

RACE 1 8:15 PM | \$400,000 | **PARISLONGCHAMP** | 1400m

4	BEAUVATIER (FR)	Superb colt that has yet to be fully tested. Keeps getting better and looks set to secure a maiden Group 1.
2	ROSALLION (IRE)	Has looked a very good colt to date. Caught the eye last time out and has a realistic chance of finishing close.
11	NATIVE AMERICAN (IRE)	Improving colt that trounced the opposition at the Curragh last time out. Steps up in class but looks good enough to do well under these conditions.
8	EVADE (FR)	Handy individual that pleased behind the favourite here early last month. Little chance of winning but can still get in on the action.
1	ZABIARI	Another fine Aga Khan colt with impeccable credentials. Drops back in trip after winning the Prix des Chênes in good order and must be afforded significant respect.

RACE 2 8:50 PM | \$400,000 | **PARISLONGCHAMP** | 1600m

9	OPERA SINGER (USA)	Good class of filly that gave us a taste of her future with an excellent success at the Curragh late August and will be a tough nut to crack if she replicates that performance.
3	ROSE BLOOM (IRE)	Facile winner of both starts to date. Is a filly with tons of progress in her and is not incapable of maintaining her unbeaten status.
7	DARNATION (IRE)	Quality element that just keeps getting better. Secured a Doncaster Gr.3 with ease recently and will have her chances.
6	RIBALTAGAIA (USA)	Sensational on her debut early last month. Has earned the right to take her chances here and must be respected.
4	LES PAVOTS (IRE)	Has come on leaps and bounds during the summer. Opened her black-type account smartly at Deauville last time out and is good enough to finish in the thick of things.

RACE 3 9:25 PM | \$1,000,000 | **PARISLONGCHAMP** | 2000m

7	AL GHADEER (FR)	Al Mourtajez colt out of Gharraa.
5	FIRST CLASS (USA)	Dahess gelding out of Toppoftheclass.
3	MOSHRIF (FR)	Consistent servant that finished 4th in the race of reference and, with form maintained, can make the frame this time.
10	AL DOHA	Decent filly that has already proven her Gr.1 credentials. Impressive over this distance and again looks a decent candidate for a place on the podium.
4	CH'ENZA (FR)	Remarkably regular sort that won at this level over track and trip earlier in the year. Is clearly in shape and can pleasantly surprise.

RACE 4 10:05 PM | \$5,000,000 | **PARISLONGCHAMP** | 2400m

13	ACE IMPACT (IRE)	Unbeaten in five starts and highly impressive in Prix du Jockey-Club. Got straight down to business on re-entry mid-August and would not be here if he couldn't get 2400m. The horse to beat.
6	WESTOVER	Quality English-trained middle-distance horse. Flew up in Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud before going down by just a head to HUKUM (7) at Ascot. Has a good draw and can again go close.
7	HUKUM (IRE)	One of the best older horses in the UK. Beat WESTOVER (6) in King George and, while no 6 year-old has ever won the Arc, he could prove the exception.
4	SIMCA MILLE (IRE)	One of the most consistent horses in the field. Twice Gr.1 runner-up before landing the big prize in Germany mid-August. Should thrive over this ground and looks a player.
11	MR HOLLYWOOD (IRE)	2nd in German Derby then close runner-up to Zagrey in Grosser Preis von Baden. Short on experience but has bags of ability and, like past German Arc winners, is eminently capable of springing a surprise.
