R4 PONT DE VIVAUX [L-H]

C1 - PRIX ELIE PICONE - 1500m (a7f1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 3
Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- 1. WILD CITY** - Two good runs at this track of late, a win on November 12th, two runs back over the trip today and a 3rd over the same in a Class 3 handicap on December 8th. Hard to ignore
- 2. TASHANKA** - Two unplaced runs of late, 3rd previously over the track and trip in a Class 4 claimer on October 8th. Enters calculations
- 3. CHOP VAL** - Decent 2nd over the track and trip in a Class 4 claimer on December 21st, and a win over the same on December 8th in a Class 3 handicap. Player
- 4. KING OF CHILL** - Placed 2nd on December 19th at Chantilly in a claimer over 1600m. Likes the PSF and can play a lead role
- 5. MANAROLA** - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap on October 25th at Bordeaux Le Bouscat. Opposable
- 6. PURPLE RAIN** - Placed 4th over the track and trip in a Class 3 handicap on December 8th. Capable of making the top three
- 7. ABSOLUTE** - Good recent form at this track, a win in November and a 2nd over 1500m in a Class 3 handicap on December 8th. Key chance
- 8. SASKATOON** - Two unplaced runs of late, a win at Nimes before that on November 11th over 1200m in a Class 4 handicap. Others preferred
- 9. BLANC BLEU** - Two unplaced runs since a win over 2000m at this track on November 24th in a Class 4 handicap. Could be more suited by slightly further
- 10. CHIVERE** - Finished 7th last time on September 14th in a Class 4 race at Parislongchamp. Has been placed on an artificial surface

Summary: ABSOLUTE (7) has solid course form recently and could be the best option in a competitive race. WILD CITY (1) is also proven over the track and trip, having scored in November and a credible third last time out in December. KING OF CHILL (4) has form on an artificial surface before and looks like a safe option each-way. CHOP VAL (3) also likes this racecourse and can be involved at the finish.

C2 - PRIX JEAN NUCERA - 1500m (a7f1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4
Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,400

- 1. MAFALDA STORY** - Three unplaced runs of late, well beaten over the track and trip on November 18th in a Class 4 handicap. Needs to bounce back to form
- 2. BRAVEHEART** - Good win over the track and trip on December 21st in a Class 4 handicap. Ideal draw in stall 1 and will be hard to beat
- 3. MAGIC TREVILLE** - Credible 6th last time, 4th previously over the track and trip on December 6th in a Class 4 handicap. In the mix
- 4. AMORE MIA** - Finished 5th over the track and trip in a claimer on December 8th when last seen. Capable but can be unreliable
- 5. MANDOKI** - Three unplaced runs recently, the latest over 2000m in a Class 4 race at this track on December 21st. Can be opposed
- 6. NO TIME** - Ran well when 2nd over the track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on December 21st behind BRAVEHEART (2). On better terms she can make things interesting
- 7. TOUTELUSIVE** - Unplaced last time, a win before that over the track and trip on December 6th in a Class 4 handicap. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 8. DON FALCO** - Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over the track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on December 6th. Can make the frame
- 9. MAYA CHOP** - Several unplaced runs of late, 6th at Deauville over 1400m in a handicap on December 13th. Others seem more likely
- 10. LOUVE PRECIEUSE** - Finished 3rd over the track and trip on December 21st in a Class 4 handicap when beaten narrowly. Hard to rule out

Summary: BRAVEHEART (2) has an ideal draw in stall 1 and was a recent winner over this track and trip in a Class 4 handicap in late December. NO TIME (6) finished second in the same race and, on better weight terms today, can give another strong account of herself. LOUVE PRÉCIEUSE (10) was third here last time out and holds each-way claims. MAGIC TREVILLE (3) handles the track and trip well and looks the best of the remainder.

C3 - PRIX DE LA REINE JEANNE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - ALL WEATHER -
Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,300

- 1. RIYAK** - He has won his last two starts, the latter over 2500m in a Class 4 race at Nancy on November 30th. Place contender
- 2. WELCOME CHARLY** - Three wins of late, the latest over the track and trip in a Class 4 claimer on December 21st. Hard to dismiss
- 3. INTERSTELLA** - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 2000m in a Class 4 claimer at this track on November 12th. Might find a few too smart
- 4. BAGAZ** - Two placed runs of late, 3rd on the latest start over 2600m in a Class 4 claimer on December 21st. Lacks consistency
- 5. LOUIS OTHON** - Three unplaced runs of late, 9th on the latter over 2000m at this track in a maiden race on December 8th. Unlikely to feature
- 6. KINGORI** - Recent success over the track and trip in a Class 4 race on December 21st. One to pay close attention to
- 7. BEN DE DIANE** - Two unplaced runs of late, 3rd before that over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap on November 24th. Looks vulnerable
- 8. KALIFE ALAPLACE** - Finished 5th over the track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on December 8th. Capable of making the top three
- 9. AL HABISSET** - Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 2600m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on December 8th. In the mix
- 10. REVENTADOR** - Placed 3rd on the most recent start in a Class 4 race on December 21st at this track. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 11. MOUTRAKI** - Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 2400m at Salon Provence in a Class 4 handicap on November 27th. Others seem better equipped
- 12. DRAGON LOVE** - Placed on the last two runs, the latest when 4th over the track and trip on December 8th. Others make more appeal

Summary: WELCOME CHARLY (2) has been in terrific form with three wins of late. His latest success was over the course and distance in a Class 4 race late in December. KINGORI (6) scored over the track and trip on December 21st and can make the selection work hard. KALIFE ALAPLACE (8) ran a credible race when fifth at this track last month and has each-way claims. REVENTADOR (10) ran well when third at this track on December 21st and can have a say off a good racing weight.

C4 - PRIX DU GENERAL BONNAFE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,400

- PATZESTEVE** - Two solid runs of late, 2nd over the track and trip in a Class 4 race on December 21st. Capable of being competitive
- RABBAH** - Two unplaced runs since a 4th in a Class 4 handicap at this track on November 5th. Top four contender
- VALENTINE DAY** - Placed on the last two runs, 4th on the latest over 2400m at Lyon La Soie on December 7th in a handicap. Enters calculations
- ZILCOVER** - Unplaced last time, 2nd previously over 2400m at Saint-Cloud on November 20th in a Class 3 handicap. Others rate higher
- MOOR MALPIC** - Placed on the last two runs, 2nd on the most recent over 2600m in a Class 4 handicap on December 8th at this track. Leading contender
- DREAM ANGEL** - Three tame efforts since a 2nd over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 4 handicap on May 17th. Hardly inspiring
- SOUPIR** - Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 2400m at Vichy in a Class 4 handicap on September 23rd. Has work to do
- LAZULITE** - Recent 6th over 2600m in a Class 4 handicap at this track on December 8th. Ought to be in the shake-up
- D'ORSAY** - Four unplaced runs of late, well beaten over 2500m in a Class 4 handicap at Deauville on December 22nd. Look elsewhere
- TERRE SACREE** - Placed 4th over the track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on December 8th. One to pay attention to and can have a say
- HASHTAG JOA** - Several unplaced runs of late, 8th at Salon Provence over 2400m in a Class 4 handicap on November 27th. Hard to fancy

Summary: MOOR MALPIC (5) ran a solid race when second over the track and trip in early December in a Class 4 handicap and can go one place better. PATZESTEVE (1) has also been in decent form recently and could be the biggest danger to the selection. LAZULITE (8) could be an option for the each-way enthusiasts to latch on to. TERRE SACREE (10) does not win very often, but ran well over the track and trip recently and has place claims.
