

**RACE 1** 10:10 AM | \$120,000 | ROSEHILL | 2000m

9	<b>STRAWBERRY IMPACT</b>	Knocking on the door. Out the back, closed with raking strides for third Midway (Bm72) at Newcastle. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Looks the one to beat.
