

R2 LE LION D'ANGERS [L-H]

C2 - PRIX PAUL SAULOU - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 2 Race - Flat - EUR € 20,100

- **1. GOLDEN BROWN -** Unplaced last time, 4th previously over 1600m in a handicap at Parislongchamp on July 3rd. Looks vulnerable
- **2. SQUARE CARNOT -** Ran well when 2nd at Clairefontaine over 1400m in a Class 2 race on July 26th. Hard to overlook
- **3. O SOLE MIO -** Creditable 4th at Clairefontaine in a Class 2 race on July 26th on his latest start. He can make his presence felt
- **4. VADINSKA -** Won on debut at Saint-Cloud over 1600m in May, she has contested two Pattern races since, 7th in a Listed race at Chantilly on June 28th on her most recent over 1600m. Key chance
- **5. MAGICAL TRAIL -** Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1400m at Dax in a Class 2 race on May 19th. Others rate higher

Summary: VADINSKA (4) was an impressive ten-length winner on debut at Saint-Cloud in May. She has since been tested in stronger company, contesting both a Group 3 and a Listed race, and most recently finished last of seven at Chantilly in June. Dropping in class here should suit. SQUARE CARNOT (2) looks a genuine danger, having placed in each of his last three outings, the latest in a Class 2 event 19 days ago. O SOLE MIO (3) also holds claims after a solid third at Clairefontaine on the same day.

C4 - PRIX JOCKEYS STARS (PRIX DE LA VEZ) - 3000m (a2m) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- **1. GOLDEN DISC -** Showed more when 2nd over 2000m at Vichy in a maiden race on July 16th. Looks capable off her current handicap rating
- **2. DARINGA -** 9th last time, a win before that over 2400m at Vichy in a handicap on July 14th. Among the leading contenders
- **3. GABYLOU -** Two unplaced runs since a 4th over 2100m at Parislongchamp in a handicap on May 25th. Might find a few of these too smart
- **4. DANSE ETOILEE -** Three unplaced runs of late, a win before that over 2950m at Machecoul on April 21st in a maiden race. One to pay attention to
- **5. BALLADE EN BARQUE -** Two solid efforts of late, a 2nd over 2500m in a claimer at Saint-Malo on July 24th when last racing. One for the shortlist
- **6. OVER THE CLOUDS -** 3rd on his most recent start over 2400m in a claiming event at Vichy on July 25th. Outside place chance
- **7. GOT MAN -** Three unplaced runs this year, 5th at Compiegne on his latest outing in a claimer on July 29th. Hard to fancy

Summary: GOLDEN DISC (1) produced a strong effort when finishing second in a Vichy maiden in mid-July, beaten only half a length. He looks capable of breaking through back in handicap company. DARINGA (2), a winner at Vichy two starts ago, rates as the main danger. BALLADE EN BARQUE (5) has been in good form, including a claiming race victory at Chantilly on July 8, and should not be overlooked. DANSE ETOILEE (4) also makes the shortlist.

C5 - PRIX DE GREZ-NEUVILLE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 12,000

- **1. DEUX DE COUPE -** Did not show her best when 8th in this division at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1600m on 26 July. Capable of much better and should fight it out
- **2. EXTRAVAGANZA** Only modest of late and finished 8th in a claimer at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1600m on 6 August. Better this distance and has a place chance
- **3. MIA TERRE -** Finished 6th in a claimer at Aix-les-Bains over 1200m on 13 July. Capable of better and could contest the finish
- **4. CLAIRE SOPHIE** Finished tenth on debut in a Conditions race at Le Touquet over 1300m on 27 July. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **5. LAKE DREAM -** Showed some improvement and was third in a claimer at Clairefontaine-Deauville

over 1600m on 6 August. Be right there at the finish

- **6. MANAGED MISCHIEF** Has run well in both starts in this division and was third at Senonnes-Pouance over 1350m on 2 August. Big chance in this line-up
- 7. LITTLE FROG Has not shown much so far and was 6th in a Conditions race at Rochefortsur-Loire over 1800m on 3 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: A very weak race, and it may be best to side with the only male in the field. MANAGED MISCHIEF (6) has performed well in this division and should make a bold bid to beat these rivals. DEUX DE COUPE (1) is clearly better than her last run and will be a big threat if showing her best form. MIA TERRE (3) has only been modest so far but can contest the finish. EXTRAVAGANZA (2) might be best suited to this distance and can make the frame.

C6 - PRIX PULSAT GAUBERT-LARDEUX (PRIX DE HAUTE FOLIE) - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 15,600

- **1. MY SECRET LIGHT -** Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 24 July. Can contest the finish
- **2. HOLY ROMANISED -** Did not show much on debut when 9th in a Conditions race at Vichy over 1600m on 30 July. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **3. JOURY -** Finished a good third on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 20 March. Returns from a break and has leading claims
- **4. DALYAMIX -** Not disgraced when 6th on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 24 July. Can make the frame with improvement expected
- **5. CARTAAM -** A three-year-old gelding by Elarqam out of Cartama who is making his debut. Dam won once in 16 starts. Watch the betting
- **6. SUMMER SOUL -** A three-year-old filly by Masar out of Fintry who is making her debut. Dam won 4 of 7 races, including a Group 2. Can win on debut
- **7. MLLE TRIUMPHANT** A three-year-old filly by Donjuan Triumphant out of Borynga who is making her debut. Dam won 9 of 73 starts. Watch the betting
- **8. BELLA D'ANJOU -** A three-year-old filly by Robin of Navan out of Lee d'Anjou who is making her debut. Dam won twice in 32 starts. Might earn some money on debut
- **9. INTENTION BORGET -** A three-year-old filly by Dariyan out of Liptone Borget who is making her debut. Dam only ran once and was unplaced. Others are preferred

Summary: JOURY (3) returns from a break. She showed promise on her debut in March and can win if fit. SUMMER SOUL (6) is well bred and makes her debut for a trainer who knows what is required from his newcomers, so keep an eye on the market regarding her chance. MY SECRET LIGHT (1) is in good form, and her experience could make her a threat in this line-up. DALYAMIX (4) was not disgraced on debut, and improvement is expected.

C7 - PRIX DU SECOURS POPULAIRE (PRIX D'ANDIGNE) - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,400

- **1. SPEEDY ANGEL -** Has struggled this year and was unplaced in a handicap at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 26 July. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- **2. TRUST ON ME -** Unreliable but did run well when fourth in a handicap ovr this track and trip on 18 July. Can be competitive again
- **3. LILITH -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a handicap at this track over 1400m on 28 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. IN THE ARMY NOW -** Unreliable but did run well when third in a handicap at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 9 July. Can contest the finish again
- **5. ALLURES DE REINE -** Unreliable and finished 7th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 31 March. Better on the PSF and could need this run returning from a break
- **6. L AMICALEMENT -** Has yet to show much and finished 6th in a handicap at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 1 August. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **7. NOBLE ANGEL -** On a very long losing run but is in good form and was fourth in a handicap at Compiegne over this distance on 29 July. Be right there at the finish
- **8. NEW TOWN -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in a handicap at Châteaubriant over 2650m on 23 July. Could be a lively danger this distance
- **9. BELCHA -** Unreliable but was a winner in a Conditions race at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 1800m on 3 August. Could earn some minor money
- **10. TOSCANE TEMPLE -** In good shape and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 1800m on 3 August. Might play a minor role
- **11. SANPEDRO -** Disappointing form this year and was 9th in a handicap at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 1 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **12. ECLAIR DE VATI -** On a long losing run and was 9th in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 10 August. Better on the grass and is not out of it
- **13. PEYTON PLACE -** On a long losing run and finished 8th in a handicap at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 1 August. Might play a minor role at very best
- **14. LLOYD -** Showed some improvement when fourth in a handicap at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 1 August. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **15. ALF A STAR -** Showed some improvement and was third in a Conditions race at Plouescat over 2600m on 4 August. More is needed to win this race
- **16. RIVER DAVEN -** Unreliable and finished fourth in a Conditions race at Dinan over 2300m on 4 August. More is needed to beat these rivals



Summary: NOBLE ANGEL (7) has improved of late and looks the one to beat in this line-up, though she will need to break a long losing streak. IN THE ARMY NOW (4) is not reliable but can be competitive off this handicap mark when in the right mood. ECLAIR DE VATI (12) has not won for some time but should appreciate the return to turf and could be a threat. TRUST ON ME (2) ran well over this course and distance and is a possible winner.

C8 - PRIX DU CHALLENGE DES ESTIVALES - CATEGORIE PLAT (PRIX SEA BIRD) - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- **1. SOGYNT -** Finished 12th in a handicap at Vichy over 2000m on 30 July. Better on the PSF and is best watched for now
- **2. RED GRACE** Only modest of late and finished 9th in a Conditions race at Châteaubriant over 1950m on 10 July. Can surprise off this handicap mark
- **3. AROWN -** Has struggled o late and finished 6th in a claimer at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2100m on 2 August. Might earn some minor money
- **4. LE SICILIEN** Not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at this track over 1400m on 28 July. Better this distance and should be a threat
- **5. POPORO -** Uneliable and finished 8th in a handicap at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 9 July. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **6. PIERRE PREMIER** Unreliable and finished 6th last time out in a claimer at Compiegne over 1800m on 21 July. Capable of playing a minor role on best form
- **7. CANNELLO -** Finished 8th last time out in a handicap at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2100m on 15 March. Could need this run returning from a break
- **8. ALSIMRYA -** Unreliable and finished 7th in a claimer at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2100m on 2 August. Might play a minor role
- **9. FELIPPO -** Only modest of late in claimers and was 6th at this track over 2400m on 28 July. Should do better this shorter distance
- **10. NIGHT ACTION -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Conditions race at Le Mans over 1400m on 10 March. Better on the PSF and should need this run returning from a break
- **11. JULIE ANAIS** Only moderate of late and finished tenth in a handicap at Châteaubriant over 2650m on 23 July. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **12. WARDAMA -** Loves this track and was victorious in a handicap over this track and trip on 18 July. Carries a 3kg penalty and can follow up
- **13. BECQUANIENTE** Only modest of late and finished 9th in a handicap at Compiegne over 2000m on 29 July. Did better earlier this year and can be a lively danger if in the right mood
- **14. PRINCESS KARA -** Bounced back to form and was third in a handicap at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 9 July. Can contest the finish
- **15. GALIK -** Disappointing of late and finishe tenth in a handicap at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1600m on 26 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **16. PODIA DAZ -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a handicap at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 1 August. Has won twice this year but others make more appeal



Summary: WARDAMA (12) has been good at this course all year. She carries a penalty for her latest course-and-distance win but is a solid selection for this lucky last race. LE SICILIEN (4) should do better back over this distance and can be a threat. FELIPPO (9) has only been modest of late but could be competitive off this lower handicap mark. BECQUANIENTE (13) is better than she has shown recently but can win a race of this nature.

C1 - PRIX DE VALMONT - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- **1. THE BLACK STONE -** Finished 6th over 1200m at Senonnes-Pouance in a Class 2 on the 9th of July 2025. Should be a contender in this class
- **2. CROOK** Not disgraced in 4th over 1400m at La Teste in a maiden on the 27th of July 2025. Can improve to earn again
- **3. HORNIG -** Well beaten in 5th over 1100m at Deauville in a maiden on the 5th of August 2025. Hard to recommend
- **4. ILE AUX ROSES -** Held in 8th over 1400m at Clairefontaine in a handicap on the 8th of August 2025. Would be a surprise winner
- **5. BAILEYS HIGHFLYER -** Dam won three times over 1000/1200m which included two wins at Group 2 level as a 2yo. The market will be out best guide
- **6. WANA CHOPE -** Finished 5th over 1000m at Vichy in a Class 2 on the 18th of July 2025. Big runner
- **7. ZENADIA -** Finished a close up 5th over 1200m at Le Lion D'Angers in a maiden on the 28th of July 2025. Can earn a minor cheque
- **8. DAISY DAISY -** Fair run in 5th over 1350m at Cholet in a maiden on the 30th of June 2025. Makes handicap debut and can threaten
- **9. EL TORO GRIS -** Moderate run in 6th over 1100m at Dieppe in a claimer on the 31st of July 2025. One to pass by
- **10. ESTHETE -** Finished 5th over 1100m at Dieppe in a claimer on the 31st of July 2025. Can run into the money

Summary: THE BLACK STONE (1) was a winner two starts back in a similar event and will be at home here. He gets weight off the back which will make a difference and he could return to winning ways. WANA CHOPE (6) has taken on stronger in recent outing but could be ideally placed to strike and make it two wins from her last three. ESTHETE (10) slots in with a nice galloping weight and gets the services of Mikael Barzalona which catches the eye. DAISY DAISY (8) has produced two solid runs to date and with further improvement, she should run well.

C2 - ARQANA SERIES DES POULAINS - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 160,000

- **1. EHTERAAZ** This gelded son of War Front is the first foal but hails from a yard that are flying and is of interest on debut. Follow the market
- **2. GAZI** Dam won once over 1500m and this colt is a half brother to Bennetot who won twice over 1800m/2000m. Yard is operating at a 21% win strike rate
- **3. MIJAS -** Dam won once over 1700m in the USA and this colt doesn't make much appeal on debut. Others inspire more confidence
- **4. JABRACADABRA -** Dam won over 1600m and this son of Cracksman may just need one run to tighten up on debut. Market will be a good guide
- **5. GET OUTTA HERE -** This son of Zelzal is nicely related being the full brother to Fraise Des Bois who has registered four wins over 1100/1200m. Significant jockey booking
- **6. AFYON -** Dam was a well tried maiden and this son of Toronado doesn't appear as a likely sort. Would be a surprise winner
- **7. SAGREMOR -** Dam won once over 1000m which came on debut but this colt may need the experience. One to pass by
- **8. RIVER CARD -** Dam was unraced and this will be the first foal to run. Yard can ready them up on debut
- **9. THANOS -** This son of Zarak makes no appeal on debut and is probably best passed by. Uninspiring pedigree
- **10. HELLO JO** Dam won twice over 1400m and this colt could be worth watching on debut. Yard is operating at a 14.5% win strike rate
- **11. LOMMI -** Dam was unraced and this son of Churchill doesn't appear to be a likely type of debut. Yard aren't known for debut winners
- **12. NORTHERN CHAMPION -** Dam was unraced but this son of Wotton Bassett could be one to keep a very close eye on. Yard can ready them up on debut
- **13. EAGLES ATTIRE -** Dam won twice over 1600m/2200m in Italy which included a win at Group 2 level. Likely to need the run

Summary: NORTHERN CHAMPION (12) comes from a yard that know what it takes to get juveniles ready and this colt could know the business on debut. Any market confidence will just enhance his claims. GAZI (2) is a colt that needs to be monitored carefully on debut, his trainer is known for having debut winners and he could be forward enough. GET OUTTA HERE (5) gets the services of Oisin Murphy which could indicate that he is showing the yard some solid work back at home and needs to be followed. EHTERAAZ (1) is another of interest given the yard he comes from and wouldn't be a surprise winner.
