R3 EVREUX [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX YVES SAINT-MARTIN - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Maiden - Flat -
EUR € 10,100**

- 1. STEALITWITHAKISS** - Much improved this year and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2200m on 11 April. Can go one place better
- 2. PINK FEVER** - Has not shown much so far and finished 7th in a claimer at Dieppe over 2400m on 16 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 3. BALTIC JUBILEE** - Well beaten on debut in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1900m on 19 February. Returns from a break and tries the grass
- 4. IXIAS** - Showed some improvement in her second start and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Le Lion-d'Angers over 3000m on 7 May. Should fight it out
- 5. NOTRE ANGLAISE** - Finished 9th on her debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 1 May. Capable of improvement and could make the frame
- 6. INZAIRE** - Has shown little so far and was 8th in a Conditions race at Argentan over 2500m on 9 April. Needs major improvement to win
- 7. MARAKANA** - Has run well in both starts, the latest when third in a Conditions race at Angers over 2300m on 2 May. Can get involved with the finish
- 8. AMARIS** - A three-year-old filly by Wooded out of Alpine Spirit who is making her debut. Her dam won once in 5 starts. Could be a threat

Summary: This looks a superb opportunity for STEALITWITHAKISS (1), who should relish this longer trip and is still improving. MARAKANA (7), third in a decent maiden at Angers, is likely to be the main danger. IXIAS (4) has plenty of stamina and comes from a yard in excellent form so does have claims in this line-up. NOTRE ANGLAISE (5) is entitled to improve on a debut at Saint-Cloud and could be a lively danger.

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C2 - PRIX FREDDY HEAD - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming - Flat - EUR € 15,400

- 1. BLUFF** - Continues to win his races, the latest in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 14 May. In good form and is capable of doubling up
- 2. ZACAPO** - Did not show his best form when 9th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 8 May. Consistent in this division and can contest the finish
- 3. BREIZHY BOY** - A bit of a disappointment when 5th in this division at Le Lion-d'Angers over 1400m on 20 April. Probably prefers the PSF but is not out of it
- 4. WILLY WINNER** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 6th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2400m on 29 April. Dropping in distance could spark improvement but others are preferred
- 5. QUARTZ DU HOULEY** - Showed some improvement when third in a claimer at Chantilly over 1600m on 30 March. Can be competitive once again
- 6. ACTO** - Off form this year and was 13th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 8 May. Has claims in an open looking race
- 7. MAROONED** - Unreliable but was third in a claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 29 April. Has a chance in this line-up
- 8. SATURDAY NIGHT** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a claimer at Deauville over 2000m on 8 April. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 9. ADVERSARY** - Not reliable and finished 12th last time out in this division at Deauville over 1500m on 12 August. Returns from a break and could be the surprise package of the race back on the grass
- 10. AMERICANO** - Has struggled this year and was unplaced in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 30 January. Returns from a break and others are preferred

Summary: Still searching for his best form this year, ACTO (6) nonetheless finds a good opportunity to regain confidence. QUARTZ DU HOULEY (5), who finished strongly on the Chantilly all-weather at the end of March, should be prominent. MAROONED (7), well treated with Malone Favriaux's claim, also commands plenty of respect, BREIZHY BOY (3), the highest-rated runner in the field, is also capable of getting involved with the finish.

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C3 - PRIX MICHELINE LEURSON - HANDICAP CHALLENGE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 - Flat - EUR € 12,800

- 1. VESCO** - Broke a long losing run when scoring in a handicap over this course and distance on 15 April. Tougher task this time but cannot be ruled out
- 2. RIO** - In good form and finished fourth in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1800m on 3 May. Should fight out the finish once again
- 3. OPIANA** - Kept to the PSF this year and was 7th in a handicap at Deauville over 1400m on 8 April. Capable of a surprise back on the turf
- 4. VALHALLA** - Consistent so far and finished third in a Conditions race at Orléans over 2200m on 1 May. Tougher task this time but can make the frame
- 5. LINTERPRETE** - Clearly has his issues and was 11th in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 3 January. Could prefer the PSF but cannot be ruled out
- 6. ASTON CLINTON** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 14 May. Can contest the finish once again
- 7. MICHIGAN FIRE** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in a handicap at Nantes over 1600m on 11 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. MISTER MAEL** - Off form and finished tenth in a handicap at Chantilly over 2000m on 12 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. SAINT AQUILIN** - Not reliable but was third in a handicap at Nantes over 1600m on 11 May. Capable of challenging for top honours
- 10. SWIFT FLIGHT** - May have needed both runs this year and was 11th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 10 May. Others make more appeal
- 11. AURORA BOREALIS** - Yet to win a race and was tenth in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 2 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 12. MOOREA** - Has only been modest this year and was 6th in a handicap at Compiègne over 1400m on 25 April. Not out of it in this line-up
- 13. WARDAMA** - Has struggled in her two starts this year and was 12th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 10 May. Others are preferred
- 14. MISSIRA** - Has only been modest so far and was 5th in a Conditions race at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2000m on 27 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: SAINT AQUILIN (9) showed his well-being at Nantes last time and now encounters very favourable conditions could be the one to be with. ASTON CLINTON (6) is similarly well treated, though a wide draw in stall 11 could make life difficult on a track where it's not always easy to come from off the pace. MOOREA (12), with three runs under her belt, should now be nearing peak fitness. VALHALLA (4) breaks from the inside rail, and that advantage could help offset his lack of experience.

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C4 - PRIX EVREUX PORTES DE NORMANDIE (CHMPT PARIS TURF DES APP. & JJ) - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 9,600

- 1. CAPITOL HILL** - Unreliable and finished tenth in a claimer at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1800m on 17 May. Hard to trust but is capable of playing a minor role
- 2. SPELONCATO** - Has struggled of late and was 12th in a Conditions race at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2000m on 7 May. Drops to a claimer and could score
- 3. HELLO ZAIN** - Has shown little in two starts, the latest when unplaced in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 8 May. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 4. ZELAST** - Unplaced in all three starts so far, the latest when 9th in a Conditions race at Saint-Brieuc over 1700m on 14 May. Others are preferred
- 5. HALSEY** - Yet to win a race and was 6th in a claimer at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 7 May. Capable of doing better and can get into the frame
- 6. CHERE ROSE** - Finished 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Vannes over 1500m on 8 May. Capable of improvement dropping to this level
- 7. AGNESI** - Has struggled this year and was tenth in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 1800m on 16 April. Did well in this division last year and could bounce back and be a lively danger
- 8. ANDRESY** - Needed his last run when 11th in a Conditions race at Dieppe over 1100m on 16 May. Fitter this time and could surprise
- 9. SULEIMA** - Has been well beaten in both starts so far, the latest when tenth in a Conditions race at Nancy over 2500m on 4 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 10. LADY'ARMOR** - Kept to the PSF of late and finished 14th in a handicap at Deauville over 1300m on 30 January. Returns from a break and could be a threat back on the grass
- 11. DARYOZA** - Has shown very little in five starts, the latest when 13th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 1 May. Needs major improvement to score
- 12. DONNALUCATA** - Battling to regain best form and was 8th in a claimer at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1800m on 17 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 13. ARCO DEI FUMI** - A three-year-old filly by Twilight Son out of Abashova who is making her debut. Her dam was unraced in France. Could need the experience

Summary: A very tricky race and there are many that can win it. On the form she showed at Pornichet in early January, SPELONCATO (2) holds leading claims. DONNALUCATA (12) has something to prove in terms of current form, but the addition of blinkers could spark improvement. AGNESI (7) has kept ticking over with a recent run in Slovakia, while CHERE ROSE (6), from a very capable yard, is open to plenty of progress.

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C5 - PRIX BERNARD DE SAINT-SEINE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 10,100

- 1. LARRY WINK** - Did not show much on debut when 12th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 5 May. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 2. L'ANNONCIADE** - Well beaten on debut when 13th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 5 May. Others make more appeal
- 3. STEPHANIE** - Finished 12th on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 29 March. Capable of improvement but others appeal more
- 4. OCALA** - Consistent last year and finished third in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 25 November. Can score if fit enough after a break
- 5. MISS DYA** - Did not show much on debut when 12th in a Conditions race at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2000m on 20 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. KISSES** - Not disgraced when 7th on debut in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 30 April. Likely to improve and is not out of it
- 7. LA BELLE HELENE** - Finished tenth on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 17 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. KARMACOMA** - Well beaten on debut when 12th in a Conditions race at Durtal over 2300m on 22 March. Needs major improvement to score
- 9. VICTORIA COLONIA** - Did not show her best when 9th in a Conditions race at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2000m on 7 May. Did better on debut and is not out of it
- 10. DIVERTIMENTO** - Finished 11th on her debut in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1600m on 11 December. Returns from a break and improvement is likely trying the grass
- 11. INFRAROUGE** - Has only been modest so far and was 6th in a Conditions race at Machecoul over 1650m on 6 April. Can make the frame this time
- 12. STARLIT DESTINY** - A good third last time out at Düsseldorf over 1600m on 25 April. Threatening to win a race and has claims in this line-up
- 13. FIGHTING SPIRIT** - A three-year-old gelding by Saxon Warrior out of Spiritis who is making his debut. His dam won twice in 8 starts. Can be a threat
- 14. SILVER RUSH** - A three-year-old colt by Havana Grey out of Ginseng who is making his debut. His dam won twice in Norway. Could need the experience

Summary: STARLIT DESTINY (12) was a good third in a Listed race in Germany last time and will understandably be strongly fancied back in maiden company. VICTORIA COLONIA (9) may not have handled very soft ground at Le Lion-d'Angers and is worth another chance on the promise of her debut. OCALA (4) will look to confirm her consistency on her first run for new connections. STEPHANIE (3) faces a less demanding field than on her debut and could take a step forward.

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C6 - PRIX THIERRY JARNET - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 13,400

- 1. OYAPOCK** - Battling to find best form and was 15th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 9 May 2025. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
- 2. SI CAPO SI** - On a long losing run and was 12th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 16 April. Better on the PSF but might make the frame
- 3. DENVER CHOP** - Has struggled this year and was 12th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 4. BAWE ISLAND** - Showed some improvement and was 5th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Might play a minor role
- 5. BOMBAY** - Has only been modest of late and was 6th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 4 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. CHUNKA WAKAN** - Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Capable of winning a race like this
- 7. BIG BOOTS** - On a very long losing run but did finish third in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Not out of it
- 8. ABRASSO** - Has not won for some time now but was runner-up in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Can go one place better
- 9. TWO TWO TWO** - Not reliable and was fourth in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Has some claims in this line-up
- 10. SWEET DAMIANA** - Has struggled of late and finished tenth in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 11. MEHANYDREAM** - Finished 6th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. On a long losing run and others are preferred
- 12. KOREM** - Yet to win a race and finished 9th in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 21 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 13. GUALTALLARY** - Has not won a race and finished 11th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Others are much preferred

Summary: A very open handicap. CHUNKA WAKAN (6), who is capable of making the running, can take advantage of a favourable draw. ABRASSO (8) hasn't been as lucky with his stall position, but has enough natural speed to overcome it. If the pace-setters go too hard up front, TWO TWO TWO (9) could pick them off late with a strong finish. SI CAPO SI (2) should strip fitter for his recent comeback run and can also shine.

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C7 - PRIX ALAIN DE ROYER DUPRE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,400

1. **ANDARTIS** - Probably needed his only run of the year when tenth in a handicap at Chantilly over 1200m on 12 May. Fitter this time but needs to find a few lengths to score
2. **REVANCHE** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Very unreliable and others make more appeal
3. **WILD MOOR** - Does not always show her very best but was runner-up in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Can be a threat once again
4. **KING RETURN** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Is capable of contesting the finish
5. **MATCH ANTHEM** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 26 April. Others are preferred
6. **FALBALA** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 20 April. Can be competitive in this open race
7. **LEGAL EAGLE** - Not reliable but was third in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1200m on 14 May. Can be competitive once again
8. **VIBRATO** - Finished 8th in a Conditions race at Compiègne over 1400m on 9 May. Drops in distance but is capable of a surprise
9. **PAPATEOU** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Can make the frame
10. **CHARISMATIC CHICK** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
11. **THE CAT'S** - Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 3 May. Capable of scoring over this distance
12. **GENERALAY** - Battling to regain best form and finished 12th in a handicap at Senonnes-Pouancé over 1350m on 13 March. Fitter this time but others are preferred
13. **MICOLEO** - Off form and finished 10th in a handicap at Vichy over 1600m on 13 May. Seems better on the PSF these days and others make more appeal
14. **EL MADAR** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a handicap at Le Croisé-Laroche over 1100m on 17 May. Has claims on best form

Summary: A very interesting lucky last race. WILD MOOR (3) responded very well to the addition of blinkers and, with the headgear retained and a good draw, should go close. KING RETURN (4) looks ready to produce a big effort at this level but will need the race to fall his way. FALBALA (6), who made a very pleasing return in France, is a major player. EL MADAR (14) is also capable of getting into the mix of things.
