

**RACE 1** 10:42 PM | \$12,000 | **PORNICHET** | 2400m

1	<b>MARSHALL LESSING</b>	Thrives at this track/PSF and, despite indifferent performances recently, retains the means to win a race of this nature. Keep safe.
2	<b>BOKEN (FR)</b>	Consistent sort in good form and physical condition. Has often performed well at this venue, so is a candidate for success.
13	<b>NAMAR</b>	Average effort last start when 8th from 16 runners and beaten 4.31 lengths over 2000m. Expect to improve here.
4	<b>BEAUFOUR (FR)</b>	Has made two comeback appearances after a lengthy absence and is likely to regain momentum sooner rather than later. Dark horse.
8	<b>MARANGES (FR)</b>	Daughter of Castle Du Berlais from Lagatera (fr) on debut.

**RACE 2** 11:17 PM | \$16,000 | **PORNICHET** | 3100m

3	<b>FOREST OF WISDOM</b>	Confirmed at this track and has already proven effective on this surface. Was a reassuring 2nd last time so has a winning chance here on that evidence.
1	<b>PIRIAC (FR)</b>	Has not raced since finishing 6 out of 6 runners over 175 days ago. Watch betting.
2	<b>LE PETIT GEGENE (FR)</b>	Has rarely disappointed at this course, which he knows very well. Ought to make his presence felt here.
4	<b>ROMANELLO (FR)</b>	Narrowly beaten last start when only 0.12 lengths over 2400m. Big chance to score here.
5	<b>ZOOM CHOP (FR)</b>	Maintained a good level of form and consistency before his recent failure (9th). Cannot be hastily condemned.

**RACE 3** 11:52 PM | \$12,500 | **PORNICHET** | 1700m

4	<b>SAILORS DELIGHT (FR)</b>	Has the apprentice jockey claims.
1	<b>RECONNECT (IRE)</b>	Average effort last start when 5th from 7 runners and beaten 4.25 lengths over 1600m. Expect to improve here.
7	<b>AZIMA (FR)</b>	Did not go unnoticed when 7th in a handicap at Chantilly recently. Not taken lightly here on that form.
12	<b>BARONCINA (FR)</b>	Should resurface sooner rather than later off her current mark. Dark horse.
5	<b>BURLINGTON ARCADE</b>	Was 8th on debut and improved to finish 6th subsequently. Should have more to offer, so may get into the picture.

**RACE 4** 12:27 AM | \$15,000 | **PORNICHET** | 1700m

3	<b>ALESSANDRO (FR)</b>	Better run last start, beaten 1.44 lengths into over 2000m. Genuine chance on the back of the last effort.
1	<b>CREW DRAGON (FR)</b>	Narrowly beaten last start when only 0.06 lengths over 1600m. Big chance to score here.
8	<b>THE CHARMER (FR)</b>	Drawn well and has the apprentice jockey claims. Will be handy.
2	<b>MEMORY DREAM (FR)</b>	Was not disgraced in a competitive field on PSF at Chantilly last time. Will be competitive, at least for the places.
9	<b>CHAMPY CHARM (FR)</b>	Finished 5th in both outings last year and is open to improvement on his reappearance. Not to be underestimated.

**RACE 5** 1:02 AM | \$19,000 | **PORNICHET** | 2100m

7	<b>IPPLING (FR)</b>	Winner of last two starts and is a big chance to make it 3 in a row.
2	<b>CORDEY ROSE (FR)</b>	Inconsistent of late but is a capable mare who has dropped to a competitive mark. Must be taken seriously.
1	<b>KINGDOM (FR)</b>	Performs well on PSF and has faced tougher opponents this year. Ought to fare better in a race of this nature.
3	<b>BOROVSK (FR)</b>	Was a winner two starts back and showed he remains competitive when finishing 4th last time, in a race he ought to have achieved a better result. Keep safe.
15	<b>SPRINGBOKS</b>	Consistent performer with sound form references and a proven record at this venue. A candidate for the places.

**RACE 6** 1:38 AM | \$16,000 | **PORNICHET** | 2100m

13	<b>PENNBLE (FR)</b>	Narrowly beaten last start when only 0.75 lengths over 2000m. Big chance to score here.
1	<b>BAFANA LINNGARI (FR)</b>	Didn't inspire again last start, beaten 12.62 lengths over 2000m. Better than recent runs suggest.
4	<b>PREMIERE ETOILE (FR)</b>	Has the apprentice jockey claims.
7	<b>LE BOLERO (FR)</b>	Better run last start, beaten 2.50 lengths into over 2000m. Genuine chance on the back of the last effort.
6	<b>HEY MAN (FR)</b>	Average effort last start when 6th from 10 runners and beaten 4.38 lengths over 2000m. Expect to improve here.
