## C2 - PRIX SHATEH - 1600m (a1m) - ALL WEATHER - Condition - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- **1. KODYAC -** Newcomer by Mister Ginoux, the dam ran a few times. From a respected trainer who can ready a newcomer. Bold show expected
- **2. GHAL'ID -** Coly by Sivit Al Maury, the dam never ran. Unlikely to trouble the principles on his racecourse debut and will improve for this run
- **3. MAMAMIA HIPOLYTE -** Placed on both starts, 4th on her last start over 2100m at Toulouse on October 10th in a conditions race. Ought to be on the premises dropping back in trip
- **4. AL MOUSTAKIM -** Colt by Mister Ginoux, the dam was unraced. Should know what is required on his debut from a good trainer. The betting can be the best guide
- **5. AGANDJIR -** Newcomer by Josco Du Cayrou, the dam ran a few times and was placed once. Likley to improve for this run and others preferred
- **6. MINEDOR DE BOZOULS -** Colt by Al Mourtajez, the dam won 5 races on the flat. From a stable that has newcomers well-tuned for debut. Monitor the betting for clues
- **7. HM AL ARABI -** Colt by Burning Sand, the dam ran once. Does not look like a first time out winner unless the betting market is vibrant
- **8. MAANORY -** Filly by No Risk Al Maury, the dam ran a few times on the flat. Should know more for this debut run, and is best watched for now

**Summary:** With a large portion of the field making their debut, it may pay to side with KODYAC (1), who is from a respected stable that will have this gelding nicely tuned. AL MOUSTAKIM (4) is by the same stallion in Mister Ginoux. From a good operator, he will know what is required, as will MINEDOR DE BOZOULS (6), who is out of a mare that won five races. MAMAMIA HIPOLYTE (3) has shown talent and could appreciate the drop back in trip.

# C4 - PRIX RAAZIQ - 2000m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Condition - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- **1. AL MESSAOUD -** Two unplaced runs, 8th on the latest over 2500m at Agen on November 9th in a conditions race. Can be opposed
- **2. NIGHT DE MIREVAL** 7th on his sole start over 2500m at Agen on November 9th in a conditions race. Has work to do to be involved
- **3. ANTINORI** 6th on his one run over 2100m at Toulouse on November 16th in a conditions race. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- **4. ASSA'AF -** Two runs so far, showing promise, the latter over 2000m at Mont-De-Marsan on August 24th in a conditions race. Consider each-way
- **5. HILAL -** Colt by Al Mourtajez, the dam won 1 race. Stable runners warrant respect and he has good aspects to his profile
- **6. NASHMEEAH AL SHAHANIA -** Finished 7th on her debut at Toulouse on November 16th over 2100m in a conditions race. Others rate higher
- **7. SHAGAF -** Placed 3rd on her sole start at Mont-De-Marsan over 2000m on August 24th. Given time since, and will be expected to get off the mark
- **8. CHAKIFA -** Placed 4th on her second start over 2100m at Toulouse on November 16th in a conditions race. Ought to be thereabouts
- **9. BADRIYA -** Three unplaced runs so far, the latter over 2500m at Agen on November 9th in a conditions race. Hard to recommend
- **10. AINHOA GOLDWIN -** Promise when 6th in a conditions race over 2500m on November 9th at Agen. She will be more clued up this time and can feature
- **11. LAMSA -** Unraced filly by Al Mamun Monalu, the dam was placed several times. From a stable that does well with debutante's. Monitor the betting patterns for cues
- **12. FRAIZTAGADA DARTEO -** Unraced filly by Al Mourtajez, the dam ran a few times. Unlikely to win on debut unless the betting market speaks volumes
- **13. PRINCESS RAQIYAH -** Unraced filly by Baseq Al Khalediah, the dam won 4 races on the flat. Should be well tuned and a bold effort can be expected
- **14. ADLAAH -** Unraced filly by Rmmas, the dam won 1 race. Should improve for this run and is best watched for any market interest

**Summary:** SHAGAF (7) made a pleasing debut in August when third over 2000m in a conditions race. She has been given plenty of time since that run and will know more this time. She can get off the mark from AINHOA GOLDWIN (10), who showed promise when finishing sixth on debut last month at Agen over 2500m. PRINCESS RAQIYAH (13) has a nice pedigree and is one to monitor in the betting for any market support. HILAL (5) could be the most forward of the colt's in the lineup.
