

TIP SHEET

FRANCE - 21st September 2021

R1 - NANTES | 17:50 | EUR €18,000 | PRIX DES ESPOIRS

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| 1 | WASSIM | Pushed forward on debut last start and boxed on well but found a couple better over 1800m at Evreux. Same rider Soufiane Saadi aboard again. Solid top-three chance. |
| 5 | LITTLE WONDER | Yet to fill a placing in two career runs and was well beaten last time when 7 lengths back in fifth over 1400m at Deauville. Open to plenty of improvement and could feature in the finish. |
| 3 | SPEEDY CHARM | Has ability and is racing well with three minor placings from five starts. Finished fifth at his most recent appearance over 1400m at Le Lion-D'angers. Ready to break through. |
| 7 | PORTBAIL | Was safely held on debut last start when sixth and beaten 10 lengths over 1600m at Deauville. Will take a lot from that hitout. Expected to be in the finish. |
| 11 | MARGESSON | Finished 7 lengths back in sixth on debut over 1300m at Deauville last start. Others rate better. |

R2 - NANTES | 18:20 | EUR €15,000 | PRIX MELLINET

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| 4 | CHUBASCO | Had been working up to a win and it came last start over 1800m at Clairefontaine. Chances enhanced by drawing a nice marble. |
| 2 | JACQUES COEUR | Ran a better race last start to finish second at Craon over 1650m. Will need further improvement to trouble these. |
| 1 | BLACK MORNING | Won three times earlier on in her prep, most recently finished fifth beaten 4 lengths at Longchamp over 1850m. Her best is good enough. |
| 3 | JAAYIZ | Recent form has been good including a win most recently over 1900m at Deauville All Weather after a sound second two starts back. Draws well in barrier three. One of the main chances. |
| 10 | ANDINO | Has been out of the money recently including last start when ninth over 1500m at Deauville All Weather three-and-a-half weeks ago, beaten 5 lengths. Will need to do a bit more. |

R3 - NANTES | 18:50 | EUR €16,000 | PRIX DE LA BAIE DE BOURGNEUF

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| 2 | PEDRO DES DUCS | Stepped up in trip last start and failed to finish the race off when sixth over 2900m at Clairefontaine. Should appreciate the step back in journey this time. |
| 4 | MILLENIAL | Turned in a better run last time out when third over 2400m at Vittel, beaten 2.75 lengths. Cannot be disregarded. |
| 1 | IRISH SOUL | Far from disgraced when fourth at Saint-Jean-De-Monts last start after finishing third two runs back at Rochefort-Sur-Loire. Up in trip and is worth some thought. |
| 9 | PANTHERE | Well in the market last but ran well below best when a 21 length sixth over 2800m at Moulins. Rates highly here and may be worth another chance. |
| 12 | ILE DU ROUME | Unraced filly by Montmartre out of Conakry. From the in-form Joel Boissard stable. Profiles well and is worth keep safe. |

R4 - NANTES | 19:25 | EUR €14,000 | PRIX DE LA COTE D'AMOUR

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| 4 | FLIGHT DE JUILLEY | Won first up at Deauville All Weather but couldn't go on with it when fourth at Longchamp last time out. Gets chance to bounce back. |
| 9 | LEE DRAGON | Six-year-old gelding who drops in journey from the last start when second over 2700m at Les Sables-D'olonne, finishing 1.5 lengths off the winner. Key runner. |
| 5 | REBEL QUEEN | Has been knocking on the door including a last start second over 2500m at Evreux when only 2.5 lengths from the winner. Has ability and is one of the chances. |
| 3 | STROMBOLI | Won two starts ago then back to earth last time when sixth over 2250m at Longchamp. Has ability and is solid top-three hope. |
| 2 | STADE VELODROME | Not a prolific winner with just three victories from 44 starts. Last start finished third over 2200m at Craon. Has ability and is one of the chances. |

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| 9 | NEVER COME BACK | Won two starts back at this track then finished third last time out over 2400m at Clairefontaine. Will need to do a bit more. |
| 7 | HYSTERIQUE | Has struggled in recent runs including last time out when fourth over 2400m at Clairefontaine three-and-a-half weeks ago, beaten 6 lengths. Prefer to see her back in form. |
| 1 | IRISH STORM | Narrowly beaten last time when second at Le Lion-D'angers, finishing just a nose from the winner. In the mix again. |
| 3 | VANCOUVER DU GUERN | Five-year-old gelding who drops in trip from the last start when second over 2700m at Les Sables-D'olonne, finishing a nose off the winner. Can improve enough to take this out. |
| 6 | ROCK OR BUST | Got home by 2 lengths at Saint Malo two starts ago. Disappointed last time at Saint Malo when 13 lengths from the winner in fourth. Hard to fault if at his best. |
