

RACE 1 5:37 PM | \$12,500 | **SALON-DE-PROVENCE** | 1100m

4	GOGOKA (FR)	Unplaced in a conditions race last time but did finish runner-up at this level previously. Will have a role to play.
1	CUNCERTA (FR)	Inconsistent filly but has the means to be competitive in her first start at this level. Ran her best race at this course.
2	OVER CHOPE (FR)	Has yet to spark the necessary improvement in better races/company but should fare better with her sights lowered now in a claiming race.
3	SANTA VANILLA (FR)	Inconsistent filly but is confirmed at this level and undeniably capable of having a say here. Keep safe.
6	HAMIDA FILIES (FR)	Could get into the picture here.

RACE 2 6:07 PM | \$20,000 | **SALON-DE-PROVENCE** | 1100m

4	QUEEN KAHINA (USA)	Quick filly who has already proven her competitiveness in handicaps at this level off her current mark. Winning chance.
3	MGHEERA	Has revealed her quality on several occasions in maiden races this year and should hold her own in handicaps of this type.
5	RISE ABOVE (FR)	Distance suited and confirmed in handicaps at this value. Should have a role to play in a race of this nature.
2	GIORGIANA (FR)	Was not disgraced in finishing 5th last time after consecutive victories. Should have a role to play.
7	GO JOHNNY GO GO GO	Performed very well in handicaps at this level during the first half of the year. Ought to have a say here.

RACE 3 6:37 PM | \$22,000 | **SALON-DE-PROVENCE** | 2400m

5	AMELIELYMPIQUE (IRE)	Talented filly, absent since for nigh on four months but did win easily at this level earlier this year so should be competitive on her return.
4	SANTHIA (FR)	Has made constant progress since the spring and should appreciate this step up to this distance. Leading light.
1	BEAUTIFUL MEMORY (FR)	Consistent filly with solid form references, including two wins over this 2400m distance. Ought to be competitive.
2	AIXELLENCE (FR)	Won a maiden race three starts back but has finished unplaced in both subsequent outings. Must reaffirm.
3	ROUGE (FR)	Won back-to-back outings before finishing 7th last time out. Capable of better.

RACE 4 7:27 PM | \$12,000 | **SALON-DE-PROVENCE** | 2400m

3	BREIZH WOOD (FR)	Ought to have a say in the finish with a repeat of last performance.
2	LE TROPIC (IRE)	Has won a claiming race and finished 2nd as well as 4th in three starts at this level. High on the shortlist.
5	ALLEZ LULU (FR)	Holding form in handicaps but with little margin at this value. Ought to fare better in a claiming race now.
4	STRATUS	Will be a factor with any improvement.
7	LE DRAKKAR (FR)	Al Wukair filly out of Screen Icon.

RACE 5 8:02 PM | \$23,000 | **SALON-DE-PROVENCE** | 1800m

2	BACK IN PARIS	Saxon Warrior colt out of Sign Of Life.
10	NOVA KEN (FR)	Kendargent filly out of Charly Nova.
8	WIKENDA (FR)	Panis filly out of Wikita.
3	PARADISE STORM (FR)	Masked Marvel colt out of Holystorm.
1	LUCKY BERE (FR)	Seahenge colt out of Niska.

RACE 6 8:37 PM | \$17,000 | **SALON-DE-PROVENCE** | 2000m

3	NEW RULER (FR)	Well-born colt who got off to a promising (2nd) start when finishing ahead of several more-experienced rivals. One to beat.
2	GOLDEN CITY (FR)	Runner-up in his last two starts, this consistent colt trained by Jean-Claude Rouget will not be winning out of turn.
5	SKATHI (GER)	Consistent since the start of the year and boasts solid form references. This trip (2000m) will be right up his alley.
7	GIMANZOR (FR)	Almanzor gelding out of Toungi.
6	LAST STICK (FR)	Johnny Barnes gelding out of Slipstick.

RACE 7 9:12 PM | \$13,000 | **SALON-DE-PROVENCE** | 2000m

1	MOUTRAKI (IRE)	In 11 races at Salon-de-Provence he finished in the top four nine times, including four successes. In good form of late and can follow up in this claimer.
8	SECRET FEELING (FR)	On a long losing streak but was runner-up the last time she was seen in a claimer. Can go one better this time.
2	THE MANAGER (FR)	Has run well twice at this course but has been disappointing of late. Capable of bouncing back to win.
3	GOOD QUESTION	Disappointing form of late and his last win was on the PSF but he should be right there at the finish if finding his best form.
5	ASPEN (FR)	Could earn some money.

RACE 8 9:47 PM | \$12,000 | **SALON-DE-PROVENCE** | 2000m

5	FORCE TRANQUILLE (FR)	Showed improvement when runner-up last time out and can go one better in this small field.
3	STAR DRACK (IRE)	Well tried this year with a win in March but has only been modest of late. He does have a winning chance in this line-up.
2	SADARAK	On a long losing streak. Drop in distance could spark improvement and is not out of it in this line-up.
7	AIRA (FR)	Could finish in the money again.
4	GOLDEN BEACH	Did better in France last year and he could be the surprise package of the race.
