

**RACE 1 10:55 AM | \$42,000 | GOSFORD | 1000m**

1	<b>PRIZE WRITER</b>	Trials (5:2-1-0). Worked impressively towards her career opener at the trials. Mollie Fitzgerald sticks from latest trial and takes a 1.5kg claim. Can make a winning debut.
8	<b>TAMPA BAY</b>	Wasn't beaten far at Scone over this distance. Can be thereabouts.
5	<b>LOVE YOU ANYWAY</b>	On a quick back-up. Well back and made some minor headway but passing mainly tired rivals to finish 6.1 lengths 4th at Newcastle. Makes a strong case in this company.
6	<b>MISS IMMY</b>	Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Goulburn. Each-way.
2	<b>MAXIMUM RIDE</b>	First-up (23-weeks). Recent trial winner. Usually gets back. Can be thereabouts.

**RACE 2 11:30 AM | \$42,000 | GOSFORD | 2100m**

2	<b>MY GREEK GOD</b>	Ran a cracking race when just edged out at Scone Oct 24. Highly rated in this line-up.
4	<b>ANULFA</b>	Form reads well for this. Forwardly placed, continued to stick on for third Plate (C1) at Canberra. Leads, handy. Key player.
3	<b>THE STARS ALIGN</b>	Third outing for new trainer/ this region. Cleared maiden ranks at Canberra Oct 10. Gave good account when 1.3 lengths 4th at Canberra second-up at blow-out odds. Among the dangers.
1	<b>JUAN PABLO</b>	Very tame performance at Hawkesbury second-up as an odds drifter. Minor money hope at best.
9	<b>LIYAH'S GIRL</b>	Narrow miss in the Plate (C1) at Canberra Oct 24. Can figure.

**RACE 3 12:05 PM | \$45,000 | GOSFORD | 1200m**

2	<b>OAKFIELD SATURN</b>	Ran home into the minors 3yo+ Midway Hcp (C1) at Newcastle when off an extended spell. Second time at 1200m suggest she is ready to peak. Fitter second-up. Drawn to receive every chance.
5	<b>ROMAN FORUM</b>	Failed to run on in the small field at Newcastle in only her second race appearance. Ticks the track and distance win box. Nice gate. Each-way.
1	<b>JAMAIS</b>	No match but kept on solidly for third at Hawkesbury. Could get into the placings.
4	<b>CALL ME SASSY</b>	Recorded a hard fought win at Hawkesbury when in the market at her second race start. Among the dangers.
6	<b>MATCHSTICKS</b>	Worked across into prominent position and found plenty for 1.7 lengths victory at Canberra Oct 24. A J Calder retains the ride. Can challenge.

**RACE 4 12:40 PM | \$60,000 | GOSFORD | 1200m**

6	<b>HEREWARD</b>	Returns for second campaign (25-weeks). Will have matured over the break. Indicated some potential placing at both his starts in first campaign. Just missed at Hawkesbury May 3. Trialled well for return.
2	<b>FUADEE</b>	Signalled some ability on debut and sure to be improved by the experience. Right in the mix.
5	<b>GOOD HOTSPUR</b>	First-up (33-weeks). Will have matured further but wasn't pushed out in latest trial. Expecting a prominent showing fresh in this line-up.
3	<b>COMPOSED</b>	Supported in early runs. Got back, ran on late with purpose to claim second at Hawkesbury in only his second race appearance. Fitter, open to improvement up in distance. Each-way.
4	<b>EXCEEDING LIMITS</b>	Put in some big strides late to place at Newcastle at first run for new trainer at a mammoth price. Could surprise.

**RACE 5** 1:15 PM | \$45,000 | **GOSFORD** | 1600m

10	<b>SLAM DUNK</b>	Tame to line in small field at Hawkesbury at this trip. Drawn favourably and under less weight. Won't need to improve much to test these.
1	<b>RIDGEBACK</b>	Posted some decent efforts from three appearances. Left in winner's wake but trudged home for the minors at Hawkesbury last start. Makes a strong case in this company.
3	<b>BOHEMIAN ART</b>	Strong SP profile. Failed to run on in the small field at Hawkesbury first up. Looking for this trip now. Fitter second-up.
2	<b>PHOENIX LEGEND</b>	Last couple encouraging. Went close at Kembla Grange two back. Ran on soundly into third in the small field at Queanbeyan. Warrants attention.
7	<b>BONDI BLOSSOM</b>	Sent forward but flat-footed when things got serious at Kembla Grange at this distance. Rough place prospect.

**RACE 6** 1:50 PM | \$42,000 | **GOSFORD** | 1600m

6	<b>EMBALLEE</b>	Rounded them up smartly in the small field at Hawkesbury over this distance. Drawn to effect. Strikes another winnable race.
4	<b>INVASIVE DREAMS</b>	Led, gave away under pressure to cross the line 3.2 lengths 5th at Randwick. Placed to much greater effect here.
3	<b>JACENZA</b>	Pressed forward and kept on determinedly at Scone at this distance. Draws to do no work. Easier here. Hard fit and warrants attention.
7	<b>INCEPTION</b>	Scrubbed up from the wide gate and boxed on bravely for a 0.7 length win at Scone. Has early speed. Among the dangers.
9	<b>DRUNKEN SAILOR</b>	Just missed at Orange Oct 9. Came from back half to post a commanding 2.8 lengths Class 3 win at Queanbeyan at \$9. A distance specialist. Each-way.

**RACE 7** 2:30 PM | \$42,000 | **GOSFORD** | 1100m

3	<b>CREPE MYRTLE</b>	Broke maiden at Randwick Dec 26. Started \$6, fighting out the finish at Warwick Farm at first run for new trainer. Second time at 1100m suggest she is ready to peak. Top prospect.
1	<b>GOLD CARD</b>	Drove hard late to nail a 0.2 lengths win at Taree first up. Will be fitter second-up and takes a 3kg claim. Could get into the placings.
6	<b>STILL ALICE</b>	Let-up (42-days). Last start this trip handily placed and gave her all running on for second at Hawkesbury when in the market. Good draw. Key player.
8	<b>BOLD DESIGN</b>	Form to date solid. Just got the nod in at Muswellbrook in second run from spell. More suitable draw. Can challenge.
2	<b>BOOMTOWN CHAT</b>	Fought hard on the speed to bag the Hcp (C2) at Goulburn in second run from spell. First time around Gosford. Only for wider exotics.
