C4 - PRIX DE LA FRANCILIENNE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 1 Race -Flat - EUR € 35,000

1. LHAKPA - Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1600m in a Listed race at Meydan (UAE) on March 1st. Leading contender

2. UNE POINTURE - Two unplaced efforts since a win over 1100m at Deauville on October 21st in a Listed race. Hard to overlook

3. FRANCESCOLI - Nice win on the one run over 1300m at Deauville in a conditions race on October 24th. He will improve and warrants respect

4. GLANWORTH - He won his last two runs, the latter over 1200m at Fontainebleau on April 12th in a Class 2 race. Might need a few to falter in better company

5. HAWKEYE - He won on his sole start over 1200m at Chantilly by 2.5L on April 10th in a maiden race. He looks like a smart prospect with improvement expected

6. MAGICAL TRAIL - Nice 2nd over 1200m in a Class 1 race at La Teste on March 22nd. She won twice last year in the UK. One to keep onside

7. PROFUMO DI IENA - She won her last two races, the latest over 1200m in a Class 2 race at Fontainebleau on March 18th. More needed in a better race

Summary: LHAKPA (1) has been competing in strong company recently, and her third-place finish at Meydan in early March stands out as a solid effort. HAWKEYE (5) is an unexposed type who impressed when winning his maiden by over two lengths at Chantilly in mid-April; he looks a smart prospect with more to come. MAGICAL TRAIL (6) was a dual winner in the UK for Charlie Appleby and shaped well on her debut for new connections last time out. UNE POINTURE (2) is another to keep in mind.

C5 - PRIX DE BARON - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,000

1. MARCAN - Placed on his last two runs, the latest when 4th at Deauville in a Class 3 handicap on April 8th. Key player

2. WONDER WOOD - 4th on the last start over 2000m at Marseille Borely on June 14th in a Class 4 handicap. Hard to fancy

3. GREEN CURRY - Fair 4th over 1900m in a Class 4 handicap at this track on April 14th. He won at Lyon La Soie in March. Player

4. JETLINER - Fair 5th over 1900m at Chantilly in a Class 4 handicap on April 14th. He has dropped to a good rating

5. KIM KARALA - Two 2nd placed runs of late, the latter over 1900m at Deauville on April 8th in a Class 3 handicap. Hard to rule out

6. PENNY DE CERISY - Nice effort to be 4th over 1900m at this track on April 14th in a Class 4 handicap last time. One to keep onside

7. MASCALINO - Three unplaced runs this year, the latter over 1800m at Le Croise-Laroche in a Class 4 handicap on March 21st. Out of form and one to steer clear of

8. MAGURO - Unplaced last time, he won before that over 1900m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on March 31st. Needs a few to misfire

9. PALETUVIER - Supplemented for this after a win over 1900m at this track on April 14th in a Class 4 handicap. Can make the frame despite the weight rise

10. ALBERT BRIDGE - Two unplaced runs since a 4th over 1800m at Le Croise-Laroche on March 21st in a Class 4 handicap. Makes limited appeal

11. JOAO - Four unplaced runs this year, the most recent over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 handicap on April 18th. One to avoid

12. SECRET GLORY - Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 1800m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 4 handicap on March 30th. Outside place chance

13. NOT SO SILLY - Creditable 4th over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 handicap on April 18th. Others seem better equipped

14. PRINCE DES DUNES - Several unplaced runs of late, the latest over 1400m in a Class 4 handicap at Parislongchamp on April 17th. Looks vulnerable

15. ZYGFRYD - Two unplaced efforts since a 2nd over 1900m at Chantilly on March 4th in a Class 3 handicap. Opposable

16. MAESTRO CHOP - Ran well to be 3rd over 1900m at this track on April 14th behind PALETUVIER (9) in a Class 4 handicap when last seen. Can be involved



Summary: MARCAN (1) could be the one to side with in this open handicap, having placed in his last two starts and appearing ready to get his head in front. JETLINER (4) can pose a threat to the selection after a solid fifth over this track and trip in mid-April. PENNY DE CERISY (6) is an appealing each-way option, especially with Mickaël Barzalona booked. KIM KARALA (5) has been knocking on the door with back-to-back runner-up finishes and should be involved in the finish.

C6 - PRIX DE SURESNES - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Listed Race - Flat -EUR € 55,000

1. AZIMPOUR - Nice 2nd in a Group 3 race over 1800m at Parislongchamp on April 6th on his second run after a win on debut over the same track and trip in October last year. Player

2. NIZAM - Ran well to be 5th at Parislongchamp in a Group 3 race on April 6th. Won on both starts last year. Can make his presence felt

3. LEFFARD - He has won his two runs so far, the latter over 2100m at Toulouse on March 3rd in a Class 2 race. Can keep on improving and be involved

4. NEW GROUND - Fair 3rd over 1800m in a Group 3 race at Parislongchamp on April 6th. Track winner last October. Place chance

5. JUWELIER - Got off the mark on his second start over 1800m at Fontainebleau on April 12th in a maiden race. Needs to keep progressing to make the frame

6. CHAUMIERE DE PRE - Won on the last start over 1900m at Chantilly in a handicap on March 31st on the PSF. More is needed back on the turf

7. NITOI - Won on debut last September over 1800m at this track and was a decent 2nd on April 13th in a Group 3 race at Parislongchamp over 2100m. Hard to rule out

Summary: A small but competitive field for this Listed event. AZIMPOUR (1) was narrowly denied when second at Parislongchamp in a Group 3 race over 1800m. He looks like the type who will improve with more experience. NIZAM (2) was fifth in the same race and could be the biggest danger, he won on both starts last year. LEFFARD (3) is unbeaten in two runs and looks a useful colt. He can make his rivals work hard for the win. NITOI (7) is a nice prospect and can not be overlooked.

C7 - PRIX DE BOREST - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

1. ESKANDANI - 3rd on the latest start over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers on April 21st in a Class 4 race. Others make more appeal

2. TARNAC - Out of form of late, well beaten at Saint-Cloud on April 18th in a Class 3 handicap. Needs to get bounce back to form

3. SAN TEODORICO - Nice effort to be 2nd at this track over 1900m in a Class 4 handicap on April 14th. Capable of being competitive

4. L'HIPPOCAMPE - Nice 4th at Deauville over 1900m in a Class 3 handicap on April 8th, and a win in January at the same track and trip in a Class 4 race. Can not be ignored

5. LEJENDARIO - Three unplaced runs since a 2nd over 2000m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 2nd in a Class 3 handicap. Has a bit of work to do

6. PIERRE LE GRAND - 7th last time, 3rd before that over 1900m at Nimes on March 29th in a Class 4 handicap. Acts well on the PSF and can feature

7. LA DOLOISE - Placed on her last three runs, a win at Chantilly on March 9th on her penultimate start over 1900m in a Class 4 handicap. Hard to rule out at this track

8. ZWIALH - Three unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1900m at this track on January 11th in a Class 4 handicap. Can blow hot and cold

9. SEDSER - Has shown very little form of late, 9th over 1700m in a Class 4 handicap at Pornichet on February 13th on the last start. She would be a shock winner

10. LIGHTED GLORY - Has been out of form, poor run on April 1st at Fontainebleau in a Class 3 handicap over 2000m. Makes no appeal

11. SEA WINGS - 5th on the last start over 1900m at this track on March 31st in a Class 3 handicap. Might find a few too smart

12. PREMIERE ETOILE - Two unplaced runs this year, the latter over 1800m at Le Croise-Laroche on April 5th in a Class 4 handicap. Pass over

13. BAILEYS ECLAIR - Ran a decent race to be 2nd over 1900m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on April 14th when beaten in a photo-finish. In the mix

14. FOREVER COCO - Four unplaced runs since a win over 1800m at Clairefontaine on June 28th in a Class 3 handicap. Hard to recommend

15. DEVIL'SPEAK - Creditable 3rd over 1900m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on April 14th. One to pay attention too

16. BONNIE HOPPS - 4th on the last run over 1800m at Fontainebleau on April 12th in a Class 3 handicap. Place chance



Summary: L'HIPPOCAMPE (4) has been in decent form of late, he won at Deauville in January in a Class 4 handicap over 1900m. He can edge this over PIERRE LE GRAND (6), who acts well on all types of surfaces and was a decent third on the turf at Nimes two runs back in late March. SAN TEODORICO (3) looks like an option for the each-way backers after a decent second over track and trip on April 14th. BAILEYS ECLAIR (13) is also worth a mention.

C8 - PRIX SERVANNE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Listed Race - Flat - EUR € 70,000

1. LAZZAT - Won his first six races, including the Prix Maurice De Geest (Gr.1) at Deauville over 1300m last August. He will be better for his 4th at Saint-Cloud on March 6th. Sets the standard

2. TOYOTOMI - Won on his last start over 1100m at Deauville in Listed race on April 8th. Can make the top three

3. VICIOUS HARRY - Creditable 4th at Deauville on April 8th over 1100m in a Listed race when last seen. Ought to be thereabouts

4. UN INSTANT - 3rd on the last run over 1100m in a Listed race at Deauville on April 8th. More id required in a better race

5. JAMES'S DELIGHT - Ran well to be 5th in a Listed race at Doncaster (UK) over 1200m on March 29th on his seasonal return. Listed winner at Deauville last July over 1200m. Player

6. MONTEILLE - Not seen since an unplaced run over 1200m at this track in a Group 3 race on October 26th. She did win a Group 3 in May 2024 at this track and trip. Needs to get back to form

7. EGIATEGIA - Won a Class 2 handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on April 14th. Steps up in class and might find a few too smart

8. THE BIG BOARD - 4th on her seasonal return over 1350m at Lyon Parilly on April 16th in a Class 3 race on her last outing. A winner 3 times in the UK. Can be opposed

Summary: LAZZAT (1) won his first six races last year, including the Prix Maurice De Geest (Gr.1) at Deauville over 1200m last August. He will strip fitter for his recent fourth at Saint-Cloud in early March and can score from JAMES'S DELIGHT (5), who was a creditable fifth at Doncaster in a Listed race in late March on his only run this year. He makes the trip from the UK. TOYOTOMI (2) won over 1100m early last month at Deauville and warrants respect. VICIOUS HARRY (3) is also one to consider.

C9 - PRIX DE BARBERY - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 22,000

1. ALCOTAN - Four unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1700m at Pornichet in a Class 4 handicap when well beaten. Needs to return to better form

2. HELLO COTAI - Won over track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on April 14th in the last start. More needed, but is in the mix

3. MISTER JULES - Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 2150m at Lyon La Soie on February 7th in a Class 4 handicap. Among the leading chances

4. LETTYT FIGHT - Ran well to be 2nd over 1900m at Deauville on April 8th in a Class 3 handicap last time out. One to pay attention to

5. KOLPLET - Respectable 4th over 2000m at Toulouse on April 20th in a Class 4 handicap. Acts on the PSF and is respected

6. FEARLESS CHEETAH - 2nd on the last start over 2400m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 4 handicap on January 9th. Others preferred

7. MANDRES - She won twice last year, once on the PSF at Deauville over 1900m last August. Fair 5th on her last start over 1900m at the same track on April 8th in a Class 3 race. Live chance

8. ROI DE FLANDRE - Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1600m at this track in a Class 3 handicap on April 3rd. The step up in trip could be a negative

9. AGOUREIL - Placed on the last three runs, 3rd on the most recent over 2150m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 4 handicap on March 23rd. Hard to discount

10. HERODION - 7th last time, he won before that over 1400m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on March 13th. Up in trip and has place claims

11. BURSARD - Has been out of form, well beaten over 1600m at Fontainebleau on March 1st in a Class 3 handicap on the last start. Hardly inspiring

12. PRINCESSE COLUMBIA - Ran well to be 2nd over 1800m at Lyon La Soie on March 30th in a Class 4 handicap on her last run. Capable of making the top four

13. PERROU - 6th last time, he won before that over 2000m at Pau on February 18th in a Class 3 handicap. Recent track form has not been ideal

14. COGNAC - 4th on the one run this year over 2100m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 handicap on April 18th. Capable but not reliable

15. LE RAPIDE - 4th on the most recent run over 1800m at Le Croise-Laroche on April 5th in a Class 4 race. Inconsistent

16. EYOTA TECA - Five unplaced runs so far, the latter over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on April 11th in a Class 3 handicap. Looks of limited talent



Summary: MANDRES (7) scored twice last year, on the turf and then on the PSF at Deauville in August over 1900m. She ran a decent race when fifth at the same track early last month and can get back in the winner's circle. LETTYT FIGHT (4) can give the selection the most to think about. He was a good second at Deauville in April and is hard to ignore. MISTER JULES (3) is one for the each-way backers to latch on to. HERODION (10) is also a good option each way, up in trip today.

C1 - PRIX DES COLOMBES - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 3 Race - Flat -EUR € 23,000

1. MEFIE TOI - Not disgraced when fourth on debut in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1100m on 19 April. Likely to improve and is not out of it

2. ASTREA - A runner-up in both her starts so far, with the latest being in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1100m on 6 April. Can go one better

3. ILE AUX ROSES - Finished fourth on her debut in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 1100m on 17 April. Can make the frame

4. TEMADIVA - Finished 5th on debut in a Conditions race at this track over 1000m on 19 March. Can contest the finish

5. REMENBER CHOPE - Has not run badly in either start and was 5th in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 1100m on 17 April. Could play a minor role

6. OSHIA - Finished third on a debut in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1100m on 19 April. Should fight out the finish again

7. SPARKS OF LOVE - A two-year-old filly by Stunning Spirit out of Spirit of Queen who is making her debut. Watch the betting

Summary: ASTREA (2) has finished runner-up in both of her starts to date and is narrowly preferred to go one better over this slightly longer trip. This is a highly competitive contest, and both OSHIA (6) and MEFIE TOI (1) made promising debuts and are open to significant improvement. More was expected from TEMADIVA (4) on her debut at this track, but she remains capable of better and could well bounce back to win this time.

C2 - PRIX DE LA CANEBIERE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Handicap - Flat -EUR € 20,000

1. LOUIS OTHON - Finished 7th on handicap debut at Saint Cloud over 2400m on 4 April. In good shape before that and has a winning chance

2. DIEGO BELLO - Showed some improvement when third in a claimer at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 11 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

3. TANFEPAS - Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 4 April. Likes this course and is not out of it

4. BLANCHE SACREE - In good shape and finished fourth in a handicap at this track over 2000m on 22 April. Can contest the finish again

5. TOUNPASS - Showed improvement on handicap debut when fourth at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 16 April. Tries a bit further and is capable of an upset

6. BLEKOU - Has only been modest this year and was 6th in a claimer at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 21 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

7. SAPODILLA - Only modest so far and was 6th in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2000m on 7 March. Could improve this distance and has a place chance

8. FUJI HANA - In good form and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 4 April. Be right there at the finish once again

9. ADHEROS - Has not shown much in three starts and was 6th in a claimer at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 11 April. Needs to do more to win

10. DIYAA - Holding form well and was runner-up in a handicap at Chantilly over 2000m on 10 April. Can go one better this time

11. WHIPPY - Has done well in claimers of late and was runner-up at Montluçon - Néris-les-Bains over 2300m on 20 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: LOUIS OTHON (1) had shown promise prior to his handicap debut, so his run at Saint-Cloud can be seen as below expectations. He has scope for improvement and is given the nod to bounce back and score. DIYAA (10) is highly consistent but tackles this longer distance for the first time. FUJI HANA (8) has also been in solid form recently and cannot be dismissed. BLANCHE SACREE (4) scored over this trip in March and ran well at this track earlier this month.

C3 - PRIX DU JAS BLANC - 2600m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming -Flat - EUR € 16,000

1. HAMURANA SPRINGST - Finished fourth on debut at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 10 November. Returns from a break and could need this run

2. KING ZARAK - On a very long losing run and was 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on 30 March. Has won this track and trip and could surprise

3. BELGIAN PRINCE - Very consistent and was runner-up last time out in this division at Marseille-vivaux over 2000m on 11 April. Can win

4. VINO - Yet to win a race and finished 5th last time out in a handicap at Moulins over 2400m on 5 April. Has a place chance in this line-up

5. FORCE TRANQUILLE - Holding form and was fourth in a claimer at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 11 April. Better this distance and has a winning chance

6. HEBE - Did not show her best when 9th in Madrid over 2200m on 29 March. Won her penultimate start and is not out of it

7. KINGORI - Has improved on the PSF this year and was a winner in a Conditions race at Marseille-Vivaux over this distance on 11 April. Can double up

8. SEABAZZ - Has struggled this year and was unplaced last time out in a Conditions hurdle at Lyon-Parilly over 3800m on 19 April. Others are preferred

9. IZZA DE LONRAY - Has not showed much in two starts and was 6th last time out in Conditions race at Hyeres over 2500m on 27 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

10. GRAZALEMA - Consistent recent form in Spain and was runner-up at San Sebastián over 2200m on 17 April. Can contest the finish again

Summary: BELGIAN PRINCE (3) made a solid return from a lengthy break when finishing second on the PSF last month. He should be fitter this time and, now back on turf, looks the one to beat. Both HEBE (6) and GRAZALEMA (10) have shown consistent form in Spain and could prove effective at this level in France. FORCE TRANQUILLE (5) is holding her form well and has done enough to merit consideration, especially as she is a previous winner over this distance.

1. CLEOD'OR - Usually gives of his best and was third last time out in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2000m on 17 April. Can contest the finish

2. POLYSPEED - Not disgraced when fourth in a Conditions race at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 17 April. Has a winning chance first time in a handicap

3. MUELHEIMER PERLE - In good form and won a claimer last time out at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 11 April. Deserves respect in this line-up

4. HENRY THE LION - On a long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at La Teste-de-Buch over 2000m on 2 April. Has a place chance

5. INDIAN PACIFIC - Unreliable but was third in a claimer at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 11 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

6. ROCQUEMONT - Has some fair form in claimers of late and was 5th at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 11 April. Could play a minor role

7. CARLSTON - Has improved of late and was victorious last time out in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2000m on 17 April. Carries a 2,50kg penalty but is not out of it

8. GIRAFFE - Unreliable of late and was tenth in a claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 13 April. Could surprise this track and trip

9. EVERMAN - Unreliable and finished 11th last time out in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2000m on 19 February. Capable of an upset when in the mood

10. MR COALVILLE - Has some fair form of late and was 5th in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 4 April. Might play a minor role

11. POP LIFE - Only modest of late and finished 6th last time out in a handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 4 April. More is needed to win

12. BELLE DE SABA - Broke a long losing run when scoring a claimer at Nimes over 2600m on 5 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: Plenty hold winning chances in this open handicap. POLYSPEED (2) brings some strong form to the table and is a narrow pick to make a successful handicap debut. CLEOD'OR (1) is consistently competitive and should be involved at the finish once again. MUELHEIMER PERLE (3) is at her best around this distance and would not be a surprise winner in this field. HENRY THE LION (4) must overcome a penalty for his last win but remains a serious contender.

1. THREE DREAMS - A runner-up in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 19 April. Manon Germain will assist, and the apprentice allowance will assist further. Good chance

2. LIVING NELSON - Finished 8th in a Handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 1800m on 30 March. Consistent on the grass and deserves to be respected

3. AQUILON - Fifth in a Handicap at this track over 2000m on 22 April. Others are much preferred in this line-up

4. KAPETANIOS - A runner-up in a Handicap at this track over 2000m on 22 April. Well drawn and can contest the finish again

5. DAMASK BLADE - Fifth in a Claimer at Nimes over 1900m on 29 March. Can play a minor role at best and needs to find a few lengths

6. OLAF THE BIG ONE - Finished 6th in a Handicap at this track over 2000m on 22 April. Others make more appeal in this line up

7. VILLA ROYALE - Fourth in a Handicap at this track over 2000m on 22 April. Some improvement in the latest and can earn

8. BLUFF - Third in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 2000m on 4 April. Seldom far off them this year, and can be competitive again

9. BOLSHKINOV - Well beaten 10th in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1500m on 23 February. Others make more appeal

10. COLBY CHOP - Finished 8th in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 13 March. Unlikely to be involved in the finish

11. RED TORCH - Third in a Handicap at Marseille-Vivaux over 1500m on 4 April. Capable of contesting the finish and deserves to be respected

12. AUTUMN TWILIGHT - Unplaced in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 19 April. Others are much preferred in this line-up

BLUFF (8) hasn't won for a while but is consistent and should be in the mix once again. LIVING NELSON (2) is clearly more effective on turf and would not be a surprise winner here. KAPETANIOS (4) arrives in good form and looks well treated off this mark, so must be respected.

3. ESTOKENIA - A winner in a Claimer at Hyeres over 1850m on 21 April. Antonio Orani retains the ride, and they can go close to winning again

4. SECRET FEELING - Unplaced in a Handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 19 April. Others make more appeal in this line-up

5. THE SHAKING - Finished 6th in a Claimer at Hyeres over 2650m on 21 April. Unlikely to be involved in the finish and needs to find a few lengths

5. SICILIAN THREAT - Finished 7th in a Conditions race at this track over 1700m on 22 April. Unlikely to be involved in the finish

6. LESBEK - Fourth in a Conditions race at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 1600m on 13 April. On Handicap debut and can go close to winning
