

RACE 1 11:07 PM | EUR16,300 | **PORNICHET** | 2100m

10	TENDER THOUGHTS (FR)	A strong 3rd in Handicap over 1800m at Deauville on 2 December. This is her first run at the track but she is in good form and likes the surface.
2	SHARK SAMURAI (IRE)	Ran 4th in a Qualifying Handicap over 1800m at Deauville on 25 November. Well rated, likes the surface and finished well in his last race.
4	JARRY LORD (FR)	Disappointing 13th in a Handicap over 1800m at Chantilly on 10 November. That was not a great performance but hopefully blinkers fitted for the first time will evoke some improvement.
5	KIEVSKY (FR)	Was 5th in a Qualifying Handicap over 1800m at Deauville on 25 November. He is a consistent performer who should be fighting out the finish.
16	DRIP	A quality 2nd in a Handicap over 2400m at this course on 5 December. That was a decent effort, especially as he was forced to race wide.

RACE 2 11:42 PM | EUR14,400 | **PORNICHET** | 2100m

9	TORTOLA (FR)	A promising 7th in a Handicap over 1600m at this track on 29 November. That was her first run back from a break and will be fitter and better suited to the distance this time.
8	ESKANDANI (FR)	A decent 6th in a Handicap over 1800m at Deauville on 3 December. His rating has dropped significantly and he should be competitive in this company.
11	TWENTY SEVEN JET (FR)	Was a well-beaten 3rd in a Handicap over this course and distance on 22 November. Has a good record at the track but has landed a wide draw.
5	GREAT CHARLIE (FR)	Ran 2nd in a in a Handicap over this course and distance on 22 November. That run puts him in contention but his is drawn widest of all.
14	SPINNING MIST	Won a Handicap over 1800m at Deauville on 3 December. She got up in the shadow of the post to win but will need to deal with her higher rating.

RACE 3 12:17 AM | EUR13,000 | **PORNICHET** | 2100m

2	SEMEUR (FR)	Ran 2nd in a Handicap over 2400m at this track on 5 December. He was beaten 6 lengths in that race but it showed a return to form and he should be right there.
8	BELLA CIAO (FR)	Was 3rd in a Handicap over 2400m at this track on 5 December. She finished behind SEMEUR (2) but she is in good form, is well drawn and should be right there.
5	PEYTON PLACE (FR)	Won a Handicap over 1600m at this course on 29 November. Finished well to get the upper hand and will appreciate the extra ground reunited with jockey Maximilien Justum.
9	CASH RULER (FR)	3rd in a Handicap over this course and distance on 22 November. A solid place getter but fails to get his nose down where it matters. Should be thereabouts.
11	ROCK OF SPIRIT (FR)	Ran 5th in a Handicap over 2400m at this course on 5 December. Finished behind the Top 2 selections but should enjoy the shorter trip.

RACE 4 12:52 AM | EUR16,300 | **PORNICHET** | 1700m

1	GOLDEN ALQA (FR)	A solid 2nd in a Handicap over 1400m at Chantilly on 21 November. She carries top weight but consistently runs well on the sand.
4	ELFENN (FR)	Finished 5th in a Handicap over 2000m at Le Mans on 6 October. She is proven at this level but will be tested on the sand in Australian blinkers this time.
7	PUNICA (FR)	Was 5th in a Handicap over 1600m at Clairefontaine on 24 October. She will be making her sand debut and should appreciate the quicker surface.
15	LOVELY DREAM (FR)	A promising 3rd in a Handicap over this course and distance on 22 November. She should improve on that effort and has winning claims.
3	KEREMET (FR)	A decent 9th in a Handicap over 1200m at Fontainebleau on 13 November. That was a promising effort over a shorter trip and he did win on this track earlier in March. Should run well.

RACE 5 | **1:27 AM** | EUR21,000 | **PORNICHET** | **1700m**

2	ASTOVE (FR)	Encouraging first-up run when finishing 5th over 1600m. Should improve and strip fitter.
6	BLACK SWAN (FR)	Ran a superb race on debut finishing 2nd over 1600m at Lignieres on 29 November and can go one better. Strong each way chance.
4	KOHAKOU (FR)	Holding form well and finished 4th at Toulouse in a Handicap on 23 November. Enters the equation.
5	MARKOS (FR)	Encouraging first-up run when finishing 4th over 1600m. Should improve and strip fitter.
1	SAIF AL LEITH (IRE)	Has placed seven times from eight starts but did let the team down last time. Ignore that, then he will be a serious contender here.
