

**RACE 1 9:55 AM | AUD250,000 | ROSEHILL | 2400m**

8	<b>JUJA KIBO</b>	Handily placed and gave his all at Randwick second-up when in the market. Ready to peak third-up. Adept heavy/proven track. This looks very winnable.
1	<b>CAMPALDINO</b>	Let down with a fine turn of speed from the back half to win in second run from spell. At optimum distance. Stays in this company with more weight but can go back to back.
14	<b>MR MONACO</b>	Started \$5.50 when sent forward and narrowly prevailed on a soft deck 3yo+ (Bm88) at second run back. Should appreciate stepping up in distance and a nice weight drop. Form good enough for this.
4	<b>TRAVOLTA</b>	Close placing in the Parramatta Cup at Rosehill. Got back, closed the race off solidly at Canberra. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Among the dangers.

5	<b>QUIETNESS</b>	Ex John O'Shea & Tom Charlton in NSW. In trailing position and kept on evenly at Randwick at resumption. Strips fitter second run back. Highly rated in this line-up.
2	<b>PINITO</b>	Steps out for third run new stable/region. Wore them down late at Randwick in second run from spell. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Stays under strong notice for this.

4	<b>COULTER</b>	Prominent and went down fighting in the Maiden company at Hawkesbury at first run for new trainer. Drawn well. Makes a strong case in this company.
7	<b>MASTER ARON</b>	Sent out \$17 when never got into the race at Rosehill last start. More suitable draw. Right in the mix.
2	<b>AMARILLO SKY</b>	Supported in early runs. On pace but under siege late and weakened out of the fight in only his second race appearance. Makes strong appeal.
9	<b>OL' MATE COOP</b>	Refused to shirk task in rain affected going in Mdn Plate this track at this distance. Sound claims.

15	<b>MARETH</b>	Picked up soundly late for 5th in the small field at Randwick. Could get into the placings.
1	<b>HIDDEN MOTIVE</b>	Led and boxed on to place in the small field for 0.5 len third at Randwick. Winner at track and distance. Strips fitter second run back. Has early speed.
3	<b>BEADMAN</b>	On an upward spiral. Kept finding to bag the Fireball Stakes at Randwick when in the market at resumption. Strips fitter second run back. Form good enough for this.
8	<b>NASHVILLE JACK</b>	Outsprinted but determined in defeat down the Flemington straight 28 Feb. Warrants attention.

2	<b>AUDITORY</b>	Solid performance in defeat in the Super Mdn at Hawkesbury in only his second race appearance. Good gate. Rates highly.
7	<b>DECOTA</b>	A very soft debut performance here 3 Mar. Drawn to get a conservative run. Likely to improve from there.
12	<b>SPANISH ARTIST</b>	Trials (3:0-0-1). Latest trial placing was a solid step forward. Bears close watching.

7	<b>ME ME</b>	Well back and made limited headway at Hawkesbury at last start this journey. Jumps from better barrier. Meeting easier opposition here. Key player.
6	<b>KITTY OKAY</b>	Showed plenty of fight on the pace at Warwick Farm. Sticky gate but has early zip. Can make her presence felt.

2	<b>AUTUMN BOY</b>	No match but still very brave in defeat in Randwick Guineas at Randwick at second run back. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Fitter now and ready to improve. Key player.
1	<b>OBSERVER</b>	Smart type building a great record. Terrific winning the Australian Guineas over 1600m at Flemington at \$1.85. Even fitter third-up and well placed to win again. Drawn to get an economic trail.
5	<b>VICTORIOUS SPIRIT</b>	Knuckled down with purpose at Flemington. Stamina on trial here. Ready to peak third-up. Each way prospect.
4	<b>GREEN SPACES</b>	Had all before him at turn and went home tamely at Randwick in second run from spell. First real test of stamina here. Sound claims.
