

**RACE 1** 10:32 AM | AUD40,000 | DOOMBEN | 1200m

1	<b>ADORA DJON'S</b>	Didn't quite finish it off the last bit at Ipswich first up. Makes a strong case in this company.
10	<b>PRETTY SMASHING</b>	Kicks off second campaign (18-weeks). Left a decent impression on debut at Sunshine Coast 8 Feb. Wiser for experience. Looked forward in recent trial. Warrants attention fresh in this company.
2	<b>APEX PREDATOR</b>	Trials (2:2-0-0). Very impressive trial CV and if brings that to the races she will be a real force. Jag Guthmann-Chester stays on from trial. Looks a forward type and warrants attention.
13	<b>SEAGOE</b>	Let-up (47-days). Put up a tidy debut performance at Muswellbrook at \$13. Better for race exposure. Since trialed at Gold Coast 2 Jun. Looks suited going to 1200m.

**RACE 2** 10:50 AM | AUD60,000 | CANTERBURY | 1550m

2	<b>FLYING ARTISAM</b>	Shown promise in limited runs. Just missed at Kembla Grange 16 May. Sent forward, outgunned late but kept boxing on at Illawarra Grange at second run back. Has gate speed.
1	<b>FARSET</b>	Backing up quickly. Honest type. Hawkesbury 3yo Mdn placegetter 21 May. Ranged up but punctured late at Randwick-Kensington.
7	<b>WAIRARAPA</b>	Gave a sight on debut at Illawarra Grange 30 May. Better for race exposure. Among the dangers again.
5	<b>RESCHS MILK</b>	Freshened. Offered little to catch the eye when debut at Newcastle when in the market 19 May. Better for run. Could take a step forward.

**RACE 3** 11:07 AM | AUD40,000 | DOOMBEN | 1200m

13	<b>TRUE INTENT</b>	Stepping out for only the second time after battling home this track when pushed out in the market 3 Jun. Better for it. Will only be improved and should have more to offer.
9	<b>NOZOMU</b>	Went home just tamely this track at \$51. Placed in Open company at Sunshine Coast second-up last campaign. Rates highly.
2	<b>BULL RAYNER</b>	Trials (3:1-0-1). It's all systems go for this gelding after winning a 1000m trial at Sunshine Coast Inner. Good draw for career opener. Can hit the ground running.
10	<b>OLD NIFTY</b>	Trials (3:0-1-0). Gets a soft draw for first assignment. Looks a forward type and warrants attention.

**RACE 4** 11:25 AM | AUD60,000 | CANTERBURY | 1250m

8	<b>GREY STAR</b>	Safely contained here on debut 27 May. Better for it. Longer trip may help. Can make her presence felt with even breaks.
6	<b>BOLLENTE BELLA</b>	Just wacked away without threatening over 1100m 2yo F Mdn this track at resumption. Among the dangers.
5	<b>WOODENBRIDGE</b>	Back for second campaign (25-weeks). Found the debut assignment beyond him at Randwick after speccing from \$41 into \$26 20 Dec. Experience gained. Two solid trials have brought her on nicely. Likely to improve from there. In the mix.
2	<b>DEMERZEL</b>	Wasn't all that far from the action on debut at Warwick Farm as a betting firmer 3 Jun. Better for it. A bit raw on debut but there's plenty of upside. Worth thought.

**RACE 5** 11:42 AM | AUD40,000 | DOOMBEN | 1350m

1	<b>ICONIFY</b>	Never looked a serious threat in the small field this track. Won't need to improve much to test these.
9	<b>ARCTIC BRIGHT</b>	Honest type. Ran home into the minors F&M Mdn Plate here. Featured both times here. Super fit from racing and worth a look.
7	<b>CANYA BERICH</b>	Resuming (91-weeks). Ex Jack Bruce in QLD. Acquitted self well with debut placing this venue when in the market 18 Sep 2024. Benefits from the experience. Two pleasing trial hitouts leading into return and has placed first-up.
4	<b>CRUSADER VOYAGE</b>	Fresh. Ex C J Waller in NSW. Sent out \$5.50 when unable to threaten at Kembla Grange. Since trialed at Doomben 2 Jun.

**RACE 6 12:00 PM | AUD60,000 | CANTERBURY | 1250m**

1	<b>DEFENSEMEN</b>	Resuming (18-weeks). Capable of figuring fresh while tuned with 3 trials. Clearly the one to beat first-up.
10	<b>MONCEL</b>	Back to the track for second campaign (20-weeks). Returned a disappointing debut performance at Randwick 24 Jan. Wiser for experience. Given two soft trials. Looks suited going to 1250m.
11	<b>PREDATION</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (33-weeks). Reasonable debut performance when battled to line at Randwick. Wiser for it. Strengthened ahead of latest prep with 2 trials. Has scope and look to betting.
2	<b>KLOCKE</b>	With leading trainer and heavily supported this track at debut and went down fighting, 8 Jun. Better for the run and experience. Can play a role.

**RACE 7 12:18 PM | AUD38,000 | DOOMBEN | 1200m**

4	<b>SHE OURS</b>	Sound but non-threatening effort in rain affected going here first up. Gets all the favours from ace draw. Fitter second-up. Solid efforts here.
6	<b>FLYING SHELLY</b>	On pace and toughed it out well on a H10 at Coffs Harbour at first run for new trainer. On pacer. Has terrific record on wet tracks. Fitter, proven second-up.
5	<b>NEPRAVDA</b>	Ran on soundly into second in the small field at Sunshine Coast at this distance. Drawn to get an economic trail. Looks suitably placed in this line-up.
1	<b>ENTERPRISE LUCIA</b>	Kept coming and just fell short this track. Warrants attention.

**RACE 8 12:35 PM | AUD100,000 | CANTERBURY | 1250m**

7	<b>CLAUDEL</b>	No match but ran on for the minors at Warwick Farm on debut when in the market 3 Jun. Better for the run. Top chance to go one better.
4	<b>KING FOR A DAY</b>	Left a decent impression on debut at Warwick Farm 3 Jun. Better for race exposure. Added distance may help. Right in this.
11	<b>OUR HUNTRESS</b>	Racing with merit. Left in winner's wake but boxed on for the minors 3yo F Mdn Plate at Warwick Farm second-up. Stats are tidy this course. This looks a nice race for the filly, just needs some early luck.
8	<b>GATWICK</b>	In the market all runs. Placed 3yo Mdn Plate at Sale 19 Apr. Led, gave away final stages at Echuca at second run back. Can show early speed.

**RACE 9 12:53 PM | AUD38,000 | DOOMBEN | 1200m**

13	<b>MOSHULU SPIRIT</b>	Prominent in choppy conditions and careered away to win the Mdn with authority at Sunshine Coast 24 May. Soft form (1:1-0-0); untested heavy. Ben Thompson retains the ride. Highly rated in this line-up.
9	<b>STEIN</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (19-weeks). Broke maiden at Doomben in her first preparation. In the minors at Doomben on debut last campaign while indicating was forward winning a Doomben trial. Has early speed.
3	<b>STATEMENT OF TRUTH</b>	Reasonable effort without seriously threatening here. Soft form (4:1-1-1); untested heavy. At optimum distance. Hard fit and right in the mix.
11	<b>SEQUEL</b>	Let-up (42-days). Not disgraced in Hcp (C1) at Eagle Farm at first run for new trainer at \$13. Since trialled at Doomben 2 Jun. Decent alley.

**RACE 10 1:10 PM | AUD60,000 | CANTERBURY | 1550m**

5	<b>VIEWPOINT</b>	On pace but folded up quickly at Warwick Farm. On pacer. Warrants attention.
7	<b>EMBALLEE</b>	Sent out \$14 when never got into the race in choppy conditions at Warwick Farm first up. Will benefit from that run. Worth a look.
4	<b>MO CHROI</b>	Resuming after a (53-weeks) spell. Ex Gavin Cromwell in Europe. International import with new trainer. Winner fresh and 2 trials will have him ready for this.
11	<b>MISSILE LEADER</b>	Restrained from wide gate, attacked line late to claim at Wagga. Gets in light. Fit from racing and not out of this.

**RACE 11** 1:28 PM | AUD38,000 | **DOOMBEN** | 1650m

1	<b>CAISHEN</b>	On pace but conceded late at Sunshine Coast in second run from spell as an odds drifter. Looking for this trip now. Among the dangers.
7	<b>BONUS SEASON</b>	Freshened. Broke maiden at Sandown-Lakeside 15 Apr. In trailing position but did not respond to pressure at Gold Coast. Easier race off Listed assignment.
8	<b>GOLDEN EYES</b>	Showed fighting qualities to win the 3yo Mdn at Sunshine Coast. Soft form (3:1-0-0); untested heavy. Ben Thompson retains the ride. Right in the mix again.
2	<b>CARNEGIE HILL</b>	Raced on the pace and went down in a thrilling stoush at Gold Coast. Fits well against this opposition.

**RACE 12** 1:45 PM | AUD60,000 | **CANTERBURY** | 1900m

7	<b>LE TROISIR</b>	Bided his time at the back and let down smartly at Warwick Farm over a longer assignment. Has won multiple times in wet. Coming back in distance should suit. Stays under strong notice for this.
6	<b>FORMAT</b>	Decent effort in the small field 5yo+ (Bm72) this venue second-up. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Gets through rain affected ground. Won't need to improve much to test these.
10	<b>VELARIS</b>	Won from just off the pace-setters here. Shown can handle the wet here. Worth a look.
4	<b>ELLE HUDSON</b>	Let down fiercely from midfield to grab second at Warwick Farm in second run from spell. Likes some juice in the track. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Among the dangers again.

**RACE 13** 2:03 PM | AUD38,000 | **DOOMBEN** | 1650m

9	<b>ALL KINDS OF FOLK</b>	Ran on soundly from midfield this venue. Effective wet. Will take stopping in this company.
7	<b>SAINT ALDWYN</b>	Showed a fine turn of foot from the back here. Soft stats (4:1-1-0); untested heavy. More ground a plus. Super fit from racing and among the dangers again.
5	<b>SAN JOSE BOY</b>	Finished too well winning 3,4yo (Bm68) at Gold Coast. Since won a Deagon trial 9 Jun. Soft form (9:2-3-0); untested heavy. Can again play a role.
11	<b>HUSH HUSH</b>	Won a 1500m Benchmark 64 at Kembla Grange two back. Warmed up nicely late in the slosh at Rosehill. Not out of this.

4	<b>MADRINA</b>	Just missed at Warwick Farm 20 May. Ran an honest race and not beaten far at Rosehill. Tactical speed, inside draw. Placed only other run at Canterbury.
2	<b>CONCHIERO</b>	Resuming (12-weeks). Placed at Caulfield first-up last campaign while tuned with 2 trials. Draw makes the job harder. Can play a role fresh in this company with even luck.
13	<b>MRS MAREE</b>	In touch and fought on dauntlessly at Warwick Farm. Awkwardly drawn but has enough speed. A few runs under her belt this campaign and right in the mix again.
12	<b>TWISTED QUEEN</b>	Steps out for third run new stable/region. Newcastle winner two back. Ran on okay without troubling in rain affected going at Warwick Farm. Dual winner this trip.
