m at Craon on June 11th in a Class 4 handicap. Key chance
- **2. MAESTRO CHOP -** Two unplaced runs of late, 3rd before that over 2500m at Le Croise-Laroche in a Class 4 handicap on May 18th. Merits consideration
- **3. HYGROVE BEC -** Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 1800m at Morlaix in a Class 4 race on May 11th. Enters calculations
- **4. PENNYWELL -** Five unplaced efforts of late, the most recent over 3000m at Parislongchamp on June 5th in a Class 4 handicap. Has work to do
- **5. ECLAIR DE VATI -** 6th last time, 3rd before that over 2650m at Chateaubriant in a Class 4 handicap on May 12th. One to keep onside
- **6. SOURCE YVETTE -** Unplaced last time, 4th previously over 2700m at Orleans in a Class 4 race on June 1st. Not reliable
- **7. GOT SHINE -** Fair 4th two runs back over 2600m at Plestin on May 18th in a Class 4 race. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **8. ALF A STAR -** Four unplaced efforts of late, the latter over 2400m at Le Lion D'Angers on June 8th in a Class 4 handicap. Looks elsewhere
- **9. NATHEPOLO -** Four unplaced runs recently, the latter over 3100m at Pornichet on November 23rd in a Class 4 handicap. Hard to recommend
- **10. COCO LIGHT** Fair 4th over 2400m at Pornichet on March 26th in a Class 4 handicap on his last start. Place contender
- **11. SOTCHI -** Several unplaced runs this year, the latter over 3000m at Craon on June 11th in a Class 4 handicap. Others rate higher
- **12. GRAND YAKA -** No worthwhile form of late, well beaten at this track in a Class 4 handicap on October 9th over 2100m on the latest start. Has an absence to overcome and is out of form
- **13. MOUNKA -** Several unplaced runs, well beaten in a Class 4 race at Erbray on June 22nd on the last start. One to avoid

Summary: SUNBEAM (1) has been in good shape with three placed efforts, the latest over 3000m at Craon when third in a Class 4 handicap. He looks ready to win. ECLAIR DE VATI (5) has eased in the handicap and was a credible third at Chateaubriant in early May on his penultimate start. He is the most likely threat to the selection. GOT SHINE (7) is one for the each-way backers to look at. MAESTRO CHOP (2) tends to blow hot and cold but is worth a mention.

C6 - PRIX DE NONANT-LE-PIN - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 13,000

- **1. SEMEUR -** Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1900m at Deauville on April 8th in a Class 3 handicap. Others rate higher
- **2. DREAM ANGEL** 7th last time, 2nd before that over 2400m at Lyon Parilly on May 17th in a Class 4 handicap. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **3. ON A SOUFFERT -** Credible 4th over 2500m at this track on June 4th in a conditions race last time out. One to pay attention to
- **4. DSCHINGIS ANGEL -** Fair 2nd over 2850m at Rostrenen on the last run in a Class 4 race on June 8th. Outside place contender
- **5. PRINCE SHALAA -** Nice 3rd over 3000m at Parislongchamp on June 5th in a Class 3 handicap and a win at Vitteaux over 2600m in mid-May. Leading chance
- **6. STRIVER -** Unplaced last time, 4th previously over 2600m in a Class 4 race at Morlaix on May 11th. Needs a personal best to win
- **7. PUERTA DEL SOL -** Two unplaced efforts of late, 3rd before that over 2100m at Mons-Ghlin (BEL) in a conditions race on April 14th. Hard to fancy
- **8. AMICIS -** 4th at Rostrenen over 2200m in a Class 4 race on June 8th last time. Might need a few to misfire
- **9. HAMILTON DESJY -** Placed on all four runs this year, 2nd on the latter over 3000m at Parislongchamp on June 5th in a Class 4 handicap. Player
- **10. ARMORIGENE** Two unplaced efforts since a 3rd over 3100m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 handicap on April 18th. Down in trip but has decent form over this distance
- **11. MY DARLING -** Fair 7th at over 3000m at Parislongchamp on June 5th in a Class 4 handicap and placed four times before that. In the mix
- **12. PRINCEDESCHAMPS -** Five unplaced runs this year, the latter over 2100m at Argentan on June 4th in a Class 4 race. Place chance
- **13. LORD SPIRIT -** 7th last time over 2500m at Le Croise-Laroche on May 18th in a Class 4 handicap. Needs to bounce back to form
- **14. RUE DE VOLGA -** Three unplaced runs this year, well beaten at Le Croise-Laroche on May 18th in a Class 4 handicap last time. Look elsewhere

Summary: PRINCE SHALAA (5) arrives in good form, including a victory at Vitteaux in mid-May over 2600m, and looks poised to strike again. He's narrowly preferred over the consistent HAMILTON DESJY (9), who has hit the frame in all four starts this year and is knocking on the door for a win. ARMORIGENE (10) drops back to a more suitable trip and appeals as an each-way contender. MY DARLING (11) is another with solid place claims and shouldn't be left out of the multiples.

C7 - PRIX DE CLAIREFEUILLE - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,000

- **1. AGELKA -** Three unplaced runs recently, the latter over 2400m at Pornichet in a Class 4 race on February 13th. Looks vulnerable
- **2. MURANO** Several unplaced runs since a win in early April over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap. Poor latest show at this track over 2100m on June 4th. Out of form and is best watched
- **3. JANISA BERE -** Two good wins this year, the latest over 2100m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on June 4th. She should be fine over this extra distance and can score
- **4. ZELINA -** Four unplaced efforts this year, 6th on the latest at this track over 2100m in a Class 4 handicap on June 4th. Not beaten far last time and she is well treated at the moment
- **5. MINNATA -** 7th last time, 3rd before that over 2400m at Nantes in a Class 4 race on May 5th. Lightly raced and has more improvement
- **6. TORTOLA -** Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 2100m at Saint-Cloud on May 23rd in a Class 3 handicap. Each way angle
- **7. LA FOUINE -** Four average performances this year, 7th at Nancy on May 20th in a Class 4 handicap on the latest. Unlikely to feature
- **8. AND WE DANCED -** Three unplaced efforts since a win over track and trip on April 9th in a Class 4 handicap. Better run expected on a track she is proven on
- **9. QATAR RIVER -** Several unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2100m at this track on June 4th in a Class 4 handicap. Makes little appeal
- **10. PREMIERE ETOILE -** 8th last time, 2nd before that over 2500m at Le Croise-Laroche on May 18th in a Class 4 handicap. In the mix
- **11. LADY STRAIGHT -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 3100m at Nantes on May 5th in a Class 4 handicap. Down in trip but is versatile and can make the frame
- **12. PELOTE BASC -** Five unplaced runs this year, the latest when 5th at Orleans on June 1st in a Class 4 race. Look for a better option
- **13. LILY MORIVIERE -** Has failed to feature in six runs so far, the latter over track and trip in a conditions race on June 4th. Opposable
- **14. SPINNING MIST -** Several unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2100m in a Class 3 handicap at Parislongchamp on June 19th. Can be avoided

Summary: JANISA BERE (3) is in excellent form, having won both starts this year—the latest in a Class 4 handicap over this track on June 4th. She looks well placed to complete the hat-trick. ZELINA (4) has slipped to a workable mark and ran respectably when sixth here 22 days ago; she's capable of giving the selection a real challenge. TORTOLA (6) shaped well when fourth in a Class 3 at Saint-Cloud two starts back and makes appeal each-way. PREMIERE ETOILE (10) also warrants a mention.

C8 - PRIX TREMPOLINO - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,000

- **1. FAR L'AMORE -** Won on his last run over 2500m at this track in a conditions race on June 4th. Hard to ignore and can be involved
- **2. MAIZIERES** 6th on the one run this year over 1700m at Pornichet on January 7th in a Class 3 race. Absent for 5 months and has been out of form
- **3. GLACIER PEAK -** 5th on the last two runs, the most recent over 2400m in a Class 4 claimer at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 22nd. Unlikely to feature
- **4. KING MOTIF** Two unplaced runs since a win over 2500m at Argentan on April 26th in a Class 4 handicap on April 9th. Each way angle
- **5. MISSRIYA -** Cedible 6th at Le Lion D'Angers on June 8th in a Class 4 handicap over 2400m. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **6. NATH SHOW -** 4th on the last two runs, the most recent over 2500m at Saint-Cloud on June 13th in a Class 4 race. Respect
- **7. LE GAST -** 4th last time, a win before that over 2500m at Deauville on January 4th in a Class 4 race. Can make the frame
- **8. STILYKER -** Two unplaced runs this year, well beaten at Parislongchamp on June 5th in a Class 3 race last time. Look for an alternative
- **9. VIANETA -** Four unplaced runs of late, the latest over 2400m in a claimer on December 29th on the PSF. Opposable
- **10. PRINCESS KARA -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 2650m in a Class 4 handicap at Chateubriant on May 12th. One to keep safe
- **11. UM ELNADIM -** Fair 4th last time out at Parislongchamp in a Class 3 handicap on June 5th over 3000m and a win before that in May at Chateaubriant. Live chance
- **12. GOGO DU BREUIL -** 6th on the one start this year over 1900m at Deauville on January 23rd in a Class 3 handicap. Pass over
- **13. LADY DU SAPHIR -** 5th on the last run over 2850m at Rostrenen in a Class 4 race on June 8th. Others appeal more
- **14. GARUDA -** Four unplaced runs so far, the latter when 7th at Dieppe on June 14th in a conditions race over 2200m. Little to recommend

Summary: UM ELNADIM (11) could be the answer to this open handicap. She arrives after two solid efforts, a win two runs back at Chateaubriant in May and a pleasing fourth at Parislongchamp earlier this month on the latest. FAR L'AMORE (1) will be full of confidence after success at this track in a conditions race on June 4th and rates as the main danger. KING MOTIF (4) won over track and trip three runs back, and if replicating that effort, he can not be ruled out. MISSRIYA (5) heads the rest.

C1 - PRIX COMPAGNIE FIDUCIAIRE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- **1. TZAREKOV** Dam was unraced and this colt comes from a yard that are thriving at the moment and doing well with young horses. Include in the play
- **2. SAIF AL LEITH -** This son of Sands Of Mali could be absolutely anything on debut and is one to keep an eye on. Trainer is operating at a 8.8% win strike rate
- **3. LE LEGIONNAIRE -** Dam remained a maiden and this colt is unlikely to pose a threat on debut. Hard to recommend
- **4. ROCKONADO -** Dam was unraced and this colt doesn't make much appeal in black and white. The market will be our best guide
- **5. OTHON -** Dam remained a maiden but this colt hails from a yard that can ready them up on debut. Bears close watching
- **6. KODVEDEV -** Dam won three times from 1700m 2200m and this colt is likely looking for further. Others preferred
- **7. CAPITOL HILL -** Dam won twice over 1500m/1600m and this newcomer is likely to need the experience first up. Would be a surprise winner
- **8. ALL IN PINK -** Dam was a maiden but this son of Zelzal could be ready to make an impression on debut. Trainer has had success with two year old's
- **9. CIAO NENE -** Dam won once over 1200m in Germany and this colt doesn't jump off the page. One to pass by

Summary: In a race for unraced young two year old's where there's very little to work with, a chance is taken on SAIF AL LEITH (2) to strike on debut. He gets the services of Maxime Guyon which signals intent and could be one worth following. ALL IN PINK (8) will be suited by this trip on debut and should be in with a chance if not too green. TZAREKOV (1) represents a trainer that has proven more than capable with young horses and he is one to monitor. OTHON (5) is from an in form yard and can go well at the first time of asking.

C2 - PRX HOLIDAY INN EXPRESS ARCACHON - LA TESTE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- **1. CHARME LA VIE -** This daughter of War Command doesn't make any appeal on paper and is best watched. Would be a surprise winner
- **2. NEPETA -** Dam performed well over ground and this newcomer doesn't appear to be suited by this trip. Follow only if there's market confidence
- **3. PINK PARADISE -** Dam was unraced but this filly makes plenty appeal on her bloodline. Trainer is operating at a 21% win strike rate
- **4. LA MARITZA -** Dam raced three times without any success and this filly appears to be the second string from the yard. Include in bets
- **5. MENGANA -** Dam failed to do much and this daughter Goken could need the experience. One to pass by
- **6. NUENCE'K** Dam won five times from 1000m 1400m and this filly could be one to keep on the safe side. Trainer has a 14% win strike rate
- **7. DINER EN VILLE -** This daughter of Study the man doesn't make much appeal in black and white and could need the outing. Appears to be the second choice
- **8. SHOWCASE -** Dam won once over 1800m and this filly hails from a yard that have had success with two year old's this year. Trainer is operating at a 15% win strike rate
- **9. PREMIERA -** Dam failed to rip up any trees but she gets the services of Mikael Barzalona which jumps off the page. Follow the market
- **10. YAGGERA** This filly hails from a yard that aren't known for debut winners and is likely to need a few educational runs. Easy to pass by
- **11. BAYS OF NAPLES -** Dam won once over 1900m and this young filly could be wanting further in time to come. Others make more appeal
- **12. SCHIZZO -** Dam went hurdling without any success and this filly could need time and more ground. Hard to fancy
- **13. ZANINA -** Dam won twice over 1200m and this filly hails from a yard that are more than capable of getting them ready to debut. Include in the play

Summary: PINK PARADISE (3) is a filly who could be worth following with keen interest should she deliver in this contest. She has a nice pedigree and could know the business on debut. ZANINA (13) ticks a few boxes on debut and with Maxime Guyon in the irons, that just indicates that she could be useful. SHOWCASE (8) is an interesting newcomer given that she could be looking for a touch further but could be forward enough to run well on debut. LA MARITZA (4) comes from a powerful yard and if there's any market confidence behind her, she needs to be respected.
