

### **R1 DEAUVILLE [R-H]**

# C1 - SUMBE PRIX KERGORLAY - 3000m (a2m) - TURF - Gr2 Race - Flat - EUR € 164,600

- **1. GOYA SENORA -** Won over 3000m at Dieppe in Class 2 Conditional on 31 July. He takes on stronger and may find this difficult
- **2. COLUMBUS -** Finished behind Double Major when fourth in a Group 3 over 2800m at Parislongchamp on 13 July. He may have to settle for the same result
- **3. SEVENNA'S KNIGHT -** Four good runs this year. Finished third over 2500m on this course in a Group 3 on 9 August. Alexis Pouchin knows him well and he may be rewarded for consistency
- **4. PRESAGE NOCTURNE -** Comes off a good third-place finish in the Group 1 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier over 3100m at Parislongchamp on 25 May. Merits healthy respect
- **5. DOUBLE MAJOR -** Dual G.1 winner who finished third in a Group 3 over 2800m at Parislongchamp on 13 July. Title holder and should be involved

**Summary:** SEVENNA'S KNIGHT (3) has produced good form this year. He comes off a good third-place finish in the Group 3 Prix De Reux. Alexis Pouchin rides and may be rewarded for consistency. DOUBLE MAJOR (5) finished third in a Group 3 at Parislongchamp last time. He won this race last year and should be competitive. PRESAGE NOCTURNE (4) ran a good race when third in the Group 1 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier on 25 May. He should hold his own in this contest. COLUMBUS (2) finished behind Double Major last time and may have to settle for the same result.

# C2 - SUMBE PRIX DU CALVADOS - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Gr2 Race - Flat - EUR € 119,000

- **1. TRUE TEST -** She is unbeaten from two starts, the latest of which was over 1400m at Newmarket on 18 July. This is her toughest test to date
- **2. NANDITA -** Finished seventh in last two starts, the latest of which was over 1400m at Sandown in a Listed race on 24 July. She should not be taken lightly
- **3. FITZELLA -** Won a good race in a Group 3 over 1200m at Ascot on 26 July. Oisin Murphy makes the trip to ride her, and she can follow up with another victory
- **4. MY HIGHNESS -** Followed up her maiden victory with a game win over 1500m on this course in Class 2 Conditional on 5 August. She is a progressive type and can bring up the hat-trick
- **5. POLLY SHELBY -** Finished second in a Conditional Listed over 1400m at Vichy on 16 July. She is a filly with scope and cannot be discounted
- **6. ARKANSAS -** Won on debut over 1400m at Chantilly in Unraced Conditional on 20 July. She takes a big step up in class but could be anything. Christophe Soumillon is booked to ride
- **7. CERAMIC** Finished behind My Highness when second over 1500m on this course in Class 2 Conditional on 5 August. She may find it difficult to win this contest

**Summary:** FITZELLA (3) hails from the visiting Hugo Palmer stable. She has good form lines to her credit and comes off a victory in a Group 3 at Ascot. Oisin Murphy does duty once again and she may be the horse to beat. MY HIGHNESS (4) is a progressive individual and has won her last two starts. This is a stronger field, but she should be up to the task at hand. ARKANSAS (6) won on debut and takes on stronger. She could be anything and can give a good account of herself. NANDITA (2) is better than her last two starts and with William Buick in the saddle, she can show.

# C3 - SUMBE GRAND HANDICAP - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 1 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 72,000

- **1. PLEASEMAN -** Has some good form lines this year. Finished fourth in Class 2 Conditional over 2400m at Chantilly on 24 June. He will need luck from the wide draw
- **2. ZEN SPIRIT -** Finished sixth over 1800m at Clairefontaine in a Listed race on 2 August. His last victory came in Class 1, and he would not be a shock winner
- **3. STERN MARKKA -** Finished unplaced over 1600m on this course in Class 1 Handicap on 10 August. Others have a stronger winning chance
- **4. WATCH HIM -** Was disappointing when eighth over 1900m on this track in Class 3 Claimer on 12 August. It is encouraging that Mickael Barzalona keeps faith in the ride
- **5. PRIDE OF AMERICA -** Finished unplaced over 1600m at Compiegne in Class 2 Handicap on 24 July. Needs to find form of penultimate run
- **6. SAVANNENSTERN -** Is a horse with plenty of scope. Finished fifth in a Class 3 Conditional over 2200m at Clairefontaine on 8 August. Cristian Demuro retains the ride, and he should fight out the finish
- **7. CLEOD'OR -** Won over 1800m at Aix Les Bains in Class 2 Conditional on 13 July. It is a competitive field, and he is capable of finishing in the placings
- **8. MY FANCY -** Won a good race over 1900m on this track in Class 3 Claimer on 12 August. He returns to handicaps at the right time and can continue with his winning momentum
- **9. STANGHELI -** Showed good signs of a form return when third over 1900m on this track in Class 2 Handicap on 5 August. He can feature if confirming that effort
- **10. COLGAN SENORA -** Finished fourth over 1900m on this track in Class 2 Handicap on 5 August. With a bit of luck in running, he should be competitive
- **11. DARI RIVER -** Finished seventh over 2000m at Vichy in Class 3 Handicap on 7 August. Will need to put best foot forward to be competitive here
- **12. TRUE TEDESCO -** Finished fourth over 1800m at Clairefontaine in Class 2 Handicap on 2 August. He is an inconsistent type and can feature on best form shown
- **13. HAVOC -** Is better than last two starts. Finished unplaced over 1900m on this course in Class 2 Handicap on 5 August. He carries a handy galloping weight and can upset under Eddy Hardouin

**Summary:** MY FANCY (8) returned to winning ways in a Class 3 Claimer on this course last time. He returns to a handicap and could continue his winning momentum. SAVANNENSTERN (6) comes off an encouraging outing at Clairefontaine. He is a horse with plenty of scope and is one of the leading contenders. COLGAN SENORA (10) was not disgraced when fourth over this course and distance on 5 August. With a bit of luck from the wide barrier position, he should be involved at the finish. STANGHELI (9) comes out of the same form line as COLGAN SENORA (10) and there should not be much separating the pair at the finish.

# C4 - SUMBE PRIX MORNY - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Gr1 Race - Flat - EUR € 350,000

- **1. OUTFIELDER -** Makes the trip across from the USA. He won on debut over 1000m at Churchill Downs on 23 May. David Egan does duty, and this son of Speightstown could be anything
- **2. COPPULL -** Comes off a good victory in the Group 2 Markel Richmond Stakes over 1200m at Glorious Goodwood on 31 July. He finished third behind Gstaad in his penultimate run
- **3. GSTAAD -** Is unbeaten from two starts and hails from the top yard of Aidan O'Brien. He was super-impressive when winning the Group 2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot over 1200m on 17 June. He should keep his record intact
- **4. WISE APPROACH -** Returned to winning ways in a Listed race over 1200m at Newbury on 18 July. He finished second in a Group 2 over 1000m at Royal Ascot in his penultimate run. William Buick knows him well and the combination merit respect
- **5. IMPERIAL ME CEN -** Finished fourth in a Group 2 over 1200m at Chantilly on 20 July. He may find it difficult to win a race of this nature
- **6. VENETIAN SUN -** Is unbeaten from three starts and takes on the males. She won a Group 2 over 1200m at Newmarket on 11 July. She looks to have class about her and with her sex allowance, she cannot be discounted

**Summary:** GSTAAD (3) comes off a super-impressive victory in the Group 2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot. The son of Starspangledbanner looks to have plenty of class and he should keep his unbeaten record intact. VENETIAN SUN (6) is a filly taking on the males and she gets her sex allowance. She comes off a good victory in a Group 2 at Newmarket. She will be looking to remain unbeaten in what is a competitive field. WISE APPROACH (4) returned to winning ways in fine style at Newbury on 18 July. William Buick rides and the combination cannot be discounted. COPPULL (2) won the Group 2 Markel Richmond Stakes at Glorious Goodwood. He finished behind Gstaad in his penultimate outing and should run an honest race.

# C5 - SUMBE PRIX DE LA CROIX D'HEULAND - 1500m (a7f1/2) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 25,900

- **1. GOUTTES DE DIEU -** Finished behind Show Set when ninth over 1400m at Clairefontaine in Handicap on 8 August. Chance on previous form
- **2. GARIGA -** Won over 1600m at Saint-Malo in Maiden on 24 July. She is a progressive type and should be involved at the finish
- **3. VICTOR VITAE -** Disappointed when eighth over 1400m at Le Lion D'Angers in Maiden on 10 August. Can feature on best form shown
- **4. SYDNEY SUNSET -** Finished third over 1600m at Clairefontaine in Maiden on 2 August. He is a progressive type and is one of the leading contenders
- **5. LIKE LINDY -** Disappointing when seventh over 1400m on this course in Maiden on 9 August. She showed promise in her first two career outings and should be right there at the finish
- **6. PRINCESS ZALTANA -** Fair form. Finished fourth over 1600m at Vittel in Maiden on 20 July. Others have a stronger winning chance
- **7. VILLA ADRIENNE -** Showed improvement when second over 1800m at Rochefort-Sur-Loire in Maiden on 3 August. Needs to confirm that effort in this competitive field to have a say
- **8. SHOW SET -** Finished second over 1400m at Clairefontaine in Handicap on 8 August. Benjamin Marie retains the ride, and he can go one better
- **9. LIEBEROSE** Finished fourth over 1600m at Clairefontaine in Claimer on 26 July. More is needed to win this
- **10. CHARMING CECILIA -** Finished seventh over 1400m at Le Lion D'Angers in Maiden on 10 August. She has plenty of scope to improve
- **11. ST GERMAIN** Finished behind Show Set when sixth over 1400m at Clairefontaine in Handicap on 8 August. She is still lightly raced and can show good improvement with luck in running

**Summary:** LIKE LINDY (5) is better than her disappointing last effort when seventh. She showed signs of promise in her first two career outings and has the ability to win a race of this nature. SYDNEY SUNSET (4) is a progressive type who is holding his own. Stephane Pasquier rides and he is one of the leading contenders. VICTOR VITAE (3) is better than his disappointing last outing and can feature on best form shown. GARIGA (2) won a good race over 1600m at Saint-Malo last time. She should have a say in the outcome of this contest.

## C6 - SUMBE PRIX JEAN ROMANET - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Gr1 Race - Flat - EUR € 400,000

- **1. SURVIE -** Finished third in a Group 1 at the Curragh over 2000m on 28 June. This is her peak run, and she can place with luck in running
- **2. CINDERELLA'S DREAM -** Won a game race in the Group 1 Tattersalls Falmouth Stakes over 1600m at Newmarket on 11 July. She got the better of January who has subsequently finished second in the Prix Rothschild. She is the horse to beat
- **3. QUISISANA** Is unbeaten from two starts this year, the latest of which was in a Listed race over 2000m at Chantilly on 20 July. She is blossoming at the moment and would not be a shock winner
- **4. ROYAL DRESS -** Disappointed when sixth in a Group 3 over 1600m at Ascot on 26 July. May be outgunned in this line-up
- **5. GRAND STARS -** Finished fourth in a Group 1 in Germany over 2000m on 27 July. Maxime Guyon picks up the ride, but she may find it difficult to win a race of this nature
- **6. START OF DAY -** Was far from disgraced when third in the Group 1 Prix Rothschild over 1600m on this course on 3 August. She has won a Listed race over this distance previously and may give a good account of herself
- **7. CANKOURA -** Comes off a victory in a Group 3 over 2000m on this course on 3 August. She finished behind Bedtime Story when third in the Group 1 Prix De Diane in her penultimate outing
- **8. BEDTIME STORY -** Is better than her last start when fourth in the Group 1 Qatar Nassau Stakes over 2000m at Glorious Goodwood on 31 July. Her penultimate run when second in the Group 1 Prix De Diane catches the eye. She is a threat

**Summary:** CINDERELLA'S DREAM (2) comes off a hard-fought victory in the Group 1 Tattersalls Falmouth Stakes at Newmarket. January has come out and finished a creditable second since. William Buick does duty, and she should take a power of beating. BEDTIME STORY (8) should pose the biggest threat if finding the form of her penultimate run when second in the Group 1 Prix De Diane. Third in the Diane last June behind BEDTIME STORY (8), CANKOURA (7) won a good race in a Group 3 on this course last time and is expected to be a warm player. QUISISANA (3) is unbeaten from two starts this year and should run another honest race.

## **R5 MONT DE MARSAN [R-H]**

## C1 - PRIX DARIYA - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Condition Race - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- **1. BIN NARAIN** Finished in the rear on the one run at Mont-De Marsan over 2150m on August 1st. He faces a stiff test to make the frame
- **2. BALHAMBAR -** Showed promise when he was 8th on his debut at Mont-De- Marsan on July 16th over 1600m. The step up in trip should be more suitable
- **3. MISTER LINSOU** Unplaced on the one run over 1600m at Mont-De-Marsan on July 16th in a conditions race. Hard to recommend
- **4. RB NAIF -** 9th on his debut at Dax over 2100m in a conditions race on July 31st. Has work ahead and might find a few of these too smart
- **5. AGHIANKIR -** 8th on his debut at Dax in a conditions race on July 31st over 2100m. Others seem better equipped
- **6. FATH ALKHAIR -** Faded in the latter stages when he was 10th at Dax in a conditions race on July 31st over 2100m. He should strip fitter this time and he has place claims
- **7. CHAGALL AL MAURY -** Ran well to be 5th on August 1st in a conditions race at Mont-De Marsan over 2150m on the only start. Progress expected and a bold show likely
- **8. SKY AMBER KRF -** 6th on his last start over 2100m at Dax in a conditions race on July 31st. Among the leading each way options
- **9. ASSA'AF -** Showed talent when he was 5th at Dax over 2100m on his only start on July 31st. One to keep onside
- **10. KHATTA'AB** Unplaced last time, 2nd previously over 1525m at Montauban in a conditions race on June 15th. Warrants respect and can make the top three
- **11. SHAMROUKH -** Unplaced last time out, 4th before that over 1400m at La Teste on July 4th on Debut. Has to improve to be involved
- **12. YAFI -** He was 11th of 14 runners on debut at Dax over 2100m on July 31st on his sole outing. Unlikely to trouble the judge
- **13. ALRAKKAD -** Unraced colt by Gazwan, the dam never ran. From a respected trainer who can ready a newcomer. Nice profile and a market check is advisable
- **14. MABJESS DE BOZOULS -** Unraced colt by Udjess De Bozouls, the dam never ran. Likely to improve for this run unless the betting patterns say otherwise
- **15. GHAL'ID -** Unraced colt by Sivit Al Maury, the dam never raced. Stable runners tend to need a run or two for experience. Watch for the time being



**Summary:** BALHAMBAR (2) showed a good deal of promise on his debut at Mont-De Marsan in mid-July. He was not given a hard introduction, and a better performance can be expected now that he has that experience under his belt. CHAGALL AL MAURY (7) could be the main threat. He will be sharper for a run at Mont-De Marsan in a Class 5 race and can step forward from that outing. ASSA'AF (9) shaped with promise on his only start at Dax late last month, and can have a say. KHATTA'AB (10) heads the rest.

# C2 - PRIX DJEZIKA - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Condition Race - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- **1. EL BNOUD -** Good debut 2nd over 2150m at Mont-de-Marsan on August 1st. She will be wiser for her pleasing run on debut and can get off the mark
- **2. ALYAMAMAH -** Fair effort when 7th on her debut at Mont-de-Marsan over 2150m on August 1st. One to pay attention too
- **3. AMBRA SAINT LON -** 7th on her only start over 1500m at Tarbes on April 19th in a conditions race. Might find a few of these too smart
- **4. SAABHA QARDABIYAH -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1525m at Montauban in a conditions race on June 15th. Unlikely to trouble the principles
- **5. NORIA DE L'AIGLE -** Two unplaced runs, the latter when 8th at La Teste over 1900m in a Group 3 PA race. Needs vast progress to make the frame
- **6. EVERSPRING -** Well beaten on her one run over 2150m in a conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan on August 1st. Look elsewhere
- **7. TURQUOISE -** Placed on two of her three starts, 4th on the latter over 2150m at Mont-de-Marsan on August 1st. Capable of a leading role
- **8. BALSAAM** 7th on her last start over 2100m at Dax in a conditions race on July 31st. Merits consideration
- **9. HAREER -** Unraced filly by Mister Ginoux, the dam never raced. Nice profile and from a respected stable. Monitor the betting for clues
- **10. KATYUSHA AT -** Unraced filly by Al Mamun Monalu, the dam ran twice. Faces a stiff task in what she has shown so far
- **11. ALTESSE DE PEDALIA -** Newcomer by Haandassa, the dam ran once. Unlikely to make a winning debut and is best watched
- **12. MORPHEE DE BOZOULS -** Newcomer by Nieshan, the dam was placed over 2000m. Stable runners tend to know what is required on debut. The betting patterns can be informative
- **13. INSA'AF** Unraced filly by Mahabb, the dam was placed a few times. This filly should improve for her debut run. Others seem more likely

**Summary:** EL BNOUD (1) made a pleasing debut when she was second at Mont-de-Marsan on August 1st over 2150m. She can step forward from that effort and is given the vote ahead of ALYAMAMAH (2), who was back in seventh in the same race. She will be more focused this time. TURQUOISE (7) was fourth in the same race and looks like a solid each-way option. BALSAAM (8) has shown talent on both starts and is one to consider.
