

**RACE 1** 9:00 AM | AUD120,000 | **RANDWICK** | 1200m

4	<b>CHAINS OF LOVE</b>	Donkey-licked them at Scone two back. Didn't quite finish it off the last bit in Open company at Eagle Farm at second run back. Can lead or take a sit. All the better and highly rated in this line-up.
1	<b>EXIT FEE</b>	Gallant display on a soft deck this venue. Among the dangers again.
13	<b>STORM MERCHANT</b>	Took care of business in small field at Murwillumbah when up to its hocks in mud at last start this journey under heavy support. Speedy and under less weight, although might encounter more pressure here. Wet tracks certainly don't pose a problem.
6	<b>OCCULT</b>	Failed to threaten on a soft deck this venue. Maps to get a sweet run. Two of his wins were this distance. Not out of this.

**RACE 2** 9:35 AM | AUD120,000 | **RANDWICK** | 1600m

8	<b>PERFECT JUSTICE</b>	Sound form. Showed a fine turn of foot from the back here on a soft deck in second run from spell. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Claiming apprentice engaged again.
6	<b>HEREWARD</b>	Fought on with some conviction for the minors at Canterbury. Drawn to effect. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Ticks the track and distance win box.
1	<b>FORBIDDEN RIFF</b>	Couldn't find enough under the big weight 4yo+ (Bm72) at Canterbury second-up. Can improve to feature.
19	<b>AUTUMN BLONDE</b>	Gritty on pace victory in testing conditions Midway Hcp (C1) at Kembla Grange. On pacer. First try over a mile and under less weight. Right in the mix again.

**RACE 3** 9:55 AM | AUD150,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 1420m

4	<b>STAR OF MACEDON</b>	Shown promise in two runs. Reserved at back and gave late chase into third at Caulfield in only his second race appearance. Fitter, has scope to progress. Suited by the longer assignment now.
2	<b>PORTARLINGTON</b>	Prominent and went down swinging 2yo (Bm66) at Morphettville Parks. Looks a serious player.
3	<b>RUNNING RICH</b>	Pushed forward and fought on solidly 2yo Classic at latest outing. Can lead or take a sit. Can challenge again.
10	<b>YOUNZAIN EXPRESS</b>	Put up a tidy debut performance at Sandown-Lakeside at \$8.50. Benefits from the experience. Capable of making an impact.

**RACE 4** 10:10 AM | AUD160,000 | **RANDWICK** | 1600m

4	<b>NITRO</b>	Went close at Scone 16 May. Gave good account 3yo+ (Bm78) this venue at second run back when in the market. Added journey should assist. This looks very achievable.
8	<b>CONCORDIA WIND</b>	Finished within striking distance 3yo+ F&M (Bm72) at Randwick-Kensington in second run from spell. Awkwardly drawn. Stripping fitter and goes into wider exotics.
3	<b>MCADAM</b>	Has a picket fence form line. Sent forward and found plenty in compact affair at Illawarra Grange. Not as well drawn this time. Sterner test here but can't rule out.
5	<b>BIRD WHISTLE</b>	Prominent and went down fighting on a soft deck in the Benchmark 78 company this track over this distance. Good gate. Makes a strong case in this company.

**RACE 5** 10:25 AM | AUD150,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 2000m

1	<b>DECALOGUE</b>	Aiming for hat-trick. Donkey-licked them at Newcastle two back. Delivered a steely performance to score 3yo (Bm72) at Randwick at last start this journey. Likes the sting out.
5	<b>MAHERS LANDING</b>	Reeled in leaders to salute at Pakenham at this distance. Capable of figuring again.
13	<b>SHE'S GOT THE CASH</b>	Latest attempt this journey when made limited headway this venue as a market drifter. Not out of this.
17	<b>RAINSUN</b>	Settled close and responded strongly at Geelong in only his second race appearance. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Warrants attention.

**RACE 6** 10:45 AM | AUD160,000 | **RANDWICK** | 1300m

7	<b>FRONT RANK</b>	With elite stable made an absolute mess of them on debut in testing conditions at Canterbury. Tim Clark retains the ride. Commands attention here.
1	<b>HELLO CAPTAIN</b>	Oozes talent. Delivered an explosive win in the 3yo (Bm64) at Canterbury at second run back. Well placed to repeat dose.
3	<b>PIMLICO</b>	Freshened. Randwick-Kensington winner two back. Settled midfield, no meaningful impression at Warwick Farm over this distance. Since trialled at Rosehill 5 Jun.
10	<b>ALPHARD</b>	Randwick-Kensington 3yo (Bm68) placegetter 13 May. Couldnt lift when the pressure went on at Canterbury. Can put last run behind him.

**RACE 7** 11:00 AM | AUD150,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 2540m

5	<b>THE WESTERN FRONT</b>	Started \$3 when toughed it out in Open company at Sandown-Lakeside over a longer test. Excels on rain affected tracks. Coming back in distance should suit. Stays under strong notice for this.
4	<b>ALDER</b>	4 weeks since last run. Won 3yo+ Hcp Terang 12 Apr. Went home tamely in soft going at Sandown-Hillside at \$8. At his best form on wet tracks.
13	<b>SAMUEL LANGHORNE</b>	Fresh. Okay at latest when settled back. Usually gets back. Among the dangers.
8	<b>KINGOFWALLSTREET</b>	Merit in Stakes form. Well back and never a factor in sticky going this venue when off an extended spell. Fitter second-up. Right in the mix.

**RACE 8** 11:20 AM | AUD160,000 | **RANDWICK** | 1800m

3	<b>SHANGRI LA IMPACT</b>	Won 3yo+ (Bm72) Randwick-Kensington 27 Apr. Set tempo, offered little resistance when challenged at Rosehill over this trip. Can lead or take a sit and brings strong wet stats.
5	<b>NASEBAH</b>	Steps out for third Aust start. Early form good. Won 3yo+ (Bm64) Randwick-Kensington 13 May. Finished within striking distance 3yo+ F&M (Bm78) here in second run from spell when in the market.
1	<b>BRAVISSIMA</b>	Determined effort to secure victory this venue. Has won multiple times in wet. First try at 1800m but can make her presence felt again.
8	<b>HORIZONS</b>	Handy and acquitted herself fairly well this track. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Right in the mix.

**RACE 9** 11:35 AM | AUD150,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 1100m

1	<b>ICE KOOL</b>	Dominant on-pace performance in the 3yo+ (Bm78) at Randwick at resumption. On pacer. First time down Flemington straight. Dialed in and stays under strong notice.
4	<b>CHOIR POINT</b>	Wore them down late at Caulfield over this distance. Hard to dismiss.
9	<b>PRESTAR</b>	Settled handy and responded well in rain affected going to fill the minors at Caulfield Heath at resumption. Gets in light. Relishes the sting out of the ground. Will benefit from that run.
14	<b>POKER</b>	Back for second campaign (40-weeks). More developed now. Made immediate impact on the track with a convincing win in heavy ground at Bendigo 7 Sep. Trial was pleasing. Craig Williams retains the ride.

**RACE 10** 11:55 AM | AUD160,000 | **RANDWICK** | 1800m

9	<b>TAZIMA</b>	Freshened. Drove hard late to nail a narrow win here. Proven record wet/track. Coming back in distance.
17	<b>BONIFACE</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Better for first Aust run. Warming into it late at Sandown-Hillside at first run for new trainer. Has his first look at 1800m here.
12	<b>SIR DINADAN</b>	Started \$6 when battled home in Benchmark 78 company in sloppy conditions at Rosehill. In the placings only prior run here. This looks very achievable.
13	<b>UNTIL VALHALLA</b>	Okay at latest when settled back. Proven in wet. A few runs under her belt this campaign and can make her presence felt.

**RACE 11 12:10 PM | AUD80,000 | FLEMINGTON | 1420m**

14	<b>THEBELMONTGANGSTER</b>	On a quick back-up. Made easy work of (Bm74) win at Sandown-Hillside at \$3.80. Can go back to back.
17	<b>ROSA AOTEAROA</b>	Won (Bm70) Bendigo 2 May. Well back and made some minor headway but passing mainly tired rivals here. Among the dangers.
9	<b>CAPPER THIRTYNINE</b>	Let-up (42-days). Won a 1400m Benchmark 78 at Flemington two back. Settled close and ran an honest race in rain affected going at Caulfield. Can lead or take a sit.
3	<b>MADERO</b>	First-up (42-weeks). Ex C Head. Trained here now. Stakes winning International runner. Placed at Fr - Saint Cloud first-up last campaign while prepared for return with a Caulfield Heath trial.

**RACE 12 12:30 PM | AUD160,000 | RANDWICK | 1000m**

2	<b>ICE KOOL</b>	Dominant on-pace performance in the 3yo+ (Bm78) this track first up. Has early speed. Well placed for repeat.
5	<b>POLYGLOT</b>	Resuming (14-weeks). Brought on with two trial hitouts and capable of a bold run first-up. Not out of this.
7	<b>PETTICOAT</b>	Raced in back half and never likely at Eagle Farm at second run back. Ready to peak third-up. Unbeaten at track and distance. Among the dangers.
10	<b>ALEPPO PINE</b>	Let-up (52-days). Ex Ben, Will & Jd Hayes in Victoria. Warmed up nicely late at Caulfield Heath in second run from spell. Since trialled at Warwick Farm 9 Jun.

**RACE 13 12:45 PM | AUD150,000 | FLEMINGTON | 1420m**

2	<b>DUCHESS ZOU</b>	On target for hat-trick. Ridden positively and showed plenty of mettle to win this venue. Leads, handy. Previous winner in wet here.
8	<b>FIRST CHORUS</b>	Rounded them up smartly in the small field at Caulfield. Has terrific record on wet tracks. Warrants attention.
3	<b>MISS ARIA</b>	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced in sticky going here. A few runs under her belt this campaign and capable of making an impact if she gets the breaks.
6	<b>STYLISH</b>	Fought bravely to the wire in the F&M (Bm84) here when off an extended spell. Strips fitter second run back and takes a 2kg claim. Won't need to improve much to test these.

**RACE 14 1:05 PM | AUD160,000 | RANDWICK | 1200m**

2	<b>BUSTLING</b>	Stationed around midfield, positive response gaining late ground in testing conditions at Caulfield at second run back. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Dual winner this trip. Placed to effect here.
6	<b>MAYFAIR</b>	First-up (22-weeks). In the minors at Randwick first-up last campaign while tuned with 2 trials. Only win to date was this distance. Not out of this fresh in this affair.
1	<b>GOLDEN DECADE</b>	Let-up (42-days). Ran on late from the back at Gold Coast in second run from spell. Could get into the placings.
13	<b>WORLD ALLIANCE</b>	Sent back (outside alley) and finished with a full head of steam in Benchmark 88 company at Canterbury at second run back. Usually gets back. Handles wet ground. Warrants attention.

2	<b>NEW YORK LUSTRE</b>	Let-up (42-days). Handy and boxed on solidly at Morphetville. Excels on rain affected tracks. Winner at track and distance.
10	<b>GIN A TONIC</b>	Set tempo, offered little resistance when challenged at Caulfield at first run back. On pacer. Fitter second-up. First time down Flemington straight.
6	<b>DE BERGERAC</b>	5 weeks since last run. Ran on well without threatening winner in the The Straight Six down the Flemington straight. Since trialled at Caulfield Heath 11 Jun. Loves the wet.

**RACE 16** 1:45 PM | AUD200,000 | **RANDWICK** | 1400m

11	<b>WHINCHAT</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Sent forward but flat-footed when things got serious at Scone first up. Since impressed with a Warwick Farm trial win 9 Jun. Barrier hurts but possesses early toe.
3	<b>GENERAL SALUTE</b>	Form fair. Kept coming and just fell short this venue when off an extended spell. Advantaged if soft. Strips fitter second run back and suited over the longer trip.
8	<b>COOL JAKY</b>	Ran on well to bag a 1.2 len win in the 3yo+ (Bm94) this track. Speedy and a nice weight drop ,although might encounter more pressure here. Has wet form. A distance specialist.
12	<b>MIDNIGHT DYNAMITE</b>	Solid 61kg winner at Doomben 16 May. Gallant display here. Excels on rain affected tracks. Highly rated in this line-up.

**RACE 17** 2:00 PM | AUD150,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 1620m

4	<b>PUNCH LANE</b>	Backing up quickly. Fought on with some conviction for the minors at Sandown-Hillside. Has early speed. Strong wet stats.
2	<b>JIMMY THE BEAR</b>	Third outing for new trainer/ this region. Wonderful competitor. Showed plenty of grit winning the (Bm100) at Caulfield in second run from spell. Relishes the sting out of the ground.
3	<b>SAINT GEORGE</b>	First-up (18-weeks). Form through last campaign reads well. Nabbed on the wire in Open company this course first-up last campaign. Worth a look fresh in this affair.
5	<b>AL DUCA</b>	Let-up (49-days). Caulfield winner two back. Very tame performance (wide draw) at Bendigo when in the market. Since trialled at Caulfield Heath 11 Jun.

2	<b>HEZDARNHOTTOO</b>	On a short back-up. Stationed handy, tried hard but winner was simply too good at Rosehill. Highly rated in this line-up.

6	<b>GIRLS GIRLS GIRLS</b>	Let-up (47-days). Not disgraced at Pioneer Park over a longer assignment. One for exotics.
1	<b>TENNESSEE WHISKEY</b>	Now 5 weeks between runs. Won a 1650m Class 2 at Beaudesert two back. Not disgraced in (Bm65) at Sunshine Coast second-up at \$26. Secures inside draw in small field.

3	<b>BENDER MCGEE</b>	Let-up (47-days). Just wacked away without threatening over 1600m Hcp (62) at Pioneer Park at last start this journey. Right in this if things pan out.
6	<b>ANPHINA</b>	On a quick back-up. Solid rally into the placings this venue over this trip when in the market. Solid efforts here. Capable of playing a key role in this.
8	<b>THE ALBION</b>	On a quick back-up. Fought bravely to the wire in the Hcp (58) here over this distance. Makes a strong case in this company.
